# ROSTER TURNOVER

Radford will feature plenty of new faces this season after losing seven seniors to graduation, including six four-year members. They are replaced on the roster by six newcomers, including three transfers and three freshmen. Fourth-year junior Justin Cousin and sophomore standout Ed Polite, Jr. lead the group of Highlander returners.

# ED'S ENCORE

After garnering Big South All-Freshmen Team honors last year, Ed Polite, Jr. will look to make an even greater impact during his sophomore campaign. Polite, Jr., was named All-Big South Second Team in the preseason after being among the league leaders in rebounding and blocked shots last year.

# SERIES HISTORY

The teams are meeting for the 12th time overall, but the first since the 2002-03 season when Elon was a Big South member. Radford holds a 7-4 all-time edge, including 5-1 in games at the Dedmon Center.

Elon's lone road victory came in its last visit to the New River Valley in 2003.

# **TEAM NOTES**

#### RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Radford looks for its third home win in as many games this season. The Highlanders shot at least 50 percent from the field in both of the victories.
- Justin Cousin is coming off a strong performance against North Carolina, scoring 14 points and connecting on three 3-pointers.
- Cousin is second on the team with 21 assists, including 13 in the two prior games inside Dedmon.
- Caleb Tanner ranks second among Big South players in 3-point percentage, connecting at a 44 percent clip (21 of 48). He is also tied for third in the conference in made 3's per game with 2.6 per outing.
- Tanner remains the Highlanders' leading scorer at 10.3 ppg. He shot a combined 8 for 12 behind the arc in the two home wins.
- Ed Polite, Jr. now ranks second in the Big South with 9.0 rebounds per game, second in offensive rebounds (3.3 per game) and third in steals (2.3 per
- Randy Phillips stands fifth in the league with 2.5 offensive rebounds per contest.
- Christian Bradford is third on the team with 7.9 ppg, while ranking seventh among conference players with 2.9 assists per contest.
- Donald Hicks has averaged 14.7 ppg in Radford's three victories, reaching double figures in each game, while shooting 53 percent from the field.
- Devonnte Holland and Darius Bolstad are a combined 29 of 42 shooting (69 percent) off the bench.

#### **SCOUTING ELON**

- Elon won six of its first seven games for its best start in 29 years before back-to-back losses at Georgetown (77-74) Sunday and at home against UNC Asheville (78-67) Tuesday.
- The Phoenix were doomed by a poor start in the UNCA loss, shooting just 27 percent in the first half and falling into a 15-point hole.
- Despite its lowest scoring output of the season in that game, Elon is still averaging 82.6 points per game with players in double figures.
- Sophomore forward Tyler Seibring tallied 21 against Asheville to take over the team lead at 12.6 ppg. He also averages a team-best 6.0 rebounds per game.

- Senior guard Luke Eddy, who was second on the team in scoring last season, is averaging 12.1 per game, along with a team-high 40 assists.
- Redshirt junior forward Brian Dawkins is also at 12.1 ppg, while shooting 63 percent from both the field and 3-point range (12 of 19).
- Sophomore guard Steven Santa Ana averages 12.0 ppg, while sophomore Dainan Swoope contributes 10.2 ppg off the bench.
- As a team, the Phoenix have attempted 251 3-pointers in their nine games, shooting 35 percent behind the arc. Overall from the field, they are at 48 percent.

#### POLITE. JR. EARNS PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH HONORS

- Coming off his impressive all-around rookie season in which he earned Big South All-Freshman Team honors, forward Ed Polite, Jr. was selected to the All-Big South preseason second team. He is just the second Highlander under head coach Mike Jones to garner preseason all-conference honors, joining Javonte Green, who did so in 2013 and 2014.
- Polite, Jr. ranked fourth in the Big South with 7.4 rebounds per game last year - second in conference play at 8.2 - and tied for second with 55 blocks. Further, he stood second in the league and 40th in the NCAA with 3.2 offensive rebounds per game,

- third among freshmen nationally.
- As the Highlanders leading returning scorer (8.7 ppg), Polite, Jr. will look to step up his offensive game this season and he has worked hard in the offeseason on expanding his shooting range.
- Meanwhile, he figures to continue to be a force on the defensive end. His 55 blocks last season were the sixth-most in single-season program history.

#### COUSIN NOW THE TEAM LEADER

- Redshirt junior Justin Cousin is the lone player on the roster that has been with the program for four vears.
- As a result, along with increasing his production on both ends of the floor, Cousin will be counted on more than anybody else to provide leadership, both vocally and by example.
- In terms of the box score, Cousin showed he was capable of putting up numbers in spurts last year. He posted double figures in five games and went through a six-game stretch in December and January in which he tallied at least eight in every contest.
- Cousin then broke out in the regular-season finale, scoring a career-high 24 points with seven 3-pointers. He followed up with 13 points and a career-best six rebounds in the first round of the Big South Tournament.





#### **COOPER OUT FOR SEASON**

- Head coach Mike Jones announced that sophomore guard Devin Cooper will miss the rest of the season with a torn ACL.
- Cooper suffered the injury during the first half of the team's game at Mercer on Nov. 22.
- He had started the first four games at point guard, and averaged 6.5 points per contest.

#### **TRANSFER TRIO**

- To offset the graduation losses and provide expereince to a team with just returning scholarship upperclassmen, Mike Jones brought in three junior transfers that will play large roles for the Highlanders this season.
- Randy Phillips has started all seven games at center and is averaging 6.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per contest. He posted averages of 8.4 ppg and 6.5 rpg at East Central CC, with five double-doubles in his last seven games.
- Christian Bradford has started the last three games at point guard in place of Devin Cooper. He leads the team with 21 assists, while averaging 7.1 ppg. Bradford totaled 813 points in two seasons at Marion Military Institute, averaging 18.5 ppg.
- Dominique Williams contributed 6.9 ppg and 4.5 rpg with seven double-figures games at Florida International. Williams has yet to play for the Highlanders due to injury, but is expected to contribute on the win when healthy.

#### **TAKING ON THE CHALLENGE**

 After picking up impressive non-conference wins at Georgetown and Penn State last year, Radford is challenging itself even more with its pre-Big South

- slate this year.
- The Highlanders face road matchups at Wake Forest and defending national runner-up North Carolina of the ACC and the Big 12's West Virginia.
- Radford also will take on formidable mid-major foes, traveling to Akron, Mercer and UNC Wilmington, playing neutral-site games against Georgia Southern and Stetson and hosting Elon and VMI.

#### **PLENTY OF AIR TIME**

- A total of eight Highlanders' games this season are scheduled for national or regional TV broadcasts.
- The season opener against Wake Forest aired on ACC Network Extra, while other televised non-conference games include Mercer (ASN), North Carolina (Raycom) and West Virginia (Nexstar).
- Radford will have two Big South games on ESPN3 (at Gardner Webb and vs. Longwood) and two on ASN (vs. High Point and at UNC Asheville).

#### **RU VOTED SIXTH IN BIG SOUTH**

- Radford was picked sixth in the Big South Conference's preseason poll comprised of votes from head coaches and media members.
- Winthrop was the unanimous favorite in the league, earning all 30 first-place votes.
- The Highlanders placed seventh in tightly bunched conference last year with a 9-9 record.

#### **ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 14 players representing six different states and the District of Columbia.
- Virginia is home to five of the members of this year's squad. The remaining nine is comprised of three from Maryland, two from North Carolina and one

each from Georgia, Ohio, Mississippi and the District of Columbia.

On June 14, 2011, Radford University officials announced the hiring of former VCU assistant coach Mike Jones as the Highlanders' seventh head men's basketball coach.

After taking over a program with just one win in the season prior to him arriving on campus, Jones has Radford contending again in the Big South while competing against the nation's top conferences.

Last year, the Highlanders posted a double-overtime season-opening win at Georgetown and followed up with a victory at Penn State, the program's first over a Big 10 opponent.

During the 2013-14 and 2014-15 campaigns, Jones guided Radford to back-to-back 22-win seasons and its first-ever postseason victories in the CBI.

The recent success can be attributed to the foundation laid in year one with Big South All-Freshmen selections Javonte Green and R.J. Price. Green, who was Jones' first All-Big South performer, and Price spearheaded the Highlanders' resurgence to the top of the league.

Under Jones' tutelage, Green developed into one of the all-time greats in Radford men's basketball history. He finished his career second in scoring, first in rebounding, first in steals, second in free throws made, second in field goals made. Price left RU ranked fourth all-time in scoring.

Jones spent the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons at VCU, which included a magical run to the 2011 Final Four with wins over USC, Georgetown, Purdue,

Florida State and Kansas. While on Shaka Smart's staff, the Rams posted 55 wins over the final two seasons Jones was on the staff. Prior to his second coaching stop in Virginia at VCU, Jones served a six-year stint on Dennis Felton's bench at Georgia from 2003-09. In 2008, Georgia advanced to the NCAA Tournament when the sixth-seeded Bulldogs won four games in three days on an SEC Champi-

While at Georgia, Jones made a name for himself when Rivals.com selected him as one of the nation's Top-25 recruiters in 2005. Jones also previously

worked under John Beilein at Richmond from 2000-02 and during the early stages of Beilein's rebuilding project at West Virginia in 2002-03.

Jones was a four-year standout at Howard, where he forged a connection with fellow Howard alumnus, Felton, who he calls the biggest influence on his coaching career.

Jones' father, Jimmy, was a star guard in the ABA from 1967-74. In 1974, Jimmy Jones signed with the Washington Bullets in the NBA, where he remained until 1977.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

North Carolina 95, Radford 50 (12/4/16)

CHAPEL HILL, N.C. - Playing at North Carolina for the first time in program history, the third-ranked Tar Heels were too much for the Radford men's basketball team at the start Sunday afternoon, dominating the first 10 minutes on the way to a 95-50 victory.

Radford did get on scoreboard first when Donald Hicks hit a jumpshot from just inside the arc on the team's opening possession. However, coming off its loss at Indiana and playing at home for the first time in more than two weeks, North Carolina came out firing with an expected initial surge. It began from an unlikely source though, as sophomore guard Kenny Williams scored 14 points in the first 4:40 for a quick 18-4 lead. Williams, who came in averaging 5.8 points per game, made his first five shots, including four 3-pointers.

The rest of the Tar Heels continued that momentum as the team combined to go 14 for 21 from the field and 6 for 11 from behind the arc boosting the advantage to 34-9 at the 9:57 mark of the half.

After the shaky start, though, Radford picked it up offensively and played basically even the rest of the half. Caleb Tanner got the Highlanders going with five points on a jumper and 3-pointer before Justin Cousin got hot, hitting 3 of 5 shots, 2 of 3 3-pointers and all three of his free throw attempts to tally 11 points. His second trey brought the Highlanders within 38-22 with 4:59 left before the break. It was a 17-point margin before Radford went the last 2:47 of the half without a field goal and North Carolina pushed the lead back up to 51-27.

#### INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- Cousin finished with a team-high 14 points on 4 of 9 from the field and 3 of 7 from long range.
- Christian Bradford also reached double figures, scoring 11 of his 13 in the second half, while Tanner totaled eight points.
- Radford shot a decent 37 percent (10 of 27) in the opening half, but for a rare occasion this year fell off in the second 20 minutes, making just 9 of 35 attempts, finishing at 31 percent for the game.
- Devonnte Holland posted a team-high six rebounds, including four on the offensive end. Ed Polite, Jr. was limited to his lowest total of the season, grabbing five.
- North Carolina, which came in ranked third in the nation in rebounding, dominated once again in that category with a 52-29 advantage.
- The Tar Heels were 21 of 37 (57 percent) from the field in the first half and finished at 52 percent overall.
- Williams, a native of Midlothian, Va., finished with a career-high 19 points on 7 of 10 shooting, including 5 of 6 from beyond the arc. He had made 8 of his 20 3-point attempts this season coming into the game.
