### KEY STORYLINES

#### HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 686-542 record during that span. Fourth-year head coach **Mike McGuire** is the program's seventh all-time head coach. The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

#### POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina. The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament. Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008. RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

## TEAM NOTES

### HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- The Highlanders cruised to a dominating 67-39 Education Day win over Western Carolina on Thursday. Radford raced out to an early 21-8 lead in the first quarter and never looked back.
- Radford's offense was paced by a season-high 15 points from freshman **Khiana Johnson** and a 14-point effort by **Jayda Worthy**.
- Johnson finished with her third double-digit scoring performance with a 15-point effort on 5 of 14 shooting from the field, including two 3-pointers. Johnson finished 3 of 4 from the charity stripe.
- The freshman paced the Highlanders in assists for the first time on the season, finishing with four.
- Worthy chipped in 14 points on 6 of 8 shooting, nearly missing her second straight double-double with nine rebounds. After missing the previous two games, **Janayla White** finished with 11 rebounds and nine points in only 17 minutes of action.
- Sydney Nunley** joined White with 11 boards. Nunley has corralled 24 rebounds in the last two games, bringing her season average to 6.6 per game.
- Destinee Walker** was unable to keep her streak of six consecutive games of double-digit scoring and three-game stretch of double-doubles. Walker finished with eight points and six rebounds.
- Walker ranks second in the Big South in scoring (15.0) and rebounding (8.0).
- Radford has won the rebound battle five times on the season, finishing with a 50-28 edge over Western Carolina. The 50 rebounds are a season-high and the first time the Highlanders have collected 5-plus rebounds since Feb. 23, 2016 at Winthrop.
- The Highlanders rank third in the Big South with 41.7 rebounds per game, however Radford leads the league in holding opponents to only 33.3 rebounds per game. Through seven games, Radford holds an 8.4 rebound margin.
- Head coach **Mike McGuire** enters the contest 18-19 against teams from North Carolina.

### SCOUTING WAKE FOREST

- Radford is the only Big South team on the Demon Deacons schedule for the 2016-17 season. They will however play two more Commonwealth foes, hosting VCU on Dec. 21 and traveling to James Madison on Dec. 31.
- Wake Forest compiled a five-game winning streak earlier in the season, but had it snapped in a 70-63 loss at Seton Hall.
- The Demon Deacons have outscored opponents 613-534 on the season for a +8.8 scoring margin (68.1-59.3).
- Four players enter the contest averaging double-figures: Ariel Stephenson (15.6), Amber Campbell (14.7), Elisa Penna (11.9) and Milan Quinn (11.6).
- Stephenson ranks 11th in the Atlantic Coast Conference in scoring, while Campbell follows in 13th.
- Quinn nearly averages a double-double with 9.9 rebounds per game, best in the ACC. She also ranks sixth with a .585 field goal percentage, shooting 48 for 52 from the floor.
- The senior has collected four double-doubles on the season, ranking 22nd in the country.
- Wake Forest is averaging 43.1 rebounds per game, holding opponents to 33.3 per contest.
- The 43.1 rebounds per game are a league best.
- Of Wake Forest's 388 rebounds, 263 have come on the defensive side of the ball for 29.2 defensive rebounds per game, which leads the ACC.

### DYNAMIC DESTINEE

- Destinee Walker** is off to a sensational start, averaging 15.0 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.
- Walker ranks second in the Big South in scoring and rebounding.
- Walker scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 22-point effort in a Dec. 4 win over UNC Greensboro.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10-plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her

first career start in the game.

- Collected three straight double-doubles, including back-to-back 20-point efforts (Nov. 26-Dec. 4).
- Leads the Big South with a .571 field goal percentage.

### ADIÓS AISHA

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate **Aisha Foy**, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time.
- Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts, Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

### NO SID = WIN

- The Highlanders have played four road contests entering the matchup with Wake Forest.
- Women's basketball sports information director Jordan Childress has been unable to travel to three out of the four contests.
- With Childress in attendance for the season opener at George Mason, Radford dropped the contest 70-56, shooting 36 percent from the field.
- The Highlanders went 3-0 in games against Davidson, UNC Greensboro and Appalachian State without Childress at the scorers table.
- Radford has outscored opponents 171-148 without Childress, averaging 57 points per game.
- The Highlanders are shooting 39.6 percent overall and 31.8 percent from 3-point land.



## ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by **Claudia Quevedo**.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

## WHAT A TURNAROUND

- Head coach **Mike McGuire**'s is 39-28 over the last two seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season.
- That 2007-08 season saw Radford win 23 contests.

## CRUNCH TIME

- Radford played in seven games that were decided by three points or less since the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders have posted a 5-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach **Mike McGuire**, Radford is 15-8 in games decided by five points or less.

## BSC PRESEASON FIRST TEAM

- White earns preseason first team honors after finishing the 2015-16 season as the only Big South performer to average a double-double. The Virginia Beach, Va., product averaged 11.9 points and 10.0 rebounds per game a season ago, earning Big South first team honors in the process.
  - White scored in double-figures in 19 games, while grabbing double-digit rebounds 14 times a season ago. In addition to averaging a double-double, White led the Big South in field-goal percentage (.571).

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade.

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

turnaround in the nation.

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament

championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.
