COASTAL VS RADFORD

• Coastal Carolina and Radford have met on 92 previous occasions with the Chanticleers owing a 65-27 advantage, including a 27-10 mark in Radford.

• Radford has won two straight, including a 5-4 win in last year's Big South Championship, and have won six of the last nine.

• While Radford has the upper hand of late, Coastal won 32 of 36 meetings from April 11, 1989 to April 19, 2013.

CCU #1 SOS - CCU IN THE POLLS

• Coastal, with an RPI of 18, is coming off a loss at #6 South Carolina. However, the Chants moved up to take over the top spot on the D1Baseball Strength of Schedule. Trailing CCU is Florida State, Florida and South Carolina.

• Coastal Carolina was ranked in four of the five polls early in the season, thanks in part to a win over defending national champion Virginia. However, Coastal was 5-5 after 10 games and dropped out of all but one poll, PerfectGame.org. The Chants have stayed in the 20-

- Coached first team Academic All-Americans Austin Fleet (2010), Tucker Frawley (2012) and Justin Creel (2013), as well as eight players that who earned a total of 12 Academic All-District honors
- Coastal Carolina is the only Big South team to win 50 games in a season (a feat accomplished four times) and CCU set school and Big South records by winning 55 games in 2010. The 55 wins also led the NCAA as did Coastal's .846 winning percentage (55-10)
- In 2010, Coastal became the first Big South team to go undefeated in league play (25-0) and go undefeated in the Big South tournament (4-0) in the same year
- Had 62 players (53 at Coastal) drafted and 89 players sign professional contracts, including 17 in the top 10 rounds at Coastal
- Rico Noel (56) and Scott Woodward (55) went 1-2 in the NCAA in stolen bases in 2010, just the second time teammates had done so. Noel also led the NCAA in stolen bases in 2009 (48). Ryan McGraw led the NCAA with 63 stolen bases in 2002, and Mike Costanzo led the NCAA in both walks (68) and walks per game (1.03) in 2005.

BECKWITH NAMED BIG SOUTH PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Coastal Carolina junior Andrew Beckwith (Blythewood) was named the Crons Brand Big South Pitcher of the Week.
- Beckwith made relief appearances in three of CCU's four games and earned two victories for the Chanticleers, as he totaled seven innings with five strikeouts.
- In a 4-3 victory over The Citadel on Wednesday, the right-hander did not factor in the decision, but his performance was a key to the win. Beckwith entered the game with CCU clinging to a 4-3 lead, runners on second and third and just one out. The Citadel tried a safety squeeze and Beckwith threw out the potential tying run at the plate before getting a strikeout to end the threat. He then pitched a 1-2-3 eighth inning with a strikeout before turning the game over to Mike Morrison, who got the save.
- In the first game of the Gardner-Webb series, Beckwith got the win in relief as he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings. He entered the game in the fifth with CCU trailing 4-3, the bases loaded and two out. Beckwith got a ground out back to him to end the inning. CCU scored six runs in the bottom of the fifth and never looked back. Overall, Beckwith retired seven of the nine batters faced.
- In the Gardner-Webb finale, Beckwith also got the win to lead CCU to a sweep. He pitched three scoreless innings. He entered in the fifth with CCU winning to a 5-1, bases loaded and no outs. He got a strikeout before allowing a RBI single to make the score 5-2 in CCU's favor. With bases still loaded, Beckwith induced an inning-ending double play to limit the damage. Beckwith allowed a two-out hit in a scoreless sixth and, after a GWU batter reached on an error in the seventh, he got another inning-ending double play while CCU pushed its advantage to 10-2 before he exited.

PREVIOUS CCU HONORS:

- TYLER CHADWICK** was named the **NCBWA National Hitter of the Week** and the **Big South Player of the Week** (April 28). Chadwick batted .583 (7-for-12) for the week, but posted a .700 (7-for-10) average in the three-game sweep versus Stetson with 12 RBI, six runs scored, three home runs and a 1.333 slugging percentage.
- G.K. YOUNG** was named **Big South Player of the Week** for the opening weekend. He was 6-for-12 with seven RBI. He hit a two-run double versus Appalachian State in the opener and a two-run home run versus Virginia while going 3-for-5 with two RBI in a loss to NC State.
