## HISTORY LESSON

Radford is in its 46th season as a varsity women's basketball program. RU has compiled a 688-544 record during that span. Fourth-year head coach Mike McGuire is the program's seventh all-time head coach.

The Highlanders have captured five Big South regular-season titles and nine tournament titles, with the last coming in 1996.

## POSTSEASON PLAY

RU qualified for the WNIT for the third time in program history last season, falling to East Carolina. The Highlanders have a 2-3 WNIT record, picking up a pair of wins in the 1989 tournament.

Prior to 2015, Radford last appeared in the WNIT in 2008. RU has made six postseason appearances in all (three WNITs and three NCAA Tournaments).

## A WIN WOULD...

Give Radford its first Big South opening win since a 81-69 decision at UNC Asheville on Jan. 3, 2011.

Give Radford five straight home wins over Gardner-Webb.

Be Radford's first Big South opening date home win since Jan. 5, 2009. The Highlanders defeated Gardner-Webb 82-74.

Nine underclassmen are set to don the Red and White in 2016-17, Radford ranks fourth in youngest rosters in the Big

Radford leads the Big South and ranks seventh nationally in field-goal percentage defense, holding opponents to only 32.6 shooting from the floor.



Radford's ranks 25th in the country in scoring defense, holding opponents to a mere 55.0 points per game.

# TEAM NOTES

#### **HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS**

- Radford's last Big South opening win came six years ago to the day (Jan. 3, 2011) with an 81-69 decision at UNC Asheville. The Highlanders last home win on the Big South opening date was against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 5, 2009 in an 82-74 victory.
- The Highlanders wrapped up non-conference play on Dec. 31 in a 78-51 New Year's Eve win over Concord. The win is the 50th of head coach Mike McGuire's career. McGuire is 50-53 during his time as the headman of the Highlanders.
- In the contest, Radford placed four players in double-figures for the second time on the season. Destinee Walker (16), Jayda Worthy (13), Claudia Quevedo (12) and Janayla White (11) led the Highlanders in scoring.
- Walker finished with her ninth game of 10-plus points and led the Highlanders in scoring for the eighth time on the season.
- The sophomore is tied for second in the league with 14.5 points per game, while leading the Big South in field goal percentage (.532) and ranking third in free throw percentage (.795).
- Worthy collected her second double-double on the season and the eighth of her career, corralling 10 rebounds. She finished with three assists, giving her six games with three-plus assists.
- The 10 rebounds improve her average to 5.9 per contest, which ranks 12th best in the league.
- White stuffed the box score on Saturday. The junior grabbed nine rebounds, blocked a career-high six shots and finished with three steals. She now has eight steals in the last three games.
- With the six blocks, White has 126 in her career, needing 14 more to move into a tie for second all-time.
- In addition, the junior leads the Big South with 8.4 rebounds per game.
- As a team, Radford has shot over 40 percent from the field on six occasions after turning in a 46.3 field goal percentage last time out.
- Radford's defense ranks inside the Top 50 nationally in several defensive categories. The hardnosed defense stands in seventh in field goal percentage defense with a 32.6 clip.

- In the other categories; Radford ranks 14th in fewest fouls committed (170), 19th in defensive rebounds per game (30.1), 25th in scoring defense (54.6) and 49th in blocked shots per game (4.8).
- In games played in the Dedmon Center, Radford has outscored opponents 291-193.

#### **SCOUTING GARDNER-WEBB**

- The Runnin' Bulldogs have three common opponents with the Highlanders. Gardner-Webb defeated Western Carolina 68-60 on Dec. 19.
- In the other two common opponent games, the Runnin' Bulldogs dropped a 72-67 decision to Appalachian State on Nov. 12 and a 76-42 matchup to Virginia Tech on Dec. 5.
- Gardner-Webb holds a 2-4 record on the road.
- With only one player averaging double-digits, Gardner-Webb has eight players averaging five or more points per game.
- Tierra Huntsman leads the team with 14.2 points per game, ranking fourth in the league. The redshirt junior also dishes out 2.5 assists per game.
- Huntsman is shooting 42 percent from behind the arc, making 21 of 50 attempts.
- Evelyn Adebayo (8.2 ppg) and Alexus Hill (7.2 ppg) round out the top three scorers for the Runnin' Bulldogs.
- Leading the team in rebounds, Charlisa Jenkins has grabbed 79 rebounds for 7.2 per contest. Adebayo follows with 6.2 rebounds per game with 29 of her 68 rebounds coming on the offensive glass.
- Gardner-Webb sports nine players averaging two or more rebounds per contest. The Runnin' Bulldogs rank second in the league and 49th nationally with 42.6 rebounds per game.
- As a team, Gardner-Webb has only collected 82 steals. Lovely Locklear has totaled 20 for 1.8 per game.

#### **THE SERIES**

- The two foes split the season series in 2015-16 in narrow fashion as the first matchup was decided by four points with the second coming in a three-point decision.
- Radford leads the all-time series 11-9 with a 6-3 record in the Dedmon Center.

The Highlanders have won the last four matchups at home.

#### **DYNAMIC DESTINEE**

- Destinee Walker continues her blistering start to the season, scoring double-figures in all but two games.
- Ranking tied for second in the Big South with 14.5 points per game, she has tallied 159 points in 11 games, second most in the league.
- Walker leads the conference with a 53.2 fieldgoal percentage, ranking 56th in the country. The next closest player to Walker in field-goal percentage in the Big South is Charleston Southern's Ke'Asia Jackson with a 43.1 shooting clip.
- Walker is 59 for 111 from the field, including 10 of 26 from 3-point land.
- In addition to scoring, Walker ranks third in rebounding with 7.3 per game.
- Walker scored double-digits in the first six games to start the season.
- Set a career mark with a 22-point effort in a Dec. 4 win over UNC Greensboro.
- Walker entered the season having scored 10plus points in only one game.
- In win over Davidson on Nov. 19, Walker played a career-high 34 minutes, earning her first career start in the game.
- Collected three straight double-doubles, including back-to-back 20-point efforts (Nov. 26-Dec. 4).

#### **CRUNCH TIME**

- Radford played in seven games that were decided by three points or less since the 2015-16 campaign.
- The Highlanders have posted a 5-2 mark in those games.
- Under head coach Mike McGuire, Radford is 15-8 in games decided by five points or less.

#### **ADIÓS AISHA**

- Radford will need to fill the void left by 2016 graduate Aisha Foy, a two-time Big South Conference honoree.
- A threat from behind the 3-point line, Foy made 129, ranking fifth all-time. Foy finished her career with a .351 3-point field goal percentage, ranking fifth in program history.
- She led the Highlanders in scoring during the 2015-16 season, averaging 12.2 points per game.
- Appearing in 113 games with earning 82 starts,
   Foy finished her career with 955 points.
- Named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's "So You Want to be a Coach" program.
- Current graduate assistant at Southeast Missouri St.

#### **ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- RU's 2016-17 roster features 13 players representing eight states and two countries.
- There are four players from Virginia and two from Ohio. Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Illinois and West Virginia have one player apiece, while Spain is represented on the international scale by Claudia Quevedo.
- Radford has one redshirt senior, three juniors, two redshirt sophomores, four sophomores, one redshirt freshman and two freshmen
- The Highlanders boast five players six feet or taller.

#### **WHAT A TURNAROUND**

- Head coach Mike McGuire's is 40-29 over the last three seasons after going 7-23 during his first season.
- In 2015-16, the Highlanders went 18-13, the most wins in a season since the 2007-08 season. Radford won 23 games that season

Radford University officials introduced Mike McGuire on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 as the Highlanders' seventh NCAA head women's basketball coach in program history.

Widely recognized as one of the up-and-coming head coaches in the country, McGuire has quickly laid a solid foundation for the program moving forward.

Despite a 2015-16 season ravaged by injuries, McGuire steered Radford to its most wins (18) since the 2007-08 season. The Highlanders, who tied for third in the Big South regular-season standings, advanced to the semifinals of the Big South tournament for the first time since 2013.

Defense was the cornerstone of Radford's success. The Highlanders concluded the season ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense (.333), 14th in scoring defense (53.3) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6).

Individually, two Radford players (Janayla White and Aisha Foy) were named to the All-Big South first team for the first time since 1992-93.

In just his second season at the helm (2014-15), McGuire guided the Highlanders to their third WNIT in school history. Radford, which finished with a 17-14 overall record, including a 14-6 Big South ledger, finished tied for second in the Big South regular-season standings. It was the Highlanders' highest finish in the conference standings since 2010-11.

McGuire's work did not go unnoticed as the conference's 11 head coaches selected him Big South Coach of the Year, marking the sixth head coach in program history to earn the accolade

The Highlanders' 10-win improvement from the 2013-14 season to the 2014-15 season was tied for the sixth-best

In addition to his coaching responsibilities, McGuire is the Big South Conference Captain, a role he will serve until 2018. He is also the women's basketball head coach representative from the Big South Conference on the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee, which is a three-year commitment.

Before Radford, McGuire spent 2008-13 as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond where he helped lead the Spiders to five straight postseason berths and a 101-60 overall record. For the second consecutive season in 2012-13, Florida Basketball Magazine named McGuire one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, and at the conclusion of the 2011-12 season, National Basketball Insider recognized him as one of the Top-14 Mid-Major assistant coaches in the country.

The Spiders posted three 20-win seasons during his tenure, including an appearance in the Atlantic 10 Tournament championship game in 2009.

At Richmond, McGuire served as the scouting coordinator. He was also charged with scheduling and the recruitment and the development of post players in the program. He also served as the academic mentor for perimeter players.

Prior to his move to Richmond, McGuire led Hidden Valley High School (Roanoke, Va.) to back-to-back Virginia Group AA state basketball titles in 2007 and 2008. He posted a 55-5 overall record while leading the Titans.

McGuire is a 2000 graduate of Roanoke College where he spent one season after matriculating as the assistant coach for the men's basketball program. In that role, he served as the recruiting coordinator and junior varsity head coach. The Maroons posted a 17-10 record in his only season as an assistant.

McGuire and his wife, Nataleigh, reside in Riner with their daughters, Harper and Ellie.


