A NEW SEASON IS UPON US

- Radford enters its 33rd season as a varsity baseball program. The Highlanders have compiled a 709-905 during that span.
- After putting together three straight 30-win seasons, including a program best 45-16 season in 2015, Radford finished the 2016 season with a 19-39 record.
- Radford finished the 2016 season with five wins in its last seven games.
- The Highlanders failed to win double-digit Big South games for the first time since 2008, finishing with a 9-15 record.

PATIENCE PAYS OFF

- Radford has collected double-digit hits in seven of its last 10 games.
- The number 11 appears to be possible as the Highlanders have finished with 11 hits in four games.
- In the series against Rider, Radford went 43 for 107 at the dish, driving in 32 runs on 10 extra base hits.
- In the 107 at bats, Radford only struck out

26 times.

- Holding a .204 batting average on March 5, Radford has improved its average to .266.
- The Highlanders went 27 for 61 with runners in scoring position against Rider

RADFORD WITH TWO OUTS

- Radford is 49 for 214 with two outs.
- Matt Roth** leads the team with 11 hits in the situation, while **Spencer Horwitz** follows with 10.
- The duo has five two-out RBIs each.
- Kyle Butler** is 5 for 14 with six RBIs in the situation.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Radford sports a roster of 24 underclassmen.
- Has the only first round MLB Draft pick in Big South history. **Eddie Butler** was the 46th overall selection of the Colorado Rockies in the 2012 draft.
- Butler was dealt to the World Champion Chicago Cubs on February 1, 2017.

HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

ABOUT LAST SEASON

- After putting together three 30-win seasons, including a program-best 45 wins in 2015, Radford saw its wins' total dip below 20 for the first time since 2007.
- The Highlanders failed to win double-digit Big South games for the first time since 2008, finishing with a 9-15 record.
- Radford ended the 2016 season on a high note, winning five of its last seven games, including a 2-2 record in the Big South Tournament.
- The 2016 Big South Tournament witnessed the Highlanders become the first eighth seed to win two games in the tournament and advance to the semifinals.
- The Highlanders return 17 letterwinners from a season ago, losing 14. Radford returns six starters from a season ago.
- Radford returns seven position players with 20-plus starts from the 2016 season.

HIGHLANDER HIGHLIGHTS

- Last time out, Radford had four players collect multi-hit games. (**Adam Whitacre, Kyle Butler, Jonathan Gonzalez, Matt Roth**)
- Butler continues his recent tear at the plate, recording 15 hits in the last nine games. He ranks third in the Big South with a .386 batting average. Butler leads the team with six doubles and is tied for the team lead with 13 RBIs.
- Gonzalez and Roth are both riding an 11-game hit streak. Roth possesses a 16-game on-base streak, while holds a 13-gamer.
- In addition, Whitacre is working on a seven-game hit streak, providing the Highlanders a strong option at the top of the order. In 42 leadoff opportunities, Whiteacre has reached base safely 14 times, boosting a .372 on base percentage.
- Zach Ridgely** continues to shine on Friday nights for the Highlanders, ranking seventh in the Big

South with 29.2 innings pitched and eighth with 25 strikeouts. The junior is slowly closing in on joining the program's Top 10 in career strikeouts, needing 29 more for a 10th place tie.

- Spencer Horwitz** has been swinging a hot bat of late, racking up seven RBIs in the last five games. On Monday, Horwitz was named the Big South's Freshman of the Week. Owing a 14-game on-base steak, Horwitz ranks second on the team with seven multi-hit games.
- Radford ranks fifth in the Big South with 12 home runs, while also ranking fifth in RBIs with 94 on the year.
- Austin Gerber** has been consistently a strong option out of the Highlanders bullpen this season. He is the conference leader in walk-to-strikeout ratio (14.00) and walks allowed per nine innings (0.43)
- Radford doesn't mind playing a little small ball, ranking 21st nationally and second in the Big South in sacrifice bunts this season. (18)
- Committing 37 errors on the season, Radford has limited its miscues to seven over the last seven games.
- Maintaining a .204 team batting average on March 5, Radford now holds a .266 clip, which is third best in the league.

SCOUTING APPALACHIAN ST.

- Right-hander Cody Wager is fresh off of tossing a gem against Charleston Southern on March 18. In 8.1 innings of work; Wager yielded only three hits, allowing no runs in the win. He punched out 10 Buccaneers, walking only one batter.
- Wager also leads the Big South in strikeouts with 35 on the season, earning Big South Pitcher of the Week for his efforts against Charleston Southern.
- The Lancers' pitching staff is deeper than just Wager, sporting Big South ERA leader Michael

Catlin. Catlin holds a 1.21 ERA in 22.1 innings pitched.

- Michael Osinski has made steady contributions all season, leading the team with a .330 batting average. The junior shortstop also leads the Big South with 25 RBIs.
- Outfielder Sammy Miller is second on the team in batting average (.322), while leading the Lancers with 17 runs scored.
- Miller and senior Alex Lewis are tied for the team lead with seven doubles on the season.
- As a team, Longwood ranks 10th nationally with 10 triples in 21 games. The Lancers also rank second in the Big South with 102 RBIs.
- Longwood is second in the Big South for stolen bases with 31. Of the 31 steals, Miller has contributed 11 of the thefts, good enough for second in the league.

RADFORD PICKED 7TH IN BSC

- Radford received 50 points and were selected to finish seventh in the 2017 Big South Conference Coaches' Preseason Poll
- The Highlanders received two fourth place votes and five sixth place votes.
- Zack Ridgely** finished third in Big South Preseason Pitcher of the Year voting, racking up eight points on two first-place votes.

Head Coach :: 10th Season at Radford

Joe Raccuia, a 1995 Radford graduate, returned to his roots on July 10, 2007 when he was named the fifth head coach in Radford baseball history. Entering his ninth season as the head man for the Highlanders, a Radford uniform has been a winning fit for Raccuia. Throughout his 13 seasons in a Highlander uniform, Raccuia has been apart of 342 total wins as a player (1994-95), assistant coach (1996) and head coach (2008-present), better than 49 percent of the program's all-time victories dating back to 1985.

Raccuia's most successful season in a Radford uniform came during an historic 2015 season as the Highlanders finished with a 45-16 record, setting a new school record in wins. The season also saw the programs first Big South regular season and conference championships, while earning a trip the NCAA Nashville Regional. In the regional, RU went 2-2, including wins over No. 3 Indiana and No. 4 Lipscomb.

RU finished Big South play with a 20-4 record, earning Raccuia the Big South Coach of the Year award. Raccuia becomes only the third RU head coach to earn the honor. Including a record six all-conference selections in 2015, 32 of Raccuia's players have earned all-conference honors.

The 2015 squad posted a .289/.386/.425 line, while leading the Big South with 122 doubles and 362 RBI. The Highlander bats were led by Big South first-teamers Josh Gardiner and Patrick Marshall. Gardiner narrowly missed the Big South batting title, finishing second with a .368 average, while leading the league with a .451 on-base percentage. Marshall led the conference and set a new RU single-season record with 59 RBI. Big South second team member Hunter Higginson finished with 25 doubles, leading the Big South and setting a new RU season record. Higginson finished second behind Marshall in RBI, driving in 53 runs. Shane Johnsonbaugh earned Big South second team honors after leading RU in hits (76), runs scored (50) and walks (38).

Radford can attest their 2015 success to their pitching staff and bullpen. The Highlanders finished with a 3.95 ERA, a new single-season record. RU

ranked second in the Big South, holding opposing batters to a .255 average. The Highlanders only allowed 276 runs, their lowest since the 2000 season. Big South First Team member, Ryan Meisinger was named a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year award after leading the NCAA in saves with 17. Meisinger finished his career with a 2.60 ERA, a new RU career mark. Michael Boyle earned Big South First Team honors after leading the Big South in wins (10) and finishing second in innings pitched (105.1). With the 10 wins, Boyle became the first Highlander to lead the league in wins, while setting a new RU single-season record.

The 2015 senior class concluded their careers with a 137-93-1 overall record, the most wins for a four-year class in program history. The group led RU to three consecutive 30-plus win seasons.

Getting players to the professional ranks has been a staple for Raccuia during his time as the headman. Raccuia has oversaw 10 players drafted in the MLB First Year Player Draft, with three players signing non-drafted free agent contracts.

In 2012, Eddie Butler was the 46th overall selection of the Colorado Rockies in the draft - the highest draft selection in Radford University program history and the first Big South Conference player to be selected in the draft's first round. On

June 6, 2014, Butler became the third Radford player to make it to the big leagues with his MLB debut for the Colorado Rockies.

Raccuia's success has come both on and off the field of play, including facilities, player development, recruiting and academics.

On his watch, two major baseball facilities have opened: the on-campus hitting facility and RU Baseball Stadium. The stadium, which opened on April 8, 2011, became the cornerstone of Radford's program thanks in part to Raccuia's extensive fund-raising and planning efforts. The project went from conception in the Fall of 2010, to completion during the 2011 season as a result of his work. Raccuia also spearheaded the work done to the playing surface and dugouts in time for the 2010 season. All of the improvements to the facilities marked the first major capital upgrades since Raccuia's playing days at RU.

On the academic side, the program has earned several honors under Raccuia. The 2008 season saw Alex Gregory collect the second Big South Scholar-Athlete of the Year award in program history. During the Raccuia reign, RU has placed seven players on the Big South All-Academic Team and two on the CoSIDA Academic All-District team.
