# FEATURED NOTES/STORIES

## SERIES HISTORY: LONGWOOD

- It's fair to say the Highlanders have dominated the overall series with Longwood, coming out victorious in 27 out of 34 meetings between the two programs. Radford has won each of the last 10 games against the Lancers, last taking a loss on Feb. 27, 2016.
- The duo of Commonwealth schools first clashed on Jan. 25, 1977 and played frequently until 1985 when a 20-year hiatus began. Their rivalry resumed in the 2000's and they most recently played each other on back-to-back days in December 2020.
- The Highlanders came out on top in both games, moving their all-time record against Longwood inside the Dedmon Center to 16-1.

## SCOUTING THE LANCERS

- If you read the "Series History" section above, you may be under the impression that Radford is the clear favorite in Wednesday's game, but those numbers simply aren't representative of the Longwood team that is coming into the Dedmon Center this time around.
- Fourth year head coach Griff Aldrich has the Lancers rolling to an 8-5 start to the season, one of its best in recent memory. Longwood leads the Big South in scoring offense (80.3 ppg), and scoring margin (+16.8) while dominating the boards with a +9.8 rebounding margin that is more than twice as much as the next closest team. To top it off, the Lancers also lead the league in turnover margin at +3.15.
- Senior guard Isaiah Wilkins leads the team with 12.1 points, 5.7 rebounds, and more than a steal per game. Leslie Nkereuwem (11.4 ppg), Justin Hill (11.2 ppg) and DeShaun Wade (10.3 ppg) add plenty of scoring punch as well.

## LAST TIME OUT

- A pair of three-point attempts missed the target as time expired and the Radford men's basketball team dropped a physical, 73-72, contest against North Carolina A&T at Carilion Clinic Court at the Dedmon Center on Saturday evening.
- With 20 seconds remaining in regulation, the Highlanders (5-9, 1-1 Big South) advanced the ball and called a timeout to draw up their play. A series of passes around the perimeter ended with a deep shot by Bryan Hart, but it glanced off the rim. Dravon Mangum corralled the rebound and kicked it to Josiah Jeffers who got up a contested three, but it was no good.
- Radford trailed by as many as 12 points in the game, including a 10-point deficit in the second half. A 12-2 run over a three-minute span brought the hosts all the way back and it was back-and-forth to the finish from there.
- Lewis Djonkam made a clutch put-back layup with 1:29 to go to give Radford a 72-71 lead, but Demetric Horton struck back with the decisive basket at the 1:08 mark.

## JEFFERS' BIG WEEK

- Fifth-year senior Josiah Jeffers has been a steady contributor to the Highlanders this season, but the 6'1" guard put together the best two-game stretch of his career this past week. He posted 23 points, five rebounds, three assists, and two steals in a win at USC Upstate and then tallied 18 points, two rebounds, five assists, and four steals in an extremely close game against N.C. A&T.
- Jeffers drew a combined 20 fouls in the two games, going 18-for-23 at the free throw line. He also shot .500 from the field and posted back-to-back season highs in minutes played at 28 and 33 respectively. The Burlington, N.C. native now ranks 10th in the nation for steals per game to boot.

## SCHEDULE CHANGES STRIKE AGAIN

- A relatively smooth start to the 2021-22 season, in terms of sticking to the schedule, has become a much more complicated series of postponements and cancellations due to the omicron variant of the COVID-19 virus.
- The Highlanders have had four straight games altered in some way due to COVID-related issues, resulting in an 18-day break between contests.

## DEFENSIVE PROWESS

- The Highlanders have shown a penchant for lockdown defense this season and the numbers show it. At one point, they held opponents below their points per game average coming into the game in seven straight contests.
- During that run, Radford, on average, held opponents 11.7 points below their season scoring average. That stretch included two teams receiving AP Top 25 votes (Virginia Tech and Furman).
- The streak was snapped at JMU when the Dukes scored 79 points, a touch above their season average of 76.5 points per game

## JEFFERS' SWIPES

- With 29 steals through 12 games, senior guard Josiah Jeffers has shown off his advanced defensive chops on

matter whether he starts or comes off the bench. The Burlington, N.C. native ranks 10th in the nation and 1st in the Big South for steals per game.

## JAVONTE GREEN: RADFORD LEGEND

- Former Radford men's basketball star and current NBA player with the Chicago Bulls, Javonte Green, had his jersey retired at halftime of the Radford-Eastern Kentucky game at the Dedmon Center on Sunday, Nov. 28
- A member of the Radford program from 2011-15, Green ranks first in program history for career games played (133) and career steals (243) while also ranking second for career points scored (1,911), career field goals made (701), and career rebounds (1,064)
- The Petersburg, Va. native was an All-Big South Conference selection in each of his four years as a Highlander and was named Big South Defensive Player of the Year in 2014-15. After earning a bachelor's degree from Radford University, he went on to play professionally overseas with stops in Spain, Italy, and Germany
- In 2019, Green became the first player in program history to sign a contract with an NBA organization when he inked a two-year deal with the Boston Celtics. During the 2020-21 season, he was traded to the Chicago Bulls, re-signed with them in the summer of 2021, and has already become a fan favorite in the Windy City with his energy, defense, and electric slam dunks.



## SHIELD UP!

- When Radford's coaching staff walks out onto the court for a game, spectators will quickly notice something unusual... a literal shield
- Graduate Assistant Justin Cousin carries with him, both during pregame warm-ups and all game, a large shield based off the Captain America character, but with the Radford logo in the middle
- The shield is Radford's version of a "kill's board", something many teams throughout the country travel with them
- A kill is recorded every time the Radford defense makes stops on three consecutive possessions. When that happens, a Radford logo is placed on the shield

## YOUTHFUL EXUBERANCE

- Radford boasts one of the, if not the number one, youngest coaching staffs in the nation



- The average age amongst the seven coaches is a mere 30 years old
- Head Coach Darris Nichols is 35 years old and his older brother, Shane Nichols, is the oldest at 37 years old
- Director of Player Development, Safet Kastrat, is the youngest at 23 years of age

#### BIG SOUTH PRESEASON POLL

- Radford was picked to finish fourth in the Big South North Division, garnering 83 points
- The Highlanders also picked up three first-place votes, showing just how wide-open the conference is this season
- No individuals on this year's squad were named to the Preseason All-Big South teams

#### NICHOLS BROTHERS: HALL OF FAMERS

- Adding to their growing legacy within the city of Radford, Head Men's Basketball Coach Darris Nichols and his older brother and assistant coach, Shane Nichols, were inducted into the Radford High School Hall of Fame on Saturday, Oct. 2, 2021
- A standout point guard on the Radford boys basketball team, Darris Nichols (Class of 2004) led the Bobcats to four appearances in the Group A tournament and was named the 2004 Timesland Boys Basketball Player of the Year.
- "Darris Nichols is one of the greatest athletes to ever play at RHS," said Radford University Director of Athletics Robert Lineburg, a 2017 inductee of the RHS Hall of Fame. "He is certainly in the conversation as the best basketball player to ever play for the Bobcats. But what's more important, is he's a Hall of Fame person. His character is beyond reproach and his leadership ability is evident in all he does."
- Shane Nichols (Class of 2002) scored 1,903 points in his career as a Bobcat and was a two-time All-Timesland First Team selection as well as a two-time All-Group A First Team pick.
- "Shane was an outstanding player for us at Wofford and I am thankful we had the opportunity to give him his start in coaching," said current Virginia Tech Head Men's Basketball Coach Mike Young, a 2015 RHS Hall of Fame inductee. "His athletic superlatives and accomplishments are well documented, but those pale in comparison to his qualities as a man, a husband and a father. As is often the case, look no further than his folks, Donna and Bill Nichols, for shining examples of what parenting looks like."



#### PRIMETIME PERFORMERS

- Radford will have four opportunities to be selected for the Big South ESPNU Wildcard game this season
- Radford boasts an 8-2 record when playing in the

- ESPNU Wildcard games
- The Highlanders have hosted six of their 10 ESPNU Wildcard match-ups thus far
- Radford won its last matchup on ESPNU on Jan. 4 against Hampton in a 79-66 contest.

#### ANTI-RACISM PATCH

- With the social injustice issues that have been a topic of 2020, Radford sports an anti-racism patch on their white and red uniforms.
- The team has made the decision to keep the Anti-Racism patch on its uniforms for the 2021-22 season as well
- Chyree Walker: "Being anti-racist is based on a conscious effort and action to provide equitable opportunities for all people on an individual and system level."

#### LOYAL TO RADFORD

- Despite the coaching changes, several players have made the decision to stay loyal to Radford and continue their quest for another Big South title
- Graduate student Bryan Hart brings his sharpshooting back to the squad while seniors Chyree Walker, Lewis Djonkam, Dravon Mangum, and Josiah Jeffers provide plenty of veteran leadership
- Junior Shaquan Jules is sure to bring down the house with his thunderous dunks and the sophomore trio of Xavier Lipscomb, Keishon Porter, and Joshua Walker add their own variety of skills to the mix

#### REINFORCEMENTS

- The new coaching staff hit the recruiting trail this offseason, bringing in six new players including five transfers
- Rashun Williams makes his way to the NRV from South Florida and Tai'Reon Joseph joins the Highlanders from Austin Peay to add Division I experience right away
- Roshaun Black, Camron McNeil, and Artese Stapleton move up from the JUCO and D2 ranks
- Derrick Jones Jr. represents the lone true freshman on the roster after committing from Blue Ridge High School in Charlottesville

#### HOME, SWEET HOME

- Radford has clearly benefited from a home court advantage over the years, evidenced by nine straight winning seasons inside the Dedmon Center dating back to 2012-13
- The Highlanders have accumulated a record of 89-36 in that time, including a 9-5 record a year ago when fan attendance was limited due to the COVID-19 pandemic

#### NIT BID: CANCELLED

- Following the 2020-21 season, the Radford Men's Basketball program was awarded its first-ever bid to the

National Invitation Tournament (NIT). Unfortunately, the tournament was never played due to the ongoing pandemic

- It would've marked Radford's sixth postseason tournament appearance in program history and first major postseason tournament bid since the 2018 NCAA Tournament







## DARRIS NICHOLS

## FULL BIO

Darris Nichols was named Radford University's eighth men's basketball head coach on April 21, 2021. A Radford, Va., native, Nichols has spent the last six seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Florida.

"Darris Nichols is a star," Lineburg said. "He was an outstanding student-athlete at Radford High School and at West Virginia University. He has climbed the ranks as an assistant coach all the way to the University of Florida in the SEC. At each stop, he has made a tremendous impact. He has played for and worked with some of America's best basketball coaches, which is so important. He is prepared and ready for this moment, and we are thrilled to welcome him home."

"With additional coaching experience at Northern Kentucky, Louisiana Tech and now Florida, Darris has made his mark on both the players he has coached and the programs he has been a part of. His success speaks for itself." President Dr. Brian O Hemphill stated. "What makes Darris unique is his story. As one of ESPN's top 40 coaches under 40, his story is one of hard work and persistence with a continued focus on family. He is someone who never lost sight of where he came from and the Nichols family values, which were instilled in him at an early age."

While at Florida he helped coach the Gators to a 123-75 record that included four straight 20-win seasons. Nichols and the Gators also tallied four straight NCAA Tournament bids.

The 2016-17 season was one of the best, while Nichols was at UF. Florida earned a 27-9 record and reached the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. The Gators finished second in the SEC with a 14-4 record, matching the second-most conference wins in team

history. Florida climbed as high as 12th nationally in both the AP and coaches polls and hit No. 3 in RPI and KenPom rankings.

Nichols, a member of Coaches 4 Change, garnered a spot in ESPN.com's 40 Under 40 in the summer of 2020, rated #17 on the national list that included both head coaches and assistant coaches. He was also rated the #2 assistant coach in the SEC in a Stadium poll of coaches around the league. He has coached three future NBA players at Florida in Dorian Finney-Smith, Devin Robinson and Chris Chiozza.

Prior to his six-year (2015-21) stint at Florida, he was an assistant at Louisiana Tech coaching under Mike White during the 2014-15 season. He helped guide Louisiana Tech to the 2015 Conference USA championship as guard Kenneth "Speedy" Smith garnered C-USA Player of the Year and AP All-American honors. The Bulldogs went 27-9 on the season and advanced to the NIT quarterfinals. The 2014-15 season also produced a 15-3 conference mark and a perfect 17-0 home record.

In one season at Wofford (2013-14), Nichols helped guide the Terriers, who were picked to finish sixth in the league by the coaches, to a 20-win season and a Southern Conference Tournament championship, earning an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. In that NCAA Tournament game, Nichols was on the opposite bench from his former head coach, as Beilein's Michigan team topped the 15-seed Wofford. The Terriers finished 20-13, including 11-5 on the SoCon.

Prior to joining Wofford, he spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Northern Kentucky where he helped transition the Norse from Division II to Division I. In 2012-13, Nichols was the defensive coordinator, and the squad ranked second in the Atlantic Sun in scoring defense, while also being two wins shy of tying the record for most ever by a Division I transitional team. In the process, Nichols developed Eshaunte Jones who was named Atlantic Sun all-conference first team. The team finished with an 11-16 mark, including 9-9 in the A-Sun.

In his first year at Northern Kentucky, the team went 23-7, tying the school record for best start in school history (13-0) along the way and participated in the Division II Tournament. The guards, coached by Nichols, led the GLVC conference in 3-point field goal percentage and 3-point field goals made.

Nichols shined as a player in the Big East. A four-year letterwinner at West Virginia under Bob Huggins and John Beilein, Nichols helped the Mountaineers to a 26-11 record and a trip to the 2008 NCAA Sweet 16 his senior season. He scored 993 career points and dished 399 assists, while shooting at a .375 clip from 3-point range. He averaged 10.7 points per game, as well as 3.2 assists per game, as a senior on the way to WVU's Sweet 16 run. He was also a member of the 2007 NIT Championship, 2006 Sweet 16 and 2005 Elite Eight teams and finished his collegiate career as a top five most winningest player in Mountaineer history.

As a junior in 2007, Nichols dished out 4.6 assists per contest and averaged 10.9 points per game as WVU posted a 27-9 record.

He led the Big East in assist-to-turnover ratio and was named to the NIT All-Tournament Team. The team reached the NIT final thanks to Nichols' game-winning 3-pointer in the semifinals versus Mississippi State.

Nichols was also twice a recipient of the Big East Academic All-Star and Sportsmanship Award and earned the 2008 Fred Schaus Captain Award for WVU intercollegiate athletics.

After graduation, he played professionally overseas with Atomeromu SE Paks of the Hungarian League's A Division. He returned to his alma mater for one season, working with the basketball staff throughout the season and coordinating summer basketball camps.

Nichols earned his bachelor's degree from West Virginia University in sociology and is married to the former Courtne McKinney.

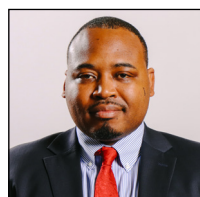
