Marian University field hockey plays host to Transylvania to open the season Sunday, August 31 at noon.

DYNAMIC DUO:

The duo of seniors Jikke Biemans and Allyson Nichols look to end their Marian careers on a high note. Members of the inaugural recruiting class for Marian field hockey, Nichols has 108 points through 48 games, while Biemans is at 98 points through the same amount of games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

The Sabres have a road-heavy season ahead of themselves with just three home games before hosting the CFHC Tournament. Marian was 4-6 last season away from Smith Field.

AROUND THE WORLD:

One of the more diverse teams at Marian, the Sabre field hockey team features student-athletes from the United States, Canada, Netherlands, Argentina, Australia, and Spain.

Marian University Field Hockey History

- Marian University field hockey was introduced as the 26th intercollegiate sport at Marian in September of 2021.
- The Sabres finished 7-8 in its inaugural season with a 2-3 conference record to earn the No. 3 seed for the SAA Tournament.
- Marian had its first winning season in 2023 after going 9-6 with a 5-3 SAA mark.
- Allyson Nichols was the SAA Newcomer of the Year and earned All-Region recognition in 2022.

SMITH FIELD FACTS

- Smith Field was built in 2002 and hosts field hockey, soccer, and lacrosse.
- Originally a grass pitch, Smith Field went under renovation in 2019 building a new turf surface to accomodate the addition of lacrosse and field hockey.
- Smith Field features a customizable scoreboard, full-service concession stand, men and women restrooms, team rooms, and lights to allow for night games. The second floor of Smith Field features a state-of-the-art press box and meeting room.
