Marian University women's ice hockey finishes its first NCHA game of the second half taking on Aurora Saturday, January 17 at 7 p.m.

CHEESING FOR SPIES:

Junior Ella Spies had a strong start to the second half of the season recording four points in the MSOE series. Spies sent game two of the series into overtime with a late extra-attacker, power-play goal and then assisted the game-winner.

PENALTY KILL PRODUCING:

The Sabres enter the weekend one of just seven teams in the nation with at least three short-handed goals on the season. The latest short-handed score came off the stick of freshman Yazmine Gonzalez in game two of the MSOE series.

SCOUTING THE SPARTANS:

Aurora opened its second half of the season falling to St. Olaf on the road in a pair of non-conference games. Freshman Macy Blooming leads the NCHA with her 440 saves on the season, next closest is 319.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

Marian enters with a 4-12-1 record all-time against Aurora. The Sabres defeated the Spartans in overtime to finish the season series last year snapping an 0-10-1 stretch in the all-time series.

MARIAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S HOCKEY HISTORY

- The Marian University women's ice hockey program began in 2009-10 under Mike Cowan.
- Marian has qualified for the conference tournament seven times during the history of the program.
- The Sabres posted the first double-digit win season in program history in 2016-17 after going 10-16-1. Marian went 7-11-0 in conference play that season and reached the NCHA Slaats Cup semifinals.

BLUE LINE ICE CENTER FACTS

- Blue Line Family Ice Center has three sheets of ice with Marian primarily playing games on Rink "A". Rink A is an Olympic sheet and the Sabres are one of two programs in the West region to play primarily on Olympic ice.
- Rink "B" at Blue Line Family Ice Center is a standard sheet of ice.
- Both the men's and women's programs enjoy state-of-the-art locker rooms with individual locker stalls, HD projectors, and television.
- Blue Line Ice Center is considered one of the premier rinks in Wisconsin and thus is one of the busiest in the state all year round.
