## GAME NOTES

### DROPPING THE PUCK:

Marian University NCAA men's hockey plays its final home game until the regular season finale hosting MSOE Friday, January 30 at 7 p.m.

### CARLSON AND CARLSON:

The twin duo of juniors Caden and Cole Carlson had a monster series against Lawrence combining for 12 points. Caden had a five-point game in the opener of the series and Cole had a multi-goal game in the finale, including the game-winner in overtime.

### FREE HOCKEY:

The Sabres are no strangers to free hockey this season having gone to overtime in five games. Marian is 2-1-2 on the year in games that need extra time and have both a shootout win and a shootout loss.

### RAIDING THE RAIDERS:

MSOE is looking to bounce back after a tough Sunday after being outscored by No. 5 St. Norbert 12-2 over five periods of hockey. Senior Austin Schwab ranks third in the NCHA for saves per game and fourth in the conference for save percentage.

### ALL-TIME SERIES:

Marian holds an advantage in the all-time series with MSOE at 54-36-3 but the Raiders have controlled the series of late. The Raiders enter with a 6-1-1 mark against Marian over the last eight meetings.

## MARIAN UNIVERSITY MEN'S HOCKEY HISTORY

- Marian University men's hockey played its inaugural season in 1995-96 going 5-2-0 under Rich Blakey.
- The Sabres have earned a pair of conference championships and have won three conference tournament championships.
- Marian has reached the 20-win plateau twice and in 2017-18 became the first program in the entire athletic department to earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament.

## BLUE LINE ICE CENTER FACTS

- Blue Line Family Ice Center has three sheets of ice with Marian primarily playing games on Rink "A". Rink A is an Olympic sheet and the Sabres are one of two programs in the West region to play primarily on Olympic ice.
- Rink "B" at Blue Line Family Ice Center is a standard sheet of ice.
- Both the men's and women's programs enjoy state-of-the-art locker rooms with individual locker stalls, HD projectors, and television.
- Blue Line Ice Center is considered one of the premier rinks in Wisconsin and thus is one of the busiest in the state all year round.
