GAME NOTES

START ME UP:

Marian University men's lacrosse caps off a doubleheader hosting Lake Forest Saturday, March 28 at 2 p.m.

SAVING SWEENEY:

Senior Jackson Sweeney has had a strong start to the season leading the NACC with 18.2 saves per game. He also ranks fifth in the conference with his .595 save percentage.

CAUSING TROUBLE:

Senior Shay Nolen continues to anchor the Sabre defense and enters fourth in the NACC with 2.2 caused turnovers per game. Nolen is also 11th in the conference averaging 4.0 ground balls per game.

SAVING THE TREES:

Lake Forest suffered its first NACC loss earlier this week falling on the road at MSOE in overtime. The Foresters rank third in the NACC averaging 11.9 goals per game. Senior Gabe Boston ranks fifth in the NACC with a face-off percentage of .622 on the season.

MARIAN UNIVERSITY MEN'S LACROSSE HISTORY

- Marian University men's lacrosse began in 2018 going 5-12 under Reid Mayberry.
- The Sabre men's lacrosse program has posted a winning season twice.
- Marian was originally a member of the Midwest Lacrosse Conference before the NACC added lacrosse in 2020.
- The program record for wins in a single season is 12 which came in 2019.
- Marian has qualified for the conference tournament twice in program history with the first coming in 2019.

SMITH FIELD FACTS

- Smith Field completed construction in 2002.
- Originally a grass pitch, Smith Field went under renovation in 2019 building a new turf surface to accommodate the addition of lacrosse and field hockey.
- Smith Field features a customizable scoreboard, full-service concession stand, men and women restrooms, team rooms, and lights to allow for night games. The second floor of Smith Field features a state-of-the-art press box and meeting room.
