FACTS

JERSEY CITY, N.J. – The Saint Peter's men's basketball team (1-2) is looking to bounce back on the road against Delaware (0-3) Tuesday night at Bob Carpenter Center, after falling to VCU last week. Tip-off for the third-ever matchup between the Peacocks and Blue Hens is set for 7 p.m. ET.

Last season, Bashir Mason's Peacocks defeated the Blue Hens at home, 72-64, in a game where they shot 42.6 percent (20-for-47) from the field. If Saint Peter's wants a similar result, the team will need to shoot better than it did in its last game against VCU.

Despite the shooting struggles, Brent Bland has been able to score at will for Saint Peter's. He dropped 25 points last game and 27 in the game before that. Bland is averaging 18.0 points per game, while shooting 50.0 percent (11-for-22) from 3-point range.

Both the Peacocks and the Blue Hens are pulling in 34.0 boards a contest, so the rebound margin will be something to look out for on Tuesday night.

ABOUT THE DELAWARE BLUE HENS: Delaware is still searching for its first win of the season after falling to Bucknell, Wilmington (Del.) and No. 7 BYU. After a rough loss to Division II Wilmington (Del.), the Blue Hens came out strong against a nationally-ranked BYU team. They were leading the Cougars, 37-34, at halftime, but ultimately lost the game on the road.

The Blue Hens are led by junior guard Christian Bliss and sophomore forward Macon Emory. Bliss is averaging a team-high 15.7 points per game while dishing out 6.3 assists. Emory has been a force for Delaware, averaging a double-double with 14.0 points and 10.3 rebounds per game.

Delaware is coached by Martin Ingelsby, who is in his 10th season as head coach of the Blue Hens.

MATCHUP HISTORY: This will be the third meeting all-time between Saint Peter's and Delaware. The Peacocks are 1-1 vs. the Blue Hens overall, with both games taking place in Jersey City. This will be the first time the two teams meet in Newark, Del.

BIG BALLER BLAND: In his last two outings, Brent Bland has scored a career-high 27 points against FDU and 25 points against VCU. He hit six 3-pointers in the win over the Knights, becoming the first Peacock player to make six or more 3-pointers in a single game since Doug Edert made seven vs. Rider on Feb. 23, 2020. Funnily enough, Edert was in attendance for the game against FDU.

Against the Rams, Bland continued to have the hot hand, cashing in on five 3s while going 8-for-16 from the field. He now averages 18.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per game.

FRESHMAN PHENOM: Saint Peter's only freshman on the roster, TJ Robinson, has turned lots of heads in his first three collegiate games. After leading the team in scoring in the season opener at Seton Hall, he earned starts against FDU and VCU. Robinson is currently averaging 11.7 points, three assists and two rebounds per game. His 11.7 points per game leads all freshman in the MAAC.

THE NEW GUYS: The Saint Peter's coaching staff brought in seven new players, which includes six transfers and one true freshman. The true freshman is TJ Robinson and the incoming transfers are Jahki Gupton, Lucas Scroggins, Shaedon Simpson, Bol Agu, J'Quan Ewing and Akil Watson.

The Peacocks also hired a new Director of Basketball Operations, Chris Mastrangelo from UConn.

FAMILIAR FACES: The 2025-26 SPU men's basketball team features six returners from last season: Brent Bland, Bryce Eaton, Elijah Perkins, Zaakir Williamson, Adetokunbo Bakare and Eric Morgan Jr.

Bland is the only remaining player from Saint Peter's 2022 Elite 8 Squad and has won two MAAC titles during his time in Jersey City.

Eaton was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.

Bashir Mason Head Coach

4th Year at Saint Peter's - 46-50 (.479)
14th as a Head Coach - 211-180 (.540)

Bashir Mason enters his fourth season as head coach of the Peacocks in 2025-26. Mason, one of the most decorated young coaches in the country and a Jersey City native, was named the 16th head coach of the Saint Peter's University men's basketball program on April 12, 2022.

In three seasons leading the Peacocks, he has a 45-48 record with a career mark of 210-178 over 13 coaching seasons. During the 2024-25 season, Mason earned his 200th career coaching victory with a win over Saint Elizabeth on November 20, 2024.

Mason has had an immediate impact on the Peacocks program in his first three seasons. In 2023-24, he guided Saint Peter's to its second MAAC Championship in three seasons and the program's fifth MAAC title. The Peacocks, picked to finish in tenth place in 2023-24, finished in a three-way tie for third place during the regular season with a 12-8 conference mark. In the MAAC Tournament, the fifth seeded Peacocks defeated #4 Rider in the quarterfinals, upset top seed Quinnipiac in the semifinals and took home the title with a 68-63 victory over #2 seed Fairfield. Mason led Saint Peter's to a 19-14 overall record last season and the team's fifth NCAA Tournament appearance.

During Mason's first season in 2022-23, the Peacocks placed tenth during the regular season. Saint Peter's again made noise in the MAAC Tournament, knocking off seven seed Fairfield in the first round. Mason's squad upset #2 seed Rider in the quarterfinals, becoming the first #10 seed in MAAC Tournament history to reach the semifinals.

Prior to coming to Jersey City, Mason orchestrated an extremely successful decade at Wagner as the Seahawks' head coach, leading the team to three Northeast Conference (NEC) regular season titles while posting a 165-130 record over that span in Staten Island. He became just the second coach in the conference's 40-year history to win three Jim Phelan Coach of the Year honors during that time.

In his final season at Wagner, Mason led the Seahawks to a 21-6 overall record and an appearance in the NEC title game, marking the third time during his tenure and ninth time in program history that Wagner won 20 or more games in one season. The 2021-22 Seahawks were the first team in NEC history to boast four All-NEC players, led by NEC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year and First Team All-NEC selection Alex Morales, while Will Martinez and Raekwon Rogers earned Second Team honors and Elijah Ford picked up Third Team accolades. Zaire Williams also picked up a spot on the All-Rookie Team. Mason also took home hardware by season's end, as he was named the National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) District 15 Coach of the Year.

Wagner's 15 conference wins in 2021-22 also matched the most in program history, while its 14 consecutive victories set the record for the longest winning streak for a Seahawk team under Mason and was the longest winning streak for a Wagner squad since winning 16 straight during the 1978-79 season under P.J. Carlesimo. Wagner's 13-0 start in NEC play was two wins short of the conference record for longest unbeaten streak to start a season and represented the first time an NEC squad won 13 straight games in over a decade. Wagner's win over Fairleigh Dickinson marked the 100th career victory in conference play for Mason, who became the 11th coach in NEC history to reach the century mark; he also earned his 150th overall victory against Fairfield this past season. Wagner also appeared in the NEC Tournament title game for the third time in his tenure as head coach (2017-18, 2015-16).

Mason has been named the Jim Phelan NEC Coach of the Year three times, most recently after the 2020-21 season, where he helped the Seahawks post a 13-5 record in NEC play while dealing with the logistical challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic. He also took home that honor after the 2015-16 and 2017-18 campaigns, leading Wagner to the regular season NEC conference title and tournament title game in both seasons.

The Seahawks have appeared in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) in three seasons under Mason, including the memorable 2015-16 installment of the tournament when he led Wagner to a 79-75 victory over top-seeded St. Bonaventure in the opening round. It was the first non-conference tournament postseason victory for Wagner in program history.

Mason leads Saint Peter's with a laundry list of national accolades, being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award as the top minority Division I head coach five times (2023-24, 2020-21, 2017-18, 2015-16, 2012-13), a finalist for the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year award three times (2021-22, 2020-21, 2017-18) and was the NABC District 18 Coach of the Year in 2017-18.

The fastest coach to win 100 games in Seahawk history, Mason coached 21 All-NEC selections during his tenure, in addition to having eight student-athletes claim All-NEC Tournament accolades as well as six were named to the prestigious NABC (NABC) First and Second Team All-District. Most recently, Mason coached two-time NEC Player of the Year and 2022 NEC Defensive Player of the Year Alex Morales.

The 2020-21 season marked the first time Wagner has ever won NEC Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, and Rookie of the Year in the same season, and was also the first time since 2007-2008 that two Seahawks earned First Team All-NEC honors.

Upon his hire at Wagner, Mason was the youngest head coach at the Division I level when he was brought on staff in March of 2012. Prior to being named the head coach, Mason was a two year assistant with the Seahawks under now University of Connecticut head coach Dan Hurley.

Academically, Mason coached a total of 17 Academic All-NEC selections and has helped every player who exhausted their eligibility at Wagner earn their degree.

Mason is no stranger to the MAAC, arriving at Wagner after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Marist College from 2008-2010. He began his coaching career at his high school alma mater, St. Benedict's Prep of Newark, under Hurley during the 2007-2008 season. As coach of the school's prep team, the Gray Bees won the New Jersey State Prep A Title.

After playing under Hurley in high school, Mason went on to enjoy an outstanding four-year career as a member of the Drexel University basketball team. A four-year starter, Mason was a stellar player for the Dragons with 1,000 points and nearly 500 assists in his career.
