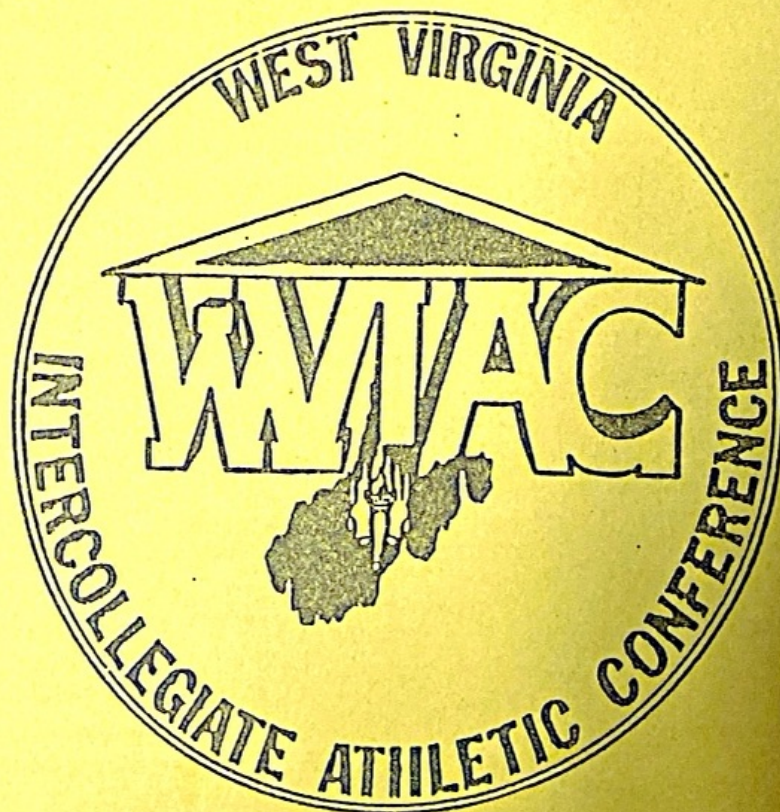

# **The West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference**

## a brief history

Nationally respected and highly competitive best describes the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC), the Mountain State's 14-team small college league, which this year begins its 71st year of operation.

Affiliated with the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) in Division I for many years, the conference has dropped its NAIA affiliation and this year begins competition with the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) in Division II. For the past two years, the WVIAC has held dual membership in NAIA and NCAA II, though its teams were not eligible for NCAA championship play.

The WVIAC was organized in 1924 through the cooperation of several schools and the State Department of Education.

Since then, WVIAC teams have enjoyed national success and ranking, and annually are among the nation's leaders in the polls. Charter members of the conference include Broaddus (and later Alderson College, which became Alderson-Broaddus), Bethany, Concord, Davis & Elkins, Fairmont State, Glenville State, Marshall University, Morris Harvey (now the University of Charleston), New River State (now West Virginia Institute of Technology), Potomac State, Salem (now Salem-Teikyo), Shepherd, West Liberty State, West Virginia University and West Virginia Wesleyan. Since the beginning, Bluefield State, West Virginia State, Wheeling Jesuit and Beckley (now the College of West Virginia) have joined.

Seven schools have left the ranks of the WVIAC since its inception. WVU left in 1927 after just two years of membership. Marshall departed in 1949, followed by Bethany and Potomac State in the 1950s and Beckley in 1977. West Virginia Wesleyan left the league in 1986, only to return to the WVIAC in 1988. West Virginia State left the conference for the 1994-95 school year while completing its NCAA membership requirements. State has rejoined the league for the 1995-96 school year, bringing the current membership to 14 schools. Eight of those schools compete in football.

The first WVIAC president was E.G. Rohrbaugh of Glenville State, who ruled for six months before being replaced by Joseph Rosier of Fairmont State. Dr. Edwin Welch of the University of Charleston is the current WVIAC president.

George Springer was the executive secretary for the league for 19 years before being named the WVIAC's first commissioner in 1966. He served eight years until his retirement in 1974.

Mike McLaughlin served as WVIAC commissioner

for 10 years before his death in 1984. The Weston native had 30 years of football and basketball officiating experience before moving into the commissioner's chair.

Mike Reed, a Glenville native and former coach and athletic facilities administrator, took over after McLaughlin's death. He became the league's third commissioner and served until 1987 when he resigned to go into the business field.

Barry Blizzard, a Bramwell native and athletic director and sports information director at Bluefield State for 11 years, became the league's fourth commissioner in November 1987. Blizzard relocated the league offices to Princeton on Dec. 1, 1987.

Currently, the WVIAC, with the slogan "*Best small college conference in America*," offers championship opportunities in football, men's soccer, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's basketball, baseball, men's golf, men's and women's tennis, softball, and volleyball, men's and women's track, men's and women's swimming, volleyball and cheerleading.

## WVIAC fax-on-demand statistics

For the second year, the WVIAC will be offering members of the media a fax-on-demand statistics and information service.

This service is an automated, 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week service which instantly sends the latest information from the WVIAC to any media outlet's fax machine.

Getting stats, scores, schedules and information is as easy as dialing a phone. First, dial the service's number on any fax machine's handset, then enter the WVIAC's passcode. From a directory of menu items, choose the categories of information to be instantly faxed back. Push the "start" button on the fax machine to activate the fax-back function.

For football, the menu includes WVIAC composite schedules and results, conference standings and statistics, player of the week selections and game summaries.

Also included for fall, in addition to WVIAC news items from the commissioner's office, are statistical and informational items for men's soccer, volleyball and women's tennis.

The winter schedule offers men's and women's basketball, while spring will feature baseball, softball and men's tennis.
