#### THE GAME

The Samford women's basketball team will host the Alabama A&M Bulldogs Saturday at 12 p.m. in the Pete Hanna Center.

Samford enters the game with a record of 3-4 on the young season. Samford is coming off a 63-49 win over Alabama State Wednesday evening.

Alabama A&M has a record of 2-4 so far this season. A&M is coming off a 68-65 win over Oakwood Tuesday night.

#### THE SERIES

Samford and Alabama A&M will be meeting for just the fifth time ever in women's basketball, with Samford holding a 3-1 advantage in the series.

The teams last met on Dec. 1, 2015, with Samford taking a 54-30 win in the game played at Alabama A&M.

The first meeting in the series came on Nov. 29, 2002. The game, won by Alabama A&M, 67-55, was a part of the Jacksonville State Classic, played at Jacksonville State University's Pete Mathews Coliseum.

#### SAMFORD AT HOME

In its 19-plus seasons of women's basketball, Samford has an all-time record of 152-98 in home games.

Now in its 10th season in the Pete Hanna Center, the Bulldogs are 91-27 in their current home. In 10 seasons in Seibert Hall, Samford had a record of 61-71 in that facility.

This season, Samford has 14 games on its schedule to be played at the Pete Hanna Center, and the Bulldogs are currently 3-0 in those games.

#### THE LAST TIME OUT

Samford earned a 63-49 win over Alabama
State Wednesday evening in the Pete Hanna Center.
In the win for Samford, Kassidy Blevins led the way with 18 points. Hannah Nichols scored 16 points, while Ellen Riggins added 10 points, four rebounds and four assists.

#### SAMFORD AGAINST SWAC TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 15-6 against the current members of the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC), including a record of 3-1 against Saturday's opponent, Alabama A&M.

Samford has played the following SWAC schools: Alabama A&M (3-1), Alabama State (10-4), Alcorn State (1-1) and Mississippi Valley State (1-0).

#### SAMFORD IN THE SOCON STATISTICS

Through the first seven games of the season, Samford leads the SoCon in field goal percentage (.433), and the Bulldogs rank second in the league in rebounding defense (34.6) and three-pointers made per game (7.1). The Bulldogs rank third in three-point field goal percentage (.362).

Individually, Kassidy Blevins ranks second in the league in steals per game (2.7), and she ranks second in field goal percentage (.533). She also ranks third in the SoCon in three-point field goal percentage (.486) and three-pointers made per game (2.4).

#### **BLEVINS CONTINUES TO IMPRESS**

Kassidy Blevins has gotten the season off to a hot start. The junior has scored at least 12 points in every game so far this season. She scored a season-high 18 points against Rhode Island, 20th-ranked Kentucky and Alabama State. For the season, she is averaging 16.0 points and 2.7 steals per game.

#### **PROVIDING A SPARK OFF THE BENCH**

Junior Hannah Nichols has provided a spark off the bench for the Bulldogs so far this season. She has scored in double figures in every game so far, and she is averaging 15.6 points per game.

#### FRESHMEN IN THE STARTING LINEUP

Two of Samford's five true freshmen have earned spots in the starting lineup this season. Forward Samantha Fitzgerald averages 8.1 points and a team-high 4.7 rebounds per game. Charity Brown leads the team in assists, dishing out 3.7 assists per game.

#### SAMFORD AGAINST IN-STATE TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 48-43 against in-state opponents, including a 3-1 mark against Saturday's opponent, Alabama A&M. This season, Samford has four games on its schedule against Alabama teams, and the Bulldogs are currently 1-0 in those contests.

Samford has played the following in-state opponents: Alabama (2-7), Alabama State (10-4), Alabama A&M (3-1), Auburn (0-2), AUM (3-0), Birmingham-Southern (3-1), Jacksonville State (18-14), South Alabama (1-0), Talladega College (0-1), Troy (7-10) and UAB (1-3).

#### A LOOK AT ALABAMA A&M

Alabama A&M enters the game with a record of 2-4 so far this season. A&M is coming off a 68-65 win over Oakwood Tuesday night.

AAMU is led in scoring by Jemeica Cobb, averaging 16.7 points per game. Hilary Williams averages 8.2 points per game for A&M.

Cobb is also the team leader in rebounding, grabbing 8.7 boards per contest. LaKashia Hill and Alisha Davis average 4.3 rebounds per game each.

Williams is the team leader in assists, dishing out 2.2 assists per game. Cobb averages 1.7 assists per game for Alabama A&M.

#### MIKE MORRIS HEAD COACH

ince taking over as the second head coach of Samford women's basketball in 2002, Mike Morris has taken the program to new heights.

Over the last 11 years, the Bulldogs have posted eight of the top-nine win totals in school history, including the program's only seven 20-win seasons.

Morris guided the program to back-to-back Southern Conference Tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2011 and 2012. The team reached a national postseason tournament for the three years in a row, including a WNIT appearance in 2010.

The 2015-16 team posted Morris' seventh 20-win season, finishing the year with a mark of 20-11 and reaching the semfinals of the SoCon Tournament.

The 2010-11 Bulldogs set a school record for wins with a 25-8 record, winning the SoCon Tournament and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the first time. Despite losing two of the top players in program history, the 2011-12 team won 20 games again, and won its second-straight SoCon title and NCAA Tournament berth.

The 2009–10 team reached the finals of the Southern Conference Tournament for the first time and earned the program's first-ever national postseason appearance. The team also earned its first national postseason win with a 66-65 win over Ole Miss in the first round of the WNIT at the Pete Hanna Center.

The 2009-10 team also tied the then-school record for wins with a 23-11 overall record and a 14-6 mark in SoCon play. In 2008–09, the Bulldogs set a school record for conference wins with a 16-4 league record in their first year in the SoCon. The team finished with an overall record of 22-7, reaching the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament.

After the season, Morris was named the 2009 SoCon Coach of the Year. The award marked the second Coach of the Year award for Morris, as he was named the Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year in 2006.

The 2007–08 Bulldogs set a then-school record for most wins in a season, posting a 23-9 overall record and a 15-5 record in the OVC. The Bulldogs also posted their first-ever wins over Southeastern Conference (Alabama) and Big 12 (Missouri) opponents, and reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament for a third year in a row.

The 2006–07 season was another winning one with a record of 18-13 and another trip to the OVC semifinals.

In the 2005–06 season, Samford posted its first 20-win season, finishing with a 21-8 overall record, and the Bulldogs were 15-5 in OVC play. For the first time since joining the league in 2003, the team reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament.

Morris has increased the team's win total in seven of his 12 seasons as head coach. In his first season (2002–03), the team won seven games, up from three the previous season. In his second season (2003–04), the Bulldogs posted 10 wins, only the second time in school history that the team managed double-digit wins. The 2004–05 squad won 13 games, and the 2005–06 team won 21 games. In 2007–08, the Bulldogs won a then-record 23 games, up from 18 in 2006–07. The 2009-10 team also won 23 games and the 2010-11 team won a school-record 25 contests.

Morris is in his 21st season overall at Samford, spending eight seasons as an assistant coach on the men's staff. While working with the men's team, Morris served as the team's top recruiter and directed Samford's summer basketball camps. He was on the bench for both Samford Atlantic Sun Championship seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances.

Before his arrival at Samford in 1994, Morris served for three years as an assistant coach under veteran coach Lenny Acuff at Belhaven College. He coached at Belhaven for two seasons before joining Acuff's staff in 1993 at Berry College in Rome, Ga. In his first year at Belhaven, the Blazers finished with the most wins in nine years, compiling a 17-16 record. The next year, Belhaven went 18-15 and hosted the first round of the NAIA District Playoffs for the first time in 20 years.

Morris played basketball for two seasons at the University of Alabama in Huntsville [UAH], where he was chosen team captain and team MVP his senior season. While at UAH, Morris was the NCAA Division II national champion in free-throw percentage, making 92.1 percent from the line. He played his first two seasons at Jefferson State Junior College in Birmingham.

The Holly Pond, Ala., native earned a B.A. in psychology from Belhaven College in 1992. He has completed 24 hours toward his master's degree in administration from Jacksonville State.

Morris is married to the former Melanie Nix of Huntsville, Ala. They have a son, Peyton, 23, and a daughter, Paige, 20.
