SAMFORD ON THE ROAD

This season, Samford has 15 games on the schedule to be played away from the Pete Hanna Center. The Bulldogs will play 13 true road games and two neutral-site games. So far, Samford is 0-5 in those contests.

Last season, Samford went 10-8 in games played away from the Pete Hanna Center, 9-8 in true road games and 1-0 in neutral-site contests.

THE LAST TIME OUT

A cold shooting start by Samford led to a 51-40 loss at Wake Forest on Dec. 18.

In the loss, Samford was led in scoring by Hannah Nichols with 11 points. Charity Brown tied a career high with 10 points in the loss. Ellen Riggins contributed eight points and seven rebounds for Samford.

SAMFORD AGAINST SEC TEAMS

Against the current members of the SEC, Samford has an all-time record of 5-18, though this will mark the first-ever meeting with Georgia.

Samford has played the following SEC teams: Alabama (2-7), Auburn (0-2), Florida (0-1), Kentucky (0-2), LSU (1-1), Ole Miss (1-0), Mississippi State (0-2), Missouri (1-0), South Carolina (0-1) and Vanderbilt (0-2).

SAMFORD IN THE SOCON STATISTICS

Through 11 games this season, Samford ranks second in the SoCon in scoring defense (58.2 ppg.) and three-pointers made per game (6.4). Samford also ranks third in the SoCon in field goal percentage (.406), three-point field goal percentage (.321), rebounding defense (35.9), assists (13.5) and assist-turnover ratio (0.9).

PLAYERS IN THE SOCON RANKINGS

Kassidy Blevins ranks third in the Southern Conference in steals (2.5 pg.) and three-point field goal percentage (.385).

In addition to Blevins, Ellen Riggins ranks third in the league in free throw percentage (.867), while Brittany Stevens ranks third in assist-turnover ratio (1.6).

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

Samford has five true freshmen on its 2016-17 roster. Four of the five players have seen significant playing time, with two earning starts. Forward Samantha Fitzgerald has started all 11 games and is averaging 8.1 points and 4.4 rebounds per game. Charity Brown has started 10 of the team's 11 games and is second on the team in assists, dishing out 3.0 assists per game.

SAMFORD AGAINST GEORGIA TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 18-30 against teams from the state of Georgia, though Thursday's game will mark the first-ever meeting between Samford and Georgia.

Samford has played the following Georgia teams: Berry College (1-0), Columbus State (0-1), Georgia Southern (9-3), Georgia State (2-11), Georgia Tech (0-4), Mercer (5-11), Morris Brown (1-0) and Shorter (1-0).

A LOOK AT GEORGIA

Georgia comes into Thursday's game with an overall mark of 7-4. The Bulldogs are coming off a 66-43 loss to Virginia Monday evening.

Georgia is led in scoring by Caliya Robinson, averaging 17.0 points per game. Mackenzie Engram scores 12.4 points per game for Georgia.

Pachis Roberts is the team leader in rebounding, grabbing 7.5 boards per contest. Robinson averages 6.3 rebounds per game.

Roberts and Haley Clark are tied for the team lead in assists, with both players averaging 3.6 assists per game.

ince taking over as the second head coach of Samford women's basketball in 2002, Mike Morris has taken the program to new heights.

Over the last 11 years, the Bulldogs have posted eight of the top-nine win totals in school history, including the program's only seven 20-win seasons.

Morris guided the program to back-to-back Southern Conference Tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2011 and 2012. The team reached a national postseason tournament for the three years in a row, including a WNIT appearance in 2010.

The 2015-16 team posted Morris' seventh 20-win season, finishing the year with a mark of 20-11 and reaching the semfinals of the SoCon Tournament.

The 2010-11 Bulldogs set a school record for wins with a 25-8 record, winning the SoCon Tournament and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the first time. Despite losing two of the top players in program history, the 2011-12 team won 20 games again, and won its second-straight SoCon title and NCAA Tournament berth.

The 2009–10 team reached the finals of the Southern Conference Tournament for the first time and earned the program's first-ever national postseason appearance. The team also earned its first national postseason win with a 66-65 win over Ole Miss in the first round of the WNIT at the Pete Hanna Center.

The 2009-10 team also tied the then-school record for wins with a 23-11 overall record and a 14-6 mark in SoCon play. In 2008–09, the Bulldogs set a school record for conference wins with a 16-4 league record in their first year in the SoCon. The team finished with an overall record of 22-7, reaching the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament.

After the season, Morris was named the 2009 SoCon Coach of the Year. The award marked the second Coach of the Year award for Morris, as he was named the Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year in 2006.

The 2007–08 Bulldogs set a then-school record for most wins in a season, posting a 23-9 overall record and a 15-5 record in the OVC. The Bulldogs also posted their first-ever wins over Southeastern Conference (Alabama) and Big 12 (Missouri) opponents, and reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament for a third year in a row.

The 2006–07 season was another winning one with a record of 18-13 and another trip to the OVC semifinals.

In the 2005–06 season, Samford posted its first 20-win season, finishing with a 21-8 overall record, and the Bulldogs were 15-5 in OVC play. For the first time since joining the league in 2003, the team reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament.

Morris has increased the team's win total in seven of his 12 seasons as head coach. In his first season (2002–03), the team won seven games, up from three the previous season. In his second season (2003–04), the Bulldogs posted 10 wins, only the second time in school history that the team managed double-digit wins. The 2004–05 squad won 13 games, and the 2005–06 team won 21 games. In 2007–08, the Bulldogs won a then-record 23 games, up from 18 in 2006–07. The 2009-10 team also won 23 games and the 2010-11 team won a school-record 25 contests.

Morris is in his 21st season overall at Samford, spending eight seasons as an assistant coach on the men's staff. While working with the men's team, Morris served as the team's top recruiter and directed Samford's summer basketball camps. He was on the bench for both Samford Atlantic Sun Championship seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances.

Before his arrival at Samford in 1994, Morris served for three years as an assistant coach under veteran coach Lenny Acuff at Belhaven College. He coached at Belhaven for two seasons before joining Acuff's staff in 1993 at Berry College in Rome, Ga. In his first year at Belhaven, the Blazers finished with the most wins in nine years, compiling a 17-16 record. The next year, Belhaven went 18-15 and hosted the first round of the NAIA District Playoffs for the first time in 20 years.

Morris played basketball for two seasons at the University of Alabama in Huntsville [UAH], where he was chosen team captain and team MVP his senior season. While at UAH, Morris was the NCAA Division II national champion in free-throw percentage, making 92.1 percent from the line. He played his first two seasons at Jefferson State Junior College in Birmingham.

The Holly Pond, Ala., native earned a B.A. in psychology from Belhaven College in 1992. He has completed 24 hours toward his master's degree in administration from Jacksonville State.

Morris is married to the former Melanie Nix of Huntsville, Ala. They have a son, Peyton, 23, and a daughter, Paige, 20.


