THE GAME

The Samford women's basketball team will open Southern Conference play by hosting defending champion Chattanooga Wednesday evening at 6 p.m. in the Pete Hanna Center.

Samford enters the game with a record of 6-8 overall. The Bullodogs dropped two decisions in last week's Hilton Garden Inn FGCU Classic, falling to UC Riverside, 51-48, and to Hampton, 63-57.

Chattanooga also enters the game with a mark of 6-8. The Mocs are coming off a 56-48 win at Presbyterian on Dec. 30.

THE SERIES

Samford and Chattanooga will be meeting for the 26th time, with Chattanooga holding an 18-7 advantage in the series.

The teams met three times last season. The teams split the regular-season series, with each team winning at home. Chattanooga then claimed a 49-41 win in the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament.

Samford has a record of 5-6 against the Mocs in Birmingham, the team is 2-10 in games played in Chattanooga, and 0-2 against UTC at neutral sites.

SAMFORD AT HOME

In its 19-plus seasons of women's basketball, Samford has an all-time record of 154-99 in home games.

Now in its 10th season in the Pete Hanna Center, the Bulldogs are 93-28 in their current home. In 10 seasons in Seibert Hall, Samford had a record of 61-71 in that facility.

This season, Samford has 14 games on its schedule to be played at the Pete Hanna Center, and the Bulldogs are currently 5-1 in those games.

THE LAST TIME OUT

Samford dropped a 63-57 decision to Hampton on the final day of the Hilton Garden Inn FGCU Classic, Dec. 30.

In the loss, Hannah Nichols scored a career-high 29 points, and she tied a school record with seven made three-pointers. Brittany Stevens scored nine points and grabbed a game-high seven rebounds.

SAMFORD AGAINST SOCON TEAMS

Now in its ninth season as a member of the Southern Conference, Samford has a record of 95-51 in league games. Against the current members of the So-Con, Samford has an all-time record of 74-45, including a 7-18 record against Wednesday's opponent, Chattanooga.

Samford's all-time record against each current SoCon school is: Chattanooga (7-18), East Tennessee State (4-1), Furman (12-5), Mercer (5-11), UNCG (14-4), Wofford (19-2) and Western Carolina (13-4).

SAMFORD IN THE SOCON STATISTICS

Through 14 games this season, Samford leads the Southern Conference in three-pointers made per game (6.7). The Bulldogs also rank second in the SoCon in free throw percentage (.721), field goal percentage (.414), three-point field goal percentage (.341) and rebounding defense (35.7 pg.).

PLAYERS IN THE SOCON RANKINGS

Samford players rank in the top five in the Southern Conference in several statistical categories.

Ellen Riggins leads the league in free-throw percentage (.857). Hannah Nichols ranks in the top five in three-point field goal percentage (3rd, .384), field goal percentage (T-3rd, .481), three-pointers per game (4th, 2.4 pg.) and scoring (T-4th, 15.4 ppg.). Kassidy Blevins ranks third in the league in steals per game (2.3), and fourth in three-point field goal percentage (.377). Brittany Stevens ranks third in the SoCon in assist-turnover ratio (1.5).

SAMFORD AGAINST TENNESSEE TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 44-50 against teams from the state of Tennessee, including an 7-18 record against Wednesday's opponent, Chattanooga.

NICHOLS SCORES CAREER HIGH, TIES SCHOOL RECORD FOR THREES

In Samford's game against Hampton last Friday, Hannah Nichols scored a career-high 29 points to lead the Bulldogs. In addition, she made 7-of-9 attempts from three-point range, tying the school record for three-pointers made in a game. Nichols shares the record with former players Chelsee Insell and Emily London.

A LOOK AT CHATTANOOGA

Chattanooga comes into Wednesday night's game with a record of 6-8. The Mocs are coming off a 56-48 win over Presbyterian on Dec. 30.

UTC has four players scoring in double figures. Queen Alford (11.1 pg.), Jasmine Joyner (10.8), Chelsey Shumpert (10.1) and Lakelyn Bouldin (10.0) lead the Mocs in scoring.

Joyner is the team leader in rebounding, grabbing 9.4 boards per contest. Keiana Gilbert averages 5.1 rebounds per game.

Gilbert also leads the team in assists, dishing out 2.9 assists per game. Shumpert averages 2.8 assists per game for Chattanooga.

THE LAST TIME AGAINST CHATTANOOGA

Samford and Chattanooga last met on Mar. 4, 2016, with Chattanooga taking a 49-41 win in the semi-finals of the Southern Conference Tournament.

In the loss for Samford, Kassidy Blevins scored 18 points. Amara Mayers scored 11 points, and Taylor Reece added eight points for the Bulldogs.

NICHOLS ON A HOT STREAK

Junior guard Hannah Nichols has begun the season on a hot streak. She has scored in double figures in 13 of the team's 14 games so far this season. She has scored over 20 points twice so far, scoring 24 points against UT Martin on Nov. 23, and then tallying a career-high 29 points against Hampton on Dec. 30. For the season, she is averaging 15.4 points per game, and is shooting 48.1 percent overall and 38.4 percent from three-point range.

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

Samford has five true freshmen on its 2016-17 roster, and four of those have seen significant playing time.

Samantha Fitzgerald has started all 14 games, and is averaging 8.2 points and a team-high 4.3 rebounds per game. Charity Brown has played in all 14 games, including 10 starts, and is second on the team in assists, averaging 2.6 per game. Katie Allen scored a career-high 13 points in Samford's win at Georgia. Paige Serup has seen action in 13 of the team's 14 games so far this season.

NEARING A MILESTONE

Coming into Wednesday night's game, Samford head coach Mike Morris is just two wins away from becoming the first coach in Samford women's basketball history to win 250 games. Now in his 15th season at the helm of the program, Morris has a career record of 248-191.

HOME COOKING

Coming into Wednesday night's game, Samford is 5-1 in home games, 1-5 in road games, and 0-2 in neutral-site contests. The Bulldogs have shot .424 in home games, but just .397 on the road. The Bulldogs are scoring 57.8 points per game at home, and 55.7 on the road.

SAMFORD IN SOCON OPENERS

In eight previous Southern Conference seasons, Samford is 5-3 in SoCon openers.

Samford has claimed wins in the team's league opener in each of the last two seasons, including a 59-42 win at Western Carolina last season.

Samford and Chattanooga have met in the SoCon opener twice, with each team winning one meeting. The teams met in the SoCon openers in 2008-09 (UTC, 55-54 in Chattanooga) and in 2009-10 (SU, 74-52 in Birmingham).

LOOKING AHEAD

Following Wednesday night's SoCon opener against Chattanooga, Samford will host ETSU Saturday. The game is scheduled for a 2 p.m. start in the Pete Hanna Center.

SAMFORD IN JANUARY GAMES

In its 19-plus seasons of women's basketball, Samford has a record of 87-76 in games played in the month of January.

Last season, Samford was 6-2 in the first month. This season, Samford has eight games in the month of January on its schedule, with Wednesday's game marking the first of those contests.

CONFERENCE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

ince taking over as the second head coach of Samford women's basketball in 2002, Mike Morris has taken the program to new heights.

Over the last 11 years, the Bulldogs have posted eight of the top-nine win totals in school history, including the program's only seven 20-win seasons.

Morris guided the program to back-to-back Southern Conference Tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2011 and 2012. The team reached a national postseason tournament for the three years in a row, including a WNIT appearance in 2010.

The 2015-16 team posted Morris' seventh 20-win season, finishing the year with a mark of 20-11 and reaching the semfinals of the SoCon Tournament.

The 2010-11 Bulldogs set a school record for wins with a 25-8 record, winning the SoCon Tournament and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the first time. Despite losing two of the top players in program history, the 2011-12 team won 20 games again, and won its second-straight SoCon title and NCAA Tournament berth.

The 2009–10 team reached the finals of the Southern Conference Tournament for the first time and earned the program's first-ever national postseason appearance. The team also earned its first national postseason win with a 66-65 win over Ole Miss in the first round of the WNIT at the Pete Hanna Center.

The 2009-10 team also tied the then-school record for wins with a 23-11 overall record and a 14-6 mark in SoCon play. In 2008–09, the Bulldogs set a school record for conference wins with a 16-4 league record in their first year in the SoCon. The team finished with an overall record of 22-7, reaching the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament.

After the season, Morris was named the 2009 SoCon Coach of the Year. The award marked the second Coach of the Year award for Morris, as he was named the Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year in 2006.

The 2007–08 Bulldogs set a then-school record for most wins in a season, posting a 23-9 overall record and a 15-5 record in the OVC. The Bulldogs also posted their first-ever wins over Southeastern Conference (Alabama) and Big 12 (Missouri) opponents, and reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament for a third year in a row.

The 2006–07 season was another winning one with a record of 18-13 and another trip to the OVC semifinals.

In the 2005–06 season, Samford posted its first 20-win season, finishing with a 21-8 overall record, and the Bulldogs were 15-5 in OVC play. For the first time since joining the league in 2003, the team reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament.

Morris has increased the team's win total in seven of his 12 seasons as head coach. In his first season (2002–03), the team won seven games, up from three the previous season. In his second season (2003–04), the Bulldogs posted 10 wins, only the second time in school history that the team managed double-digit wins. The 2004–05 squad won 13 games, and the 2005–06 team won 21 games. In 2007–08, the Bulldogs won a then-record 23 games, up from 18 in 2006–07. The 2009-10 team also won 23 games and the 2010-11 team won a school-record 25 contests.

Morris is in his 21st season overall at Samford, spending eight seasons as an assistant coach on the men's staff. While working with the men's team, Morris served as the team's top recruiter and directed Samford's summer basketball camps. He was on the bench for both Samford Atlantic Sun Championship seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances.

Before his arrival at Samford in 1994, Morris served for three years as an assistant coach under veteran coach Lenny Acuff at Belhaven College. He coached at Belhaven for two seasons before joining Acuff's staff in 1993 at Berry College in Rome, Ga. In his first year at Belhaven, the Blazers finished with the most wins in nine years, compiling a 17-16 record. The next year, Belhaven went 18-15 and hosted the first round of the NAIA District Playoffs for the first time in 20 years.

Morris played basketball for two seasons at the University of Alabama in Huntsville [UAH], where he was chosen team captain and team MVP his senior season. While at UAH, Morris was the NCAA Division II national champion in free-throw percentage, making 92.1 percent from the line. He played his first two seasons at Jefferson State Junior College in Birmingham.

The Holly Pond, Ala., native earned a B.A. in psychology from Belhaven College in 1992. He has completed 24 hours toward his master's degree in administration from Jacksonville State.

Morris is married to the former Melanie Nix of Huntsville, Ala. They have a son, Peyton, 23, and a daughter, Paige, 20.


