### SAMFORD TRAVELS TO MERCER FOR KEY SOCON CONTEST

The 15th-ranked Samford football team will travel to Macon, Ga., to take on the Mercer Bears in a key Southern Conference game Saturday at 2 p.m. (CT). The game can be heard on FM-99.1 The Game or at www.991thegame.com. It can also be seen live on ESPN3.

Samford enters the game with a record of 5-3 overall and 3-2 in SoCon games. The Bulldogs had won three in a row before dropping a 23-21 last-second heart-breaker to Chattanooga last week.

Mercer is currently 4-4 overall and 3-3 in league games. The Bears took last week off from competition. Mercer last played on Oct. 21, falling, 28-21 at Furman.

#### **THE SERIES**

The Samford Bulldogs and Mercer Bears are meeting for the 24th time, with Samford holding a 12-10-1 advantage in the series.

The teams last met on Nov. 12, 2016, with Samford earning a 24-19 win at Seibert Stadium. Since Mercer joined the SoCon in 2014, Samford is 3-0 against the Bears.

#### SAMFORD ON THE ROAD

Saturday's game will mark Samford's fifth and final road game of the 2017 regular season, and the Bulldogs are 2-2 in those games so far. Last season, the Bulldogs went 2-5 in road games. Under head coach Chris Hatcher, Samford is 7-9 in road contests.

#### SAMFORD AGAINST SOCON TEAMS

Now in its 10th season as a member of the Southern Conference, Samford has a record of 40-35 in league games. So far this season, the Bulldogs are 3-2 in

Against the current members of the Southern Conference, Samford has an all-time record of 66-65-4. The Bulldogs are 12-10-1 all-time against Saturday's opponent, Mercer.

Samford's overall record against each current SoCon member is: Chattanooga (10-30-3), The Citadel (5-6), ETSU (3-1), Furman (9-10), Mercer (12-10-1), VMI (5-0), Western Carolina (12-3) and Wofford (10-5).

#### THE LAST TIME OUT

Samford suffered a 23-21 last-second setback to Chattanooga last Saturday at Seibert Stadium. The Mocs kicked a field goal with 19 seconds left to win the game.

Devlin Hodges passed for 333 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions in the loss. Chris Shelling caught seven passes for 87 yards and a touchdown. Kevin Marion had seven catches for 78 yards, while Kelvin McKnight caught six passes for 104 yards and a score.

The defense was led by Aaron Harris and Shaheed Salmon with nine tackles each. Carter McManes had an interception and a fumble recovery to go along with his five tackles. Horace Roberts also had an interception for the Bulldogs.

#### SAMFORD VERSUS GEORGIA TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 26-30-1 against teams from the state of Georgia, including a mark of 12-10-1 against Mercer. Samford has played the following Georgia teams: Abraham Baldwin (1-0), Clark Atlanta (1-0), Georgia (0-2), Georgia Southern (4-5), Georgia Southwestern (1-2), Georgia State (1-0), Georgia Tech (0-8), Gordon College (1-1), Kennesaw State (1-0), Mercer (12-10-1), Morris Brown (1-0) and West Georgia (3-2).

#### **SCORING POINTS**

Samford has scored in its last 187-consecutive games. The last time Samford was shut out in a football game was on Nov. 9, 2000, a 29-0 loss at Tennessee Tech.

#### HODGES NAMED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

Samford junior quarterback Devlin Hodges has been named to the watch list for the Walter Payton Award, which goes to the top player in all of FCS football.

Last season, Hodges completed 375-of-530 passes for 4,088 yards and 36 touchdowns, all school records. Through the first eight games of the season, Hodges has thrown for 2,654 yards and 22 touchdowns while completing 66.0 percent of his passes.

#### **HODGES BREAKS CAREER RECORDS**

Samford quarterback Devlin Hodges has recently broken a pair of school career records in only his junior season.

He has already set the school's career record for completions with 802, breaking the old record of 704, set by Ray Nelson from 2001 to 2004. He has also thrown for 8,972 yards in his career, breaking the old record of 7,950, set by Nelson.

#### **HOME WIN STREAK SNAPPED**

Samford's 23-21 setback to Chattanooga last week snapped the Bulldogs' nine-game home win streak. The team's last home loss came on Oct. 31, 2015 in a 20-17 loss to Furman.

#### **SOCON PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

So far, Samford has had a player earn SoCon Player of the Week honors four times this season. On Sept. 18, Austin Barnard was named the Special Teams Player of the Week. On Oct. 2, Devlin Hodges earned Offensive Player of the Week honors. Hodges earned the honor again on Oct. 23, and Omari Williams was named the league's Defensive Player of the Week, also on Oct. 23

#### THE LAST TIME AGAINST MERCER

Samford and Mercer last met on Nov. 12, 2016, with Samford earning a 24-19 win at Seibert Stadium.

In the win for Samford, Devlin Hodges passed for 401 yards and three touchdowns. Karel Hamilton had 16 catches for 154 yards and two touchdowns. Emmanuel Obajimi caught 12 passes for 137 yards and a touchdown.

Deion Pierre and Christian Stark had eight tackles each to lead the Samford defense.

### SAMFORD IN THE SOCON STATISTICAL RANK-INGS

As a team, Samford leads the Southern Conference in passing offense, averaging 334.0 yards per game. The Bulldogs also lead the league in kickoff returns (22.5 ypr.).

Individually, Devlin Hodges leads the league in passing yards per game (331.8) and total offense per game (342.5 ypg.). Kelvin McKnight leads the SoCon in receptions per game (8.4), receiving yards per game (114.0), scoring (8.2 ppg.) and all-purpose yards per game (123.8). Darius Harvey is the SoCon leader in kickoff return average (22.5 ypr.). Austin Barnard leads the league in punting (45.5 ypk.). Omari Williams is the league leader in passes defended (1.38 pg.), while Ahmad Gooden leads the SoCon in tackles for loss per game (1.56).

### SAMFORD IN THE NCAA STATISTICAL RANK-INGS

Samford currently ranks eighth in the nation in passing offense, averaging 334.0 passing yards per game. The Bulldogs are also rank eighth in the nation in fewest penalties per game (4.38) and 12th in fewest penalty yards per game (40.88). Samford is 15th in fourth-down conversion percentage defense (30.0%) and in net punting (38.64).

Individually, Kelvin McKnight is third nationally in receptions per game (8.4) and eighth in receiving yards per game (114.0). Devlin Hodges ranks sixth in the nation in passing yards per game (331.8) and fourth in total offense per game (342.5).

#### MCKNIGHT A CONSISTENT THREAT

In each of Samford's eight games so far this season, leading receiver Kelvin McKnight has had at least five catches. He has had at least one touchdown catch in seven of the eight contests, and he has had at least 100 receiving yards in five of the games, while finishing with 97 yards in another contest.

#### **QUICK STRIKES**

So far this season, Samford has continued the trend of quick scoring drives since Chris Hatcher became the program's head coach. This season, Samford has had 16 scoring drives of two minutes or less, including 11 scoring drives of one minute or less. The time of those drives have been: 0:03, 0:10, 0:14, 0:28, 0:31, 0:32, 0:46, 0:47, 0:52, 0:57, 1:00, 1:02, 1:05, 1:07, 1:17, 1:48.

In two-plus seasons under Hatcher, Samford has had 64 scoring drives of two minutes or less and 33 that have lasted one minute or less.

#### FRESHMAN WITH A NOSE FOR THE BALL

Redshirt freshman defensive back Koi Freeman has made big plays look routine so far this season. He leads the team and is tied for second in the SoCon in interceptions with three. He also has one fumble recovery so far this season.

# GOODEN ADDED TO BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

Junior defensive lineman Ahmad Gooden was recently added to the watch list for the Buch Buchanan Award, which goes to the top defensive player in all of FCS football. He enters this week's game as the team leader in tackles with 69. He also leads SoCon in tackles for loss and ranks third in the league in sacks.

#### **BIG PLAYS**

Big plays have come often for the Samford offense so far this season. Through the first eight games of the season, the offense has produced 18 plays of 30 yards or more. Seven of those 18 plays have been for at least 50 yards, including a season-long 72-yard pass from Devlin Hodges to Chris Shelling at Western Carolina.

#### **SPREADING THINGS AROUND**

So far this season, 16 different Samford players have caught at least one pass in a game for the Bulldogs. Junior Kelvin McKnight leads the group with 68 catches for 935 yards and 11 touchdowns. Sophomore Chris Shelling is second on the list with 45 receptions for 563 yards and four scores.

#### SAMFORD COMING OFF A LOSS

So far this season, Samford is 1-1 in games following a loss. In nearly three full seasons under head coach Chris Hatcher, Samford is 5-6 when coming off a loss.

### TURNOVERS, PENALTIES TOO MUCH TO OVER-COME IN LOSS TO CHATTANOOGA

In last week's 23-21 loss to Chattanooga, Samford committed seven turnovers (three interceptions and four fumbles). The seven turnovers were the most for a Samford team in the program's Southern Conference era. The team also committed eight penalties for 87 yards. The 87 penalty yards were a season high for Samford, eclipsing the 81 yards on eight penalties the team committed at Western Carolina.

Samford has an all-time record of 154-151-18 in games played in the month of November. This season, Samford has three games scheduled for November, and Saturday's game marks the first of those contests. Last season, Samford posted a record of 1-3 in the 11th month.

# SALMON NAMED WINNER OF CHARLES WILLIAMS MEMORIAL JERSEY

Senior linebacker Shaheed Salmon has been named the 13th recipient of the Charles Williams Memorial Jersey. The jersey, the No. 5, is given each year to a senior leader on the Samford team. The jersey honors former Samford player Charles Williams, who died in a car accident on May 23, 2003.

Previous winners of the jersey were Ossie Buchannon (2005), T.C. Myers (2006), Jay McCurty (2007), Rodney Shepherd (2008), Jon Weber (2009), Bryce Smith (2010), Sean Thompson (2011), Ryan Dudchock (2012), Justin Shade (2013), Brinson Porter (2014), Carson Barnett (2015) and Devon Schmitt (2016).

#### PRESEASON SOCON HONORS

Samford placed six players on the Southern Conference's coaches' preseason All-SoCon team. The Bulldogs had five players on the first team: Devlin Hodges (QB), Kelvin McKnight (WR), Ahmad Gooden (DL), Shaheed Salmon (LB) and Omari Williams (CB). Austin Barnard (P) was named to the second team.

#### SOCON PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

The SoCon released its preseason polls for both the coaches and media in July, and Samford was picked to finish third in both polls. Samford received three first-place votes in the media poll.

Wofford was picked as the preseason favorite in both polls. The Citadel was picked second in both polls, followed by Samford in third, Chattanooga fourth and Mercer fifth.

On Georgia's next drive, Fromm hit Mecole Hardman for a five-yard touchdown pass to give Georgia a 7-0 lead with 3:48 left in the first quarter. On the next UGA drive, Chubb scored on a 32-yard run to make the score 14-0 with 1:45 left in the opening quarter.

Fromm connected with Terry Goodwin for a 51-yard touchdown to push Georgia's lead to 21-0 with 10:32 left in the second quarter. Samford got on the scoreboard when Hodges hit Marshall for a nine-yard touchdown to cut the lead to 21-7 with 5:49 left in the second quarter. On Georgia's next drive, the Bulldogs fumbled and Samford's Christian Stark recovered at the Georgia 25-yard line. CULLOWHEE, N.C. – Samford junior quarterback Devlin Hodges threw for a school-record 516 yards, but the 17th-ranked Bulldog football team dropped a heart-breaking, 38-34 contest at Western Carolina in the team's Southern Conference opener at E.J. Whitmire Stadium.

On the final drive of the game, Samford started at its own one-yard-line with 1:31 to play. The Bulldogs drove to the Western Carolina three-yard-line where it was 1st-and-goal with 20 seconds to play. Treyvon Paulk then rushed to the two-yard-line. After an incompletion, Hodges ran to the one-yard line where Samford called timeout with just two seconds remaining. # CHRIS HATCHER HEAD COACH

Thris Hatcher was named Samford's 36th head football coach on Dec. 11, 2014.

Now in the middle of his third season at Samford, Hatcher boasts a career record of 139-70 in 17-plus years as a college head coach, having previously coached at Murray State, Georgia Southern and Valdosta State.

Last season, Hatcher led the team to a 7-5 record and a spot in the NCAA Division I-FCS Playoffs. The 7-5 record marked the program's sixth-straight winning season, the longest streak in program history.

Under Hatcher's tutelage, quarterback Devlin Hodges set school records for single-season completions (375), attempts (530), passing yards (4,088) and touchdown passes (36). Hodges

was named the SoCon's Offensive Player of the Year and a third team All-American at the conclusion of the season.

As a unit, the Samford offense ranked third among all FCS schools in passing offense, averaging 349.4 passing yards per game. The offense also ranked sixth in the nation in red zone offense (90.2%), 11th in team passing efficiency (155.24), 12th in scoring offense (35.1 ppg.) and 14th in total offense (446.2 ypg.).

In his first season at Samford in 2015, Hatcher put his stamp on the Bulldog program. Samford finished the season third in the nation in passing offense (332.9 ypg.), seventh in the nation in total offense (479.7 ypg.) and seventh in fourth down conversions (66.7%). Hatcher's special teams also stood out, ranking fifth nationally in kickoff return average (24.34 ypr.).

Hatcher led the Bulldogs to a 6-5 record that first season, ending the season with a pair of impressive Southern Conference road wins at Wofford and Mercer. The 2015 team also produced a pair of All-Americans in cornerback James Bradberry and place-kicker Anthony Pistelli.

Hatcher came to Samford after serving as the head coach at Murray State University from 2010 to 2014. In five seasons as the head coach of the Racers, Hatcher's teams employed the high-powered "Hatch Attack" offense to top the Division I-FCS football charts. In 2014, the Racers ranked second in the nation in passing offense, averaging 327.2 yards per game. The team also ranked 15th in total offense at 468.3 yards per contest.

MSU used a balanced attack in 2013. The Racers rushed the ball 424 times, while throwing it 458, in averaging 398.6 yards of offense. The offense was spearheaded by All-America wide receiver Walter Powell, who hauled in 66 passes for 837 yards and 13 touchdowns in just 10 games.

The 2012 Murray State offense led the Ohio Valley Conference for the third-straight season. MSU averaged a school-record 484.4 yards of offense per game, while also setting a new single-season record by averaging 348.9 yards through the air.

The 2011 season saw the Racers go 7-4 and post back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since the 1999-2000 seasons. MSU closed the season winning five of its final six games, including going on the road and knocking off nationally-ranked Tennessee Tech.

The Racer offense was among the most prolific in the nation as MSU ranked third in scoring offense, fourth in total offense and seventh in passing offense. The 5,070 yards of total offense marked just the fifth time in school history MSU amassed over 5,000 yards, while the 460.9 yards per game were the third-most all time. The Racers also rushed for 152.27 yards per game.

The defense was not to be outdone as the Racers recorded their first shutout in seven years with a 39-0 victory over Mississippi Valley State. It also marked the first shutout on the road since 1986, and the first non-conference road shutout since the 1979 season.

In 2010, the Racer offense led the OVC in passing offense, total offense and scoring offense, while ranking fourth nationally in passing offense, fifth in total offense and fifth in scoring offense.

Hatcher is no stranger to the Southern Conference, as he served as the head coach at Georgia Southern from 2007 to 2009.

In his first season with the Eagles in 2007, Hatcher led GSU to the second-best regular season turnaround in program history, a plus-4 improvement from 2006. The Eagles ranked among the national leaders in various categories on offense, defense and special teams. He also coached five All-America players, including quarterback Jayson Foster, the second Walter Payton Award winner at GSU.

The Eagles returned to the national rankings after a 14-week hiatus as the Hatcher era got off to a 4-1 start. GSU climbed as high as No. 11, after the Eagles recorded three-straight victories at No. 5 Appalachian State, ending the Mountaineers 30-game home winning streak, at home against No. 25 The Citadel and at No. 10 Wofford.

The prolific offense ranked first in rushing, eighth in total offense, eighth in scoring offense and 23rd in sacks allowed. The defense was 14th in turnover margin and 17th in fumbles recovered, while the special teams ranked 25th in net punting.

The 2008 season saw Hatcher guide the Eagles to the program's 25th winning season in 27 years.

In late October, the Eagles set an NCAA record for the largest fourth-quarter comeback as GSU erased a 31-3 deficit for a thrilling 38-31 overtime victory at Western Carolina. The OT contest was just the first of an NCAA record four overtime games played by the Eagles in 2008.

Hatcher's team provided impressive numbers in all three phases. The offense ranked 20th nationally in passing and scoring, while the defense ranked 26th in sacks and 22nd in tackles-for-loss. The special teams units finished 14th in punt returns and

36th in kickoff returns.

All of this was done as Hatcher and his staff were forced to play close to 30 freshmen on a consistent basis throughout the season. In all, five Eagles received All-SoCon honors and seven freshmen representing offense, defense and special teams were named to the inaugural SoCon All-Freshman Team.

Prior to his time at GSU, Hatcher molded Valdosta State into one of the most dominant teams in Division II.

The winningest coach in Blazers' history, Hatcher was 76-12 at his alma mater. In his first year back at VSU, Hatcher took a 4-7 squad the previous year and produced a 10-2 overall record (8-1 in GSC action) and a berth in the Division II playoffs. He coached quarterback Dusty Bonner, who was a two-time winner of the Harlon Hill Trophy as the NCAA Division II Player of the Year, an award Hatcher won himself in 1994.

His 2001 and 2002 teams posted back-to-back undefeated records during the regular season, part of a Gulf South Conference record 35 straight victories during the regular season.

During the 2004 championship season, the Blazers lost their season-opener before rattling off 13 consecutive victories, capped by a 36-31 victory over Pittsburg State in the title game. Hatcher was named National Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association and was the offensive coordinator for the East squad at the Hula Bowl.

In 2005, Valdosta opened the season ranked No. 1 for four-straight weeks and saw the season culminate with a sixth-straight NCAA postseason appearance. Despite an 8-2 record in 2006, the 10th-ranked Blazers did not receive an invitation to the playoffs, marking the first time that occurred in the Hatcher era.

The 2006 team finished sixth nationally in passing offense (283 yards per game), 12th in scoring offense (34.9 ppg.) and 19th in total offense (389.9 ypg.). In addition to the offensive success, the 2006 defense ranked 27th nationally in scoring defense (15.7 ppg.) while the special teams ranked third in punt returns (17.3 ypr.) and blocked seven kicks.

The Macon, Ga., native spent one year as quarterbacks/tight ends coach at the University of Central Florida where he worked with future NFL quarterback Daunte Culpepper. He then spent three years working with the quarterbacks at the University of Kentucky where he worked under former VSU head coach Hal Mumme. During his time with the Wildcats, he coached the No. 1 NFL draft pick, All-America quarterback Tim Couch.

While at UK, Hatcher and the Wildcats played in the 1999 Outback Bowl, the program's first New Year's Day Bowl in 47 years, then followed that the following year with a berth in the '99 Music City Bowl. It marked the first time the Wildcats had consecutive bowl appearances in 15 years.

Hatcher carried his success on the playing field to help him develop into one of the nation's winningest coaches. A two-time All-American quarterback at VSU (1993 and 1994), Hatcher threw for 11,363 yards and 121 touchdowns during his stellar career. During his senior year in 1994, he led the Blazers to their first postseason berth, advancing to the quarterfinals, and when it was all said and done set 29 VSU passing and total offense records.

Among the national records he once set were a 68.5 career completion percentage and a streak of 20-straight completions in a game against New Haven. Hatcher held 14 Valdosta State, 13 Gulf South Conference and 17 Division II national records. He also started 41 consecutive games, posting a 29-10-2 record.

Not only did Hatcher excel on the field, he was just as successful in the classroom. Twice he received the Gulf South Conference's Commissioner's Trophy which is awarded to the league's Most Outstanding Student-Athlete. He finished his senior year by winning several national honors including: the NCAA Top Eight Award, the CoSIDA Academic All-America National Player of the Year and a postgraduate scholarship from the National Football Foundation and College Football Hall of Fame.

At the time when Hatcher won the Harlon Hill Trophy, he won by the second-largest voting margin in the then-19-year history of the award. Hatcher was also voted to the GSC Football team of the 1990s.

The honors continued to add up even after his playing days. Hatcher was named to the Valdosta State University Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001, in his first year of eligibility. He was also elected into the Macon Sports Hall of Fame the same year.

In 2005, Hatcher was inducted into the Division II Hall of Fame. Hatcher was also inducted into the inaugural class of the GSC Hall of Fame in 2014.

Hatcher graduated from Valdosta State in 1995 with a bachelor's degree in health and physical education.

He and his wife, Lori, also a graduate of VSU, are the parents of a son, Ty, and daughter, Talley.
