- 2 Saskatchewan is 6-0 all-time vs the Griffins. The first matchup came in the 2014-15 season.
- 3 The Huskies average 12.2 kills per set – good for third in the conference. On the other end, MacEwan's 9.9 kills per set is the only mark under 10 in the conference.
- 4 CJ Gavlas and Etienne Hagenbuch have recorded 99 and 100 digs respectively; both inside the top 10 of the conference.
- 5 Colin Fraser producing at an efficient rate so far this season – his 25% hitting percentage is good for fifth in the conference (min. 3 kills/set).

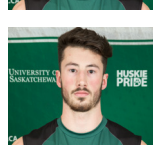
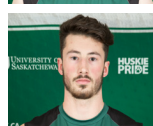

Brian Gavlas took over the Huskie men's volleyball program as head coach in 1992 from Tom Graham. Since taking over the team, Gavlas has led the Huskies to four Canada West Championship titles and 10 appearances in the CIS Championship tournament. Under him, the team was crowned CIS champions twice -1998-99 and 2003-04 – and finished with a silver twice -1997-98 and 1999-00.

For his success, he has been named Canada West Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year four times (1995-96, 1997-98, 2000-01 and 2012-13) and CIS Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year in 2000-01. He has also been named Huskie Athletics Coach of the Year four times – 1995-96, 1998-99, 2000-01, 2012-13. He has also been named the 3M Canadian Coach of the Year in 2001. He also coached on the international scene. He was an assistant coach at the 2005 Summer Universiade in Izmir, Turkey, as well as head coach of the DTV Volleyball Club, a professional team in Duran, Germany for one season in 2001-02.
