- The Huskies offence goes as Adam Machart goes. The third-year running back's historic regular season came to an end on Saturday, with the Saskatoon native setting the program's single-season rushing yards record with 1,331 yards.
- Saskatchewan was dominant at home in 2019, outscoring their opponents 135-44 with home-field advantage in their four regular-season games.
- The Huskies have defeated the Golden Bears in their last eight meetings in Saskatoon, with their most recent defeat being a 32-31 loss in the 2010 postseason.
- Sam Baker has registered 15 receptions for 235 yards and four touchdowns in his three games played.
- Saskatchewan's Nelson Lokombo, Clovis Lumeka, Nixen Voll and Ramsey Derbas each finished the regular season in the top five in pro passer rating allowed

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN BEARS

- Alberta head coach Chris Morris led the program to their first season a .500 record or better during his seven-year tenure with the team. Morris will coach in the second Canada West playoff game of his career, with his first being a 39-22 loss to Calgary in the 2017 Canada West semifinal.
- Fourth-year quarterback Brad Launhardt, who spent time with the Edmonton Huskies before re-joining to the Golden Bears, led the Canada West with 2328 passing yards while recording 298 rushing yards, which was most among the conference's quarterbacks.

SASKATOON – It was a record-breaking day for Adam Machart and an important one for the Saskatchewan Huskies as they took down the Alberta Golden Bears by a score of 22-9 on a cold day in Saskatoon.

Coming into the game with 1104 rushing yards on the season, Machart needed 163 yards to break the Huskies' program record of 1267 set by Doug Rozon in 1999. The product of Saskatoon achieved that and then some, rumbling for 227 yards on 29 carries to etch his name into the Huskie record books.

With the win the Huskies clinch second place in the conference and the right to host a playoff game for the first time since 2014. If results around the league hold out, facing them in that playoff game will be these very same Golden Bears who finish the season at 4-4 and are back in the playoffs after missing out in 2018.

Buoyed by Machart's big day the Huskies outgained the Golden Bears 453-134.

Mason Nyhus went for 226 yards through the air and the familiar Sam Baker was his favourite target, catching six balls for 68 yards and a touchdown.

Alberta quarterback Brad Launhardt threw for 115 yards but the most explosive Golden Bear was Wesley Bookland who returned a missed field goal 120 yards for a touchdown.

After the teams exchanged punts early, Alberta got on the board thanks to their special teams. A field goal from Saskatchewan sailed wide, Bookland gathered it deep in his endzone and exploded past the Huskie tacklers for the major.

EDMONTON – Adam Machart rushed for a career-high 180 yards and Nelson Lokombo pulled down his fourth interception in as many games but Jonathan Giustini hit a 45-yard field goal with 46 seconds left, as the Alberta Golden Bears earned a third-straight upset win with a 19-17 victory over the No. 8 ranked Saskatchewan Huskies, Saturday afternoon at Foote Field.

Alberta drove 68 yards in just 1:24, which included a 31-yard pass play on third down, to set up the game-winning field goal from the rookie Bears kicker.

It's the second straight week the Bears have scored in the final minute to secure a win, after beating Manitoba 29-26 in Week 3 thanks to a touchdown with six seconds left. Their 3-1 record puts them alone in second place, while the Huskies fall to 2-2.

In a game that was dominated by the respective defences, neither team held a lead larger than five. Alberta's offence, particularly in the second half, was more productive than Saskatchewan's as they finished the game out-gaining the Huskies 445-327.

Alberta quarterback Brad Launhardt had another strong performance, finishing with 330 passing yards, 30 rushing yards and one TD pass. Fifth-year receiver Ben Kopczynski added to his conference-lead in receiving with eight catches for 141 yards.

Huskies starting pivot Ethan Watson compiled 134 passing yards on 17 completions. However, the Huskie offence was led by running back Adam Machart, who has rushed for totals of 93, 134, 134 and 180 in his four games of action in 2019.

Saskatchewan Huskies (3rd Season 2019)
Regular Season Record: 12-13

Former University of Saskatchewan offensive lineman and retired-CFL standout Scott Flory joined the Huskies' coaching staff in August 2014. He was named head coach of the Huskies in March of 2017.

Returning home to Saskatchewan after a 15-year career with the Montreal Alouettes in the Canadian Football League, Flory served as the team's offensive coordinator for the last three seasons.

During Flory's impressive CFL career, he was named a CFL All-Star nine times, a CFL East All-Star 11 times and handed the Most Outstanding Offensive Lineman Award twice. He also won three Grey Cup Championships with Montreal in 2002, 2009 and 2010.

Flory played with the Huskies from 1994 to 1998. Winning two Vanier Cup championships with the Huskies in 1996 and 1998, Flory was drafted to the CFL by the Montreal Alouettes in 1998 (third round, 15th overall). He was named a Canada West All-Star three times and a CIS All-Canadian twice in during his University career.
