OPENING TIP: Rutgers will work to improve to 18-1 in non-conference home games under Steve Pikiell when it welcomes No. 15 Seton Hall for the annual Garden State Hardwood Classic. The home arenas for the schools, dubbed the "RAC" and the "Rock," are separated by a 27-mile drive. The sold out rivalry match-up signals the first capacity crowd at the RAC since Ohio State on Feb. 8, 2015 and the first against the Pirates since Feb. 12, 2011. RU has the opportunity to defeat a ranked foe for the first time since downing No. 4 Wisconsin 67-62 on Jan. 11, 2015. RU also has the chance to beat a ranked SHU squad for a 2nd time after a 70-64 road victory over the No. 22 Pirates on Feb. 4, 2001.

THE OPPONENT: Under 8th-year head coach Kevin Willard, Seton Hall has won five straight and has achieved its highest national ranking since 2001. Four SHU players average double figures in scoring, led by Desi Rodriguez (19.4). Angel Delgado is the NCAA active career leader in double-doubles with 57.

- With 12 against Fordham, junior Corey Sanders became the 42nd RU men's basketball player to reach 1,000 career points and will be recognized pre-game. Senior Mike Williams enters Saturday with 989 career points.

- Rutgers leads the nation in rebounding (45.67) and offensive rebounding (15.92), while placing fourth among all D-I programs in both scoring defense (57.8) and field goal percentage defense (35.9). The Scarlet Knights are first or second in the Big Ten in eight stat categories.

- Rutgers is in the midst of playing four of seven games against opponents ranked or receiving votes.

- Deshawn Freeman is 2nd in the Big Ten in offensive rebounding (3.17) and fourth in rebounding (8.3), while Geo Baker leads all Big Ten freshmen in minutes-per-game (31.2).

- Saturday marks the fourth of five straight contests at the RAC versus metro foes.

- Rutgers inked three during the early signing period, guards Montez Mathis and Ron Harper, Jr. and forward Shaq Carter (see bios).

GARDEN STATE HARDWOOD CLASSIC: THE CONNECTIONS

- RU Director of Athletics Pat Hobbs joined the Scarlet Knights on Nov. 29, 2015, moving south down the New Jersey Turnpike after notable achievements at SHU. He served as Dean at the Seton Hall School of Law from 1999 to 2015 and oversaw the Department of Athletics for the Pirates from 2009 to 2011.
- Steve Pikiell twice directed Stony Brook against Kevin Willard-led Seton Hall, with the Pirates winning both match-up by a total of three points. On Dec. 28, 2012, SHU defeated SBU 60-59 at the Prudential Center. On March 13, 2012, the Pirates defeated the Seawolves 63-61 at Walsh Gym in the opening round of the NIT. RU Director of Basketball Operations Bryan Dougher scored 12 points on four three-pointers for SBU in that game
- RU senior guard Mike Williams and SHU senior guard Khadeen Carrington were teammates at Bishop Loughlin HS in Brooklyn, N.Y. The duo helped the Lions to consecutive CHSAA Class AA intersectional final appearances. Williams, Carrington and SHU senior center Angel Delgado were also teammates on the AAU circuit with the New York Lightning.
- SHU assistant coach Fred Hill served as head coach at RU from 2006-07 to 2009-10.

GARDEN STATE HARDWOOD CLASSIC: THE SERIES

Rutgers and Seton Hall have met 68 times on the collegiate hardwood dating to 1916, with Seton Hall holding a 39-29 advantage in victories, including four straight. The Pirates won the last three match-ups by double digits, but 18 of the 20 prior meetings were decided by six points or less or in overtime. The teams have played 55 times since 1974-75 and have met every season since 1995-96. Rutgers is 16-17 all-time at home versus the Pirates.

THE GARDEN STATE HARDWOOD CLASSIC TROPHY

The #GSHClassic Trophy is a perpetual rivalry trophy is constructed primarily from recycled Asbury Park boardwalk planks, which were retrieved during a re-decking after Superstorm Sandy. The trophy topper is formed in the state of New Jersey with the base mimicking the form and texture of a basketball. "1916" is branded on the topper, which signifies the year of the initial meeting between the schools on the hardwood. The athletics logos are affixed at their geographic locations. The official logo of the Garden State Hardwood Classic, which was conceived and created by former Seton Hall women's soccer student-athlete Peggy Nicolle, adorns the base. The trophy stands 32 inches tall and weighs 33 pounds. New Jersey resident Colin Pezzano, a 2014 graduate of the University of the Arts, created the one-of-a-kind award. The trophy was constructed in a workshop on a farm in Cumberland County, N.J.

GARDEN STATE HARDWOOD CLASSIC: THE GAME BALL

The Rutgers and Seton Hall Army ROTC programs will run the game ball from South Orange to the RAC on gameday with the help of state police. The run will unfold as a relay, with groups of four (two cadets from each school) traveling four miles each. All 20 cadets will participate in the final 1.6 miles. The game ball will be delivered beforehand to Hobbs, who has served in leadership roles at both schools and was instrumental in the hiring of each head coach.

THE WAY YOU LOOK TONIGHT

- Rutgers has held three teams under 40 points. The last time RU limited three or more teams to under 40 points in a season was 1945-46 (Haverford, Franklin & Marshall, Panzer, Camp Kilmer).
- Geo Baker shot 7-of-11 versus FDU en route to his first career double-double (19 points, 11 assists), which was comprised of the most helpers by an RU player in a regulation game since Marquis Webb also had 11 versus Syracuse on Jan. 24, 2005.
- Rutgers limited No. 3 MSU to a season-low 62 points and 38.6 percent

shooting, well below its season average of 50.2 percent.

- At No. 12 Minnesota, Rutgers had five players score in double-figures for the first time since six players at Miami on Nov. 13, 2016.

- Rutgers won by 14 vs. East Carolina with one player in double-figures. The last time RU won by double-digits with one player scoring in double-figures was a 69-55 win over Robert Morris on Nov. 11, 2008.

- Geo Baker's 29 points vs. Bryant marked the most for an RU freshman in a regulation game since Todd Billet had 31 vs. Notre Dame on Jan. 18, 2000. Baker's seven 3-pointers were the most for an RU rookie since Billet made eight triples that same game.

- RU's 16 blocks vs. Bryant were the most since issuing 18 vs. St. Peters Dec. 22, 2009.

- The 94-38 win over CCNY tied the largest margin of victory in program history, matching the 56-point (91-35) win over Trenton State on Dec. 9, 1936. The 60 rebounds were RU's most since 74 against Keene State on Dec. 7, 1992.

Head Coach Steve Pikiell | @COACHPIKIELL

- 19th head coach in the history of Rutgers men's basketball.
- Responsible for one of the biggest turnarounds in Division I, leading RU to a plus-117 improvement in RPI, as well as major NCAA ranking improvements in virtually every statistical category.
- 26 seasons of coaching experience.
- Eight coach of the year awards.
- He and his wife Kate are the proud parents of four children.
- Two-time team captain at point guard under Naismith Hall of Fame Head Coach Jim Calhoun at Connecticut.
- One of nine children, grew up with three brothers and five sisters and enjoyed a storied career at St. Paul Catholic HS in Bristol, Conn. A three-time all-state selection, he had his No. 21 jersey retired by the school.

Associate Head Coach Karl Hobbs | @COACHKARLHOBBS

- 30 seasons of coaching experience and 18 post-season appearances.
- Directed George Washington to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances as head coach and captured two national titles as an assistant at Connecticut.
- Was an assistant coach for the United States U-19 team that included two-time NBA champion and MVP Steph Curry and DeAndre Jordan.
- Was named Massachusetts Schoolboy Player of the Year in 1979-80 after leading Cambridge Rindge & Latin High School to the state title. He was coached scholastically by Mike Jarvis and was a teammate of Patrick Ewing.

Assistant Coach Brandin Knight | @BKNIGHT20

- NJ native with a reputation as one of college basketball's top young coaches, advanced to 10 NCAA Tournaments as either a staffer (eight) or student-athlete (two) at Pitt, including four Sweet Sixteen appearances.
- A 2003 Wooden All-American, 2002 Associated Press All-American and two-time All-Big East honoree, Knight's No. 20 jersey was retired by the Panthers on March 4, 2009.
- An East Orange native, Knight's brother Brevin was a 12-year NBA veteran and a consensus All-America point guard at Stanford. The Knights represent one of only eight brother combinations in Division I history to earn All-America honors. His father Melvin, a former Seton Hall assistant coach and player, serves as the athletic director at Essex County College (N.J.).

- Has 30 years of collegiate coaching experience, working with Steve Pikiell the past 12 seasons.
- Has achieved success throughout his career at multiple levels. He helped programs to six NCAA Tournament appearances, comprised of two each at the Division I, II and III levels, as well as a berth in the Junior College Final Four.

IF I HAD YOU

Construction has begun on the RWJBarnabas Health Athletic Performance Center at Rutgers University. Slated for completion in 2019, it will be built on the site of the existing parking lot southwest of the RAC and northwest of the Business School. The Center signals a partnership between Rutgers and RWJBarnabas Health to create a comprehensive sports medicine program to serve Rutgers athletes, students and communities throughout New Jersey. Through this partnership, RWJBarnabas Health will become the exclusive health care provider for Rutgers Athletics, while creating a best-in-class sports medicine program that can be expanded across the state. The building will provide a state-of-the-art practice facility for men's and women's basketball, wrestling and gymnastics.

Rutgers, RWJBarnabas Health, state and community officials broke ground on the 295,000-square-foot, four-story sports facility and parking deck in a ceremony on Nov. 1, 2016. The RWJBarnabas Health sports medicine center will be accessible to the entire Rutgers community and the public, in addition to Rutgers athletes.

THE LAST DANCE

Corey Sanders became the 42nd player in RU men’s basketball history to reach 1,000 points, scoring 12 on 5-of-8 shooting, to help Rutgers to a 75-63 win over Fordham Tuesday evening at the RAC. Six players scored in double figures for the Scarlet Knights. Sanders achieved the millen-nium mark via a short-range floater with 35 seconds remaining in the first half. He was joined in double figures by Deshawn Freeman, Geo Baker, Issa Thiam, Candido Sa and Mike Williams. Freeman had 14 points and 10 rebounds to register his 14th career double-double, while Baker scored 12 points, Thiam 11, and both Sa and Williams added 10. It marked the first time RU had six players in double-figures since an 87-66 win against Drexel on Nov. 13, 2016. Rutgers grabbed 45 boards, including 15 off the offensive glass, and was +18 on the boards.

COME FLY WITH ME

Rutgers began this season the same way it concluded the last, with an emphasis on community service and giving back. Rutgers and St. John’s raised \$15,000 for American Red Cross Disaster Relief via a charity exhibi-tion at the RAC on Nov. 5. The day prior (Nov. 4), the team hosted a clinic with the Special Olympics New Jersey unified basketball team that will represent the Garden State at the 2018 Special Olympics USA games. On Nov. 7, players volunteered at Elijah’s Promise Soup Kitchen in New Bruns-wick as part of RLA’s Annual Week of Service. The kitchen serves almost 300 meals a day and over 100,000 meals a year to individuals who would otherwise go hungry. On Sept. 24, the team participated in the Tunnel to Towers 5K Run. The event symbolizes Stephen Siller’s final footsteps from the foot of the Battery Tunnel to the Twin Towers, and pays homage to the 343 FDNY firefighters, 71 law enforcement officers, and thousands of civil-ians who lost their lives on Sept. 11, 2001. Last season, men’s basketball had 100% team participation in Rutgers Leadership Academy community service initiatives. Joey Downes was one of nine student-athletes to travel to Honduras with the RLA in June to benefit Soles4Souls, a global not-for-profit dedicated to fighting poverty.

The 2018 Big Ten Men’s Basketball Tournament will take place at Madison Square Garden, Feb. 28-March 4. The league held its annual media day from the World’s Most Famous Arena on Oct. 19. Rutgers is 45-55 at the current (since Feb. 1968) Madison Square Garden. Overall at MSG since 1949, Rutgers is 51-57.

NIGHT AND DAY

- Last season, Rutgers more than doubled its overall win total and tripled its conference victory total from 2015-16.
- Achieved a plus-117 rank improvement in RPI, as well as major NCAA ranking improvements in rebound margin (+299), scoring defense (+272), three point FG defense (+247), offensive rebounds (+244), rebounds (+232), field goal percentage defense (+226) and blocks (+114).
- Ranked among the top 100 in 10 NCAA statistical categories, including among the top 50 in seven, after ranking among the top 150 in just two statistical categories in 2015-16.
- Earned the program's first Big Ten Conference road and tournament victories.
- 9-1 start marked the best head-coaching debut in Rutgers men's basketball history.
- 6-0 signaled the sixth-best undefeated start in the 110-year history of the program.
- Posted an undefeated home record in non-conference play.
- Out-rebounded opponents in 11 of 18 conference games, after winning the boards in just three league contests in 2015-16.
- Ten Big Ten games were decided in single digits after suffering 15 league losses by double digits in 2015-16.
- Played the second-toughest conference schedule in the Big Ten according to Ken Pom analysis.
- Played 17 games, 52 percent of its schedule, against programs that earned NCAA (13) or NIT (4) bids.

SOMETHING WONDERFUL

Quincy Douby was officially inducted into the Rutgers Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 20, 2017. He scored 1,690 points, the sixth-highest total in Rutgers men's basketball history, in three seasons. The Brooklyn native averaged 25.4 points per-game as a junior in 2005-06, setting the school record for points in a season (839), to lead the league in scoring en route to becoming RU's only First Team All-Big East Conference selection. The Haggerty Award winner as the Metropolitan Player of the Year and an All-American in 2005-06, Douby is among the Rutgers career leaders in every offensive category.

Press Row/Press Box: For the 2017-18 season, working media space, as well as television and radio broadcast locations, will be located in the North side press boxes of the RAC. Rutgers radio is located in press box three (PB3), television in PB4A, writers in PB4B and PB4C and visiting radio in PB5. Wireless internet access is available, as well as live game stats via Statbroadcast.com. Please see and OAC representative for password information.

In-Season Interview Policy: Requests for coaches, players and basketball staff members should be made at least 24 hours in advance. All interviews must be coordinated through the OAC.

Practice: Practices are closed to the public. Practices are open to accredited members of the media with prior arrangements through the OAC. The shooting of video footage at practice must be approved by an OAC representative and be conducted during the first 20 minutes of practice. Rutgers players are unavailable on game days until post-game interviews commence.

Post-Game Press Conferences: Post-game press conferences at the RAC begin approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of each game. A member of the Rutgers OAC staff will escort head coach Steve Pikiell and selected/requested players to the interview area, located in the media center. The opposing coach and players (if requested) will also be brought to the media conference room, either before or after Rutgers depending on time constraints. The opposing team may also elect to conduct their post-game outside of its locker room. Please see a member of the OAC with any questions or specific requests for interviews.

The John Carroll School Head Coach John Zito: "Montez is a super tough kid. He can really score the ball from all over the floor, from all three levels. He's gotten much better over the last two years. He can really get to the basket, he can finish through contact, and he's really good in the open floor. He's a really good defender. His size and athleticism, along with his skill set allow him to do some things that a lot of guys can't.

"He's just a great, great kid. He's a little more on the quiet side, but is a really funny kid. He gets along really well with all his teammates. He's very respectful and just a pleasure to be around."

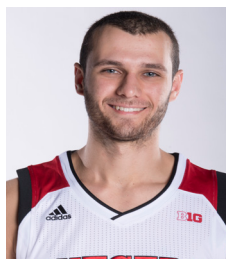
