Successful Alumni

Rutgers women's basketball celebrated three of its most distinguished alum during the last year. Kahleah Copper earned a gold medal in the 2024 Olympic Games with Team USA in addition to a WNBA 2025 Finals appearance with the Phoenix Mercury. Benijah Laney-Hamilton was crowned the 2024 WNBA Champion with the New York Liberty as well. Cappie Pondexter was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as a part of the 2025 Class and Matee Ajavon was also inducted into the Rutgers Hall of Fame as a part of the 2025 class.

Copper helped Team USA to its eighth straight gold medal and her first, with a 67-66 win over France on August 11. Copper came up huge off the bench in the gold medal game with 12 points, including 10 in the fourth quarter to help secure the victory.

Laney-Hamilton also made history with the Liberty, bringing the first WNBA Championship to New York. She played a huge role in game two of the series, netting 20 points in addition to two rebounds and two assists to give the Liberty its first victory of the series. In addition, she scored at least two points in the other four games.

The 5-9 guard who played for Rutgers from 2001-06, Pondexter was the fourth Scarlet Knight in women's basketball history to be named a First Team Kodak/WBCA All-American as well as the unanimous choice as the 2006 BIG EAST Player of the Year and the first player in league history to be named to the All-BIG EAST First Team four times during her career. Pondexter is a two-time WNBA champion (Phoenix Mercury

'07 & '09), a seven-time WNBA All-Star and a three-time All-WNBA First Team selection.

Coquese Washington was named the third full-time head coach in the history of Rutgers women's basketball on May 23, 2022. A three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year during her 12-year tenure at Penn State, Washington (first name pronounced ko-KWEES) arrived "On the Banks" with extensive experience program building and coaching championship-caliber basketball.

During her third and most recent season at the helm of the Scarlet Knights, Washington brought the team back to the postseason for the first time in 2021, with the program's third appearance in the WNIT.

Destiny Adams ended her collegiate career with a historic season, helping the team advance to the WNIT Great 8 with the program's seventh triple-double and first since 2020. Adams was also named to the Big Ten Second Team, USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Midseason Watch List selection, All-ECAC Second Team and First Team All-MET.

The Scarlet Knights continued to grow under Washington in her second slate at the helm. The team celebrated its 50th season in program history, highlighting historic moments, players and coaches throughout the year, which culminated in a grand celebration for Alumni Weekend. RU also inducted its inaugural Knights of Honor class in the 1982, 2000 and 2007 teams with banner in Jersey Mike's Arena.

The squad earned its sixth advance sellout in program history and first since 2006, against Iowa, which became the most attended basketball game between men's and women's contests of the entire 2023-24 campaign.

Destiny Adams had a breakout year in her first campaign "On The Banks" under Washington. The transfer led active players on the team in multiple statistical categories while also ranking top-5 in the conference. She earned All-Big Ten Second Team (Coaches) honors and an Honorable Mention (Media). In addition, Adams set the Big Ten Tournament single game rebounding record with 24 boards in the opening round.

In her first season as head coach, Washington set a solid foundation for the team. She guided the program to its 1,000th win in program history with a road victory over Minnesota (Jan. 12), becoming just the 22nd Division I team and the third squad in the Big Ten to reach the milestone. In the same game against the Gophers, Washington also picked up her 100th Big Ten win.

Washington aided freshman guard Kaylene Smikle in chasing greatness, as she was named to the All-Big Ten Second Team (Media & Coaches) and the Big Ten All-Freshman team (Media & Coaches). The guard also collected three Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors, the most in program history. Under Washington's direction, Smikle became Rutgers' all-time leading freshman scorer, ending the season with 573 points to best the previous high of 536 points. She is the third freshman in program history to amass 500+ points.

Smikle paced the team with 17.9 points per game in addition to averaging 19.5 points in Big Ten play. She was the only Scarlet Knight to net 20+ points in a game during the season and accomplished the feat 15 times, including versus 12 Big Ten opponents, leading all freshmen in reaching double-digit scoring. The Farmingdale, New York product also paced the team with 56 three-pointers and 69 steals to rank top-10 in the conference in both categories.

Washington also saw Chyna Cornwell named an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention (Media) as well as earning the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award. In a breakout season, Cornwell paced RU with nine

double-doubles, including four in Big Ten play.

Before settling "On The Banks" Washington spent two seasons at Notre Dame, marking her second coaching stint in South Bend after serving as assistant coach for her alma mater from 1999-2007. She earned her first head coaching position at Penn State, where she became the first female African American head coach in the school's history and went on to lead the Lady Lions to three Big Ten titles and four NCAA Tournaments. Washington also spent the 2019-20 season as associate head coach at Oklahoma.

During her most recent two seasons at Notre Dame, the Fighting Irish returned to the national scene with an appearance in the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2022. The Sweet 16 run marked Washington's 10th season on the sidelines in South Bend following an eight-year stint as an assistant under Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame inductee Muffet McGraw, highlighted by eight consecutive NCAA Tournaments, four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances, and the 2001 NCAA Championship.

The Washington era at Rutgers signals the head coach's return to the Big Ten. From 2012-14, the Lady Lions claimed three consecutive Big Ten regular-season titles, becoming one of four programs in conference history to win three or more regular-season crowns in a row. She guided Penn State to Sweet 16 appearances in 2012 and 2014 while developing 17 players to All-Big Ten status on 32 separate occasions.

Washington earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors three times (2012-14), WBCA Regional Coach of the Year twice (2012, 2013), and was named a finalist for WBCA National Coach of the Year two times (2012, 2013). She was also selected as the 2011 and 2014 Black Coaches Association (BCA) Female Coach of the Year.

Her programs' success has mirrored her prowess on the recruiting trail, where she signed 12 top-25 recruiting classes throughout her coaching career at Notre Dame and Penn State. After recruitment came development as Washington mentored six All-Americans and 13 future WNBA professionals. During her tenure at Notre Dame, Washington was directly responsible for developing three All-Americans and two Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award winners – Niele Ivey (current Notre Dame head coach) and Megan Duffy (current Marquette University head coach). Washington also worked with Alicia Ratay, who is the NCAA's career three-point field goal percentage leader.

A student of the game, Washington enjoyed success in the college ranks and later as a professional in the WNBA. During her time in an Irish uniform, Washington rewrote the record books with 554 career assists (seventh all-time) and 307 career steals (third all-time). Her 2.7 steals-per-game career average still holds the top spot in South Bend. Washington was just as impressive in the classroom, earning her undergraduate degree in just three years and, later, earning a juris doctorate from Notre Dame Law School in 1997 to become a "Double-Domer."

Washington then played six seasons in the WNBA and won a WNBA title with the Houston Comets in 2000. She followed the Comets' championship season with another strong campaign in 2001, ranking among the Top 10 in the WNBA in assists (ninth) and steals (fourth) as the Comets made their fifth consecutive playoff appearance. Midway through the 2002 season, she was traded to the Indiana Fever, where she guided that club to its first-ever playoff berth and became the first player in WNBA history to lead three different squads to the postseason.

She was a key figure in helping create the WNBA Players Association (WNBPA), serving as the

founding president of the WNBPA from 1999 until 2001. She served as the executive vice president of the WNBPA from 2001 until her retirement in 2003. Washington led negotiations for the association's first collective bargaining agreement, and as executive vice president, was a mainstay in the negotiations for the league's second collective bargaining agreement, which brought about the first free agency system in women's professional sports.

Washington's service to the game has gone beyond coaching. She has served on the WBCA Board of Directors and led a committee tasked to grow the game of women's basketball. She won a gold medal with Team USA at the 2013 World University Games and served on the USA Basketball Women's Junior National Committee from 2009-12. She was a member of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund Board of Directors from 2012-15 and served five years on the NCAA Women's Basketball Issues Committee. Currently, she Co-Chairs the WBCA's Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Committee.

A native of Flint, Michigan, Washington was inducted into the Greater Flint Area Sports Hall of Fame in December 2009. Washington and her husband, Raynell Brown, have two children, Quenton and Rhaiyna.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

Head coach Coquese Washington added four new coaches to her staff this offseason in Senior Associate Head Coach Shannon LeBeauf and assistant coaches Sean LeBeauf, Danielle Edwards and James Spinelli.

Before coming "On The Banks," Shannon LeBeauf, one of the top assistant coaches in the nation, spent the last 14 seasons on the sidelines at UCLA as an Assistant and Associate Head Coach for the Bruins. She is a proven recruiter, having tallied 14 Top-25 recruiting classes over her stellar career, including UCLA's first-ever No. 1-ranked recruiting class in 2014-15 and its second No. 1 class in 2021-22. In her extensive time with the Bruins, LeBeauf helped guide the team to 321 wins and nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including an Elite 8 berth in 2018 and most recently, a Final Four appearance in a historic 2024-25 campaign.

Sean LeBeauf spent the previous four seasons at UC Riverside as an assistant coach. There he helped the Highlanders to 55 wins including 38 victories in Big West play. He helped the team advance to the Big West Tournament Championship in 2024 and onto the

WNIT.

Dani Edwards arrives in Piscataway, New Jersey from SMU where she was hired as the Director of Player Personnel in April 2021 but went onto become an Assistant Coach and Recruiting Coordinator for the past four seasons. Edwards helped the Mustangs to new heights during her tenure, collecting 50+ overall wins and 20+ conference victories. She helped the team reach the WNIT her first two seasons, the first time the Mustangs made the postseason in back-to-back campaigns for the first time since 2014 and 2015.

James Spinelli spent the last two seasons at Northeastern as an assistant coach after spending five seasons as the Video Coordinator at Notre Dame. While with the Huskies, he coached the wings as well as serving as the lead scouter on staff and running in-practice skill development for the guards. Spinelli was also responsible for all the analytics utilized by the Huskies.

Jeanine Wasielewski enters her third season as an assistant coach for the Rutgers women's basketball team in the 2025-26 campaign and assumes the role of Offensive Coordinator for the Scarlet Knights.

STAFF UPDATES

Washington also made some changes to her staff.

After two seasons as an assistant coach "On The Banks," Nneka Enemkpali will now serve as the team's Chief of Staff. In this new role, Enemkpali will helm administrative operations for the program as the team's primary liaison to internal support units for athletics including compliance, the R Fund, the alumni office, ticketing services, and the offices of the Chancellor and President. In addition, Enemkpali will work closely with Washington concerning matters related to revenue sharing and NIL management.

Enemkpali will also work with external units, collaborating with marketing, sports information and brand advancement on social media and communications initiatives. She will facilitate strategic community engagement opportunities for the program, while also serving as liaison to season ticketholders and the women's basketball booster club, The Cagers Club.

After one season as the interim Director of Basketball Operations, Alejandro Ramirez has been promoted in the role full time. Ramirez assists Washington with the day-to-day operations of the program in all aspects including team travel, game day organization, practice operations and recruiting.

Ramirez leads multiple game day operations efforts including the game day schedule and managing shootarounds for both home and away teams. Ramirez works in close conjunction with multiple Rutgers departments, in particular, equipment and facilities. He oversees the robust Scarlet Knight student-manager program, hiring, training and scheduling all managers working with the program. In addition, Ramirez organizes and directs all summer camps for Rutgers Women's Basketball.

TRANSFERRING IN

Washington and her staff welcomed six transfers for this upcoming season including Lauryn Swann (Arizona), Kaylah Ivey (Boston College), Nene Ndiaye (Boston College), Faith Blackstone (Stephen F. Austin), Imani Lester (Kansas State), Yacine Ndiaye (UNCG).

Swann comes to RU after spending her freshman season at Arizona. She was named to the 2025 Big

12 All-Freshman Team as well as earning a Big 12 All State Bench Performance of the Week and Big 12 Freshman of the Week twice. The Queens, New York native recorded 12 double digit outings and led the team in scoring five times, including a career high 22 points against Utah, (Dec. 31) knocking down a career-best six three-pointers and shooting 85 percent from field. She made 50-of-128 three pointers during the 2024-25 slate, making her one of only six Wildcats who made more three-pointers in a campaign in program history.

Ivey spent the last four seasons at Boston College where during her senior season, she led the ACC and ranked third in the nation with a 3.3 assist/turnover ratio on 160 assists and 49 turnovers. She recorded 16 helpers to go along with no turnovers against Miami (Jan. 16), the most by a player in a single ACC game since 2002. Ivey ended the season 8th in program history at BC with 455 assists.

Nene Ndiaye played the past two seasons at Boston College and most recently during her sophomore season, appeared in 30 games and made 10 starts. She scored a career high 16 points and tied a season-best six rebounds at Pittsburgh (Feb. 6) and ended the campaign averaging 4.4 points and 2.3 rebounds per game and netted points in 23 outings. Ndiaye was also a part of the Senegal U18 National Team and in the 2020 Afrobasket Tournament.

In Blackstone's most recent season at Stephen F. Austin, she helped the Southland Tournament Championship and secure a spot in the 2025 NCAA Tournament. She was named a First-Team All-Conference selection after leading SFA with 14.8 points per game in addition to averaging 6.1 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.8 steals.

Lester spent the last two seasons at Kansas State where she helped the Wildcats to a 28-8 overall record and a Sweet Sixteen appearance in the NCAA Tournament. She saw action in 34 contests and set multiple career-highs including points, field goal percentage, rebounds, assists and steals.

Yacine Ndiaye played her freshman and sophomore seasons at UNCG. She helped the Spartans to a historic 2024-25 slate, including a SoCon Tournament Championship and a trip to the 2025 NCAA Tournament. Ndiaye saw action in 27 games and finished second on the team with 21 blocks. She also appeared in 12 contests during her freshman campaign.

NEW KNIGHTS

The team also brought in two freshmen in Precious Gem Wheeler and Makylah Moore.

Wheeler attended Franklin High School. She broke out during her sophomore season in 2022-23, recording 9.9 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.8 blocks per game. Wheeler also helped to lead Franklin to the Somerset County Tournament semifinals.

Moore helped her team at Nazareth High School to a NYSHSAA Championship recording 18 points and 10 rebounds in the title tilt. She also guided her team to a Borough Championship. During her senior season, the Brooklyn, New York native averaged 21.4 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.3 steals per game. Reached double digit points in all 29 games, including 20+ points 11 times and 30+ five times. In addition, she posted five double-doubles and six or more rebounds in 19 contests.
