#### THE GAME

For the first time this season, Illinois State will travel outside the state lines when it travels to Brookings, South Dakota, to face South Dakota State. The No. 11 ranked Redbirds (6-3, 3-2 MVFC) will look to bounce back after a tough defeat at the hands of No. 9 UNI last week, while the No. 4 ranked Jackrabbits (7-2, 4-1 MVFC) look to win their second in a row after a bounce-back win at Missouri State last weekend.

#### THE SERIES

The Redbirds and the Jackrabbits will meet for the 10th time, with South Dakota State holding a narrow a 5-4 advantage over Illinois State in the all-time series dating back to 2008. The Jacks have won the last two games and three of the last four overall against the Redbirds. Those wins have been very close, with a combined margin of just 18 points. The last times the two met in Brookings, the Jacks needed overtime to come away with a 27-24 win.

#### THE COACHES

Illinois State: Brock Spack (Purdue, 1983) is in his 11th season as the head coach at Illinois State (80-48). Spack led the Redbirds to three-straight FCS playoff appearances from 2014-16 and guided the Redbirds to back-to-back shares of the MVFC title in 2014-15. He is the second winningest coach in ISU football history, trailing only Edwin Struck (86).

**South Dakota State: John Stiegelmeier (SDSU,1979)** is in his 23rd season as the head coach of his alma mater (165-102). Stiegelmeier has led his teams to winning records in 18 of his 22 full seasons, including 13 of 15 at the Division I Football Championship Subdivision level, and to eight FCS playoff appearances.

#### HEAD COACH BROCK SPACK

When **Brock Spack** was named the 20th head coach in Illinois State football history prior to the 2009 season, it did not just mark the beginning of a new era in Redbird Football, but it also signaled the beginning of an entirely new belief system for the type of football program that Illinois State could field. Since that time, the Redbirds have posted eight .500 or better campaigns, including a 13-2 record in 2014 on way to the FCS National Championship game. Spack guided the Redbirds to three-straight playoff appearances from 2014-16 and four in the past seven seasons overall. Spack heads into his 11th season ranked second in ISU program history in wins (80) and has the best winning percentage among coaches with more than one year.

#### **CLEAR BAG POLICY**

The Illinois State Athletics Department will continue its clear bag safety policy for fans and patrons attending games at Hancock Stadium during the 2019 season. Ensuring the safety of Redbird fans and guests is a top priority for ISU Athletics, and this new policy falls in line with similar safety measures instituted all over the country in collegiate and professional athletic venues. Media members MAY STILL BRING IN BAGS, however they MUST check in at the designated GATE 5 media entrance on game day and have their bag checked and tagged.

#### REDBIRD SPORTS NETWORK

WJBC (AM 1230, FM 93.7), the flagship station of Illinois State athletics, will serve as the host of the Redbird Sports Network.

#### REQUESTING CREDENTIALS

Credentials (game and parking) can be obtained by contacting the Athletics Communications Office, Campus Box 7130, Normal, IL, 61790-7130. Requests must be received on official letterhead at least two days prior to the game. Passes that are not mailed will be available at the Will Call window at the main ticket gate on the East side of the stadium 90 minutes prior to kickoff.

#### PRACTICE PROCEDURES

Most practices are open to the media, but only the first 15 minutes are available to photographers/ videographers. For all other media, it is recommended that an advance call be made to the athletics communications office to check on the status of practice for a particular day.

#### REGULAR-SEASON INTERVIEW POLICIES

- Head Coach: Brock Spack will do general interviews following practice Tuesday-Thursday. All other requests for interviews must be submitted to the athletics communications office at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled interview.
- Assistant Coaches: Arrangements should be made through the athletics communication office. Most interviews will be conducted after practice Tuesday-Thursday.
- Players: All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice Tuesday and Wednesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Players who attend the Tuesday luncheon will not be available following practice that day.
- Postgame: The Illinois State locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Brock Spack and requested players will be brought to the designated interview area. At home, the postgame media conference will take place on the fourth floor of the Hancock Stadium press box.

#### POST GAME INTERVIEW PROCEDURES

Postgame interviews following home contests are conducted in the Hancock Stadium press box (fourth floor). A golf cart is available to transport representatives from the visiting team to the interview area. TV lighting is also provided and there is wireless Internet access in the room.

After road games, representatives will be brought to a designated area. The locker room is closed at all times

#### THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT

- South Dakota State University is located in Brookings, South Dakota, and has an enrollment of 12,107 students. The Jackrabbits are members of the Missouri Valley Football Conference and play their home games at Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium (19,340).
- The Jackrabbits are ranked No. 4 in both the STATS FCS Top 25 and the latest AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. The Jacks' only two losses have come at the hands of Minnesota, who is still undefeated on the season in the Big Ten, and to No. 1 ranked North Dakota State two week ago. SDSU has now appeared in the top 25 of 102 consecutive media polls dating back to October 2012.
- South Dakota State had its 15-game home winning streak snapped in a 23-16 loss to the Bison two weeks ago. Since Dana J. Dykhouse Stadium opened in 2016, the Jackrabbits have gone on to compile a 24-3 record (.889 winning percentage) on their home field.
- Last week, SDSU racked up more than 500 yards of total offense and carried a shutout into the fourth guarter, defeating Missouri State, 35-14, on the road at Robert W. Plaster Stadium.
- The potent Jacks offense, led by the combination of Pierre Strong and Cade Johnson, is averaging 33.2 yards per game on the season. Strong is nearing the 1,000 yard mark on the season and has scored seven touchdowns on the year. Johnson recorded the eighth 100-yard game of his career and moved into fifth place in career receiving yards at SDSU with 2,490 last week against Missouri State.
- Standout linebacker Christian Rozeboom leads the way for the Jacks' defense with 68 tackles, with three TFLs and two interceptions on the season.

#### LAST TIME VS. THE JACKRABBITS (10/27/2018)

A 21-point second-quarter scoring outburst by No. 7 South Dakota State propelled the Jackrabbits to a 38-28 victory over the No. 9-ranked Illinois State Redbirds at Hancock Stadium. Senior quarterback Jake Kolbe replaced injured starter Brady Davis at the half and finished the game 15-of-23 for 183 yards with three touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Andrew Edgar led the team in receiving, as he finished with career-highs in receptions (9), yards (202) and touchdowns (2) for the Redbirds in the defeat.

#### **NO FLY ZONE**

Redbird cornerback Devin Taylor had a strong sophomore campaign for the Redbirds in 2018, and has certainly built upon that success in 2019. Taylor currently ranks fourth on the team with 42 tackles, including 32 solo stops, and leads the Redbirds with 10 pass breakups. He also recorded his second interception of the season, when he picked off UNI's Will McElvain in the second quarter of Saturday's game. With 12 passes defended, Taylor ranks among the league's best defensive backs and is proving once again why he was worthy of All-MVFC honors a year ago.

#### FINALLY LEAVING THE LAND OF LINCOLN

A scheduling anomaly for the Redbirds in 2019 resulted in the team not having to leave the state of Illinois until this upcoming weekend, when ISU flies to South Dakota to play the Jackrabbits. Five home games and four road contests against in-state foes have kept the Redbirds close to the nest, but that all changes this week when the nationally-ranked Jacks host the Redbirds. So far, the road has been kind to the 'Birds with a 3-1 record including three-straight wins over Eastern Illinois, Southern Illinois and Western Illinois. ISU has averaged over 23 points per contest in those games and have limited their hosts to an average of just 8 points per game.

#### SIMON SAYS

When he joined the Redbirds this summer after transferring from Iowa, Brandon Simon knew he would have an opportunity to make an immediate impact in a strong ISU defense. Mostly playing in a reserve role, Simon has racked up three sacks and 5.5 TFLs on the season from his outside linebacker position. The majority of that production has come in the past four games, with sacks in back-to-back wins at Southern Illinois and Western Illinois and TFLs in three out of the last four games, including one in his first career start against UNI.

#### REDBIRDS FLYING HIGH IN NATIONAL POLLS

Illinois State currently sits at No. 11 in the STATS FCS Top 25 and No. 12 in the FCS Coaches Poll. Four MVFC teams are ranked again in the polls this week, including North Dakota State (No. 1), South Dakota State (No. 4), Northern Iowa (5) and Illinois State (11) . The Redbirds have been ranked in every poll so far this season, with a high ranking of No. 6 in the FCS Coaches Poll.

#### STRONG IN THE RED ZONE

Thanks to an increase in sacks and TFLs through nine games this season, the Illinois State defense finds itself in the Top 20 in FCS football in total defense (17th). Another key reason for that success has been the team's ability to keep opponents from scoring in the red zone. Opponents are scoring just 56.7 percent of the time when inside the Redbirds' 20 yard line, which is the No. 1 mark for a defense in all of FCS football.

#### STARTING FAST

For the past several seasons, the Illinois State football team has been known as a second half team, pulling away from opponents late in contests to pick up wins. However, that trend seems to be reversed so far in 2019 as the Redbirds have outscored opponents 55-40 in the first quarter and 120-71 in the first half. The Redbirds are now 6-1 when they are tied or leading at the half and have outscored opponents 199-160 overall.

#### **80 FOR SPACK**

Brock Spack's resume as the head coach at Illinois State includes four FCS playoff appearances, a MVFC Coach of the Year honor and a FCS Championship Game appearance. Thanks to his team's win over Indiana State, Spack was able to add another accolade with his 80th career win as the head coach at Illinois State. With a career record of 80-48 (.625), Spack is the second-winningest coach in program history and is just 6 wins away from tying Edwin Struck for the career wins record at ISU.

#### MR. ROBINSON'S NEIGHBORHOOD

James Robinson has already cemented his legacy as one of the best running backs in school history, and his performances of late have only added to his resume. With his 180 yards rushing against Indiana State, Robinson increased his career total to 3,469 yards, just 233 yards short of catching Toby Davis at No. 2 with 3,702 yards, well within his reach with four games left to play in the season. The Rockford, Illinois, native also ranks No. 2 in the ISU career record books in yards per carry (5.74) and second in rushing touchdowns with 40.

#### PROTECTING THE NEST

Opposing teams coming to Hancock Stadium have not felt very welcome in the past 11 seasons, as Redbird teams led by Spack have not been very accommodating in the win column to visitors. ISU is a combined 51-14 at home during Spack's tenure and have gone 34-8 at Hancock Stadium since the renovation of the facility in 2013.

#### HIMMELMAN DOES IT AGAIN

For the second time this season, Illinois State offensive lineman Drew Himmelman was named the Missouri Valley Football Conference Offensive Lineman of the Week. Steady rain and wind played havoc on the Illinois State and Indiana State game last Saturday, forcing most of the offensive action to the ground. That seemed to play in the favor of the Redbirds, as the ISU rushing attack led by Drew Himmelman and the offensive line amassed 287 yards on the ground in a 24-7 victory over the Sycamores. Himmelman graded out at 92 percent and was instrumental in the success of James Robinson, who rushed for 180 yards and two scores on the ground in the adverse conditions.

#### **HAPPY HOMECOMING**

Welcoming back alumni for Homecoming each year is something every college football team looks forward to, however the Redbirds may enjoy it just a little bit more than others. Since 2009 when Brock Spack took over as head coach, the Redbirds are 9-2 in Homecoming contests. The 'Birds have won the last three in a row and are 51-41-6 overall on Homecoming dating back to 1916.

#### HE CAN DO IT ALL

With so much attention paid to James Robinson by opposing defenses, there has been room for other Redbird offensive players to take charge. Against Western Illinois, it was transfer running back Jeff Proctor's turn, as he was the change of pace the Redbirds needed in their defeat over the Leathernecks. Proctor led the Redbirds in rushing (81 yards) and receiving (46 yards) to account for 127 yards of total offense in the game. His one-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter capped off the scoring for the Redbirds and a career day for Proctor, who set personal bests in rushing and receiving against WIU with his first career score as a Redbird.

#### **TURNOVERS A PLENTY**

Call it a mixture of giveaways by the Leathernecks and takeaways by the Redbirds, but whatever it was the result was five turnovers by Western Illinois in the Redbirds' road win. The five turnovers (3 fumble recoveries, 2 interceptions) were a season high for the Redbirds and they took advantage of the Leatherneck mistakes, turning them into 14 points. The interceptions by Devin Taylor and Christian Uphoff were their first of the season for both and upped the team's total to eight on the year, with eight different players recording picks.

#### **STATE CHAMPS**

For the second-straight year, Illinois State completed a season sweep of its fellow FCS Land of Lincoln foes to take home the unofficial state title. The Redbirds picked up road wins at Eastern Illinois, Southern Illinois and Western Illinois, with the last two coming in the past two weekends. With ISU's win at Western Illinois, the team improved to 10-2 against the Leathernecks under the leadership of Brock Spack and the team has now won 9 of the last 10 games against WIU. Had it not been for a loss at NIU, the Redbirds would have had a clean sweep of state of Illinois foes.

#### **SACK MASTERS**

For the second time this season, the Illinois State defense racked up nine sacks against an opponent as the Redbird lived in the backfield in their win over Southern Illinois. The Redbirds recorded nine sacks and 12 TFLs in their victory in Carbondale, matching the nine sacks accrued in a win at Eastern Illinois earlier in the year. A total of six different players recorded a sack, with Romeo McKnight leading the way with three and Jason Lewan adding two. Linebackers Ty DeForest and Tuvone Clark, lowa transfer Brandon Simon and safety Clayton Isbell also got in on the act for ISU. Illinois State currently ranks fourth in the FCS with 3.67 sacks per game and 33 total.

#### RECEIVERS STEP UP

After the injuries to starting wide receivers Andrew Edgar and Taylor Grimes were announced, ISU head coach Brock Spack made a point to mention that his team had quality, albeit young depth at the position. Against Southern Illinois, that depth proved beneficial for the Redbirds. Senior Braxton Haley doubled his season total with five grabs for 72 yards to lead the way and true freshman Kacper Rutkiewicz continued his strong campaign with three grabs for 80 yards in the victory. Redshirt freshman tight end/fullback Jacob Carl also hauled in the first pass of his career and running backs James Robinson and Jeff Proctor each got a chance to make a play out of the backfield. Austin Nagle, though, had the biggest impact with a two-yard TD catch in the second quarter that gave the Redbirds a two-score lead at the time.

#### SEPT. 18, 2010 - BROOKINGS, SOUTH DAKOTA

Junior transfer **Ashton Leggett** posted his first career 100-yard rushing game at Illinois State, as the Redbirds jumped out to a 24-0 lead and held on in the Missouri Valley Football Conference opener for a 24-14 road victory over No. 20-ranked South Dakota State at Coughlin-Alumni Stadium.

#### SEPT. 24, 2011 - NORMAL, ILLINOIS

Wide receiver **Tyrone Walker** set a then career-high with 10 catches for 143 yards and one touchdown and running back **Ashton Leggett** led the Redbird rushing attack with 29 carries for 98 yards with two touchdowns, as Illinois State held off South Dakota State for a 20-13 victory at Hancock Stadium.

#### OCT. 4. 2014 - NORMAL. ILLINOIS

Marshaun Coprich rushed for 174 yards and set a career-best with four touchdowns, as No. 22-ranked Illinois State rolled to a 45-10 victory over No. 9 South Dakota State on Homecoming at Hancock Stadium. Coprich scored three touchdowns in the first quarter to stake the Redbirds to an early 21-0 lead and ISU never looked back.

#### OCT. 22, 2016 - NORMAL, ILLINOIS

Illinois State scored 28 first-half points and capitalized on two fourth-quarter turnovers to knock off MVFC leader No. 7 South Dakota State by a score of 38-21 in front of 7,595 fans at Hancock Stadium. ISU's defense had a big day, tallying three interceptions including one by senior La'Darius Newbold that he returned 92-yards for a touchdown to seal the victory.
