JACKS HOST IOWA STATE IN KEY BIG 12 DUAL

BROOKINGS, S.D. — The South Dakota State University wrestling team brings a five-match winning streak into a dual Friday night against 16th-ranked lowa State.

Action begins at 7 p.m. at Frost Arena, with online video coverage available through FloWrestling.org (subscription required). The Warm Up Frost event will feature winter-related giveaways.

The Jackrabbits enter the dual with a 6-3 overall record, including a 3-0 mark in Big 12 Conference duals. SDSU ran its winning streak to five last week with a 25-13 road win at then-No. 16 Northern lowa on Jan. 10, followed by a 17-16 home win two days later over Wyoming.

South Dakota State ranks second among team receiving votes in the NWCA Division I Coaches' Poll and is 23rd in the dual rankings conducted by Intermat.

lowa State, meanwhile, carries a 4-3 overall dual record into Friday's matchup and a 1-0 mark against Big 12 foes after posting a 45-0 victory Jan. 9 at Utah Valley. The Cyclones, who feature eight ranked wrestlers in their lineup, ended last week by going 1-2 in the Sun Devil Duals, defeating Harvard (34-6), while losing to Campbell (14-22) and host and 12th-ranked Arizona State (12-21).

SERIES VERSUS IOWA STATE: Friday's dual will mark the 13th time South Dakota State and Iowa State have met on the wrestling mat. The Cyclones lead the all-time series, which dates back to a 27-2 ISU victory during the 1951-52 season by a 10-2 count.

lowa State won the first nine duals in the series before the Jackrabbits recorded two consecutive convincing victories at Frost Arena during the 2016-17 (27-9) and 2017-18 (30-15) seasons.

The Cyclones turned the tables in strong fashion last season, shutting out the Jackrabbits, 47-0, on Feb. 1, 2019, at Hilton Coliseum. Four lowa State wrestlers won by pin, one picked a win by forfeit, while two others earned victories by major decision.

LAST WEEK: The Jackrabbits turned in a successful week on the wrestling mat, recording a pair of Big 12 dual victories and also having a number of younger wrestlers win titles at the Ridgewater Open.

South Dakota State 25, Northern Iowa 13

South Dakota State took control of its wrestling dual Jan. 10 against Northern Iowa by winning five of the first six matches and went on to defeat the 16th-ranked Panthers, 25-13, at West Gym in Cedar Falls, Iowa.

DannyVega set the tone for SDSU in the opening bout of the night, scoring a 10-6 decision over 18th-ranked Jacob Schwarm at 125 pounds. After Schwarm opened the scoring with a takedown, Vega countered with a reversal and four-point near-fall for a 6-2 lead. Vega put the match away in the third period with a pair of takedowns.

Redshirt freshman 133-pounder Zach Price gave SDSU a 6-0 lead with an 11-4 decision over Kyle Biscoglia before UNI got on the board as 16th-ranked Michael Blockhus rallied in the third period for a 7-5 decision over Clay Carlson at 141 pounds. Carlson led 4-2 through two periods before Blockhus scored on an escape and two takedowns in the third and final stanza.

Two-time NCAA qualifier Henry Pohlmeyer swung the momentum back in the Jackrabbits' favor with a win over seventh-ranked MaxThomsen in a battle between nationally ranked 149-pound wrestlers. The 17th-ranked Pohlmeyer began the scoring with a first-period takedown and led 4-0 early in the second period following a reversal. In the third period, Pohlmeyer recorded his second takedown of the match, picked up two points on a near-fall and added a point for riding time to post a 9-1 major decision.

It was Pohlmeyer's third win in a row overThomsen, following a pair of one-point victories last season.

The Jackrabbits pushed their winning streak to three matches in a row as Colten Carlson tallied a 4-0 decision over Derek Holschlag at 157 pounds and newcomerTanner Cook continued to impress at 165 pounds with a third-period pin of Austin Yant. Since being inserted into the lineup at the South Beach Duals two weeks ago, Cook is 4-0 with all four victories by fall. He leads the squad with nine pins on the season.

UNI, 1-3 overall and 1-1 in Big 12 duals, stemmed the tide with wins by fifth-ranked Bryce Steiert and fourth-ranked Taylor Lujan at 174 and 184 pounds, respectively, to close the gap to 19-10. Lujan's victory was a 10-3 decision over Zach Carlson, who entered the matchup ranked 16th by FloWrestling.

Tanner Sloan, ranked 20th at 197 pounds, slammed the door shut on a late UNI comeback by notching the Jackrabbits' second fall of the dual, pinning Noah Glaser in 1 minute and 42 seconds.

In the final bout of the night, 14th-ranked heavyweight Carter Isley of UNI needed overtime to defeat the Jackrabbits' Blake Wolters, 3-1.

SDSU's last dual win over a ranked opponent was a 22-16 victory over an 11th-ranked Northern Iowa squad on Jan. 21, 2018, at Frost Arena

South Dakota State 17, Wyoming 16

South Dakota State and Wyoming each won five matches, but it was DannyVega's technical fall in the opening bout of the wrestling dual that proved to be the difference in a 17-16 Jackrabbit victory Jan. 12 at Frost Arena.

A junior from Tucson, Arizona, Vega scored the first eight points of his 125-pound match against Jacob Svihal on a takedown, two-point near-fall and four-point near-fall. He wound up with an 18-3 technical fall midway through the second period after tallying an escape, takedown and another four-point near-fall.

After seventh-ranked Montorie Bridges posted a 5-1 decision over Zach Price to get Wyoming on the board, the Jackrabbits built their lead to 11-3 with decisions by Clay Carlson and Henry Pohlmeyer. Carlson turned in a 12-6 victory at 141 pounds, while Pohlmeyer scored a 6-2 decision over Jaron Jensen in the 149-pound matchup.

The Cowboys gained a 13-11 lead with three consecutive wins. Dewey Krueger (157 pounds) and 12th-ranked Hayden Hastings (174) each won by decision, while Cole Moody ended the Jackrabbits' Tanner Cook's streak of wins — and pins — with a 13-3 major decision in the 165-pound bout.

SDSU's Zach Carlson, ranked 16th, put the Jackrabbits on top for good with a hard-fought 3-2 decision over Tate Samuelson, staving off a takedown attempt at the final horn of their 184-pound matchup.

At 197 pounds, 20th-ranked Tanner Sloan gave SDSU the cushion it needed by winning a 6-3 decision against Stephen Buchanan.

Needing to avoid giving up bonus points to win the dual, the Jackrabbits' Blake Wolters took 20th-ranked Brian Andrews down to the wire in the heavyweight bout. The match was scoreless through two periods with Andrews working from the top in the third. Andrews was unable to get a turn on Wolters and had to settle for a 1-0 decision with the point coming via a two-minute riding-time advantage.

Ridgewater Open Recap

In other wrestling action over the weekend, six Jackrabbit wrestlers won or shared titles Jan. 11 at the Ridgewater Open in Willmar, Minnesota.

Winning outright titles were 133-pounder Trayton Anderson and 157-pounder Dalton Lakmann. A freshman from Northfield, Minnesota, Anderson went 2-0 in competition, posting a 12-1 major decision over Nic Cantu of St. Cloud State and defeating Sam Kulseth of Concordia-Moorhead, by technical fall, 18-3.

Lakmann, a redshirt freshman from Redding, California, won all three of his matches by decision, including a 5-2 win over Spencer Miller of St. Cloud State in the championship bout.

The first Jackrabbit duo to share a title were 141-pounders Caleb Gross and Rylee Molitor. Gross received a first-round bye, then went 2-0 to reach the championship bout. Molitor notched wins by technical fall, fall and major decision to set up a title match against Gross, but the teammates did not wrestle.

Also sharing a title were heavyweights Bowen McConville and SpencerTrenary. McConville pinned both of his opponents, while Trenary was awarded an opening-round bye and notched a 17-0 technical fall over St. Cloud State's Tyler Hugg in the semifinals.

Completing the Jackrabbit effort at the Ridgewater Open were freshman 184-pounders Jacob Schoon and Caleb Orris, who tied for second place with 2-1 records in round-robin competition. Both Jackrabbits were defeated by Tyler Ryan of St. Cloud State and did not wrestle each other.

POHLMEYER HONORED: South Dakota State 149-pounder Henry Pohlmeyer was named Tuesday as Big 12 Wrestler of the Week after helping lead the Jackrabbits to a pair of victories over conference opponents.

A senior from Johnston, Iowa, Pohlmeyer opened the week with a 9-1 major decision over seventh-ranked Max Thomsen in a Jan. 10 dual at Northern Iowa — a matchup in which the Jackrabbits came away with a 25-13 dual win over the 16th-ranked Panthers. He closed the weekend with a 6-2 decision over 19th-ranked Jaron Jensen of Wyoming on Jan. 12 as SDSU prevailed 17-16 in the dual.

With his two wins, Pohlmeyer improved to 11-3 on the season, including 4-1 in duals. He vaulted from being ranked 17th by both FloWrestling and TrackWrestling to 10th in this week's rankings. He also is ranked 11th by Intermat.

BIG 12 SUCCESS: Now in its fifth season as an affiliate member of the Big 12 Conference for wrestling, South Dakota State has proven it can contend in one of the top wrestling leagues in the country.

Since joining the league at the start of the 2015-16 season, the Jackrabbits have combined to post a 27-10 record in duals against Big 12 opponents, with seven of those losses coming during the 2018-19 campaign. SDSU posted an 8-0 mark in Big 12 duals during the 2017-18 season.

The Jackrabbits also turned in back-to-back third-place efforts at the Big 12 Wrestling Championship in both 2017 and 2018, after a fourth-place finish at their inaugural league meet in 2016.

RABBITS RANKED: Five South Dakota State wrestlers appear in the NCAA Division I rankings compiled by a variety of media outlets.

Ranked throughout the season have been Henry Pohlmeyer at 149 pounds and Tanner Sloan at 197 pounds. A two-time NCAA qualifier and a senior from Johnston, lowa, Pohlmeyer was the big mover this week, vaulting to 10th in the rankings conducted by both FloWrestling and TrackWrestling. He also rejoined the Intermat rankings at No. 11.

Sloan, a redshirt freshman from Alburnett, Iowa, was ranked in the top 10 by three media outlets earlier in the season. He is currently ranked 17th by Intermat, 19th by TrackWrestling and 20th by FloWrestling.

At 184 pounds, Zach Carlson has moved into all three rankings, holding spots of 12th by TrackWrestling, 14th by Intermat and 16th by FloWrestling. He holds a 15-4 record, including sharing a team-best 7-2 mark in duals.

Also appearing in the rankings this week are 125-pounder Danny Vega and 165-pounder Tanner Cook. Vega, a junior who previously competed at Iowa State, is ranked 20th by Intermat and 26th by TrackWrestling. He has a 6-1 mark in duals since entering the lineup Dec. 20 versus Minnesota.

Cook, a freshman from Ilion, New York, posted pins in each of his first four duals of the season to take over the 26th spot in the TrackWrestling rankings this week.

Also appearing in the rankings this season, but not currently ranked, are 133-pounder Zach Price and 141-pounder Clay Carlson. Both are redshirt freshmen.

COACH HAHN: Damion Hahn, who helped build Cornell into a national power as an assistant coach, was hired on April 9, 2018, to lead the Jackrabbit wrestling program.

"Damion represents everything we are looking for in being able to take our wrestling program to the next level," said South Dakota State University Director of Athletics Justin Sell in announcing the hire. "His success both as a collegiate wrestler and coach, along with his ability to recruit high-achieving student-athletes on and off the mat, made him the ideal candidate. He is a tremendous ambassador for the sport who will work tirelessly to ensure wrestling thrives both on our campus and across the country."

During his first season with the Jackrabbits, Hahn faced a rebuilding task as SDSU featured new starters in six spots in the lineup. SDSU finished with a 3-10 dual record, including a 2-7 mark against Big 12 Conference opponents.

The Jackrabbits ended the 2018-19 season with a 10th-place finish at the Big 12 Wrestling Championship and had one NCAA qualifier in 149-pounder Henry Pohlmeyer. Hahn enters this week with a 9-13 career dual record at SDSU.

Hahn spent 12 years as an assistant coach and later the associate head coach at Cornell in Ithaca, New York. During his tenure, the Big Red recorded 11 top-10 team finishes at the NCAA Championships, including consecutive runner-up finishes in 2010 and 2011. He mentored 50 All-Americans, 12 of whom were individual NCAA champions. Cornell also won 12 straight Ivy League dual championships and 11 consecutive Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association team titles.

In accepting his first head coaching position, Hahn made a return to the Midwest. As a collegiate wrestler at Minnesota, Hahn won NCAA individual national titles as a junior and senior. A four-time All-American, he also was a three-time Big 10 individual champion and was named the Jesse Owens Big 10 Male Athlete of the Year in 2004. The Golden Gophers won team NCAA championships during both his freshman and sophomore seasons. He finished his collegiate career with a 118-21 record.

Hahn was inducted into the University of Minnesota's M Club Hall of Fame in 2018.
