Women's Basketball Game Notes

The South Dakota State women's basketball team heads into Summit League action after a successful non-conference slate, hosting Western Illinois in a two-game series this weekend at Frost Arena.

The Jackrabbits completed the non-league portion of their schedule with a 7-2 record, capturing wins over three nationally-ranked opponents. Most recently, the Jackrabbits defeated Northern Iowa, 74-62, on Dec. 23.

Western Illinois is 2-8 overall and 1-1 in Summit League after splitting its first pair of contests with North Dakota State last weekend. The Fighting Leathernecks' only other win on the season came over Bellarmine, 79-57.

THE SERIES: Friday's game will be the 29th meeting between the two programs, with the Jackrabbits holding a 26-2 advantage in the all-time series. Additionally, SDSU has won the last seven contests against the Leathernecks. Western Illinois claimed both of its wins over the Jacks on its home court in Macomb, Illinois, and has yet to win at Frost Arena since the series began during the 2007-08 season.

MAJOR MILESTONES: SDSU head coach Aaron Johnston is just one win away from claiming 500 career wins. He will be the 34th active Division I coach to reach the milestone. Additionally, Johnston is South Dakota State's and the Summit League's all-time winningest women's basketball coach.

Three Jackrabbits are approaching 1,000-point milestones. Myah Selland currently has 945 career points. Tylee Irwin and Paiton Burckhard are at 829 and 767 points, respectively.

SELLAND HONORED: Myah Selland was selected as the Summit League's December Female Athlete of the Month, announced by the league office earlier this week.

A junior from Letcher, Selland started all seven December games for the Jackrabbits, while averaging 19 points, 7 rebounds, 3.4 assists, 1.6 steals and 29.4 minutes played. She shot 50 percent from the field, including 37.9 percent from beyond the arc. Additionally, Selland registered three double-doubles throughout the month. She scored in double figures in all seven contests, including two 20-plus point performances.

Selland led the Jackrabbits in wins over then 18th-ranked Gonzaga (75-72, OT) and then-

No. 20 Missouri State (60-52). In the win over Montana State, she recorded career-bests of 27 points and 12 rebounds. At Missouri State, Selland posted a season-best six assists and four steals.

Selland has earned three Summit League Women's Basketball Player of the Week awards this season (Dec. 7, 21 and 28). This is her first time being named Athlete of the Month.

SCOUTING WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois is 2-8 overall and 1-1 in Summit League play. The Leathernecks opened league action last weekend BY splitting its series with North Dakota State, defeating the Bison in the first matchup, 77-65, before falling 93-60 the next day.

Senior Grace Gilmore paces the team with 10.9 points and 3.1 assists per game. In the series against North Dakota State, she recorded 14 and 15 points, respectively. In the season opener against Wisconsin she turned in a season-high 19 points while adding four assists and three steals.

Evan Zars is averaging 10.7 points and a team-best 8.1 rebounds per game. She has tallied three double-doubles on the season and pulled down as many as 17 rebounds in WIU's season opener. She leads the squad with 19 blocks. Elizabeth Lutz paces the team with 21 steals.

Danni Nichols is also averaging double figures with 10.6 points per game. She adds 12 steals and has registered one double-double.

As a team, Western Illinois is being outscored by its opponents, 77.7-65.1. The Leathernecks are shooting 37.2 percent from the field and 28.1 percent from long distance.

J.D. Gravina is in his 10th season at the helm of the Leathernecks with a 150-137 record.

IN THE POLLS: South Dakota State has been at least receiving votes in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the *USA TODAY*/Coaches Poll all season.

On Dec. 7, after beating then 15th-ranked Iowa State and then-No. 18 Gonzaga, the Jackrabbits entered the AP Poll for the first time in 11 years at No. 22. Additionally, State was tabbed No. 21 in the Coaches Poll that week. The squad has since fallen out of the AP Poll but continues to receive votes.

The Jackrabbits ranked No. 25 in the CoachesPoll on Dec. 22 and 29. They are currently receiving 55 votes in the most recent poll.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION: Paiton Burckhard and Myah Selland were named to the All-Summit League Preseason First Team, while Tylee Irwin and Tori Nelson earned All-Summit League Preseason Second Team accolades.

Last season, Burckhard picked up first-team all-Summit honors, while Nelson was named Summit League Freshman of the Year and earned a spot on the All-Newcomer Team.

SDSU Head Coach Aaron Johnston



Aaron Johnston has built the South Dakota State University women's basketball program into a standard bearer within The Summit League and across women's college basketball. The dean of Summit League women's basketball coaches, Johnston has infused a culture of excellence, embraced the balance of student and athlete and has the name South Dakota State equating to success.

COACHING EXCELLENCE

Now in his 21st season at the helm of the Jackrabbits' program, Johnston has created a mid-major powerhouse. Johnston has guided SDSU to 13 consecutive postseason appearances, including nine NCAA Tournament berths, since the program made the jump to Division I in 2004-05. The four-time Summit League Coach of the Year (2008, 2009, 2012, 2014) has guided the Jackrabbits to a winning record in all 20 previous years at South Dakota State, and has led SDSU to 17 20-win seasons, including 13 of the last 14 years.

Johnston is South Dakota State's winningest women's basketball coach with a 499-168 career record (.748 winning percentage) heading into the opening weekend of league action for the Jacks. In Summit League play, he is the overall career (.744, 329-113) and conference (.836, 179-35) leader for winning percentage, and is also first in overall victories and league victories. He entered the 2020-21 season with a 30-3 (.933) Summit League postseason tournament record and a 35-17 (.673) mark in overall postseason games.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Under Johnston's guidance, South Dakota State has set a standard of excellence both on the court and in the classroom. The Jackrabbits have finished no worse than third among Division I programs in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll for seven of the past 13 seasons, and led all divisions of women's basketball in team GPA four times—including three consecutive seasons (2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08)—and again during the 2010-11 campaign.

Also during Johnston's tenure, the Jackrabbits have had five CoSIDA Academic All-America honorees and a pair of NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship recipients.

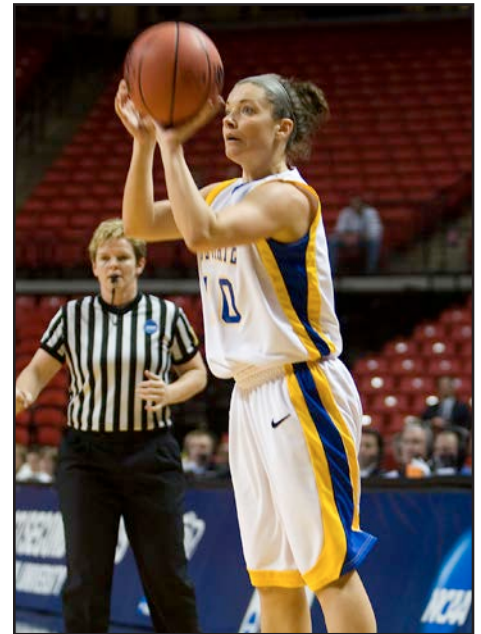

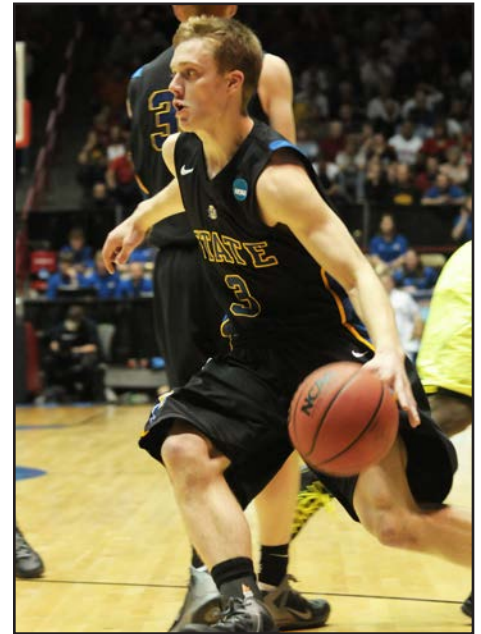

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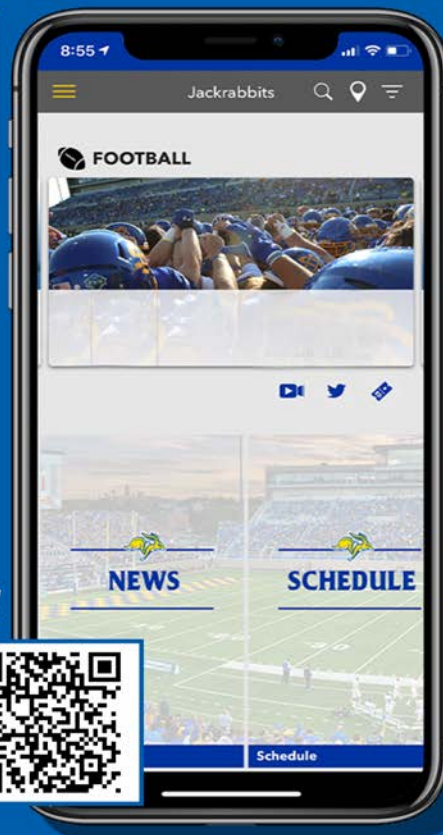

Men's Basketball Game Notes

The South Dakota State men's basketball team opens Summit League play by hosting Western Illinois in a two-game series at Frost Arena. Tipoff both nights is set for 7:30 p.m..

SDSU enters league play 6-3, coming off a 93-50 drubbing of Mount Marty in the Jacks' first home action of the season Jan. 4. Matt Dentlinger scored 21 points in 19 minutes, connecting on 7-of-8 attempts from the field. Luke Appel posted a career-high 16 points, David Wingett also added 16 and Baylor Scheierman tallied his fifth double-double with 12 points and a career-best 14 rebounds.

Six Jacks are averaging at least 7.7 points per game. SDSU features two of the top 10 scorers in the Summit League in Noah Freidel (17.5 points per game, 4th) and Baylor Scheierman (14.2 points, 10th).

Scheierman also leads the league in 3-point percentage (48.9) and ranks second in rebounds per game (8.8), fourth in field goal percentage (53.6), and seventh in steals (1.2).

The Jackrabbits have won 25 home games in a row, ranking as the fifth-longest active streak in Division I. In addition, SDSU has won each of its last 28 Summit League games in Frost Arena.

ABOUT WESTERN ILLINOIS: Head coach Rob Jeter took over the Leatherneck program on March 30, 2020, and quickly performed a complete makeover of the team's roster.

Only two players remain from last year's squad that finished 5-21 and missed the Summit League Tournament.

The Leathernecks are 2-7 this season, dropping their first two league games to North Dakota State last weekend. Twelve different players have logged at least nine minutes per game.

Tamell Pearson, a 6-10 junior forward who transferred from UAB, leads the team with averages of 12.8 points and 7.6 rebounds.

Justin Brookens, a first-team All-American at Iowa Lakes Community College last year, is averaging an even 10 points while shooting a team-best 41 percent from deep. He exploded for 37 points at Eastern Illinois on Dec. 12 — the second most in a game by a Leatherneck in the program's 40 years of Division I hoops.

THE SERIES: South Dakota State has dominated the overall series, 28-5, and has never lost to Western Illinois in Brookings.

The Jackrabbits are 14-0 against the

Leathernecks in Frost Arena, 10-4 in Macomb, and 4-1 in five Summit League Tournament meetings.

SDSU has won eight of the last nine in the series and swept the Leathernecks last year, winning 91-56 in Brookings (Jan. 4) and 71-61 in Macomb (Feb. 1).

Arguably, the most memorable meeting between the two occurred on March 6, 2012, when the Jacks defeated the Leathernecks 52-50 in overtime to win the Summit League Tournament inside the Sioux Falls Arena.

The series began with the Leathernecks winning in Macomb, 64-41, on Dec. 31, 1948. The programs met one more time in Division II, as the Jacks claimed a 98-86 win to advance to the Elite Eight on Feb. 29, 1980.

LAMB BONANZA: The 29th annual Lamb Bonanza is earmarked for Saturday's double-header.

The event highlights the school's support of the lamb and wool industries in the state.

As part of the annual event, lamb pelts will be auctioned off. Traditionally an on-court event at halftime, this year bids are being taken remotely.

#BeatType1 GAME

Friday's series opener is SDSU's annual #BeatType1 Game, held in partnership with the Summit League and Sanford Health, to bring awareness to the disease.

More than 1.25 million Americans, most of whom are children, are battling type 1 diabetes.

More than 70,000 boys and girls under the age of 14 are diagnosed with type 1 diabetes each year.

SCHEIERMAN'S SUCCESS: SDSU's Baylor Scheierman has taken his game to another level during his sophomore campaign.

The Aurora, Nebraska, native posted consecutive double-doubles in wins at Iowa State and Bradley, earning Summit League Player of the Week honors.

He followed that up with two more double-doubles in wins vs. North Dakota State and North Dakota as part of the Dakota Showcase in Sioux Falls.

In all, he has scored in double figures in eight of eight games, and posted double-doubles on five occasions.

SUMMIT LEAGUE FAVORITES: South Dakota State was the pick to win the Summit League in the conference preseason poll, garnering 33 of 36 first-place votes. The Jackrabbits return the Summit's coach and player of the year and feature three preseason all-league honorees.

Douglas Wilson was voted as player of the year, while Noah Freidel joined him on the first-team. Matt Dentlinger was chosen as second-team all-league.

UP NEXT: The Jackrabbits are scheduled to resume Summit League action Jan. 15-16 at Omaha. Women's games will tip off at 3 p.m. each day, with men's games starting at 7 p.m.

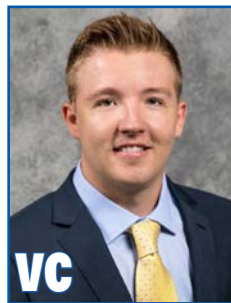

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2020-21 Jackrabbits Basketball

SDSU Head Coach Eric Henderson

Eric Henderson was promoted to head coach of Jackrabbit men's basketball March 27, 2019, and is in his second season at the helm in 2020-21. He previously spent three years as an assistant at South Dakota State, rising to associate head coach for the 2018-19 campaign.

Henderson's first season as a collegiate head coach was a historic one, as he was named the 2019-20 Summit League Coach of the Year while guiding the Jackrabbits to a 22-10 record and share of their third-straight Summit League regular season title. Henderson coached three all-league performers, including the league's Player (Douglas Wilson) and Freshman (Noah Freidel) of the Year. SDSU went 16-0 at home in 2019-20 and posted a 13-3 record in league play.

Overall, Henderson holds a 28-13 record (.683 winning percentage) at SDSU heading into this weekend's games.

The 22nd head coach in Jackrabbit basketball history, Henderson began his coaching career as an assistant at Wayne State (Neb.) from 2001-03 and returned to the collegiate ranks as an assistant at North Dakota State from 2014-16 after coaching in the prep ranks in Wisconsin.

A gifted teacher and skill development coach, Henderson has been

an integral part of the program's recent success. In his four years at South Dakota State, the Jackrabbits have compiled a 92-43 overall record, including a 48-14 mark in Summit League play.

SDSU made postseason appearances in 2017 (NCAA), 2018 (NCAA) and 2019 (NIT), and were in line for a fourth consecutive postseason berth before COVID-19 restrictions disrupted play nationwide.

The Jackrabbits have held one of the top home-court advantages in Division I men's basketball, combining for a 56-3 record at Frost Arena over the past four seasons. SDSU put together a 21-game home-court winning streak from January 2017 until December 2018 and enters 2020-21 with 24 consecutive wins inside Frost Arena.

A 2000 graduate of Wayne State (Neb.), Henderson began his collegiate coaching career at his alma mater from 2001-03 as an assistant coach. After coaching girls' basketball at Wayne Community School for two seasons, he moved on to Iowa State, where he was the graduate manager for the Cyclones' men's basketball team from 2006-08 and a learning specialist for the 2008-09 season.

He returned to coaching in the prep ranks at Burlington Catholic Central High School in Burlington, Wisconsin, from 2009-14, while also serving stints as principal and athletic director.





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On top of game action, the Jackrabbit Sports Network and Cubby's Sports Bar & Grill team up for one-hour weekly shows highlighting the sports. The John Stiegelmeier Radio Show airs Monday nights in the fall, while the Jackrabbit Basketball Coaches Show features both head men's coach Eric Henderson and women's coach Aaron Johnston in the winter.

Additionally, fans can stay up to date on all 19 SDSU varsity sports with the Jackrabbit Daily Sports Update, a three-minute report that airs every weekday on all network stations.

All game broadcasts and coaches shows can be heard live throughout the world wide web or can be accessed on-demand. It's all free at Jackrabbits All-Access on GoJacks.com. Fans can also access the broadcasts via TuneIn.com or the TuneIn mobile app by searching "Jackrabbits."

WNAX-AM 570 is the flagship station of the network and works with Learfield IMG College and SDSU athletic broadcast services to produce and distribute each broadcast. WNAX-AM 570 airs every daily show, coaches show, football, men's and women's basketball game. In the event that both the men's and women's basketball teams play simultaneously, the men's games air on WNAX-AM 570 while the women can be found on WNAX-FM 104.1.

Additionally, Brookings Radio's five-station cluster partners with the Jackrabbit Sports Network. KJJQ 910 AM "The Ranch" is the Brookings affiliate for football and men's and women's basketball while also serving as the flagship for SDSU baseball coverage each spring.

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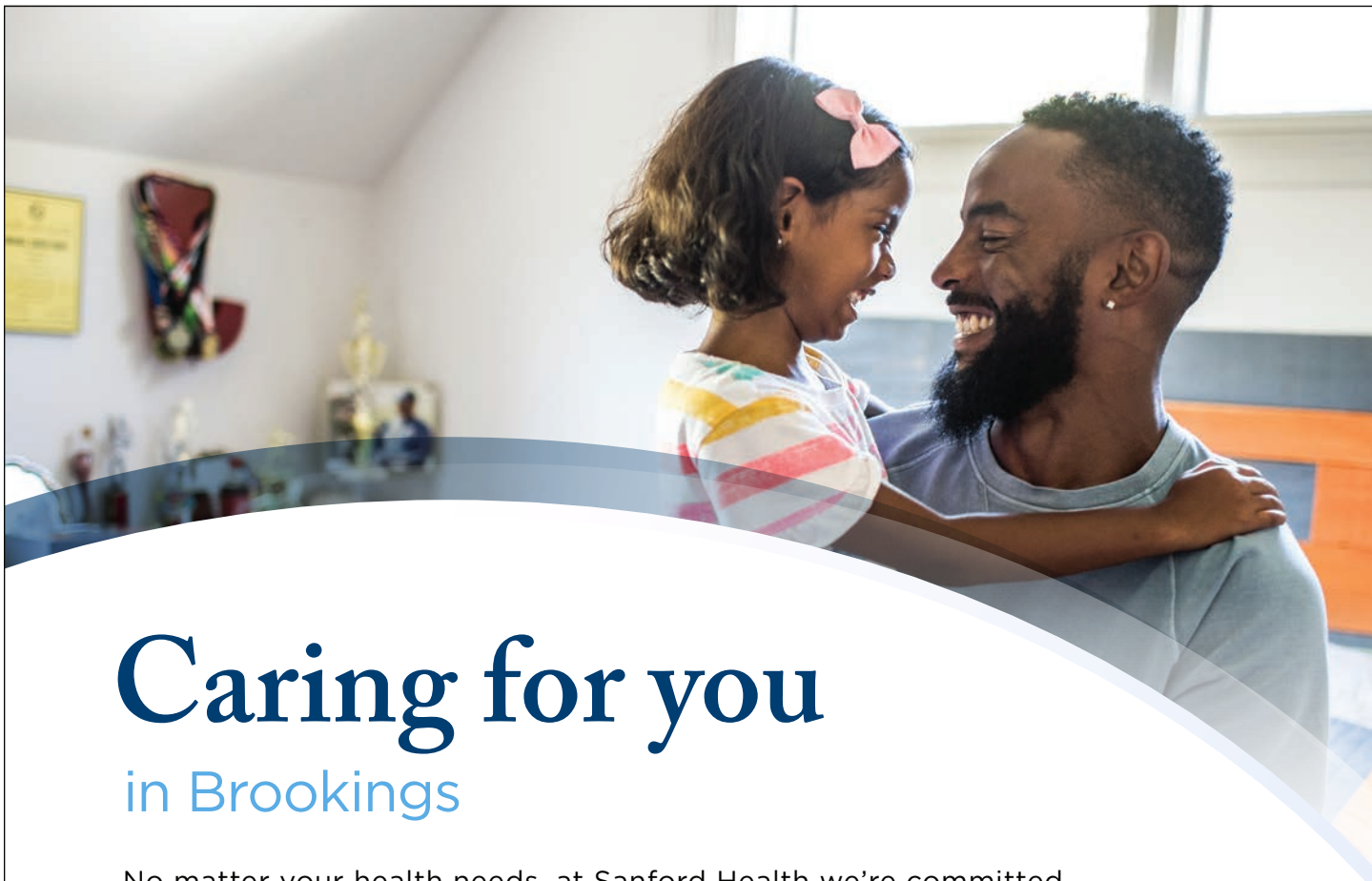
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
