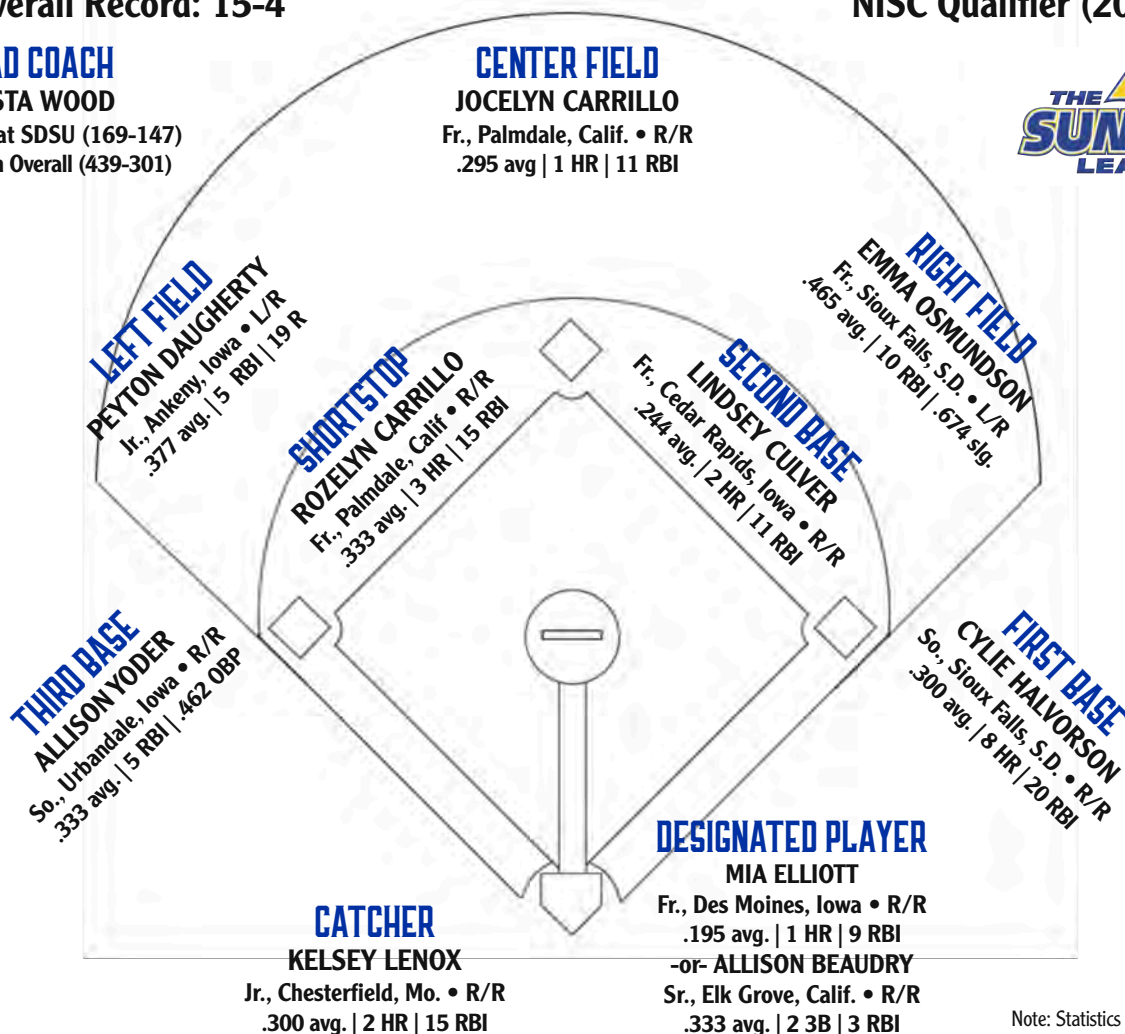

JACKRABBITS BEGIN SUMMIT PLAY AT KC

BROOKINGS, S.D. — After finding success in the pre-conference portion of its schedule, the South Dakota State University softball team will turn its attention to Summit League play this weekend as the Jackrabbits travel to Kansas City for a four-game series.

Doubleheaders are slated for noon both Saturday and Sunday at the Urban Youth Academy in Kansas City, Missouri. The games will be available for viewing at KCRoots.com/watch.

The Jackrabbits have compiled a 15-4 mark so far this season and are coming off a pair of five-inning wins over Northern Colorado last weekend at the Connie Clausen Classic in Omaha, Nebraska.

Kansas City also is off to a strong start to its 2021 season, entering the weekend with a 14-7 overall record. The Roos dropped a 9-3 home decision to 15th-ranked Arkansas on Tuesday, but did notch a 6-5 victory at sixth-ranked Oklahoma State last weekend en route to a 3-2 mark at the 2021 Oklahoma State Invitational.

SDSU will be playing its first Summit League game since 2019, when the Jackrabbits turned in an 11-7 league record and made an appearance in the conference tournament. The 2020 season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic prior to the start of league play.

Kansas City makes a return to the Summit League after a seven-year hiatus. The Roos left the Summit following the 2013 season and competed as a member of the Western Athletic Conference through the spring of 2020.

THE SERIES: Friday's opener will mark the 34th meeting between South Dakota State and Kansas City on the softball diamond. The Roos lead the all-time series, which dates back to 2007, by a 20-13 count.

The two squads last played in 2019, splitting a pair of games at a tournament hosted by Creighton in Omaha, Nebraska, March 16-17. Kansas City won the first game, 6-4, despite two hits apiece by the Jackrabbits' Lyndsey Crist and Kerigan Torres.

The Jackrabbits claimed the second meeting, 10-8 in eight innings, behind 2 2/3 innings of scoreless relief by Taylor Compton. Crist drove in three runs on a bases-clearing triple as part of six-run third inning, while the eighth-inning runs came across on a fielder's choice and ensuing throwing error. The March 17 victory upped SDSU's record that season to 21-7.

SHORT HOPS: Following are some quick notes regarding the South Dakota State softball team so far this season:

- The Jackrabbits have hit 19 home runs as a team in 19 games, including a streak of six consecutive games with a homer from March 5-9;
- Cylie Halvorson leads the team with eight home runs and hit a homer in each of the Jackrabbits three games against Kansas March 10-11;
- Halvorson has two separate three-game home run streaks this season;
- The Jackrabbits have scored double digits in runs five times in 2021, with four of those games versus Northern Colorado;
- With an average of 6.53 runs scored per game, the Jackrabbits rank 28th among Division I squads;
- SDSU is 3-0 in one-run games this season, winning each of the three games in its last at-bat;
- The Jackrabbits put together a streak of nine consecutive errorless games from March 6-12 and rank 10th nationally with a .982 team fielding percentage;
- SDSU has outscored the opposition by a combined 72-21 in the first three innings of games this season, including 19-2 in last weekend's two-game set against Northern Colorado;
- The Jackrabbits are 12-0 this season when leading after four innings.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Several Jackrabbit players have earned Summit League Player/Pitcher of the Week honors so far during the 2021 season.

Outfielder Emma Osmundson was the most recent as she was named Summit League Player of the Week on March 15 after helping lead the Jackrabbit softball team to another successful week.

A freshman from Sioux Falls, Osmundson batted .545 (12-for-22) with three runs batted in, eight runs scored and a .727 slugging percentage over seven games. She posted four multi-hit games, including a trio of three-hit efforts, and also tallied two doubles and a triple, and stole three bases.

In her final three-hit performance, Osmundson drove in the game-winning run with a double in the top of the seventh inning against Northern Iowa on March 12 as the Jackrabbits prevailed, 2-1. SDSU finished the week with a 4-3 record, winning two of three games at Kansas, while splitting two-game sets against Wichita State and UNI.

Osmundson was the second Jackrabbit in as many weeks to earn the award, joining fellow freshman Rozelyn Carrillo. SDSU also has had two Summit League Pitchers of the Week so far in 2021 with Tori Kniesche (Feb. 15) and Grace Glanzer (March 8) receiving the honor.

PRESEASON POLL: South Dakota State has been picked to finish second in the upcoming Summit League softball race, according to a preseason poll conducted among the league's seven head coaches that was announced in mid-February.

North Dakota State, which has won the last six Summit League championships, claimed the top spot with six first-place votes and 36 points. The Jackrabbits claimed the other first-place vote to finish second with 31 points. South Dakota was third with 25 points, followed by Omaha with 19 points.

Rounding out the preseason poll were Kansas City (16), North Dakota (12) and Western Illinois (8).

The Jackrabbits compiled a 15-8 record in an abbreviated 2020 season that was canceled before the start of league play and return a solid nucleus led by Summit League Players to Watch Grace Glanzer and Cylie Halvorson.

A native of Sioux Falls, Glanzer burst onto the scene as a freshman in 2020, leading the league with 74 strikeouts and a 12-2 record. She finished with a 1.73 earned run average and held opponents to a .215 batting average.

Halvorson, also a Sioux Falls native, paced the Summit League with seven doubles while hitting .406 with 19 runs batted in in 22 games. She notched eight multi-hit games and recorded a .641 slugging percentage in 2020.

Summit League play for the Jackrabbits begins March 27 at Kansas City, with the four-team Summit League Softball Championship scheduled for May 12-15 in Fargo, North Dakota.

Teams will now play four-game series in league play, consisting of back-to-back double-headers. Game times are set for noon and 2 p.m. for Jackrabbit home contests.

NO-HITTER HISTORY: Grace Glanzer's no-hitter against Oregon State on March 5 marked the second year in a row a Jackrabbit pitcher accomplished the feat.

Morgan DeMarais hurled a no-hitter March 8, 2020, against Merrimack, in a game played in Madeira Beach, Florida. DeMarais struck out seven and did not walk a batter, missing out on a perfect game due to two hit batters and a Jackrabbit error.

Glanzer's no-hitter is the sixth on record in program history; the others:

- Jessica Jones, April 24, 1990, versus Nebraska-Omaha (W, 1-0);
- Melissa Allevan, March 29, 2002, versus Northern State (W, 17-1; 5 inn.);
- Meggan Staton, March 3, 2003, vs. Rollins (W, 1-0; 8 inn.);
- Meggan Staton, March 6, 2003, vs. Lynn (W, 5-0);
- Morgan DeMarais, March 8, 2020, vs. Merrimack (W, 12-0).

A returning freshman from Sioux Falls, Glanzer nearly duplicated her feat March 19 against Northern Colorado, taking a no-hit bid into the fifth — and final — inning. She allowed a one-out infield single in the fifth and ended with a one-hit shutout as the Jackrabbits posted an 11-0 victory.

KNIESCHE OFF TO QUICK START: South Dakota State freshman Tori Kniesche was honored as Summit League Pitcher of the Week Feb. 15 following an impressive opening weekend on the softball diamond.

A right-hander from Wayne, Nebraska, Kniesche posted a 2-0 record with a 1.00 earned run average and 23 strikeouts in a pair of seven-inning complete-game efforts for the Jackrabbits at the Doc Halvorson UNI-Dome Classic in Cedar Falls, Iowa.

In her collegiate debut against Drake on Feb. 12, Kniesche struck out 12 and walked four, allowing one run on three hits. The next day, Kniesche fanned 11 Northern Iowa hitters, once again giving up only one run and three hits.

For the season, Kniesche is 7-1 with a 1.95 ERA and 56 strikeouts in 43 innings.

DAUGHERTY SETS THE TABLE: Jackrabbit outfielder Peyton Daugherty has paced the SDSU offense during the pre-conference season. The junior from Ankeny, Iowa, reached base safely in the first 10 games and 16 of 19 games this season while batting out of the leadoff spot.

A junior from Ankeny, Iowa, Daugherty ranks second on the team with a .377 batting average (26-for-69) and leads the team with 19 runs scored and eight stolen bases. She also has notched a team-best nine multi-hit games.

GOOD THINGS HAPPEN IN THREES: South Dakota State accomplished a rare feat in the sixth inning of its Feb. 12 season opener against Iowa State — hitting three triples in the same inning. Jocelyn Carrillo started the parade of three-baggers with a leadoff triple and pinch-hitter Emma Osmundson followed two batters later with a triple in her first collegiate at-bat. Peyton Daugherty then stepped to the plate and made it three triples in four at-bats in the inning, lining one to the right-center gap to plate Osmundson with what was then the tying run.

Osmundson has taken over the team lead with three triples as the Jackrabbits have combined for 11 three-base hits so far this year, including four in the two games last weekend at the Connie Claussen Classic.

SDSU's average of .58 triples per game ranks third among Division I programs this year. The Jackrabbits registered six triples as a team in 22 games during the abbreviated 2020 season.

SISTER ACT: Sisters and Palmdale, California, natives Rozelyn and Jocelyn Carrillo have both put up impressive numbers so far this season to solidify spots in the Jackrabbit starting lineup.

Jocelyn, the team's starting center fielder, is batting .295 and has driven in 11 runs. Six of her 13 hits so far this season have gone for extra bases, including the go-ahead home run in the top of the 10th inning of the Jackrabbits' 15-11 victory at Kansas on March 10.

Rozelyn ranks second on the squad with three home runs, while ranking in a tie for second with 15 runs batted in and third by hitting at a .333 clip. She also has performed well at the shortstop position, committing only one error in 52 total chances.

BEAUDRY GIVES A BOOST: Senior Allison Beaudry made up for lost time last weekend with a pair of impressive performances at the plate.

Beaudry entered the series against Northern Colorado hitless in five at-bats all season, but recorded hits in three of her four at-bats over the two games, collecting three runs batted in and scoring four times. She tripled in each of the games for a 1.750 slugging percentage.

Beaudry batted .273 with a home run, five doubles and eight RBIs during the pandemic-shortened 2020 season.

COACH WOOD: Krista Wood begins her seventh season as head coach at South Dakota State in 2021.

Already the program's winningest coach with a 169-147 record after being hired to lead the program in August of 2014, Wood boasts a 439-301 overall career record after eight successful seasons at Wayne State College.

She has coached five NFCA All-Midwest Region selections (the first four in SDSU's Division I era) and 18 All-Summit League selections in her time at SDSU, including the 2016 Summit League Freshman of the Year (Ali Herdliska) and 2018 Player of the Year (Brittney Morse). Herdliska is the only Jackrabbit to earn All-Summit League honors four times in her career, and twice picked up an NFCA All-Midwest Region nod.

The Jackrabbits have won 20 or more games four times under coach Wood, and prior to the cancellation of the 2020 Summit League Championships had reached the league's year-end tournament in each of her first five seasons, including a championship series run in 2018.

SDSU won 37 games in back-to-back 2018 and 2019 seasons, earning berths in the National Invitational Softball Championship both seasons. Wood was named the Summit League's Coach of the Year in 2018 while guiding her team to a program-record .673 winning percentage, breaking the 35-win mark for the second time in history.

Her 2020 squad won 15 games and posted a Summit League-best .652 winning percentage before COVID-19 precautions ended the NCAA's Division I softball season nationwide.

Wood put together a 270-154 mark at Wayne State, turning the Wildcat program into a winner after inheriting a 10-win squad when she was hired before the 2007 season. She brought WSC to three consecutive NCAA Division II National Tournaments between 2009-11, including a 2010 NCAA Central Region crown. The Wildcats won a school-record 43 games during that season and claimed the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference tournament title.

Wood coached internationally during the summer of 2009, leading a United States team (sponsored by USA Athletes International) at the Oldenzaal Invitational in Holland.

A native of Missouri Valley, Iowa, Wood spent two seasons as an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University after a stellar playing career at Nebraska-Omaha from 1999-2003. She helped the Mavericks to the NCAA Division II national championship in 2001 as a sophomore and finished her career as the all-time winningest pitcher in Maverick softball history with 106 wins and 530 career strikeouts.

Wood was named to Omaha's athletic hall of fame in 2020.

In the 2001 national championship game, Wood tossed a two-hit shutout with five strikeouts in a 4-0 win over Lewis University. She also ranks second in career shutouts at UNO with 43, and earned numerous honors as a player at UNO, earning First Team All-NCC honors three times, while also collecting three All-NCC Academic Team awards. She earned NFCA All-Region First Team honors in 2002 and a Second Team All-Region selection in 2001. Wood also earned North Central Conference Freshman of the Year in 2000.

Wood also coached at the high school level, serving as the pitching coach at Omaha Gross High School in the fall of 2003 and at state-qualifying Omaha Westside High School in 2004.

Wood earned a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education K-12 with an endorsement in coaching from the University of Nebraska-Omaha in 2004 and received a master's degree in sport management in 2006 from St. Cloud State University.

THE ROSTER: The 2021 SDSU softball roster features 24 players from six different states and one foreign country. Of the 24 players, eight are from South Dakota, four hail from Iowa and California and three are Nebraska natives. Two players call Minnesota and Missouri home. The international player hails from Italy.

By class, three are seniors, six are juniors, five are sophomores and 10 are freshmen.
