KEY STORYLINES

- South Dakota State enters Monday's contest coming off a win over No. 24/25 Kansas State Saturday. The Jacks are 2-1 against ranked opponents this season.
- The Jackrabbits are 19-1 in their last 20 games at Frost Arena.
- According to WarrenNolan.com, South Dakota State currently has the 12th toughest strength of schedule in the country.
- Four players put up double figures against K-State, the second straight game the Jacks have had four players with at least 10 (Selland -19, Burckhard - 13, Timmer & Vlastuin - 12).
- Myah Selland leads the Jacks in scoring (15.7 PPG) and steals (1.5 SPG). She has scored at least 20 points three times this year and at least 10 on seven occasions.

- Haleigh Timmer averages 10.6 PPG. She has been very consistent for the Jacks with six games in the 9-12 points range.
- Seniors Myah Selland and Paiton Burckhard are quickly climbing SDSU's career scoring chart. Selland ranks fifth with 1,759 career points and Burckhard ranks 11th with 1,511 career points. The full list of 1,000-point scorers is on page five.
- ■The Jacks' senior class brings a wealth of experience and talent into its final season. Paiton Burckhard leads the nation in career games played (143), Dru Gylten ranks second nationally in career assists (586) and Myah Selland ranks 13th in career field goals (656) and 15th in career points (1,759).

MORE NOTABLES

ABOUT THIS MATCHUP

South Dakota State hosts UT Martin Monday night in the first ever matchup between these programs.

The Jackrabbits are 6-4 this year after knocking off No. 24/25 K-State Saturday afternoon in Kansas City. SDSU is 19-1 in its last 20 games at Frost Arena.

UT Martin is 3-5 on the year and on its second game of a six-game road stretch. The Skyhawks most recently beat Vanderbilt 66-54

ABOUT THE JACKRABBITS

South Dakota State enters the matchup 6-4 on the season and 3-1 at home in Frost Arena.

The Jacks most recently beat No. 24/25 K-State 82-78 in a neutral-site game Saturday afteroon in Kansas City.

Through 10 games, Myah Selland averages 15.7 points and 1.5 steals, both team highs, while tallying 6.0 rebounds and 3.7 assists, which rank second.

Haleigh Timmer adds 10.6 PPG for the Jackrabbits while Paiton Burckhard chips in 9.8 PPG and Tori Nelson adds 8.0 PPG.

Kallie Theisen has come off the bench in every contest to grab a team-high 6.1 rebounds on average and contributes 6.5 PPG. Burckhard averages 6.0 rebounds per game and Nelson adds 4.1.

Dru Gylten paces the Jacks with 3.7 assists per game. Theisen averages nearly 1.0 block per game.

Two of SDSU's four losses this year have come to teams that are now ranked - Creighton (then-No. 21/21, now-No. 18/18) and UCLA (then-RV, now No. 13/14)

JACKS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

South Dakota State is 17-34 vs. ranked opponents since 2006-07. The team is 8-6 in Frost Arena, 4-15 on the road and 4-10 at neutral sites. A complete list of ranked opponents is on page six.

The Jackrabbits most recent ranked opponent was No. 24/25 Kansas State, which SDSU beat 82-78 on a neutral floor in Kansas City Saturday, December 10.

SDSU also topped No. 4/10 Louisville 65-55 in SDSU's final game of the Battle 4 Atlantis on November 21. It is the highest ranked team SDSU has beaten in the program's Division I history.

SERIES HISTORY

SDSU opened the 2022-23 season with a 78-69 loss to No. 21 Creighton on Monday, November 7.

Last season SDSU went 1-1 against ranked opponents. The Jacks fell to No. 14 Iowa State in Ames before beating No. 15 UCLA at the Gulf Coast Showcase.

Prior to beating Louisville, the Jackrabbits' 75-64 win over 12th-ranked Syracuse at the NCAA Tournament in 2019 tied for the highest ranked team they have beaten in program history. Syracuse was also the highest team South Dakota State has defeated on the road.

SDSU faced its highest-ranked opponent Jan. 2, 2014, when it played then-No. 2 Notre Dame (L, 94-51) in South Bend.

PRESEASON POLLS

The Jackrabbits were picked to finish first in Summit League's Preseason Poll after winning a share of the regular season title a season ago.

The Jackrabbits picked up 36 of the 40 possible first-place votes. South Dakota received the other four.

Paiton Burckhard, Paige Meyer and Myah Selland were named to the preseason All-Summit first team while Tori Nelson landed on the second team. Selland was tabbed as the Preseaon Player of the Year for the second straight season.

SDSU'S 1,000 POINT CLUB

SDSU's Myah Selland and Paiton Burck hard are both members of the Jackrabbits' 1000-point club. Selland entered the season with 1,602 career points, ranking ninth all time, and Burckhard has 1,413 career points, ranking 15th all time. Tori Nelson entered the year with 874 career points. The full list of 1,000-point scorers is on page five.

NATIONAL PRESEASON HONORS

In addition to her Preseason Player of the Year honor, Myah Selland was named to the watch list for the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year award, the Cheryl Miller Small Forward award, the Wooden Trophy and the Naismith Trophy.

Selland earned 2020-21 WBCA Honorable Mention All-America accolades and was a finalist for the Becky Hammon Award in 2020-21.

SUPER SENIORS

Paiton Burckhard, Dru Gylten and Myah Selland will each use their Covid-19 bonus eligibility this season. The trio has a combined 381 games of experience at the collegiate level.

Burckhard enters her fifth year as a Jackrabbit. She averaged 11.3 points and 5.6 rebounds last season, which ranked second and first on the team, respectively. She was one of two Jacks to start all 38 games.

Gylten, a graduate transfer from Utah, is in her sixth season of collegiate basketball. She spent her first year as a redshirt for the Utes, then started the next four seasons. Gylten's 553 career assists ranks fourth in Utah history. She averaged 5.2 assists per game last year.

Selland enters her sixth at South Dakota State. She paced the Jackrabbits with 14.3 points per game last season and chipped in 5.5 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.2 steals, all of which ranked second on the team.

WOODEN CITIZENSHIP CUP

Myah Selland has been named a finalist for the Coach Wooden Citizenship Cup by the Athletes for a Better World organization.

The award is presented annually to athletes who best display character, teamwork and citizenship, the attributes Athletes for a Better World deems central to transforming individuals, sport and society. The Coach Wooden Citizenship Cup establishes the recipients as athletes of excellence both on and off the field.

Selland is a high academic and athletic achiever for the Jackrabbits and is involved in a number of community service organizations - most notably as a co-founder of the nonprofit Her Turn. More information on Her Turn is on the next page.

Selland is a two-time CoSIDA Academic All-American with a 3.98 GPA. She already holds and undergraduate degree in exercise science from South Dakota State and is currently pursuing a second degree in community and public health.

The announcement of the College Cup winners - one male and one female - will be made during the first week of January 2023.

NEWCOMER NOTES

SDSU added five players to the roster this season - one graduate transfer and four true freshmen.

Dru Gylten joins the Jacks following five seasons at Utah, where she ranks fourth all-time with 552 career assists. She started all 104 games played at Utah and led the PAC-12 in assists with 5.2 per game last year.

Ellie Colbeck was named the Minnesota Class 2A Player of the Year as a high school senior and was a top-13 finalist for the 2022 Miss Minnesota Basketball award. Colbeck was twice named to the Minnesota all-state team. She scored a program-record 2,497 career points as an Otter and averaged 25.6 points, 7.2 rebounds, 5.7 assists and 2.3 steals as a senior.

Madison Mathiowetz was a top-five finalist for the Miss Minnesota Basketball award as a high school senior. She was a three-time Class A Minnesota all-state selection and four-time conference player of the year. Mathiowetz ended her high school career with 3,762 points, which is the St. Mary's school record and ranks fourth in the history of Minnesota girls basketball. She averaged a blistering 34.9 points, 11.5 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 3.8 assists as a senior.

Brooklyn Meyer graduated from West Lyon with 1,493 career points, 967 career rebounds, 413 career blocks and a .541 career field-goal rate, all school records. Her 119 blocks as a senior is also a school record. Meyer was a three-time first-team all-state selection and earned all-tournament team honors at the lowa State Tournament as a junior and senior.

Natalie Nielsen was a three-time all-district honoree and four-time all-conference selection for Akron-Westfield High School. She ended her career with 1,289 career points, which ranks second all-time for the Westerners, and is the program's career leader in rebounds with 810. Nielsen averaged 17.2 points and 10.4 rebounds as a senior.

SEASON PREVIEW

The Jackrabbits return six of its top seven scorers from last year's 29-9 WNIT championship squad, including the 2022 WNIT MVP and 2022-23 Summit League Preseason Player of the Year Myah Selland. Selland averaged 14.3 points per game last season to pace the Jackrabbits and added 5.5 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.1 steals on average, all of which ranked second on the team.

Selland is just one of a number of talented returners. She was joined on the Summit League's preseason first team by Paiton Burckhard (11.3 PPG, 5.6 RPG, 2.2 APG) and Paige Meyer (10.4 PPG, 3.7 RPG, 4.1 APG). Tori Nelson (10.3 PPG, 4.2 RPG, 1.9 APG) landed on the league's preseason second team.

Haleigh Timmer averaged 8.0 PPG for the Jackrabbits as a freshman. She moved into the starting lineup during the Jacks' WNIT run and averaged 17.1 PPG on her way to all-tournament honors. Kallie Theisen (6.3 PPG, 4.8 RPG, 1.2 APG) rounds out the returners from the regular rotation. Mesa Byom, Madysen Vlastuin and Regan Nesheim are also back for the Jackrabbits.

SDSU added five newcomers in 2022-23 - one graduate transfer and four true freshmen.

MORE JACKRABBIT NOTES

Dru Gylten comes to SDSU as a graduate transfer from Utah where she averaged 5.2 assists per game last year. Freshmen Madison Mathiowetz and Ellie Colbeck join the Jacks to provide depth as guards while Brooklyn Meyer and Natalie Nielsen come in as forward options.

CHAMPIONS IN THE CLASSROOM

The Jackrabbits posted a 3.837 team GPA in 2021-22, the top GPA in all of NCAA Division I and the highest single-year GPA in the program's Division I era.

It was the fifth time in the award's history SDSU earned the No. 1 ranking (2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08, 2010-11, 2021-22).

Myah Selland was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America second team for the second consecutive season in 2021-22. She was joined on the Summit League's all-academic team by teammates Tylee Irwin and Tori Nelson.

All 14 Jackrabbits from last season's roster earned a spot on the Summit League's Academic Honor Roll. All eligibile Jacks (those in their second year and beyond) were named to the Summit League Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence.

HER TURN

SDSU's Tori Nelson and Myah Selland are the co-founders of a non-profit foundation called Her Turn, which is designed to create more equitable sporting opportunities for girls and young women in the Brookings community.

Her Turn is a scholarship program designed to provide sport opportunities to young girls within the Brookings community who may not otherwise have the chance due to financial need. Recipients of a Her Turn scholarship will be able to attend an SDSU athletic camp of their choice at no cost to their family.

This past summer, Her Turn provided scholarships for SDSU sports camps to nine girls in Brookings.

The summer after NIL legislation passed, Nelson and Selland reached out to a few of their professors to talk about how they could use their reach and influence to help more young girls get into sports. From the Her Turn website: "The importance of participating in sports at a young age cannot be overstated, especially in young girls. Unfortunately, girls face unique challenges in sports participation. Statistically, they have fewer opportunities to get involved, are less likely to play in the first place, and are much more likely to drop out earlier if they do. On the contrary, girls who do have the opportunity to participate in sports reap benefits such as improved mental and physical health, and learn valuable lessons pertaining to hard work, collaboration, and teamwork."

SDSU also claimed regular season titles in 2008, 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2019 and 2021.

State has won nine Summit League tournament titles in the past 15 years. The Jackrabbits are 30-5 all-time in the Summit League postseason.

KANSAS CITY, Mo. - The South Dakota State women's basketball team held off a late surge by No. 24/25 Kansas State to beat the Wildcats 82-78 Saturday afternoon at Municipal Auditorium.

SDSU moves to 6-4 on the season and 2-1 against ranked opponents this year. K-State is now 9-2.

Four Jacks finished in double digits, led by a 20-point outing on 8-of-11 shooting from Myah Selland. The redshirt senior also contributed five rebounds, two assists and a steal. Paiton Burckhard was 4-for-5 on the afternoon for 13 points and posted seven boards and a block. Vlastuin chipped in 12 points, all from the 3-point line, and had four rebounds, four assists and two steals. Haleigh Timmer also had 12 points and added five rebounds.

Neither team gained more than a six-point advantage in the opening 20 minutes and the Jackrabbits went into the locker room up four, 41-37. SDSU extended that lead to nine within the first minute of the second half, scoring five straight out of the break, and later took a 12-point lead on a pair of Madison Mathiowetz free throws. The Jackrabbits led by eight after three quarters.

The Jackrabbits took their largest lead of the game - 14 points - on a Vlastuin 3-pointer three minutes into the fourth period but then were held to only two more field goals the remainder of the contest. A 12-4 run pulled the Wildcats back within six with 90 seconds to play but the Jacks fended off the Wildcats' comeback with seven made free throws in the final minute.

Mathiowetz and Brooklyn Meyer finished with six points each. Despite being held scoreless in the first 39 minutes of the contest, Tori Nelson knocked down five free throws in the last 60 seconds to help secure the win.

South Dakota State shot 51 percent from the field and 36 percent from the 3-point arc compared to 36 percent field goal shooting and a 22 percent 3-point showing by K-State. The Jacks had a 45-30 advantage in rebounding and 6-5 edge in blocks.

The Wildcats turned the Jacks over 20 times and committed only eight turnovers themselves. They also had a 13-4 lead in steals. K-State was led by Gabby Gregory's 31 points and six rebounds.
