KEY STORYLINES

- South Dakota State begins conference play on the road Monday when the Jackrabbits visit Tulsa to take on Oral Roberts. The two teams picked atop The Summit League Preseason Poll are slated to tipoff in the Mabee Center at 7 p.m.
- The Jackrabbits and Golden Eagles match up for the first time since a 106-102 overtime affair ended in SDSU's favor on Feb. 24 of last season. The Jackrabbits trailed by as many as 13 before shooting their way back into the contest to open the second half. SDSU was led by Luke Appel's 41 points and 10 rebounds as well as Douglas Wilson's 29 points.
- SDSU holds a 19-11 all-time series edge over the Golden Eagles. The Jackrabbits' all-time best win streak of seven over ORU spanned from Feb. 4, 2017 to Jan. 29, 2020. The Golden Eagles are 7-7 at home against the Jacks. ORU's last win in the series came in The 2021 Summit League Tournament. ORU ended SDSU's season that year with a 90-88 victory in the conference semis.
- The Jacks have won two consecutive games. SDSU is coming off a 77-76 thriller over Eastern Washington (Dec. 10) and an 85-56 victory against Mount Marty (Dec. 12). The Jacks' win over the Eags featured a 23-point comeback with less than nine minutes to play, while SDSU led for nearly 38 minutes in its defeat of the Lancers.
- SDSU is 5-7 overall this season. The Jackrabbits halted a four-game losing streak, its longest in five years, with the win over EWU. Heading into conference play, SDSU has been led by Zeke Mayo who surpassed 500 points and 100 assists in his college career last time out. Matt Dentlinger joined Alex Arians as 1,000 point scorers at SDSU in the win over EWU.
- ORU is 9-3 overall and on a six-game win streak following an 80-77 victory over Missouri State on Friday. Preseason Player of the Year Max Abmas leads a trio of double digit scorers with 19.9 per game. The Golden Eagles are 10th in Division I in scoring (85.3) and seventh in 3-pointers (11.1).

- His 2021-22 team became first in Summit League history to go undefeated (18-0), led NCAA in 3-point percentage (44.5%) and finished fourth in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll.
- Henderson's squads have won at least a share of the Summit League regular season title in each of his first three seasons at the helm of the program.
- A Jackrabbit has earned All-League honors eight times in three seasons under Henderson.
- Henderson has a 28-2 record inside Frost Arena in his four seasons as head coach and the Jackrabbits are 68-5 at Frost Arena during his seven seasons with the program.

LAST TIME OUT

Five double-digit scorers and two career-high scoring efforts highlighted South Dakota State's 85-56 victory over Mount Marty on Monday, Dec. 12, in a non-conference men's basketball matchup at Frost Arena.

The Jackrabbits (5-7) held the Lancers to back-to-back halves of 28 points while keeping Mount Marty under 36% from the field over the course of 40 minutes. SDSU led by a 41-28 margin at halftime, but a 48.5% shooting clip in the second half propelled the Jacks to a 16-point edge in the last 20 minutes of action.

SDSU was boosted in the first half by Tanner Te Slaa who led the way with 11 points. He eventually scored a career-high 14 points while grabbing eight rebounds and dishing out three assists.

The second half saw Broden Lien and Zeke Mayo pick up the offensive pace for the Jackrabbits. Lien went 6 of 9 from the floor over the final 20 minutes of play, eventually recording a career-high 20 points. He finished with seven rebounds and two assists. Mayo registered 13 points in the second half as well. The sophomore guard ended the night with 18 points, eight rebounds and seven assists.

Also scoring in double digits were Matt Mims (11) and Matt Dentlinger (10). Dentlinger led SDSU on the boards with nine rebounds.

SDSU CLOSES OUT TOUGH NON-CON

The Jackrabbits' non-conference slate was one of the toughest in Division I men's basketball. Through 12 games, SDSU's average opponent NET rankings was 21st in the nation. SDSU's schedule featured top 150 NET-ranked teams in Akron (148), Boise State (36), Arkansas (18), James Madison (51), Kent State (33) and Alabama (7).

JACKS COMPLETE IMPROBABLE COMEBACK

SDSU defeated Eastern Washington, 77-76, on Dec. 10 with one of its greatest comeback rallies in program history.

The Jackrabbits trailed 69-46 with 8:36 remaining. The comeback bid started at that point with a pair of Matt Mims free throws and saw SDSU outscore the Eggs 31-7 in the less than nine-minute span. Zeke Mayo recorded his career-high 30th point on the game-winning basket with two seconds left. SDSU forced five EWU turnovers in the span and finished a perfect 15 of 15 from the free throw line.

A LOSING SKID UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY

South Dakota State ended a four-game losing skid when the Jackrabbits topped Eastern Washington on Dec. 10. The four-game losing stretch was a first for the Jackrabbits since the 2016-17 slate. The Jacks had a pair of four-game losing streaks that year. SDSU hasn't had a five-game stretch of defeats since the 2009-10 season.

The consecutive losses came on the heels of a difficult part of the team's schedule. The Jacks dropped contests at Kent State (83-68) and No. 11/14 Alabama (78-65) on back-to-back days, then lost to Montana (81-56) in Missoula on Dec. 6.

JACKRABBITS COMPLETE MTE SHOWING

South Dakota State went 1-1 in appearance at the Hostilo Community Classic in Savannah, Ga., from Nov. 25-26. The multi-team regular season event was the 11th for SDSU in the previous 10 seasons. SDSU is now 21-12 overall in MTEs during that span. The Jackrabbits went undefeated in MTEs in 2012-13, 2014-15 and 2015-16.

The Jacks completed a notable superlative in their opening win over Valparaiso, 61-50, at Enmarket Arena. SDSU kept Valpo off the free throw line. It was the first time SDSU has done that to an opponent during its Division I era.

- The two sides faced each other once in 1968 before the Jackrabbits began facing the Golden Eagles yearly as part of The Summit League starting in 2008.

ZEKE MAYO STANDING OUT EARLY

Sophomore guard Zeke Mayo has picked up his game as the season has progressed and now leads the Jackrabbits in both scoring and rebounding. He currently has 14.3vpoints and 6.5 rebounds per game marks. He has season-high contests of 30 points and two 13-rebound efforts.

He was named on Nov. 23 to the Lou Henson National Player of the Year Award Watch List which recognizes the top mid-major player in Division I college basketball.

FRESHMAN MAKING EARLY IMPACT

William Kyle III has been a solid contributor for the Jackrabbits in his first college season. He's nearly averaging double digits scoring. He's scored in double digits five games this year, while he's had five games with six-plus rebounds. The Bellevue, Neb., product has started in every game for the Jackrabbits so far this season.

TOUGH START TO SEASON FROM DEEP

After leading the nation in 3-point shooting percentage a season ago, the Jackrabbits are off to a considerably colder start from long range. The Jacks rank 167th in the nation with a clip of 34.1%, a more than 10% drop from last year's 44.5% mark. SDSU has been led from long range this season by Charlie Easley (44.7%) and Matt Mims (37.5%).

SUPER SENIOR OFF TO STRONG START

Sixth-year senior Matt Dentlinger was a focal point for the Jackrabbits offensively to open the 2022-23 season and has had a solid year so far for the Jacks.

Dentlinger scored in double figures in three straight games to start the season which was a first for him since the 2020-21 campaign. He also had the Jackrabbits' game-winning layup with one second remaining in their 68-66 victory at Boise State on Nov. 9. He became the program's 52nd member of the 1,000-point club in the win over EWU on Dec. 10.

A GLANCE INTO PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

Despite earning their fifth consecutive regular season title, and winning their eighth in the last 10 years, the Jackrabbits were picked second in the 2022-23 Summit League Preseason Poll behind Oral Roberts. Luke Appel and Zeke Mayo each received All-Summit League Preseason First Team recognition. Appel was the league's Sixth Man of the Year in 2021-22, while Mayo was selected to the Summit's All-Newcomer Team.

HISTORICAL MARKS IN 2021-22

SDSU went on a 21-game winning streak over the course of the 2021-22 season which was the longest active stretch in Division I when the Jacks lost to Providence in the NCAA Tournament. The Jackrabbits' 30 games won overall were a school and league record.

LEADING THE NATION FROM 3

The Jackrabbits were highly efficient from 3-point range a season ago, setting a program record and leading Division I with a 44.5% clip. Returners this season in Charlie Easley, Alex Arians and Matt Mims all recorded top 10 single-season marks.

JACKS HIGH IN POLLS THROUGHOUT 2022

The Jacks were featured on the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll throughout the 2021-22 season and finished the season fourth behind Gonzaga, Murray State and Saint Mary's. SDSU also received votes in the AP Top 25 poll for five straight weeks heading into the NCAA Tournament.

FROST ARENA DOMINANCE

South Dakota State has one of the best home court advantages in Division I men's basketball. Since the beginning of the 2015-16 season, the Jacks are 91-5 in Frost Arena, a .948 winning percentage.

They recently had a 17-game win streak snapped in their home confines, but have won 74 of their last 767 games in Frost. Dating back to the 2011-12 campaign, SDSU has won over 94% of its games at home, with only Gonzaga (94%) and Kansas (95%) also over 94%.

SDSU has been perfect at home in seven of the last 11 seasons. In that span, no other program has had more than five unbeaten seasons at home.

OFFENSIVE SUMMIT LEAGUE HISTORY

The Jackrabbits featured one of the most productive offenses in the 40-year history of The Summit League last season.

SDSU averaged 85.9 points per game which was the highest mark in the conference since 1996 when Troy averaged 94.4 points. No team in the league's history did what SDSU was able to last season as the Jacks completed marks shooting over 50% from the field, 45% from deep and scoring over 85 points per contest.

DEFENSE NO PUSHOVER IN 2022

South Dakota State finished second in The Summit League in scoring defense a season ago, holding teams to 71.4 points per game in regular season conference play.

The Jacks held opponents below 80 points in 15 of their 18 league games. Eight times, league teams have been held below 40% shooting. Only six times in the league has a team shot better than 35% from deep against SDSU.

NO EASY TASK AGAINST THE POWER FIVE

The Jackrabbits recorded their ninth victory over a "Power Five" opponent in 14 seasons on Dec. 11, 2021, when they defeated Washington State, 77-74, in Spokane on a neutral court. SDSU is 2-0 against both Iowa State and Iowa in that span. The Jacks also own victories over Ole Miss, TCU, Minnesota and Washington.

SDSU had a couple more opportunities against high-quality teams in 2022-23. The Jacks fell to No. 9/10 Arkansas 71-56 on Nov. 16 and fell to No. 11/14 Alabama on Dec. 3 78-65.

MAYO READY TO SERVE IN SOPHOMORE YEAR

Zeke Mayo looks to build off a successful freshman season heading into his sophomore campaign.

A season ago, Mayo was the only freshman selected to The Summit League All-Newcomer Team. He scored in double figures in 20 of 34 games last year and shot over 47% in league play. He was picked to the 2022-23 Preseason All-Summit League Team.

RETURNING TRIO MAKE SDSU 3-POINT CHART

The Jackrabbits were the top shooting team from deep in the nation in 2021-22 and three players on the current roster played big roles in that category.

Charlie Easley, Alex Arians and Matt Mims were extremely productive from long range a season ago. Easley recorded the second best mark ever in program history by going 48-for-96 (50%). Arians registered the fourth best clip as he shot 36 of 73 (49.3%) from long range. Mims tied for 10th on SDSU's single-season chart as he made 37 of his 80 attempts for 46.3%.

DENTLINGER DOING IT ALL

Senior Matt Dentlinger has been around for some time in Yellow and Blue and has made an impact both on and off the floor for the Jackrabbits.

A 1,000-point scorer in his college career, Dentlinger has been selected as an Academic All-District choice three times and has been chosen as an Academic All-American in consecutive years. The Arcadia, Iowa, native has already earned an undergraduate degree in mechanical engineering and is pursuing a master's in engineering.

He's also served on a four-student team that represented SDSU in the Moon to Mars Ice & Prospecting Challenge Sponsored by NASA. His squad, which was tasked to design, build and test prototype systems to extract water from ice deposits buried underneath the soil, was one of 12 finalists from universities throughout the country.

APPEL MAKES SOME HEADLINES

Luke Appel was The Summit League's 2022 Sixth Man of the Year behind a 60% shooting percentage in conference play. He scored in double digits 14 times.

He gained the spotlight for his 41-point performance in a Feb. 24, 2022, victory at Oral Roberts. The point total was the most by a Summit League player last season. Appel became the first Jackrabbit to score 30 points while not starting a game, while he was the first Division I player in the last 25 years to post a 40-point double-double.

SIXTH-YEAR SENIOR STATUS

The Jackrabbits returned two veterans on the roster in Alex Arians and Matt Dentlinger who are each in their sixth years at South Dakota State University. Both players have competed in 135 games in their careers. The two have paved their way to the top 10 mark at SDSU of 127, while the program record of 139 is in each of their grasps which is held by Chad White (2009-14) and Reed Tellinghuisen (2014-18).

Arians is closing in on the games started record of 127 by Tellinghuisen. Arians stands at a mark of 125 starts which is currently second in program history.

SDSU'S RUN OF SUCCESS

South Dakota State has played in eight of the last nine postseasons, excluding the 2019-20 season when the COVID-19 pandemic caused the cancellation of all postseason tournaments. The Jacks have been to six NCAA tournaments, a pair of National Invitation Tournaments and one trip to the College Basketball Invitational.

SDSU has won six Summit League Tournament since 2011-12 and at least a share of eight of the last nine regular season crowns, including six straight.

The Jackrabbits have won 20 or more games in four of the last five seasons and eight of the last 11 campaigns.

FIRST BANK & TRUST ARENA RENOVATION

Construction has begun on the complete renovation of Frost Arena which will turn SDSU's home facility into First Bank & Trust Arena.

Opened with a \$20 million lead gift, the project is estimated at \$50 million. New and improved locker rooms and offices are also a part of the design. The arena is expected to be completed in the fall of 2024.
