1-0 Overall/0-0 Big Sky in 2023 ♦ September 9, 2023

THE MATCHUP

One of the most anticipated games on the FCS calendar in 2023 arrives in Week Two, as third-ranked Montana State visits No. 1 and defending FCS National Champion South Dakota State on Saturday. These intermittent rivals have refamiliarized themselves lately, meeting for the fifth time in MSU's six most recent seasons. The Cats and Jackrabbits met in the FCS Playoffs in 2014, 2021 and 2022.

BOBCAT TEAM NOTES

- ▶ The Cats stand 2-11 all-time as an FCS school against opponents ranked No. 1.
- ▶ Montana State won for the ninth straight time when opening its season at home in Saturday's Gold Rush, dating to the 2000 loss to Humboldt State.
- ▶ Montana State's 25 wins in the last 30 games is tied for the second-best such stretch in Bobcat history (with 1975-78), trailing 26-3-1 (1956-59).
- ▶ The Cats won their 21st straight home game by winning the 2023 opener, MSU's longest home win streak ever and the longest active FCS home win streak.
- ▶ Brent Vigen's 25 wins is 11th in MSU history, his 25-5 start is the quickest ever by a Bobcat head coach, and his five playoff wins is most among MSU coaches.
- ▶ MSU has committed only four turnovers in its last 10 games, and 12 total in 2022.

ON THE MSU OFFENSE

- ▶ Montana State's 63 points is its most ever in a season opener.
- ▶ The Bobcats rushed for 407 yards against Utah Tech, MSU's most in an opener.
- ▶ Scottre Humphrey's 114 yards rushing Saturday was the most by a Bobcat true freshman in a season opener since at least WWII.
- ▶ MSU's 633 total yards vs. Utah Tech is the ninth-most in Bobcat history.
- ▶ Sean Chambers' two TDs Saturday raises his career total to 21 in 12 career games.

ON THE MSU DEFENSE

- ▶ MSU intercepted three Utah Tech passes, its most since picking off three against Idaho State in 2022.
- ▶ Montana State's +3 turnover ratio on Saturday was matched or bested only twice in 2022, when the Cats finished +13.
- ▶ David Alston's interception was the first by a Bobcat defensive lineman since Tyronne Fa'anono in 2018.

STADIUM STUFF

- ▶ MSU opened Bobcat Stadium's 50th year in front of 21,967 fans Saturday, the second-largest home crowd in MSU history and the largest for an foe other than UM.
- ▶ MSU has sold out 14 straight regular season games in Bobcat Stadium.
- ▶ The Cats own a 21-game home winning streak, the longest in program history.

BIG SKY BULLET POINTS

- ▶ Montana State's 402 rushing yards leads the Big Sky and the FCS.
- ▶ MSU's 42.9 points a game last season led the Big Sky, and its 63 points vs. Utah Tech was the most by a Big Sky team and third-most in the FCS in week one.

Scouting South Dakota State

- Last season's FCS National Champion, South Dakota State opened a new season and a new era - Jimmy Rogers took the coaching reins from John Stiegelmeier after a 26-year career which produced 199 wins - by beating Western Oregon 45-7.

- The Jackrabbits rushed for 207 against WOU, but spread the workload around. Amar Johnson carried eight times for 70 yards, Angel Johnson 10 times for 48 yads, Chase Mason three times for 40 yards, and Payton Trophy candidate Isaiah Davis four times for 19 yards.

- The explosive Jackrabbits scampered for two runs of at least 30 yards, and completed two passes of at least that many yards.

- South Dakota State's 11 consecutive FCS Playoff appearances is the second-longest active streak, trailing only North Dakota State's 13 straight.

- The Jackrabbits own 15 consecutive wins, dating to a 7-3 near miss in the 2022 season opener at Iowa, and have won 13 straight home games.

- South Dakota State's 13 straight home wins includes one over the Bobcats. Montana State's current 21 straight home wins includes one over the Jackrabbits.

Bobcat Team Notebook

- Montana State picked up in 2023 where it left off last December, beating Utah Tech 63-20. The victory was MSU's 21st straight in Bobcat Stadium, the longest such streak in school history, and in that stretch of home games only three games resulted in a single-digit margin of victory (MSU beat Idaho 20-13 in 2019 and beat Weber State 43-38 and 33-25 in 2022). The Bobcats have scored over 50 points five times in those 21 games, 40 or more points 13 times, and at least 30 points 18 times.

- The Bobcats posted their fourth straight winning season and 16th this century in finishing 12-2 in 2022. The 12 total wins and 10 regular season victories matched school records.

- The Gold Rush win to open 2023 raised MSU's all-time record to 62-52-5 in season openers, 92-23-4 in home openers, and 43-7-2 when opening a season at home.

- Montana State has advanced to the FCS Playoffs in four straight seasons and to the semifinal round in three straight seasons, both program bests. The Cats stand 8-4 during the last four post-seasons. The Bobcats have earned 13 playoff berths - in Division II once, I-AA or FCS the other dozen

- MSU finished 8-0 at home in both 2021 and 2022, the third and fourth unblemished home campaigns in the Sales/Bobcat Stadium era (1976, 2005). The stadium opened 50 years ago.

- MSU's 2022 home season began in sweltering 98 degree heat, and ended at 10 degrees as the Cats finished the playoff win against William & Mary.

- The Bobcats own a 20-game winning streak in Bobcat Stadium, dating to a home loss to Sacramento State in 2019. The longest home winning streaks in MSU history:

- MSU's four-year seniors own a 36-9 career record, which comes on the heels of the 44 wins by the Class of '22. The .772 winning percentage of those 2022 seniors trailed only the .816 compiled by the 1956-59 group anchored by Sonny Holland.

- Montana State has improved its record in five straight seasons - 4-7 to 5-6 in 2017, 5-6 to 8-5 in 2018, 8-5 to 11-4 in 2019, 11-4 to 12-3 in 2021, 12-3 to 12-2 in 2022.

Bobcat Legacy Number

Former Bobcat coach Jeff Choate introduced 41 as Montana State's legacy number in the summer of 2016, a tribute to the Treasure State's status as the 41st state in the Union and to Montana State's iconic 1941 football team, the last group of Bobcats to play football before World War II. By the end of the 1944 season 10 Bobcat football players had perished in the war effort, a fact observed by famed sportscaster Bill Stern. Stern's 1944 All-America football was comprised only of those 10 men, and in the next year their names had been memorialized nationally and read into the Congressional record. By the time the 1945 academic year dawned, four teammates had joined those 10. Bozeman's Grant Collins wore no. 41 when Choate decided to designate it as MSU's legacy number, and Belgrade's Brayden Konkol was the first Bobcat selected specifically for the honor.

- Tommy Mellott's 79 rushing yards against Utah Tech pushed him past the 2,000-yard mark for his career. He has now gained 2,063 yards as a Bobcat, 14th in school history.

Bobcat Defensive Notebook

- Brent Vigen's Bobcat teams have lost five games since the former Wyoming and North Dakota State assistant took over at the beginning of the 2021 season. Among those five losses are the only three games in that time in which the Bobcats recorded zero sacks and takeaways (NDSU in the 2021 FCS Championship game, South Dakota State in the FCS Semifinals last season, and last year's Oregon State loss).

- The Cats have forced at least one turnover in 11 of the last 12 games, with the playoff loss at South Dakota State last December the exception. The turnover margin in that span is +17.

- David Alston's interception of a Utah Tech pass was his first as a college player, and MSU's first by a defensive lineman since Tyrone Fa'anono in 2018.

- Bobcat defensive ends Ben Seymour and Kenneth Eiden IV, who also plays inside at times, logged MSU's two sacks on Saturday. One season ago Bobcat defensive linemen logged 24 of the team's 32 sacks, with ends getting 12 of those. Eiden was second on the team with eight sacks as a redshirt freshman a season ago.

- Three Bobcats intercepted passes in the Utah Tech game. Defensive end David Alston, nickel Caden Dowler and cornerback Takhari each came away with picks. All three are returners from the 2022 team, but their interceptions Saturday were the first of their careers.

- Bobcat linebackers intercepted seven of the team's 13 passes in 2022. During the 2023 season opener three Bobcats picked off passes, but none were by an MSU linebacker. A defensive end, nickel and cornerback each picked off Utah Tech passes.

- Montana State's first two takeaways against Utah Tech resulted in Bobcat touchdowns. After the third, MSU's offense ran out the second half clock.

- Montana State posted a string of at least one interception in six straight games late in 2019, snagging a pick in 12 of 14 contests that season. MSU intercepted a pass in nine of 2021's 15 games and in 10 of 14 in 2022. Add the team's interceptions in the Utah Tech game and the Cats have intercepted at least one pass in 31 of the team's most recent 43 games.

- MSU's +1.26 turnover margin was 3rd in the FCS and 1st in the Big Sky during the 2022 season, and the Cats began 2023 heading down the same road. Montana State took the ball away from Utah Tech three times without giving it away. MSU's turnover margin total in the four seasons:

Kick Team Notes

- Montana State enters 2023 with new players holding down kickoff, place-kicking and punting duties. Or at least, a new player. Brendan Hall begins the season manning all three specialties. The last Bobcat to enter the season as both kicker and punter was Rory Perez in 2012 and 20
- The Bobcats averaged 2.6 punts per game a season ago. In last week's season opener, Brendan Hall punted once.
- The best testimony to MSU's prolific 2022 offense was that it did not punt in three of the team's 14 games, and punting twice or less in six games.
- Brendan Hall's punting (48 yards on his only attempt) and place kicking (9-for-9 on PATs) drew considerable attention, but Bobcat coach Brent Vigen has raved about his kickoffs since the 6-8 Hall transferred from SMU. That was on display Saturday, when all 10 of his kickoffs resulted in touchbacks.
- Marqui Johnson returned an Oregon State kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown in 2022, MSU's first score on a kick return since 2015. He also slipped down just short of the goal line on an 87-yard return vs. William & Mary.
- Taco Dowler's 67-yard punt return for a touchdown against Morehead State in 2022 was MSU's first since Shawn Johnson in 2013 against UM. His 71-yarder against William & Mary made him the fourth Bobcat to house two punts in a season.
- Blake Glessner has kicked off 103 times this season, with 66 touchbacks.
- MSU long snapper Tommy Sullivan has played as one of the team's most consistently excellent performers since his debut in 2021. Making every one of the team's long snaps since then, he has produced only two less-than-perfect snaps in his three-year career. One came on his first career snap, the second in miserable weather conditions at South Dakota State in the 2022 playoffs.

- Derryk Snell's presence settling under the first punt MSU forced in 2023 as the rare fullback/punt returner turned some heads, but he foreshadowed that situation at the end of 2022. In the season finale at South Dakota State, the Jackrabbits targeted Snell on kickoffs. The then-junior responded by bringing back four of them for 121 yards, including an impressive 66-yarder.

- Montana State's cover units didn't get much of a workout in the season opener. All nine of Brendan Hall's kickoffs and his only punt resulted in touchbacks.

Bobcat Coaching Notebook

● Brent Vigen's 24 wins is already 11th in Bobcat history. His 29 games coached is 16th. His .828 winning percentage is easily the best in school history.

● Brent Vigen opened his first season as a head coach (at any level) against Wyoming in 2021, where he worked from 2014-20, and closed it against his alma mater, North Dakota State, where he began his coaching career in 1998.

● Brent Vigen is one of three Bobcat coaches in the Gold Rush era of home openers (since 2007). Rob Ash won all nine of his Gold Rush Games, Jeff Choate was 3-1, and Vigen is 3-0. It's worth noting that seven of Ash's nine Gold Rush wins came against Division II opponents, although the most recent game the Cats have played against a non-DI program came in Jeff Choate's second home game in 2016. Choate's only Gold Rush loss, and one of the wins, came against ranked FCS foes.

● Brent Vigen joins Mike Kramer (2005) and Sonny Holland (1976) as MSU's only coaches with perfect home seasons in Sales/Bobcat Stadium. Vigen is 16-0 at home, the best start to any Bobcat coaching career (Herb Agocs, 1958-59, and Fred Bennion, 1914-15, each started 8-0). His 12 wins in 2021 was third-most in Big Sky history for a first-year head coach, second-most for a first-year coach without previous head coaching experience, and the most ever by a Bobcat coach.

● Three coaches left MSU to become head coaches elsewhere: Jim Sweeney after 1967 (Washington State), Ott Romney after 1927 (BYU), and Walter Powell after 1919 (Stanford). Five other left to become assistants: Jeff Choate went to Texas before the 2021 season, Doug Graber went to the Chiefs after 1982, Wally Lemm moved on to the Cardinals after 1955, Clyde Carpenter went to Tennessee before returning to Montana as a high school coach, and DV Graves left after 1921 to become baseball and assistant football coach at Washington.

● The first North Dakota State graduate to lead the Cats, Brent Vigen joins Earle Solomonson as former Bison coaches to assume the head coach role at MSU. Solomonson won 15 games from 1987-91 after three seasons as NDSU's coach, including an NCAA Division II title.

● In 1914 Montana State hired Fred Bennion as head coach after he'd attained success at Utah and BYU. , and by all accounts was drawn to Bozeman by the opportunity to study and work in agriculture while coaching. Since then, only Schubert Dyche (1928-35, 1938-41), Jack Croft (1936-37), Tom Parac (1968-70), Cliff Hysell (1992-99), and Brent Vigen (2021-) led MSU without prior head coaching experience.

● Montana State's current coaching family tree primarily traces back to North Dakota State and Craig Bohl. Brent Vigen and assistant Bryan Shepherd both played at NDSU, while Taylor Housewright (Wyoming) and Willie Mack Garza (North Dakota State, Wyoming) previously worked with Bohl and Vigen.
