SERIES HISTORY (0-0)

This is the first time the Cardinals and Jackrabbits have met.

UIW

- The much-anticipated Cardinals vs. Jackrabbits matchup was tabbed the Stats Perform FCS game of the Week.
- UIW is sitting at No. 11 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll and No. 12 in the Stats Perform Top 25 Poll. The Cardinals have now been featured in the FCS Top 25 Poll for 40-straight weeks, the fifth longest streak in the FCS behind North Dakota State, South Dakota State, Montana, and Montana State.
- With the home-opener win over Northern Colorado, Killough has improved his career record at UIW to 10-2 to start his second season as head coach.

JACKRABBITS

- The defending champions are coming off their first loss in almost two years after putting up a 20-44 fight against No.17 Oklahoma State.
- 2023 Walter Payton Award winner Mark Gronowski threw for 264 yards and two touch downs last week against the Cowboys.
- Amar Johnson and Angel Johnson combined for 100 yards on the ground.
- Griffin Wilde tallied one touchdown and 150 yards in the air on seven catches, while Grahm Goering added one touchdown and 69 yards on four catches.
- Adam Bock led the Jackrabbit defense with 12 tackles and Caleb Francl registered a career-high eight tackles.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

- This is the first time the Cardinals and Jackrabbits have met.
- In 2022, the Cardinals faced two Missouri Valley Football opponents. UIW opened up the season with a win against the No. 9 Southern Illinois Salukis and closed the season with a loss at No. 3 North Dakota State to cap off the fourth playoff run in UIW football history.

PLAYERS TO WATCH

- Following his first game in red and black, Walthall was named the Southland Conference Offensive Player of the Week. Coming from Hawai'i, Walthall capped off the 28-7 win with 103 receiving yards on five catches and a 46-yard touchdown to take the 14-7 lead over the Bears in the second quarter. Another transfer student-athlete debut, Roy Alexander finished with six catches for 64 yards.
- Zach Calzada found the endzone twice on Saturday while throwing for 205 yards.
- Dekalon Taylor and Isaiah Robinson split the workload on the ground rushing for 81 and 82 yards respectively.
- The Cardinals defense continues to shine with Mister Williams and Kendrick Stone each snagging an interception. Williams ended the night wit five tackles, one interception, one QBH, and one fumble return.
- Tylan Foster and Stone each tallied nine total tackles on the night, while Mason Chambers added eight tackles and two pass breakups.

UIW Football Takes Down No. 9 Southern Illinois

SAN ANTONIO – Following an hour and forty-minute rain delay pushing kickoff of the home-opener Saturday night, the University of the Incarnate Word football team was chomping at the bit to face No. 9 Southern Illinois University.

Head Coach G.J. Kinne made a statement in his first win as a head coach, defeating a higher-ranked FCS opponent by 35 points. On the opposite side of the ball, the defensive line put in work, coming up three minutes shy of three full quarters on the field.

The Cardinals came out the gate with a 66-yard receiving touchdown from Taylor Grimes just two minutes into the game. Carson Mohr solidified the 7-0 start that led to a 64-29 Cardinal victory.

On his second catch of the night, Grimes caught a 55-yard touchdown pass from Lindsey Scott Jr. for his second touchdown in eight minutes, totaling 121 yards.

With under a minute left in the first, Scott Jr. did a somersault into the endzone as the Cardinals took a dominating, 22-0 lead.

SIU scored its first touchdown of the game in the second quarter after Ro Elliott rushed for 55 yards into the endzone. The Cardinals answered as Scott Jr. found Darion Chafin on a 79-yard touchdown pass to claim a 21-point lead (29-7).

In the red zone, the Salukis rushed for six yards into the endzone, cutting the lead to 29-13 with just under five minutes in the second quarter. SIU ended the half with a 47-yard field goal, bringing the score to 29-16.

The Cardinal defense stood strong, holding the Salukis to a fourth and goal 32-yard field goal (29-19) in the third.

Scott Jr. found Marquez Perez as he tip-toed into the endzone then, just over a minute later, Tiji Paul intercepted the Salukis and returned for a 36-yard UIW touchdown (43-19).

Jaelin Campbell was left wide open in the red zone and Mohr completed his sixth (6-6) PAT of the night as UIW extended the lead to 50-22 midway through the fourth quarter.

Brandon Porter delivered Scott Jr's sixth touchdown of the night off 391 passing yards late in the fourth (57-29). With a minute on the clock, Caleb Berry rushed into the endzone capping off the night with a 64-29 statement win over Southern Illinois.

Clint Killough - Head Football Coach

Clint Killough, a former UIW student-athlete and associate head coach, was promoted to the position of UIW head football coach in December of 2022. Killough was named head coach in the midst of the best season in program history, heading to the FCS Semifinals for the deepest playoff run in the UIW football era.

During his inaugural season, the 2023 UIW football team finished with a 9-2 (6-1 SLC) overall record, marking the third-most wins in program history behind 2022 and 2021. Killough took over a program that saw 66 total departures from the 2022 roster and rebuilt the Cardinals into a conference championship-contending team with only one returning defensive starter and three returning offensive starters. Killough, along with his new coaching staff, united the 2023 Cardinals to become the top statistical offense (total offense and scoring offense) and statistical defense (total defense and scoring defense) in the Southland Conference. Nationally, the Cardinals reached rankings in five different defensive categories and four offensive categories. Defensively, UIW finished first for team passing efficiency defense, tied for fourth for defensive touchdowns, fifth in third down conversion percentage, eighth for first downs defense, and tenth for total defense. Offensively, UIW ended the season ranked second in the nation for passing

offense, second in total offense, eleventh for team passing efficiency, and twelfth for scoring offense.

The Cardinals appeared in the Coaches Poll Top 25 and FCS Stats Perform Top 25 Rankings every week during the 2023 season, coming in as high as No. 4 in weeks six and seven. UIW had been active in the rankings for 37 straight weeks, the fifth-longest streak in the nation behind North Dakota State, South Dakota State, Montana, and Montana State.

The 2022 Cardinals, with Killough as associate head coach and wide receivers coach, rewrote the record book. The team had two wide receivers sitting in the top five in FCS for receiving touchdowns and receiving yards after winning back-to-back Southland Conference Championships.

Killough, a UIW alum, played for the Cardinals for three seasons (2013-2015) before returning to UIW in 2018 as the quality control coach for the inside receivers. He quickly climbed the coaching ranks as he was elevated to associate head coach/wide receivers coach/recruiting coordinator in January of 2022. Killough has been with the program through all three Southland Conference Championships ('18, '21, '22) and all three FCS Playoff runs.

Upon winning the 2021 Southland Conference Championship, the Cardinals defeated Stephen F. Austin to advance to the second round of the FCS Playoffs. Killough mentored a wide receiver core in an offense that threw for 4,680 yards and 48 touchdowns. Robert Ferrel nabbed a first team All-Southland Conference honor, while Trevor Begue, currently playing with the Edmonton Elks (CFL), produced 474 receiving yards and six touchdowns.

Even through the shortened 2021 spring season, the Cardinals achieved their highest ranking in school history (No. 13) while Killough guided the top two wide receivers in Tre Wolf and Ferrel. Ferrel produced 474 receiving yards and six TDs, while Wolf added 467 yards and two touchdowns. Ferrel finished the season with second team all-conference honors.

In 2019, Killough coached Kam Williams to become the program's first student-athlete to average 100 receiving yards per game through five games while also adding four touchdowns and 35 receptions.

During his first coaching season at UIW, Killough mentored Kody Edwards and Phillip Baptiste to first team All-SLC selections. Baptiste broke the single-season program record for receptions (59), total points (357), and receptions per game (5.36). Edwards set program bests with five 100-yard receiving outings and 1,389 all-purpose yards while breaking the program record for career receiving yards (2,353) and receptions (140). As a program, the 2018 team set multiple records to include total offense (5,315), total points (357) and touchdowns (48) as it finished the season with the first Southland Conference Championship and berth to the FCS Playoffs.

Killough began his career in 2017 at Bowling Green State University under Head Coach Mike Jinks. He worked directly under Defensive Coordinator Perry Eliano as the defensive backs/ special teams graduate assistant while also serving as the WRs graduate assistant under coach Seth Doege.

Graduating from UIW in 2015, Killough obtained a Bachelor of Business Administration in Finance.

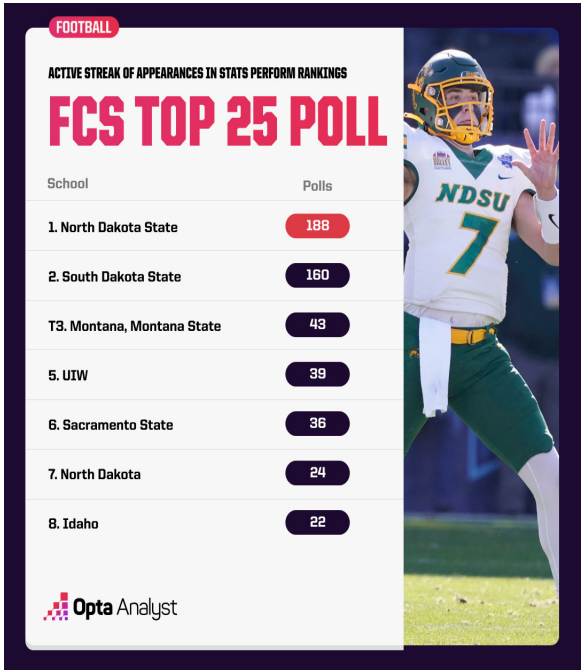

Football Opens Season with Home Win over Northern Colorado

August 31, 2024



SAN ANTONIO – The University of the Incarnate Word football team picked up a win in its first game of the season, defeating the University of Northern Colorado (UNC) 28-7 on Saturday night.

Zach Calzada threw for more than 200 yards for two touchdowns, 103 of those yards and one TD went to Jalen Walthall. Dekalon Taylor and Isaiah Robinson split the workload on the ground rushing for 81 and 82 yards respectfully.

The Cardinals came out strong scoring quickly in only five plays. The drive was capped off by a 27-yard rush for a touchdown by Taylor. UIW kept the pressure on UNC and on the next drive Mister Williams caught an interception giving the Cardinal offense the ball back.

UNC responded the next time out with a five-play drive to tie up the game, 7-7.

The Cardinals and Bears went back and forth, neither one gaining the edge until the final minutes of the first half when Calzada found Walthall streaking down the field for a 46-yard touchdown; breaking the tie and sending UIW into the break up, 14-7.

Coming out of the locker room the Cardinals took over, dominating in all three phases of the game. UIW forced a turnover on the first kickoff of the half, scoring on the

first drive, and getting off the field in just three plays.

Taylor found his way into the end zone once again stretching the Cardinal lead to 28-7. UIW was able to control the clock and keep the Bears off the board for the remainder of the game earning the first win of the season.
