A LOOK AT THE PANTHERS

Birmingham-Southern, who had a bye week last week, finished non-conference play with a perfect 3-0 record, outscoring their opponents, 145-32. Averaging 48 points per game, good for 10th-best in all of NCAA Division III, the Panthers are one of 13 teams with a total offense of 500 yards or more, joining SAA foe Trinity (577.5).

Robert Shufford, who we found out this week in a D3football.com feature story that he prefers to be called by Chris, but a lot are calling him, Mr. All-American. The senior enters Saturday's contest with 3,271 rushing yards, good for sixth-most in all of Division III among active players.

So far this season, the 2019 AFCA and D3Football.com First Team All-American has rushed for 519 yards this season, seventh-best in the country, and has scored nine on the ground, second-most in Division III.

Since 2019, the McKenzie, Ala. native has achieved 100+ yards on the ground in 14 of 16 games.

On the defensive side of the ball, Seth Gable (23), Cameron DeArman (21) and Connor West (21) are the top three tacklers for BSC. However, DeArman and Court Coley each have at least three sacks on the season for the Panthers.

Tony Joe White is in his fifth season as head coach of the Birmingham-Southern Panthers, and he holds a 21-16 overall record.

LAST TIME OUT VS. BSC

Sewanee and Birmingham-Southern played under the lights at historic Hardee-McGee Field at Harris Stadium on Sept. 21, 2019. Down 35-3 after three quarters, the Tigers put 27 points on the board in the final quarter thanks to two touchdown receptions by Cyrus McCullough and Wesley Porter C'21 pick-six for 58 yards.

Alex Darras C'20 threw for 342 yards on 23-of-44 passing with three scores. McCullough caught a career-high 192 receiving yards on nine catches.

MR. 3000

Cyrus McCullough has had a stellar career with the Purple and White, and he is eyeing some career milestones. The senior is closing in on 3,000 all-purpose yards as he enters Saturday's game with 2,641.

Now at 1,537 receiving yards, he is just 463 away from eclipsing 2,000.

He's also picking up the yardage on kick and punt returns, totaling 1,088 between the two categories.

COMING IN BUNCHES

Sewanee's 29-point performance was the most in a game since the Tigers had 25 in a game versus Millsaps on Homecoming 2019, Nov. 2.

Additionally, the Tigers' 20-point fourth quarter was the most since the 27-point explosion in Sewanee's 49-30 setback to Birmingham-Southern on Sept. 21, 2019.

MORRICE RUNS THIS TOWN

George Morrice had two big rushing plays in Sewanee's contest with Westminster. Along with his 51-yard rush late in the first quarter, his 30-yard run in the fourth quarter helped his team scored in three straight drives in the third and fourth quarters.

With his 102-yard performance on Saturday, the junior now has 514 yards on the ground on 92 carries.

THE ATHLETIC: JOURNEY BACK TO SEWANEE A FOUNDING SEC MEMBER THAT HAS NO REGRETS

Seth Emerson, beat writer for the University of Georgia for The Athletic, stopped by campus in August 2021 to talk Sewanee's past, present and future of the football program.

Emerson, whose father, grandfather and uncles all attended the college, shared his story of his visit to the Domain, while meeting with Director of Athletics Mark Webb, Head Football Coach Travis Rundle and others and sharing their stories.

Sewanee was a founding member of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) in 1933, and despite not winning a game during their time in the league, the program did notch one All-American, Rupert Colmore Jr., in 1936.

TRINITY TABBED TO WIN SAA IN 2021

Beginning in the 2021-22 season, the Southern Athletic Association (SAA) will start preseason polls for each of its 21 sponsored sports. On Tuesday, Aug. 31, the football preseason poll was released. Voted by the head coaches, Sewanee was listed in seventh with 19 points.

Trinity, the co-champions of the SAA in 2019, edged 2020-21 champion Berry by two points to earn the league's preseason favorite. Hendrix, who won the SAA West Division in 2020-21, took third place.

The league went to divisional play last year due to COVID-19 pandemic. The conference will revert back to one champion with no championship game as in previous years.

AUSTIN OUT

On Aug. 13, 2020, Austin College announced that they would move from the SAA to the American Southwest Conference (ASC) as a football affiliate starting in the 2021 season. The Roos were affiliate members from 2017-20 after the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference (SCAC) discontinued football as a conference sport in 2016.

Austin was 11-23 in four seasons overall and 8-19 in league play. The Roos posted their only .500 season in 2019 with a 5-5 mark and 4-4 in league play, defeating Centre, Millsaps, Sewanee and Rhodes.

The Roos will join full members Belhaven (Miss.), East Texas Baptist, Hardin-Simmons (Texas), Howard Payne (Texas), Mary Hardin-Baylor (Texas), McMurry (Texas) and Sul Ross State (Texas), as well as affiliate members Southwestern (Texas) and Texas Lutheran.

SOUTHWESTERN IN

When the SCAC ended its conference sponsorship of football in 2016, Southwestern and Texas Lutheran were accepted by the ASC as affiliate members. After the 2022 season, the Pirates will switch conferences again. On Aug. 19, the SAA announced that Southwestern University will join the league as an affiliate member beginning in the 2023 season.

The Pirates, which restarted its program in 2013, have a 14-17 record overall and a 16-18 mark in league play as members of the ASC entering the 2021 season. Picked ninth in this season's conference preseason poll, the Pirates will continue competition in the league through the 2022 season.
