OPENING DRIVE

128

Sewanee begins its 128th year of college football on the Cumberland Plateau. Starting competition in 1891, the Tigers are playing in their 1,082nd game all-time with 491 victories.

54

Tennessee, for the first time since 2006, defeated Alabama, 52-49, coming within two points of the most points Alabama has allowed in a game since 1907. That record belongs to the University of the South. The Tigers annihilated the Crimson Tide, 54-4, on Oct. 21.

89

Saturday's meeting between Rhodes and Sewanee will be the 89th in the series history. This is the most times Sewanee has played an opponent in history. The series started in 1899 with a 54-0 throttling on Nov. 3. Six days later, Sewanee went on its historic road trip where the won five games in six days on the road.

DIVISION III

A LOOK AT THE LYNX

Rhodes College enters the annual Orgill Cup contest coming off a 31-7 victory at Millsaps. After getting shut out in their last two games and scoring just seven points in their first three games, the Lynx totaled 323 yards of offense thanks to 170 yards on the ground.

Leading the running game is Elijah Bane's 315 yards on 95 carries with five scores, followed by Michael Thomas's 202 yards.

Senior Luke Macias has over 1,000 passing yards on the season with a 56.6% completion rate. Catching three of his five receptions in the end zone is Andrew Pickens, who has 456 receiving yards.

On defense, Kobe Bins is having a stellar season with 7.5 sacks and 11 tackles for a loss. Evan Byrd leads the team with 45 stops.

Rich Duncan, who was Berry's offensive coordinator from 2013 to 2020, is in his second season at the helm at Rhodes College.

THE EDMUND ORGILL TROPHY

The strong football rivalry of Rhodes-Sewanee dates back to 1899, but since 1954, the two Tennessee schools have battled each fall for possession of the Edmund Orgill Trophy.

Edmund Orgill (1899-1983), who was ironically born the year the cross-state rivalry began, had close ties to both schools. He was Chairman of the Board of Regents at Southwestern and the chairman of the Board of Regents at the University of the South. A 1920 graduate of Virginia, Mr. Orgill received honorary degrees from Rhodes and Sewanee in 1954. He was elected mayor of Memphis in 1956.

Trophy Inscription: *The Edmund Orgill Trophy is presented annually by Southwestern of Memphis and the University of the South at Sewanee to the winner of each year's football game as evidence of their esteem for and gratitude to a man whose benefactions to them are measureless. Initiated on November 13, 1954.*

(Note: Rhodes was called Southwestern until 1984).

Saturday's meeting marks the 68th in the Orgill Cup. Rhodes holds the 37-29-1 advantage all-time in the series. Sewanee last won the cup in 2018, which came from Harris Stadium.

THE ONE THING TENNESSEE DID NOT DO VERSUS ALABAMA

In case you missed it on Oct. 15, the traditional "Third Saturday in October" game between the University of Alabama and the University of Tennessee saw some firsts. UT defeated Alabama for the first time in the Nick Saban era (2006), and it's probably the first time in 16 years that the goal post has been replaced at Neyland Stadium.

UT saw some school records either matched or broken, as wide receiver Jalin Hyatt posted five receiving touchdowns to tie both the program and the SEC record. Meanwhile, quarterback Hendon Hooker tied Heath Schuler for 18 straight games with at least one passing touchdown.

There was one record that Tennessee did not break in its 52-49 victory: the most points allowed in a game by an team opposing Alabama. Vanderbilt holds the record for most points scored against Bama with 78 in 1906, but since 1907, that record belongs to the University of the South, as the Tigers dropped 54 on the Tide.

115 years ago on Oct. 21, the Crimson Tide hosted the Tigers in Tuscaloosa. After defeating Auburn in Birmingham two days before, 12-6, Sewanee rolled to a 54-4 win, and had a 38-4 halftime advantage.

According to the *Sewanee Purple* on Oct. 25, the game started a 3 p.m. with 25-minute halves.

The Crimson Tide have the advantage in the series, 17-10-3, but Sewanee was dominant in the first 11 meetings that started in 1893. Winning nine and tying one to start the series, Sewanee won six straight between 1896 and 1911, outscoring them 162-16 in that stretch.

That 1907 season saw Sewanee go 8-1 on the year, with six of its wins via shut out. Along with Auburn and Alabama, Sewanee also defeated Mississippi State, Ole Miss, Virginia, Georgia and Georgia Tech. Only MSU made the trek to the Domain, the other wins came either at a true road site or a neutral site.

NUMBER 300

Sewanee's game at Hendrix on Oct. 15 marked the 300th conference game between Sewanee's three Division III conferences: the College Athletic Conference (CAC), the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference (SCAC) and the Southern Athletic Association (SAA).

Sewanee played in the CAC in 1962 to 1990, the SCAC from 1991 to 2011 and the SAA since 2012. During the stretch, the Tigers have won 12 conference championships between the three leagues and seven players were four-time All-Conference selections.

IK MIKE

Setting a new career-best in rushing yards in a game with 241 against Millsaps, senior Michael McGhee had the eighth-best rushing performance in SAA history. With the performance, he eclipsed the 1,000-yard rushing mark in his career.

Recording the second 200-yard running game in Sewanee history since 2012, it is the most in a game since Cody Daniel's 232-yard performance against Emory & Henry in 2014.

Posting two of his 21 carries of 70 yards or more, McGhee was named the SAA Offensive Player of the Week and was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week on Oct. 3.

Currently sitting on 631 rushing yards after seven games, he is looking to be the first Tiger to 1,000 rushing yards in a season since Max Fuller in 1998.

YOUR FIRST INTERCEPTION IS A PICK SIX

Kaleb Seay secured his first career interception last week against Centre, and it was returned 23 yards for a fourth quarter touchdown.

As a team, Sewanee has had four different players record an interception.

HITTING THE ROAD FOR THE FIRST TIME IN WEEK 6

After Sewanee played four straight games at historic Hardee-McGee Field at Harris Stadium, the Tigers are in the middle of a back-to-back road stretch.

Last week, the Tigers traveled for the first time in 2022 after spending the first four games on the Domain.

This was just the third time in program history (1993-2000-22) that the Tigers began the season at historic Hardee-McGee Field at Harris Stadium with four games.

The 1993 season saw Sewanee not leave the State of Tennessee for the first six games.

Along with five home games, Sewanee made a trip to Lebanon, Tenn. to face Cumberland and Memphis to Rhodes. Sewanee's lone trip out-of-state came on Oct. 30 (Millsaps).

BOOMING PUNTS

Sophomore Jack Satterfield set a new season-best for the SAA against Millsaps on Oct. 1. The Murfreesboro native set a career-high of 79 yards to set the conference mark for the year to this point, and it is the second-longest punt in SAA and school history, trailing John Cleveland's C'18 82-yard boom in 2015.

HITTING THE BIG FIVE-0H

The contest versus St. Scholastica on Sept. 3 had some new highs in points scored in the Travis Rundle era.

The Tigers' 50 points is the most since Rundle became head coach in 2017, and it is the most since the 43-point explosion vs. Kenyon in 2018.

Sewanee's last 50-point game came in 1997 with a 56-30 win against Millsaps.

BLANKING OPPONENTS

The Tiger defense posted a shutout for the first time in almost 15 seasons in Week 1's dub of St. Scholastica (Minn.).

Prior to Sept. 3, the Purple and White recorded a 19-0 shutout on Sept. 20, 2008 against Colorado College.

Sewanee recorded its 203rd shutout out of the 491 wins of its storied history. 41% of the team's dubs have come via the shutout. This includes the five shutouts in six days that the historic team of 1899 accomplished. That team shut out 11 of its 12 opponents that

year, allowing just 10 points to John Heisman's Auburn team in Montgomery, Ala. on Nov. 30.

Sewanee also has 18 shutouts that ended in a tie, with the last one coming against Millsaps in 1961.

EIGHT FOOTBALL PLAYERS INDUCTED INTO THE ORDER OF THE GOWN

The football program saw eight players earn their gowns at the Fall Convocation on Sept. 16. The latest inductees include Harris Cravens, David Durden, Keegan Glaze, John Harbison, Kason Holder, Jose Osa, Brody Palmer and Holt Stewart.

Starting in 1873, the Order of the Gown is one of the oldest traditions at the University of the South. A badge of academic distinction, undergraduates earn membership in the OG as seniors (students with 96 or more hours) if their academic average for the previous two semesters at Sewanee is 3.00; as juniors (students with 64-95 hours) if their academic average for the previous two semesters is 3.20; as sophomores (students with 32-63 hours) if their academic average for the previous two semesters is 3.40.

THE END OF AN ERA

Sept. 10's contest between the Generals and the Tigers will likely be the end of the series, at least for the next two years. The teams have played in 65 of the last 67 seasons, not playing in 2007 and 2020.

While most of the series was played near the end of the season, the teams shifted to playing in September for the 2003 season.

While the series was all the rave back in the day, it has been on the side of the Generals since the early 1990s. Since 1991, Sewanee has won just five times vs. W&L, with the last win coming on the Domain in 2014.

The meeting at Harris Stadium was the 70th meeting all-time between the two schools, and it is the longest series in Sewanee history that's not a conference opponent.

- Trinity linebacker James Ogunrin was named to the D3football.com National Team of the Week.
- Two of the top-three teams in the SAA will go head to head Saturday when Trinity visits Centre. A Tigers are 4-0 in league play and Colonels right behind at 3-1.
