Martin provided a spark off the bench in helping Quinnipiac capture the St. Mary's Classic following Thanksgiving Classic. The 6-foot-3 freshman guard turned in back-to-back 12-point performances in two-point victories over Monmouth and Monmouth last St. Mary's. Martin nearly averaged one point per minute in the tournament opener against Big Ten member Monmouth and sank the clutch dagger with a jumper-leading basket. The rookie guard, who scored 13 points in 16 minutes, broke a 62-60 tie by hitting a game-winning jump shot with 00:01 left on the clock. Martin saw her playing time increase to 24 minutes in the tournament title tilt against St. Mary's. Her 14 points and four rebounds were key factors in the 68-47 triumph over the West Coast Conference program. Martin's first assist last week came in a crucial spot against the Monmouth team. The Wagner State product set up Felicia Rowan's three-pointer that gave the Flash a 68-62 advantage over St. Mary's with 1:51 remaining in regulation. Martin was impeccable from the free throw line during the two-game clip, shooting 7-for-7 at the stripe.

FRANCIS WOULD ENTER THE NORTHEAST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT AS THE EIGHT SEED, TAKING ON THE LONG ISLAND UNIVERSITY BLACKBIRDS, THE TOURNAMENTS TOP SEED. THE TERRIERS WOULD PULL OUT THE UPSET, AS IT WAS THE FIRST TIME THAT THE SCHOOL HAS QUALIFIED FOR THE SEMI-FINALS AS WELL AS BEING THE ONLY # 8 SEED TO UPSET THE # 1 SEED IN NORTHEAST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT HISTORY.

DESPITE HAVING THREE STARTERS ON THE INJURED LIST, THE 2007-08 TERRIERS WERE RESILIENT AND MADE IT BACK TO NORTHEAST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT. IN 2009-10, MILANO WAS ABLE TO ACHIEVE PERSONAL MILESTONES IN HER COACHING CAREER. THE TERRIERS ENDED A THREE-YEAR DROUGHT IN THE BATTLE OF BROOKLYN AS THEY DEFEATED LONG ISLAND UNIVERSITY, GIVING MILANO HER 35TH NORTHEAST CONFERENCE VICTORY. A MONTH LATER, WITH A LAST SECOND FREE-THROW, ST. FRANCIS WOULD STUN 2008 NORTHEAST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONS, ROBERT MORRIS, GIVING COACH MILANO HER 50TH CAREER VICTORY, THE MOST WINS BY A ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE WOMEN'S HEAD COACH.

MILANO GAINED HER EARLY COACHING EXPERIENCE AT NORTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY AS A GRADUATE ASSISTANT AND AT SETON HALL UNIVERSITY WHERE SHE EARNED A MASTER'S DEGREE IN SPORTS MANAGEMENT.

BEFORE COACHING, MILANO SPENT TIME AT INTEGRATED SPORTS INTERNATIONAL, SPORTS MARKETING FIRM WHERE SHE PUT TO WORK HER B.S. IN MARKETING FROM WAGNER COLLEGE (1995). IN 1998, MILANO CAME TO ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE AS ASSISTANT COACH FOR THE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM AND SERVED AS THE COLLEGE'S ASSISTANT ATHLETIC DIRECTOR OF BUSINESS AFFAIRS, POSITIONS SHE HELD UNTIL 2002. AFTER A BRIEF STINT AT HOFSTRA UNIVERSITY WHERE SHE SERVED AS FIRST ASSISTANT, MILANO RETURNED TO ST. FRANCIS FOR THE 2003-2004 CAMPAIGN TO LEAD THE TEAM AS HEAD COACH.

THIS PAST FALL, IN RECOGNITION OF HER ACCOLADES AT WAGNER, DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS WALT HAMELINE ANNOUNCED THAT MILANO WAS VOTED INTO THE SCHOOL'S HALL OF FAME IN HER FIRST YEAR OF ELIGIBILITY.

MILANO WAS A FOUR-YEAR STALWART ON THE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAMS OF THE EARLY 1990s. SHE AVERAGED 12.5 PPG, 5.0 RPG AND 4.5 APG FOR HER CAREER AND WAS NAMED TO THE NEC SECOND TEAM AS A SOPHOMORE AND TO THE ALL-NEWCOMER TEAM AS A FRESHMAN BEFORE BEING BESET BY INJURIES.

MILANO SCORED 1,046 POINTS DESPITE PLAYING JUST 84 CAREER GAMES AND GRADUATED AS THE 12TH-HIGHEST SCORER IN SCHOOL HISTORY (CURRENTLY 21ST). SHE ALSO RANKS AMONG THE PROGRAM LEADERS IN ASSISTS (382) (6TH) AND STEALS (148) (8TH). MILANO WAS ALSO A TWO-YEAR CAPTAIN AND TEAM MVP.

VENEY WAS ABLE TO CONVERT ON A MID-RANGE JUMPER TO CUT THE DEFICIT TO FOUR, 64-60 WITH FORTY SECONDS IN OVERTIME. THE QUAKERS' MEGHAN MCCULLOUGH HIT TWO BIG FREE-THROWS TO GIVE UPENN A COMFORTABLE SIX POINT ADVANTAGE.

THE TERRIERS BUILT THEIR LARGEST LEAD OF THE CONTEST, 29-20, A MINUTE INTO THE SECOND HALF AFTER KAUFMAN NAILED A JUMPER FROM INSIDE THE PAINT. IT CAPPED A 9-0 RUN FOR THE TERRIERS AFTER UPENN'S ALYSSA BARON DRAINED A THREE-POINTER TO CUT THE TERRIERS LEAD TO TWO, 22-20 WITH 2:59 REMAINING IN THE FIRST HALF.

IN THE OPENING HALF THE QUAKERS TOOK A 10-4 LEAD SIX MINUTES INTO THE CONTEST AS IT TOOK ST. FRANCIS JUST OVER TWO MINUTES BEFORE GETTING ON THE BOARD AS KAUFMAN WAS ABLE TO NET HER FIRST HOOP AS A TERRIER.

THE TEMPO PICKED UP IN THE MIDDLE OF THE FIRST HALF AS BOTH TEAMS TRADED BUCKETS FOR A STRETCH OF THREE MINUTES WHICH SAW THE GAME TIED AT 17 AFTER FRESHMAN FORWARD COLETTE HOUNSHELL NETTED HER FIRST POINTS AS A TERRIER.

ST. FRANCIS SHOT 41.8 PERCENT (23-OF-55) OVERALL AND SHOT AT A 84.6 PERCENT CLIP (11-FOR-13) FROM THE FREE-THROW LINE WHILE UPENN WENT 23-OF-64 (35.9 PERCENT) AND WERE JUST 3-OF-21 (14.3 PERCENT) FROM THREE-POINT LAND.
