TERRIER TIDBITS

St. Francis (NY) vs. UCONN Series History

The Terriers men's soccer team opens up the 2011 season against a familiar opponent, the #5/8 UConn Huskies of the Big East. This makes the second straight year that St. Francis opens up their season against the Huskies in Storrs, Connecticut.

The game marks the eighth straight year in which St. Francis has kicked-off their season with a road contest. The last time the Terriers opened the season at home dates back to the 2003 season when they hosted the Saint Peter's College Peacocks on August 29, 2003 (SPC won 4-1)

The Terriers are looking for their first win against the defending Big East champions, as St. Francis is 0-4-0 all-time. Last season, the Huskies blanked St. Francis 2-0 despite the visitors putting up a valiant fight to reach intermission with the score deadlocked at zero.

Weir, Toma and Bigdeli Selected as 2011 Captains

Head Coach Tom Giovatto has announced that seniors Aldo Toma, Robbie Weir and junior Farzan Bigdeli have been named team captains for the 2011 season.

"Aldo, Robbie and Farzan have been vital to our development as a program," said Giovatto, who is entering his fifth season as head coach of the Terriers. "They have been through tough times and have experienced the rewards of the team's hard-work. The trio are primary examples of what it means to be a student-athletes. They are hard-working, dedicated individuals that give 100% on the field and 110% in the classroom."

Toma, a senior defenseman, has been a starter for the past three seasons. His primary responsibility on the field is to take charge of the defense from his right-back position. Toma's leadership and experience will be essential this year as the Terriers are set to welcome some new faces to the team in 2011.

Weir, a senior midfielder, was a tri-captain last season along with graduated defenders Nicholas and Greg Baum. The native of Prestwick, Scotland will patrol the central midfield for Giovatto's bunch. He will be one of the focal points to control the tempo of the offense and when given the opportunity, the 5-11 midfielder can bend the ball with the best of them. Weir has tallied five goals, six assists and sixteen points over his first three seasons.

Bigdeli, a junior from Forest Hills, NY, will provide a spark for the Terriers, whether he is in the starting lineup or coming off the bench. A member of the College's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC), Bigdeli will be looked upon by the underclassmen for leadership as they adapt to playing on the collegiate level.

Men's Soccer Gears Up for 2011 Season

With the start of the season this Saturday at #7 ranked UConn, the 2011 St. Francis (NY) men's soccer team will be a young squad, with the return of 14 players, including six starters from the 2010 squad.

"We compete in a very competitive conference and our goal remains the same. Each year we are vying for a Northeast Conference championship," said head coach Tom Giovatto, entering his fifth season at the helm.

Expectations:

Head Coach Tom Giovatto expects his squad to improve on the defensive end while converting on scoring opportunities when given the chance.

Players to Watch in 2011:

Sophomore forward Gabriel Bagot and junior midfielder Adam Maabdi will be looked upon to start a "French Connection" of their own. Last season, Bagot recorded four goals, one assist and nine points in thirteen games played. Maabdi, on the other hand, looked to pass more with his explosive speed as the Frenchman recorded a team-leading six assists in 2010. Also look for senior tri-captain Robbie Weir (2 goals, 4 assists, 8 points) as a scoring option with his ability to bend the ball from long distances and off corner-kicks.

Goalkeepers:

St. Francis has three netminders on the roster this season. The most tenured is junior Liam Burton. New to the fold are junior Tyler Clarhaut and freshman Wesley Woodley. Each bring a different dynamic between the pipes.

Defense:

After losing constant staples Nicholas and Greg Baum due to graduation, the Terriers revamped the defensive end, led by senior tri-captain Aldo Toma and sophomore Frank Lopez. Both Toma and Lopez will provide stability in the backfield as the Terriers will incorporate newcomers Bryant Vargas, Riccardo Milano and Ronny Schafer.

Midfield/Forward:

Losing your top scorers is never easy for a program but the coaching staff is excited about some of the newcomers. Finding the right balance will be the key for Giovatto's bunch. At the forward position, Gabriel Bagot will be looking to show no signs of a "sophomore jinx" as he posted stellar numbers in thirteen games last season. Senior Jonas Pantelidis along with new arrivals Marcello Zuccaro and Giorgio Ferrara will be vying for key minutes upfront.

This year's squad is stocked piled with midfielders that each bring something special to the team. Senior tri-captain Weir along with juniors Farzan Bigdeli, Richie Arkoi, Maabdi, Klement Gjushi, and Ben Graver are the upperclassmen this year and are expected to provide leadership for the newcomers. The underclassmen will look to make names for themselves, especially sophomores John Johansson, Simon Ytterbom, and James "Junior" Caicedo. Giovatto added two
