## ABOUT ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE

ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE WAS FOUNDED IN 1859 AS ST. FRANCIS ACADEMY BY A GROUP OF NEWLY ARRIVED FRANCISCAN BROTHERS FROM IRELAND. THE BROTHER'S MISSION WAS TO EDUCATE YOUNG MEN FROM WORKING-CLASS FAMILIES IN THE BROOKLYN DIOCESE. ST. FRANCIS ACADEMY PROVIDED A SOUND EDUCATION WITH A RIGOROUS CURRICULUM AND PERSONAL SUPPORT, ALL FOR A MODEST TUITION, CHARACTERISTICS THAT ENDURE TODAY.

IN 1884, ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE RECEIVED ITS CHARTER FROM NEW YORK STATE ESTABLISHING A LITERARY COLLEGE WHICH COULD AWARD DIPLOMAS, HONORS, AND DEGREES. IN 1926, ST. 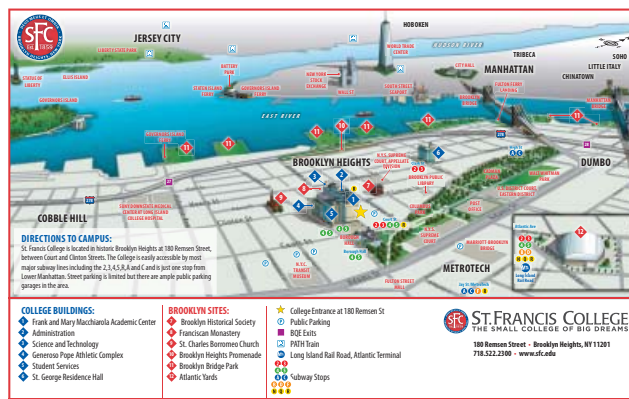

## HEAD COACH GLENN BRAICA

### 2011-2012 NEC COACH OF THE YEAR THIRD SEASON AS HEAD COACH ALMA MATER: QUEENS COLLEGE CAREER RECORD: 31-31

Brooklyn native Glenn Braica was named the 17th head coach in the history of the St. Francis College men's basketball program on May 20, 2010.

"I'm extremely excited to be the new head coach at St. Francis College," Braica said at his press conference. "I would like to thank Irma and the administration for giving me this opportunity. I believe that the experience I have gained in all facets of coaching has prepared me for the challenge of re-establishing St. Francis as one of the best programs in the Northeast Conference. It's my desire to work with people of high integrity who understand the importance of academics and the values of St. Francis College. I will build a program that properly reflects the institution's high expectations of its student-athletes in the classroom, on the court and in the community."

"With Glenn we get a true Brooklynite; someone who has spent his entire career making connections within the New York City basketball community," added AD Garcia. "He's someone who cares about his student-athletes not just when they play for him, but years later. He is their mentor for life."

When St. Francis Director of Athletics Irma Garcia introduced Braica to the campus and media she said, "This is a great day for St. Francis College basketball. Glenn was a solid coach for us when he was here the first time. Now with six years in the Big East under his belt, he's coming back with incredible experience that will give our program a huge lift toward the upper echelon of the Northeast Conference."

In his first season on the sidelines in 2010-2011, Braica led the Terriers to a 15-15 campaign and the No. 5 seed in the Northeast Conference Tournament. It was the program's best record since the 2003-04 season when St. Francis finished 15-13 and won a share of the NEC regular-season title. Under Braica, the Terriers increased their scoring by more than six points per game from the previous season and were one of the best teams in the country in taking care of the basketball, averaging a conference-low 13.3 turnovers per game. The team also led the circuit with 7.80 steals per game.

Last season, St. Francis hosted their first home conference tournament game since 1997 after placing fourth in the league standings. Braica's focus on defense is certainly paying off. Last season his squad was one of the best in the nation at defending the three-point line. The Terriers ranked second in the NEC and 17th in the country in defensive three-point field goal percentage. Braica was rewarded by being named the Jim Phelan NEC Coach of the Year



as well as the NABC Division I District 18 Co-Coach of the Year.

In his first stint at St. Francis, Braica patrolled the Terriers' sidelines for 15 years and was the Associate Head Coach from the 2000-01 season to 2003-04 under Ron Ganulin. During Braica's last seven years at St. Francis, the Terriers posted a 118-83 record, including an 88-42 mark in the NEC and captured two regular season titles. They finished with a .500 or better record in the league seven-straight years, at that time the longest active streak in the conference. They also reached the NEC Semifinals five times and had two championship game appearances in Braica's last five seasons.

Braica helped Ganulin orchestrate the Terriers' offensive system, which ranked first or second in the NEC in each of the last five seasons he was on staff. During his tenure the squad emerged from the league's lower tier and went on to become one of the conference's marquee programs. From 1998-2004, the Terriers had one player named the league's Player of the Year, six first-team All-NEC selections, five second-team All-NEC honorees, two players that led the league in scoring, two NEC Rookies of the Year and a NEC Defensive Player of the Year. Braica recruited and coached several student-athletes that would go on to pro basketball careers during his time with the Terriers.

Following his first span at the college, Braica spent six seasons as an assistant at St. John's under Norm Roberts. When Roberts became head coach at St. John's, Braica, a teammate at Queens College, was his first hire. He is a proven recruiter, scout and strategist, and was instrumental in helping St. John's rebuild its program.

"I truly believe that Glenn has the whole package," said Roberts. "He brings experience, tremendous coaching ability as well as the personality and demeanor to promote and elevate St. Francis College to the top of the Northeast Conference."

Braica was also praised by Roberts for his ability to reach out to the community and Red Storm alumni, bringing former players back into the fold. He was also one of the co-directors of the Norm Roberts basketball camp, helping to increase enrollment from 75 campers in 2004 to 260 kids per session in 2009.

While at St. John's, Braica recruited and helped develop First Team All-Big East guard Dwight Hardy and Sixth Man of the Year Justin Burrell. He also worked with D.J. Kennedy and Cedric Jackson, who both played in the NBA for the Cleveland Cavaliers.

From 2001-03, Braica was the head coach for the Empire State Games New York City men's open team, which won gold medals in 2001 and 2002, as well as a silver medal in 2003. The team included former Terriers Cliff Strong, Sean Dantzer, Damien Herard, Devon Neckles, Karl Sanders, and Tristan Smith as well as current NBA player Royal Ivey. Braica has also coached numerous players that participated in this past year's NBA Summer League, including Dwight Hardy (Miami Heat), Justin Burrell (Golden State Warriors), D.J. Kennedy (Cleveland Cavaliers), and Paris Horne (Charlotte Bobcats).

Braica attended St. Agnes High School and Bishop Ford High School in Brooklyn in the early 1980s and graduated from Queens College in 1989. Braica began his coaching career at New York City Tech as an assistant in 1988. He also served as a teacher at The Reece School and in the New York City Board of Education from 1989-1994.

Braica and his wife, Christine, live in Brooklyn.

hosted their first conference playoff game since 1997 by earning the #4 seed in the NEC Tournament.

"It was difficult at the beginning of last year," said Head Coach Glenn Braica. "We had nine road games to start the season, Dre went down with an injury and we were very inexperienced. But it's a testament to our team's character, their work ethic, and to their toughness, that they were able to stay together and have a fine year. Opening the season with nine road games can do one of two things: It can either make you better, or it can break you. I'm glad it made our team better, and it's a tribute to our players."

The progress from last season will hopefully carry over into the 2012-2013 campaign as the Terriers will return four starters, a healthy Calloway, and a host of quality reserves. Stefan Perunicic (11.6 ppg., 2.4 rpg.), the school's second-leading 3-point shooter of all-time graduated along with versatile guard Justin Newton, but reigning NEC Coach of the Year Braica will have several options to choose from to replace them.

The return of the crafty Calloway along with sophomore Brent Jones will give St. Francis a pair of talented point-guards to help steer the team through the demanding challenges of a 29-game regular-season schedule. A slate that will include a local clash against St. John's in the new Barclays Center Winter Festival on Saturday, December 15th. The Terriers will also play the annual "Battle of Brooklyn" against LIU-Brooklyn in the Barclays on February 10th. "Brooklyn finally has a great arena to call its own and we anticipate Barclays Center will boost excitement in local college basketball," said Braica. "Our program now has a chance to compete in a world-class arena and host national and local teams just a short walk from our school. Barclays Center will host many memorable moments and thrilling college basketball in the coming years."

Calloway, who was hurt in an early-season practice, was able to

With starting point guard Dre Calloway sidelined by a season-ending shoulder injury in late November, St. Francis Brooklyn got off to a slow start last season, but began turning things around once the new-year arrived. Over the next month, the Terriers began to build momentum and won nine-of-ten games to vault into the upper tier of the Northeast Conference standings. By year's end, St. Francis had won 12 league contests, the most for the program since 2003-04, and finished 15-15 overall. Further, the school

projected after Calloway's injury and that experience should serve him well. At times, the Brooklyn native performed like an upper-classman with his ability to create turnovers (team-high 42 steals), push the ball up the floor and break down the defense. "Brent is very talented and he did a great job progressing last year as a freshman, Braica explained. "He is obviously able to do some things as far as getting his own shot and getting the other guys shots that not many guys can do."

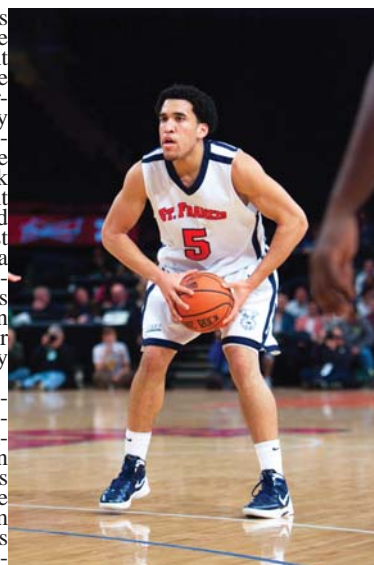
One Terrier who resembled anything but a typical freshman was hulking power forward Jalen Cannon. The tenacious Cannon was named to the NEC's All-Rookie Team after averaging 8.0 points and a team-high 8.8 rebounds per game. He was the second-leading freshman boarder in the country and was 5th in rebounds

per 40 minutes (14.4). The Pennsylvania native recorded eight double-doubles on the season and tied a conference-high with 20 boards at Fairleigh Dickinson. Offensively, he shot a sizzling 60 percent from the floor in league contests. "In addition to being an outstanding player, Jalen is an outstanding person and is a pleasure to coach," said Braica. "He's without question the best rebounder that I have ever coached. He was much more ready than I expected him to be. Jalen can be one of the best players in the league and we look forward to him being a cornerstone of our team for the next three years." Senior Akeem Johnson (11.3 ppg., 5.1 rpg.) continued his steady improvement and has developed into one of the top frontcourt players in the NEC. Although a bit undersized, his quickness and arsenal of post-moves allows him to score in a variety of ways. "Akeem has done a great job for us and he's a terrific kid," Braica said. "He works very hard, he's serious about what he's doing, and is getting payback for all the time he put in over the summer, in the offseason, and throughout the year. We couldn't be happier with him."

Senior Travis Nichols will be another experienced returner who will help up front. In fact, Nichols started 14 contests last season and averaged 9.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 20.0 minutes per game. Nichols is an effective shooter from beyond the arc (41 percent) and uses his strength to score inside as well. "Travis is an excellent offensive player and rebounder," said Braica. He's worked very hard since the end of last season to prepare for his senior year."

The frontcourt depth should be a strong point as well with four players vying for playing time. Junior Matt Milk is a wide-body who has exhibited flashes of terrific play in his first two seasons. "Matt is tough and reliable," Braica stated. "He's also a highly intelligent player and he had a very good off-season." Sophomores Kevin Douglas and Lowell Ulmer are both extremely athletic players who figure to improve and contribute on a consistent basis. Hardworking junior Milos Trivic will also compete for playing time up front. P.J. Santavenere got his feet wet last season and proved to be a valuable role player. The sophomore showed plenty of athleticism on both ends of the floor and has the ability to slash to the hoop as well as knock down a long-range jumper.

Two newcomers who are expected to provide depth in the backcourt are freshman combo guard Anthony White (Mastic, NY) and junior Aleksandar Isailovic (Belgrade, Serbia). The 6'3" White was a three-time All-League, All-Conference, All-Suffolk County and All-Section XI player at William Floyd High School. "Anthony is a physical guard that gives us versatility on the perimeter," Braica said. "He's got a great feel for the game, possesses the ability to create his own shot, and is an exceptional ballhandler and passer." Isailovic played two seasons at Collin Community College in Plano, Texas and will have two seasons of eligibility remaining. The 6'4" Isailovic, who once hit 10 treys in a game at Collin, averaged 10.5 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 0.7 steals per game in his freshman campaign. "Alex is a tremendous outside shooter," Braica explained. "He's got the ability to change the game quickly from three-point range."

The Iona transfer paced the league in treys per game (2.77) and hit 35 percent from downtown. Mockford delivered in some big moments, including a game-winning trifecta at Howard, a 28-point explosion in a win at Sacred Heart and a 22-point outburst in a victory at NJIT. The lightning quick Jones (7.9 ppg., 3.9 apg.) was asked to play more minutes (22.2) than

## ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN MEN'S BASKETBALL HISTORY

ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE BOASTS THE OLDEST BASKETBALL PROGRAM AMONG NEW YORK CITY'S COLLEGES, PUTTING ITS FIRST PLAYERS ON THE COURT IN 1896 ONLY FIVE YEARS AFTER DR. JAMES NAISMITH INVENTED THE GAME. THE COLLEGE'S FIRST RECORDED GAME CAME IN 1901 AGAINST BROWN UNIVERSITY. THE BOYS FROM BROOKLYN FINISHED THE 1901 SEASON WITH A 13-1 MARK.

ST. FRANCIS WAS A MAJOR PLAYER ON THE SPORTS SCENE DURING THE CITY'S COLLEGE BASKETBALL GLORY DAYS OF THE 1940S AND 1950S. THE 1942 SQUAD AVERAGED 59 POINTS PER GAME AND IN 1949 THE TERRIERS BECAME THE FIRST TEAM IN THE NEW YORK CITY AREA TO HAVE ITS GAMES BROADCAST ON TELEVISION. ST. FRANCIS DEFEATED SETON HALL IN THE INAUGURAL TELECAST ON WPIX. IN THE '50S THE TEAM COMPETED IN THE NATIONAL INVITATION TOURNAMENT (NIT) SEVERAL TIMES AND WAS RANKED SECOND IN THE NATION IN 1955, A SEASON IN WHICH THE TERRIERS STRUNG TOGETHER 18 CONSECUTIVE WINS.

IN THE 1953-1954 SEASON, THE TERRIERS ACCUMULATED THE HIGHEST WIN TOTAL IN THE 105-YEAR HISTORY OF ST. FRANCIS BASKETBALL, 23 WINS AND 5 LOSSES. THAT YEAR, THE ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE TERRIERS PARTICIPATED IN THE NIT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY, LOSING TO HOLY CROSS IN THE QUARTERFINALS. IN 2003, THE TERRIERS PARTICIPATED IN THE PRESEASON NIT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY, LOSING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS IN THE FIRST ROUND.

THE 1998-1999 TEAM, HAD THEIR FIRST 20-WIN SEASON IN 43 YEARS. PRIOR TO THE 1998-99 SEASON, THE LAST ST. FRANCIS TEAM TO SURPASS THE 20-WIN MARK WAS THE 1955-1956 TEAM LED BY HEAD COACH DANIEL LYNCH, WITH AN OVERALL RECORD OF 21-4.

OVER THE LAST DECADE, THE TERRIERS HAVE COME CLOSE TO WINNING THEIR FIRST NORTHEAST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP AND EARNING THEIR FIRST INVITATION TO THE NCAA BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT. DURING THAT TIME THE TEAM HAS WON TWO NEC REGULAR SEASON TITLES – INCLUDING A SHARE OF THE CROWN IN 2003-04 – AND HAS MADE FIVE NEC TOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL AND TWO CHAMPIONSHIP GAME APPEARANCES.

THE TERRIERS ARE ONE OF JUST FIVE SCHOOLS THAT HAVE NEVER MADE THE NCAAs DESPITE BEING MEMBERS OF DIVISION I SINCE THE MODERN RE-CLASSIFICATION OF THE DIVISION IN 1948. THE OTHERS ARE WILLIAM & MARY, ARMY, NORTHWESTERN, AND THE CITADEL.
