Terriers Looking To Stop Three-Game Skid: Host Pennsylvania

The St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers women's basketball team will look to get back in the win column as they take on the University of Pennsylvania this evening.

This evening's contest is the second of four meetings with the Ivy League. The Terriers fell to Cornell (74-56) back on November 28th. St. Francis Brooklyn will host Yale University on Saturday, December 8th and conclude their matchup against the Ivy League against Columbia on December 11th.

Scouting University of Pennsylvania

The Quakers enter tonight's contest winners of their last two contests, most recently a thrilling 58-53 overtime victory against Bucknell at the Palestra. All five of Penn's contests have been decided by single digits.

Alyssa Baron is the team's leading scorer and rebounder as the third-year player is averaging 16.2 points per game while pulling down 7.6 rebounds a contest. Baron is logging the most minutes per game for UPENN, averaging 38.4 minutes per contest. Keiera Ray is the team's second leading scorer and rebounder at 12.2 ppg and 5.2 rpg, respectively.

All-Time Against The Quakers

Wednesday marks the eighth all-time meeting between St. Francis Brooklyn and Pennsylvania with the Quakers leading the all-time series, 7-0. This series began back during 1997-98 season. This will be the fourth meeting at the Pope Physical Education Center, with UPENN holding a 4-0 record

ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN TERRIER TIDBITS

LAST TIME OUT

The St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers fell to the Fairfield University Stags, 53-42 on December 1st at Alumni Hall. Sophomore forward Jessica Kaufman was the lone Terrier to finish the game scoring in double figures, as she finished the contest with 12 points on 5-of-11 shooting from the field in 32 minutes of action.

Second-year guard Eilidh Simpson pulled down a career and game-high 11 rebounds in 36 minutes of play. Sophomore Sarah Benedetti and Jaymee Veney finished the game with nine and eight points, respectively.

ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN AMONGST THE NCAA

Through the first five games of the 2012-13 season, St. Francis Brooklyn is among the top-100 schools in several statistical categories.

As of December 2nd, the Terriers rank 13th in Free-Throw Percentage at 79.4 percent. Fellow Northeast Conference member Mount St. Mary's is the overall leader at 82.3 percent.

St. Francis Brooklyn ranks 41st in the country in Field Goal Percentage Defense, holding opponents to 33.9 percent. Iowa State leads the entire NCAA at 28.2 percent.

TERRIER THREE PARTY

St. Francis Brooklyn has recorded at least one made three-pointer in 207 straight contests. The last time the Terriers didn't convert on a three-pointer was back on November 23, 2005 against the Lafayette College Leopards in Easton, Pennsylvania.

SERVING IT UP

St. Francis Brooklyn is averaging 13.6 assists through the first five games of the 2012-13 season. Compared to this point last season, the Terriers are averaging close to three more assist per game, as they averaged 10.8 through this point a season ago.

In the Northeast Conference, the Terriers rank first in the league dishing the ball at a pace of 13.6 dimes a game.

LOW PERCENTAGE SHOTS

This season, St. Francis Brooklyn has held four out of five opponents under 40 percent shooting from the field. The Terriers have only allowed Cornell to shoot 50 percent from the field (26-of-52).

As a team, St. Francis Brooklyn ranks first in the Northeast Conference in Scoring Defense, only allowing opponents to score 296 points (averaging 59.2 ppg) and holding their opposition to just 33.9 percent from the field (97-of-286).

PAYBACK

The St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers are 2-1 against teams they played last season. So far, they have avenged the 2011-12 losses to Army (won 50-47 on Nov. 12) and Delaware State (won 69-50) but were unsuccessful against the Fairfield Stags, on December 1st.

Fairfield defeated the Terriers last season, 53-30, in Brooklyn Heights.

BOXING OUT

Sophomore guard **Eilidh Simpson (Melbourne, Australia/Wesley College)** pulled down a season-high 11 rebounds against Fairfield back on December 1st.

NO KAUFY-BREAK NEEDED

Sophomore forward **Jessica Kaufman (Melbourne, Australia/Presentation College Windsor)** has scored in double-figures in her last four contests.

After just scoring a single point in the season opener at Army, Kaufman is averaging 11.3 points per game and 3.5 rebounds a contest while shooting 60 percent from the field (21-of-35) while logging an average of 22.5 minutes during this span.

QUITE THE FECH

Freshman combo guard/forward **Leah Fechko (Twinsburg, Ohio/Twinsburg)** has given the Terriers a spark off the bench.

Appearing in all five contests, including her first career start at Fairfield, the Twinsburg, Ohio native is averaging 4.0 ppg and 4.0 rebounds per contest while ranking third on the team with 11 assists.

Fechko has grabbed five or more rebounds on two separate occasions and gives head coach John Thurston the flexibility to insert Fechko as a guard or to replace one of their post players.

MAKING THE CASE

Freshman center **Casey Cummings (Leesburg, Virginia/Loudon County)** had her best performance as Terrier against the Cornell University Big Red on November 28th.

Cummings played a career-high 17 minutes in which she went 4-of-7 from the field for eight points. The 6-2 center was able to grab a career-best four rebounds in the contest.

BENEDET-THREE

Sophomore guard **Sarah Benedetti (Canton, Connecticut/Canton)** has continued to give St. Francis Brooklyn a threat from the outside. In the Northeast Conference, Benedetti ranks second in Three-Point Field Goals made and 10th in Three-Point Field Goal Percentage.

Amongst those in the NCAA, Benedetti, is in the top-150 in Three-Point Field Goal Percentage, converting on 35.3 percent from the outside. The Canton, CT native ranks 75th in the NCAA in Made Three-Pointers Per Game as she is converting 2.4 per contest.

ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN TERRIER TIDBITS

ANYTHING FREE, IS ALWAYS A GOOD THING

Through five games this season, the St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers has converted 54-of-68 from the line (79.4 percent), which is good for second in the Northeast Conference behind Mount St. Mary's (51-of-62 | 82.3 percent).

Three Terriers are perfect from the charity stripe thus far this season. **Jaymee Veney (12-of-12); Sarah Benedetti (8-of-8); and Leah Fechko (6-of-6).**

FROM DOWNTOWN (BROOKLYN)

St. Francis Brooklyn once again is amongst the top shooting three-point teams in the Northeast Conference through the first four games of the season.

The Terriers have connected on 28-of-82 from beyond the arc, for 34.1 percent, which currently ranks second in the Northeast Conference. St. Francis Brooklyn is averaging 5.6 made three-pointers a contest, which is good for second in the Northeast Conference.

ENDING THE OPENING DAY/NIGHT JITTERS

On Monday, November 12th, the St. Francis (Brooklyn) Terriers women's basketball team secured its first opening night win, as they defeated the Army Black Knights, 59-47.

The victory was the first win on opening night in nearly five years, November 11, 2007 to be exact, as the Terriers defeated the New Jersey Institute of Technology, 58-54, at the Pope Physical Education Center.

Prior to the Army contest, the last time the Terriers won an opening night game on the road came back on November 20th, 2004, in which they defeated the Iona College Gaels, 70-64, in New Rochelle, New York.

MAKE A GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION

St. Francis (Brooklyn) won its 2012-13 season opener on Nov. 12 at Army thanks in large part to an impressive debut by one of their three freshmen.

First-year guard/forward Leah Fechko (Twinsburg, Ohio/ Twinsburg) entered the game at the 15:51 mark of the first half and recorded her first career points on a layup opportunity at the 13:18 mark of the second half, which gave the Terriers a 39-33 lead.

ST. FRANCIS BROOKLYN TERRIER TIDBITS

A WHOLE NEW WORLD IN BROOKLYN HEIGHTS

The St. Francis College women's basketball team enters the 2012-13 season with a new leader, a reorganized staff, three new players and a foundation established after last year's largest recruiting class in program history.

As Head Coach John Thurston gets set to embark on his first season as head coach, he joins a small fraternity of women's head coaches who were formerly head coaches in Division I men's programs having served at James Madison from 1985-88. Early in the summer, Thurston added Nettie Respondek as an assistant coach to the staff, joining holdovers Dionne Dodson and Kaitlyn Vican. Dodson was promoted to first assistant by Thurston as she enters her fifth season in Brooklyn Heights while Vican embarks on her second year at St. Francis College.

As for the team, the Terriers return all five starters from last year's squad. Sophomore forward Jaymee Veney, who was named to the Northeast Conference All-Rookie Team last season, led the team in scoring (8.9 points per game) and rebounding (5.7 per contest). Veney was the Terriers' most consistent shooter, finished the year at 49.5 percent, which was second in the NEC and holds the 7th highest field goal percentage in single season among all St. Francis College women's basketball players.

Fellow classmate Jessica Kaufman had an injury plagued debut season on Remsen Street. When healthy, the Melbourne, Australia native was the team's second leading scorer (8.4 points per game), despite missing a total of 13 games. Sophomore Sarah Benedetti will be looked up to be the Terriers primary long-range threat. The native of Canton, Connecticut tied the St. Francis College women's basketball program record with seven made three-pointers against Robert Morris in Moon Township. On the year, Benedetti finished sixth in the NEC in three-point field goals made (51).

FAIRFIELD, CONNECTICUT---The St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers fell to 2-3 on the season after dropping an 52-43 decision against the Fairfield University Stags on Saturday afternoon.

Sophomore forward Jessica Kaufman was the lone Terrier to finish the game scoring in double figures, as she finished the contest with 12 points on 5-of-11 shooting from the field in 32 minutes of action. Second-year guard Eilidh Simpson pulled down a career and game-high 11 rebounds in 36 minutes of play. Sophomore Sarah Benedetti and Jaymee Veney finished the game with nine and eight points, respectively.

Two Stags finished the game in double-figures, led by Katelyn Linney, who posted 14 points on 5-of-15 shooting from the field, including 4-of-13 from beyond the arc while playing the entire forty minutes. Alexys Vazquez contributed eleven points on 3-of-8 shooting in 33 minutes of play.

Both teams struggled to find their touch early in the contest. After Veney converted on a layup attempt at the 17:37 mark, the two teams didn't record a made field goal until the 12:38 mark where Vazquez of Fairfield was able to drain a long-range three to put the Stags up 5-2. That three-pointer ignited a Fairfield run as the home team was able to extend their lead to nine, 11-2.

St. Francis Brooklyn responded with a 14-0 run over the next seven minutes and seventeen seconds to take a 16-11 lead. Benedetti was able to connect on three-point to give the Terriers their first lead of the afternoon at the 6:08 mark. Veney's layup off a miss three-pointer extended the Terriers' lead to five, 16-11; with 3:48 to go before the break. It was largest lead St. Francis Brooklyn held on the afternoon.

Both teams traded buckets in the opening seconds of the second half before Fairfield was able to tie the ballgame at 26 apiece after Felicia Da-Cruz converted on a layup attempt. The Stags were able to score seven of the next 13 points to take a 33-30 lead at the 14:02 mark.

St. Francis pulled to within one after Simpson was able to hit the running jumper in the paint after receiving the feed from Robinson. The Terriers were able to regain the lead at the 12:34 mark after newcomer Leah Fechko was able to hit both her free-throw chances.

Fairfield responded after Katie Cizynski was able to draw the foul and make the layup, which put the home team up five with twelve minute remaining in regulation. Both teams stumbled into a four-minute scoring drought before Linney was able to make a three-pointer jump off the dish from Vazquez to put Fairfield up five, 39-34 with 8:17 remaining.

Down the stretch, the Terriers were able to trim the Fairfield lead to five, 45-40 after Kaufman converted on two more points. Kaufman had a chance to cut the deficit to one possession but missed on a 12 foot jumper in which the Stags were able to corral. The Terriers couldn't box out on a missed layup by Brittany MacFarlane as the Stags maintained possession and held on for the nine point lead.

St. Francis Brooklyn was able to out-rebound Fairfield by a 38-35 margin. The Stags were able to contain the long-range threat of the Terriers, holding St. Francis Brooklyn to just 18.8 percent from beyond the arc (3-of-16), while Fairfield shot 25.0 percent from beyond the arc (7-of-28).

John Thurston enters his first season as head coach of the St. Francis College women's basketball program. Overall, Thurston embarks on his 40th season on the sidelines.

Thurston takes over for Brenda Milano, who announced her resignation after nine years on the sidelines. Coach Thurston finished his second-season with program, serving as the Associate Head Coach last year, as he brings a wealth of experience to the program.

Thurston is one of only a few coaches who have been a Head Coach at the NCAA DI, DII, DIII and NAIA levels in 26 years of coaching men's college basketball from 1971-1997. During the early 1970's, Thurston's Fairleigh Dickinson-Florham teams were known for their high scoring offense, averaging almost 100 points per game.

During the following ten years as an assistant and three as Head Coach at James Madison University, the Dukes went to four NCAA tournaments and one NIT. For his tremendous efforts in the 1986-87 season, Thurston was named the Colonial Athletic Association "Coach of the Year."

In nine years at Wingate University, he served the dual role of Athletic Director and Head Basketball Coach and is credited with moving the athletic department from NAIA status to nationally competitive NCAA DII affiliation.

From 2001-2003 Thurston held the position of General Manager at Atlanta's Suwanee Sports Academy establishing widely respected basketball training programs and bringing national events such as the adidas Showtime Championships and adidas Top Ten All-Star game to the Atlanta area. While planning the Suwanee Sports Academy venture Thurston took over the girls program at Marist HS in Atlanta in 1999.

During his three years at the helm the War Eagles broke school records for wins each year advancing to the State Tournament each year with a pair of Elite Eight appearances. His teams were ranked in the Top Ten in GA all three years and six of his players went on to play college basketball, five at the Division I level.

Thurston returned to collegiate coaching in the fall of 2003 to serve as Ann Hancock's top assistant at UNC-Wilmington and has been involved with the women's game for eight years on both the major and small college levels.

In 2005, Thurston moved to Northwood University in West Palm Beach, FL to develop the school's first ever women's basketball program. In their first two seasons of competition, he led the Seahawks to two Florida Sun Conference

titles, and their first appearance at the NAIA National Tournament in 2008 in Sioux City, Iowa. He was named FSC Coach of the Year in 2008, and under his guidance, Katie Vican (2007, current assistant coach of the Terriers) and Kara Otterbine (2008) were named FSC Player of the Year.

Thurston has gained respect through the years as an evaluator and developer of talent, ranging from two NBA players, six overall NBA draft choices, seven European professionals, four "Rookies of the Year", three "Players of the Year", one "Defensive Player of the Year", eighteen All-Conference selections, three 2000 pt. scorers and thirteen 1000 pt scorers. Twelve of his former players have already been elected to their school's Hall of Fame.

A 1966 graduate of Archbishop Molloy High School he was an All-City performer in both baseball and basketball under legendary Coach Jack Curran and was a 1966 draft choice of the Los Angeles Dodgers. He continued his education at Seton Hall University graduating with a degree in Government. He played both baseball and basketball for the Pirates and was awarded the John F Kennedy Award in 1970 as the school's outstanding student-athlete.

He and his wife, Candice, have been married for 40 years and have two daughters, Clancy and Corey and four grandchildren, Jack, Rhone, Luke, and Elsa.
