TERRIERS AT A GLANCE

- **Amy O'Neill** - The Terriers return their starting point guard who is heading into her senior season. O'Neill averaged 6.8 points, 5.0 assists, 4.4 rebounds, and 2.0 steals per game as a junior. Last season, she was tied for first in the league in assist to turnover ratio (1.5), ranked second in assists, and was tied for fourth in steals.
- **Maria Palarino** - Started 29 games and logged 29.0 minutes per game. She averaged 9.3 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 2.1 assists per game as a junior. She was named the NEC Player of the Week on December 19, following a huge game against Iona where she scored 22 points.
- **Jade Johnson** - The guard was named to the All-NEC Second Team after ranking fifth in the conference in points per game (14.7) last season. She led the league three-point field goal percentage (42.1%) and was fifth in free-throw percentage (77.2%). She scored a career-high 28 points in a win over Saint Peter's.
- **Dominique Ward** - Ward comes to St. Francis Brooklyn after she spent three years as a member of the Rhode Island women's basketball team from 2014-17. Over the course of her career at Rhode Island, Ward averaged 6.6 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.6 assists, and 1.5 steals per game.
- **Mia Ehling** - Made 23 appearances off the bench for the Terriers in 2017-18 and averaged 13.6 minutes per contest. She finished the season averaging 4.0 points, 1.4 rebounds, and 1.3 assists per game.
- **Abby Anderson** - Made 30 appearances off the bench for the Terriers as a freshman and played 15.1 minutes per game. She averaged 4.7 points on 39.1 percent shooting from the field and 2.5 rebounds per game as a freshman.
- **Ebony Horton** - Joins the Terriers from Charnwood College in Loughborough, England. Horton was named the 2017-18 WEABL Defensive Player of the Year. As a senior, Horton averaged 15.0 points and 6.8 rebounds per game en route to being named a WEABL All-Conference Player.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS

The Terriers' regular season will commence at the Brooklyn-based Pope Physical Education Center on November 6, hosting Mercy College at 7 p.m., followed by a rematch with the Manhattan Jaspers on November 10 at 2 p.m. It will be the first time the Terriers begin their season at home since the 2010-11 season, which was also against Manhattan.

The team's first road trip will land them at Morehead State, whom the Terriers faced last December, to participate in the three-day Morehead State Classic from November 16-18, and subsequently remaining on the road for three-straight games afterward, beginning at Seton Hall on November 25.

The Terriers will host three consecutive home games between December 10-19, starting with Saint Peter's followed by Albany and Princeton, whom the Terriers haven't faced since 2007.

The Terriers will then end their non-conference run at Stony Brook on December 30, which will carry them into Northeast Conference play at the turn of the calendar.

NEC LEAGUE PLAY

The Terriers are set to play a 10-week, 18-game round-robin schedule, beginning Saturday, January 5, and ending on Thursday, March 7. The Terriers tip-off their conference slate on Saturday, January 5, as they'll host Wagner, followed by their first road league contest at Bryant on Monday, January 7.

Following a back-to-back home weekend against the Pennsylvania-based Robert Morris and Saint Francis (PA), the Terriers will remain in Brooklyn Heights to host their fourth of five matchups, facing Sacred Heart on Saturday, January 19.

The annual Battle of Brooklyn takes place on Monday, January 21, at LIU Brooklyn's Steinberg Wellness Center. The Terriers have emerged victorious in five of the last six Battle's of Brooklyn and have won 10-of-13 against the Blackbirds, dating back to the 2012-13 season.

The Battle of Brooklyn marks a four-game road swing for the Terriers, which ends on Saturday, February 2, at Sacred Heart, two weeks before LIU Brooklyn comes to Remsen Street, where the Terriers will play the first of two consecutive home games.

NEC play will carry the Terriers into early March, where they'll end their regular season at Central Connecticut State on Thursday, March 7, three days after their last regular season home matchup on Monday, March 4 against Mount St. Mary's.



Linda Cimino was named the 13th head women's basketball coach in St. Francis Brooklyn women's basketball history by Director of Athletics Irma Garcia on May 21, 2018.

A familiar face to the Tri-State Area, Linda Cimino brings passion, pride and commitment with her as she enters the gold doors on Remsen Street.

Cimino's positive energy and relentless work ethic changed the culture at Binghamton University (America East) over the past four years, both on and off the court. Known for her passion and enthusiasm, Cimino considers player development, strong recruiting and building relationships key ingredients in constructing a winner. Her leadership style reignited a sense of energy and pride at Binghamton.

In the last three seasons, the Bearcats have averaged 15+ wins and have played at or above .500 in conference play each year. This past season, the Bearcats received a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), marking the first time that program reached a national postseason tournament since Binghamton moved up to NCAA Division I prior to the 2001-02 season. Playing in its first-ever Division I national postseason game, Binghamton won 70-59 at Youngstown State in the opening round of the WBI. It was a historic win for the Bearcats in more ways than one. Binghamton finished with 20 wins for the first time since the 2000-01 season, the year before it moved up to the NCAA Division I level. Binghamton also boasted the America East Player of the Year Imani Watkins, who set the schools all-time scoring record. Watkins was also named to the All-America East First Team and finished up her career with 2,125 points. Alyssa James was an anchor for Cimino on the defensive end of the floor. James joined the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound club in 2017-18 and set the America East and Binghamton blocks record for a career with 270. James also became just the second three-time America East Defensive Player of the Year in conference history.

In 2017-18, Binghamton was included among the top 50 teams in the nation in several categories. As a team, Binghamton was ranked ninth in the nation with 5.9 blocks per game. It was also 24th in field goal percentage defense (.362), 34th in scoring defense (57.4 ppg.), and 47th in steals (9.9 spg.).

Peers have taken notice of Cimino as she was named the 2016 America East Coach of the Year. Binghamton was picked to finish last in the America East Conference in 2015-16, but under Cimino's guidance, it finished in a three-way tie for third place. The Bearcats won their most games (14) and most conference games (eight) since the 2010-11 season, putting Binghamton amongst the most improved teams in the NCAA. At the America East Tournament, Binghamton advanced to the conference semifinals for the first time since 2011.

COACHING STAFF



As a coach who focuses on player development, Cimino takes great pride in working with her players to reach their full potential. Most notably, Kim Albrecht had two breakout seasons under Cimino's guidance, capping her career as a NCAA statistical champion in which she led the country in free throw percentage (91.4). This was the first statistical champion in Binghamton basketball history.

Her first year with the Bearcats saw a program best two players named to the America East All-Rookie Team, including the America East Rookie of the Year.

The team's ability to shoot the ball significantly improved under her guidance as the team finished first in the America East in free-throw percentage (.720) after finishing last the season prior to her arrival. The team also finished third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage after finishing sixth the previous season.

Cimino arrived at Binghamton after a successful eight-year run as the head coach at Caldwell University. Her strong ability to connect with and motivate her players played a significant role in her rebuilding the Cougars' program. She is the program's all-time leader in wins with a 128-100 (.561) overall record. This includes a 90-52 (.633) mark in her final five years at the helm, averaging 18 wins a season after Caldwell went 39-71 in the four years prior to her tenure. In only her second year with Caldwell, her team was recognized as one of the most improved teams in the country.

In 2010-11, Cimino led the Cougars to their most successful season in the program's history. She guided the program to the most wins in their history (21), broke the mark for win percentage (.778), made the program's first appearance in the national rankings and won the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference (CACC) Regular Season Championship.

In addition to the 2010-11 championship, Caldwell shared the CACC title in 2012-13 while also going 15-4 in conference play and rattling off a school record 15 consecutive wins. In both 2012-13 and 2013-14, Caldwell advanced to the CACC Tournament championship game. Furthermore, Caldwell earned a bid to the ECAC Division II Tournament twice during her career.

Cimino was able to attract high caliber student-athletes to Caldwell that paid off for both her team and the student-athletes. She recruited and coached three CACC and two ECAC Rookie of the Year players, as well as two CACC Players of the Year and two Division II All-Americans.

Under Cimino's watch, Caldwell was just as successful in the classroom. Thirteen different players were selected to the CACC's All-Academic Team, and during the 2013-14 season, the overall team GPA was a 3.4.

Away from the court, Cimino has had an equally impactful career as an athletics administrator. In addition to her success as Caldwell's head coach, Cimino was the Associate Director of Athletics and Senior Woman Administrator all eight years. She oversaw facilities, game-day operations and scheduling for all Caldwell programs, in addition to serving as the sport administrator for all of the women's teams. Cimino was also heavily involved in Caldwell's Cougar Pride Booster Club, oversaw the Student Athlete Advisory Club (SAAC) and coordinated the athletic department's community outreach program. In 2011, she was selected to participate in the NCAA's Women and Minorities Mentor Program.

Among her committee work, she was recently appointed the Chair of the NCAA Women's Basketball Rules Committee. She has served on the NCAA Women's Basketball Regional Advisory Committee (East Region), in which she was also a NCAA site representative for two regional tournaments. She also served on the NCAA Division II USA Today Coaches Poll Committee and WBCA National Coach of the Year Award Committee. At Binghamton, Cimino was selected to take part in the pilot WBCA Mentoring Program.

Prior to arriving at Caldwell, Cimino was a health education teacher in the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District for five years. During that span she was as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Adelphi University after previously serving as the head girls' varsity basketball coach at Calhoun High School for three seasons. She began her college coaching career at the age of 22 as the head coach at Queensborough Community College, where she led the team to the CUNY championship game in 2002.

A member of Adelphi's basketball program from 1997-00. She graduated from Adelphi in 2001 with a Bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education and her Master's degree in Health Education from Adelphi in 2004. A native of Lincoln, RI, Cimino was All-State in both basketball and softball at North Smithfield High School.

Chenel Harris-Smith joined the Terrier women's basketball staff as the associate head coach in June, 2018. Harris, brings six years of coaching experience from Robert Morris, Stony Brook University, University of Arkansas, and most recently Binghamton University.

Prior to her arrival in Brooklyn, Harris-Smith served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Binghamton University where she coached alongside head coach, Linda Cimino. Together, they helped lead the Bearcats to their most successful season in it's NCAA Division I history. The Bearcats tallied a program high 20 wins and saw it's first ever post-season berth, appearing in the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). Binghamton advanced to the second round, defeating Youngstown St. in the opening round.

At Binghamton, Harris-Smith was responsible for recruiting and served as the guard position coach. She oversaw the skill development of 2017-2018 America East Player of the Year, Imani Watkins and All Conference Selection, Kai Moon.

During the 2016-2017 season, Harris-Smith served as an assistant in the SEC under Jimmy Dykes at the University of Arkansas. There, she was responsible for recruiting as well as implementing the guard and post skill development. She also assisted in day to day responsibilities.

Harris-Smith spent two seasons as the top assistant and recruiting coordinator at Stony Brook University. She was instrumental in the recruitment of the 2015 Rookie of the Year, Ogechi Anyagaligbo as well as an All-Rookie selection, Davion Wingate. At Stony Brook, Harris-Smith also served as the post position coach, developing three All-Conference selections.

Familiar to the Northeast Conference, Harris-Smith spent two seasons as an assistant at Robert Morris University, where she helped lead the Colonials to their first NCAA Tournament bid in seven years in 2013-2014. She was responsible for the recruitment of three All-Rookie selections. Harris-Smith also oversaw community service, academics, and post development.

Heavily involved in the community, Harris-Smith established several service initiatives, including Step It Up, an anti-bullying program implemented to promote the importance of acceptance in elementary schools nationwide. She also started Hoops for Hope to raise money for breast cancer research through the Glimmer of Hope Foundation.

As an undergraduate, Harris started 88 of 120 games for Kent State during her four-year career. She tallied 901 points and 573 rebounds as a standout forward for the Golden Flashes, earning All Mid-American Conference honorable mention and All-Rookie honors.

At the completion of her undergraduate playing career, Harris-Smith interned at the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). There, she organized The So You Want to Be a Coach Program, which is held in conjunction with the National WBCA Convention.

Professionally, Harris-Smith played for the Trinidad and Tobago National Team in 2011. She averaged 12.6 points and 5 rebounds per a game. She also ranked among the top three-point field goal and free throw percentage in the Caribbean Basketball Confederation (CBC) Championship for women.

Harris-Smith received her bachelor's degree in Business Management in 2010 from Kent State University and is currently pursuing her master's degree in Athletic Leadership from Rider University.

Sean Smith joined the Terrier women's basketball program in June, 2018. Smith brings over 11 years of coaching experience and a wealth of knowledge having worked at the NCAA Division I and grassroots level.

Prior to his arrival in Brooklyn, Smith spent three seasons as assistant women's basketball coach at Rider University. There, he served as the guard position coach. He also assisted with the day to day responsibilities.

During the 2017-2018 season, four Broncos earned weekly awards from either the MAAC or College Sports Madness. At the conclusion of the regular season, three Rider players garnered All-MAAC recognition. Stella Johnson and Kamila Hoskova were named Second Team All-MAAC and freshman Jaiden Morris landed on the MAAC All-Rookie Team.

Smith oversaw the skill development for Johnson, Hoskova, and Morris. Johnson led the team in scoring, averaging 16 ppg and ranked in the top ten among all MAAC players in every statistical category. Hoskova became the 22nd player in program history to score 1,000 career points. She ended her stellar tenure with the Broncos eighth all-time in scoring with 1,255 points.

The team had a record-breaking season in 2016-17, finishing 24-9 and earning the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) automatic bid to the WNIT thanks to a second-place finish during the regular season. The post-season berth was the first for the Broncos at the Division I level. Smith helped guide the Broncos to arguably the most successful season in program history. The 2016-17 season saw the Broncos rack up 24 wins and earn the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll, Rider posted an 8-2 mark both on the road and at home in conference play. The team swept eight MAAC opponents during the regular season and was ranked for four weeks in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. Smith was instrumental in the skill development of Rider's first ever MAAC Player of the Year, Robin Perkins and All-Rookie Selection, Stella Johnson.

The 24 wins are the most victories by the Broncos under Head Coach Lynn Milligan and the most for the program since the team won 26 games during the 1981-82 season. The 24 wins against Division I opponents is the most in a single season in program history as well. The 16 MAAC wins are also the most under Milligan in a season and in program history. The team finished above .500 in conference play for the third time since entering the league and the No. 2 seed is the best for Rider since joining the MAAC as well.

Smith came to Lawrenceville from the University of Maine, where he spent two seasons as assistant coach, under current Maine men's basketball head coach, Richard Barron.

In his last season at Maine, the Black Bears went 23-9, 14-2 in the America East, advancing to the WNIT after reaching the AE semifinals. Maine won 17 games in 2013-14 and advanced to the second round of the Women's Basketball Invitational.

Prior to joining the Black Bears, Smith was the lead skills trainer with Peach State Basketball since 2009. While with Peach State Basketball, Smith coordinated all individual skill developments during EBA camps and showcases. From Mount Holly in South Jersey, Smith served as an individual trainer to over 100 athletes nationwide through Peach State and later expanded his roll by starting his own skill development company "ATG Hoops" in the New Jersey area where he trained players up and down the eastern seaboard. Smith's company hosted four showcase events annually including the ATG showcase which drew players from seven states.

Smith served as a counselor for numerous basketball camps and clinics including Cannon Baker's Nike Elite camp at Georgia Southern University as well as the Princeton University camp for Barron and John Thompson III. Smith was an assistant under Clint Bryant at Augusta State University. While at Augusta State, he assisted the recruiting coordinator in all aspects of recruitment. As a freshman at ASU in 2000-01, Smith helped the team advance to the NCAA tournament after being crowned conference tournament champions for the first time in school history.

Smith also served as assistant camp director for the Clint Bryant basketball camp while at Augusta State. One of Smith's early coaching jobs was head junior varsity boys and assistant Varsity boys coach at Rancocas Valley Regional High School. Smith built a JV program that compiled a record of 35-5 over two seasons, including a perfect 19-0 run in 2012-13. At RV, Smith helped guide the varsity program to a 24-2 regular season mark and the school's first conference title in five years.

Smith graduated from Rutgers University in 2005 with a bachelor's degree in psychology and earned a master's degree in Athletic Leadership from Rider University in 2018.






