TERRIERS AT A GLANCE:

Nevena Dimitrijevic- Guard- Freshman

- Named Northeast Conference's Player and Rookie of the Week, along with Prime Performer on 11/25. The first Terrier ever to do so.
- One of three Terriers to achieve three or more conference Rookie's of the Week. (Tiffany Hill in 2004-05 with 4) (Leah Fechko in 2012-13 with 3) (Kim Weir in 2001-02 with 3)

Alyssa Fisher- Guard- Freshman

- Averaged 20.9 Points-Per-Game, 4.9 Assists-Per-Game, and 4.3 Steals Per Game...Achieved 1st Team All-District.
- Named USA Today All-USA Louisiana Girls Basketball 2nd Team.

Jade Johnson- Guard - Senior- Captain

- Became the 18th player to score 1,000 points in program history last season. Named to 2019-20 NEC All-Preseason Team.
- Finished 2018-19 campaign among the top in select NCAA rankings that included free-throw percentage (6th), three-point field-goal percentage (15th).

Ally Lassen - Forward - Junior - Captain

- Finished #1 on NEC field-goal percentage chart at 56.9 in '18-19.
- Named NEC Prime Performer twice during the 2018-19 campaign. Started in final 11 games of her sophomore season.
- Currently sits top five in the program's history book for field-goal percentage

Abby Anderson- forward - Junior - Captain

- Averaged 10.2 minutes per game. Finished the season with 3.4 points per game, 2.4 rebounds per game, and 0.6 assists per game. Registered points in 23 of her 31 appearances. Tied a career high in points with 10, twice against Chicago State and Loyola (MD).

Jenna Jordan - Forward - Freshman

- Scored 1,100 points and grabbed 1,300 rebounds...Earned spot on First-Team All-County three-times. Was named Second-Team All-State.
- One of two Terriers with a double-double this season (Dimitrijevic)
- Former commit of LIU Brooklyn in 2018-19.

Cayln Richardson - Guard - Freshman

- Combined 1,548 points between private school, and high school.
- Nominated for McDonald's All-American Game
- Lettered in Track and Field during freshman year in high school.

BROADCASTER TIPS

- The Terriers will be facing the Mountaineers of Mount St. Mary's (MD) for the first time since the 6-seeded Mount took down the 3-seeded Terriers in the 2018-19 NEC Tournament Quarterfinal.
- St. Francis College currently holds an 8-53 overall record against Mount St. Mary's.
- Freshman guard Nevena Dimitrijevic is the first Terrier to achieve four Rookie of the Week awards by the NEC in a single season since Tiffany Hill in 2004-05, and the first in the conference since Mount St. Mary's Michaela Harrison (4) last season.
- Last season, now senior guard Jade Johnson earned 14 conference prime performer awards, which was the most seen by a Terrier in program history.
- Dimitrijevic is the lone freshman in all the nation (Division I) ranked Top 10 in assists, with 103. The nearest freshman is Colorado's Jaylyn Sherrod (Ranked 12th with 97)



SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION:

- Mount is off to a 4-1 start in NEC play for the first time since the 2014-15 season. The current Mountaineers will look to avoid the fate of that squad, who proceeded to lose 11 of their final 13 games. A 5-1 start would mean Mount's best NEC start since 1999-2000 when they won their first seven games.
- Junior Kendall Bresee leads in rebounding (7.2 RPG) and assists (3.6 APG). Harrison leads with two steals per game and Rebecca Lee leads with 1.4 blocks per game.
- The Mountaineers are 8-0 when scoring more than 40 percent from the field, and 4-0 when they outrebound their competitors. In four contests the team shot over 50 percent, including the season-high 55 percent vs. Frostburg.
- Mount St. Mary's owns a 53-8 alltime advantage over St. Francis Brooklyn, including a 27-3 mark at Knott Arena. The Mount's record against St. Francis Brooklyn is the team's best against any NEC opponent. Mount won two of three last season, including an upset in the NEC quarterfinals in Brooklyn.
- The Mountaineers returns 11 players from last year's roster, including four starters in Jatarrikah Settle, Michaela Harrison, Bridget Birkhead and Rebecca Lee.
- Rebecca Lee recently joined the Mount's all-time top-10 list for most blocks in a season. The junior center had 29 blocks on the year, which tied for seventh-most in a season by a Mountaineer.

RECORD BOOK AT A GLANCE

- Senior guard Jade Johnson tied Pam Curcio (1,394) on the program's all-time scoring list to co-occupy 6th place, against Robert Morris. The Australian tallied nine points against the Colonials.
- Next stop on the scoring list for Johnson is Christine Cunningham (1,496) who holds sole possession of 4th place, where the Aussie is 102 points away from tying.
- Jade Johnson is 47 three-point field goals away from surpassing Sarah Benedetti for the all-time program's triples made record.
- The aforementioned Johnson is 39 triple attempts away from tying Tiffany Hill for second all-time on the program's attempt list.
- Jade Johnson is three free-throws away from surpassing Jasmine Robinson (245) for 9th all-time on the completed free-throws listing. Five away from passing Caitlyn O'Malley (247) for 8th all-time.
- Jade Johnson is 13 field-goal attempts away from tying Elaine Hunt (1,131) for 8th place on the all-time field goal attempts in program history listing.

LOOK AHEAD TO 2020-21

St. Francis College Brooklyn women's basketball Head Coach Linda Cimino has announced the signings of Emma Trawally Porta and Zharia Hutchinson. The pair become the first two women's basketball student-athletes to sign their respective National Letters of Intent (NLI) for the 2020-21 season. "We are really excited for Z (Zharia Hutchinson) to join our program next year. She is a versatile forward, who plays with a lot of energy and is relentless on the glass. She is a great addition to our up tempo style of play, and she has an extremely high motor. She is capable of making an impact in the game at multiple areas." Commented Cimino. Hutchinson is a 5-foot-10 forward from Montgomery, AL. The Gulf coast native attended Franklin Road Academy, and was a part of the Girls' Varsity team throughout her entire high school career. During the 2018 campaign, her team would claim the Regional Championship, and earn a second-place finish in the State Championship. This past summer, the Montgomery native played AAU basketball for Team Brandon-Wright Hutchinson has garnered several personal accolades which include a pair of selections on the All-District Team as well as an All-Region MVP honor. Hutchinson was also recognized by her school for joining the 1,000-point club. During the Carpet Capital Christmas Classic, she was named to the All-Tournament Team. Finally, Hutchinson was also named a finalist for the WillGo Girls Basketball Player of the Year. Trawally Porta is a 6-foot-2 forward from Barcelona, Spain. The Spaniard attended Escola Lola Anglada before transferring to Institut Thalassa. Trawally Porta played club basketball on Femení Maresme U18, where she tallied 12 points per game and helped lead her team to an 18-8 record. "We are really excited to have Emma join our program. She is a strong post player, who will make an immediate impact for us. She is a competitor, and a dominant force on the glass. Her size will allow her to thrive in this conference." Said Cimino. While at Institut Thalassa, the Barcelona native was a part of second and fourth-place teams in the Catalonia Championships during multiple seasons. While playing five years at the Spanish high school level, Trawally Porta helped her team finish fifth in the Spanish Championships.

SHE'LL TAKE A DOUBLE-DOUBLE PLEASE!

Freshman forward Jenna Jordan and guard Nevena Dimitrijevic are a pair of 21 players in the Northeast Conference to have recorded a double-double this season. Saint Francis University has Haley Thomas as their lone student-athlete with a double-double this season (15 pts, 12 rebounds @ FGCU on 11/22/19)

DIAL LONG DISTANCE

Senior guard and captain Jade Johnson returns as the Terriers all-time leading three-point getter in a single season, as she obtained an even 100 during her junior season. Johnson also has been "working on taking the ball off the bounce more, and improve her leadership where she has done an amazing job with that." Aside from the new improvements from the Australian native, she is primed to be in the top five in almost every category from a season ago, where she placed in. Johnson is on pace to land in the top-10 in three-pointers attempted, three-point field goal percentage, and free-throw percentage in the program's history book. And of course, on the NCAA's listings throughout the season.

NOT YOUR NORMAL CONFERENCE SEASON

The Terriers are now one of 11 teams within the Northeast Conference. Last season, the NEC welcomed former NE10 Division II, Merrimack Warriors to the family. Here are the changes St. Francis College Brooklyn will see this season:

- Now with an Odd number of teams in the conference, the schedule will feature each team playing one specific team on the road and at home, while the specific team will play eight teams twice (1 home, 1 away).
- Longest road trip is four games beginning on January 11 at Saint Francis (PA), continuing on January 13 at Robert Morris. The following weekend in Staten Island at Wagner on January 18, and concluding on Monday, January 20 at Mount St. Mary's (MD).
- Longest homestand is three that begins on January 25, against Robert Morris and concludes on February 1 against Sacred Heart.
- Head Coach Linda Cimino earned 12 conference victories last season, which was a Terrier program record.
- Plays vs. Fairleigh Dickinson (1/2) and @ Central Connecticut (3/5) one time each.

NCAA RECOGNIZING THE TERRIERS (AS OF 1/19)

Freshman guard Nevena Dimitrijevic currently has 103 assists, where she sits in seventh place. The Serbian guard is ranked fifth in the nation in the assists-per-game category with 6.4 APG. Senior guard Jade Johnson ranks 12th in the nation averaging 38.01 minutes on the hardwood this season. Junior forward Ally Lassen ranks 29th in free-throw's made with 78. She sits tied with Central Michigan's Micaela Kelly.

TERRIER NOTES

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Terriers are averaging 74.6 points-per-game inside the Daniel Lynch Gymnasium in six games played this season. St. Francis Brooklyn is 4-2 during the span. Freshman guard Nevena Dimitrijevic leads all student-athletes on her home-court by registering an average of 21 points-per-game. The entire team also holds their opponents to below 30 percent from beyond-the-arc. The scoring margin is also +4.2, compared to a -18.0 scoring margin outside of Brooklyn Heights.

INDIVIDUAL NEC LEADERS (AS OF 1/19)

The Terriers have three players ranked in the top 20 of the conference in scoring (Johnson, Dimitrijevic, Lassen). Johnson sits second on the points per game chart with 16.7. Freshman guard Nevena Dimitrijevic sits in fourth averaging 14.4 PPG. Junior Ally Lassen sits tied for fifth, averaging 14.4 PPG with Robert Morris' Nneka Ezeigbo. Dimitrijevic sits atop the assists leaderboard with 103 total through 16 games, and averages 6.4 APG. The Serbian native also sits tied for second on the steals chart as she's averaging 2.06 SPG and totals 33 in 16 games. She is tied with Robert Morris' Isabella Posset. Dimitrijevic ranks second in the conference in assist/turnover ratio with 2.15 per-game. Jade Johnson ranks atop the conference leaderboard in three-pointers made averaging 2.67 per game.

JEN LEEDHAM NAMED U16 COACH!

St. Francis College Brooklyn women's basketball Associate Head Coach Jennifer Leedham was named the Head Coach of Great Britain's U16 Girls' 2020 FIBA European Championship team. "I am honored to be selected. I believe I have a major opportunity to grow and help influence the future of British Basketball. I am proud and excited to work with such a phenomenal group of young girls. My hope is that we can grow as a unit over these next couple of years and truly embody the passion that the senior women's team have shown over the last three years," commented Leedham. Leedham is the lone female head coach to represent Great Britain throughout all age groups in the European Championships. "Jen is a shining example and a brilliant role model for young players and coaches. Her appointment is a step in the right direction to having greater female representation in key roles within our sport," said Great Britain's Youth Teams Performance Group Chair, Charlie Ford. The 2020 U16 Women's FIBA European Championships are set to take place during the month of July in the countries of Gibraltar, Bosnia and Herzegovina in the Balkans, and Matsinhos, Portugal.



CONGRATULATIONS COACH!

Head Coach Linda Cimino has reached the 200-win plateau throughout her NCAA career. Spanning from her time in New Jersey as the coach of Caldwell, to Binghamton in the America East, and currently with the Terriers, the Rhode Island native and rules-committee representee also earned her 21st victory at the helm on Remsen Street so far. During her 14 year career, seven of those have been winning seasons, as she looks for her eighth this year. As the head coach of the Terriers up to date, she has had the highest scoring offense in the Northeast Conference averaging at least four points ahead of the next team on the respective listing. On the Division I level, Coach Cimino holds 72 victories between Binghamton and St. Francis College. She was honored with a game-ball and plaque presented by the athletic department in a special pregame ceremony prior to the Fairleigh Dickinson contest on 1/2/20.

NEVENA'S HISTORIC FRESHMAN YEAR...SO FAR

Freshman guard and Serbian native Nevena Dimitrijevic has gotten off to a historical start for the Terriers. Currently, the Northeast Conference has recognized Dimitrijevic as Rookie of the Week four times (11/25, 12/8, and 12/16, 1/15). Nevena becomes the third ever Terrier to achieve three or more respective awards (Tiffany Hill in 2004-05 with 4), (Leah Fechko in 2012-13 with 3), (Kim Weir in 2001-02 with 3). She, and her teammate Jade Johnson have a combined 11 (Dimitrijevic with 5, Johnson with 6) 20+ scoring contests. The lone player in the conference with nine is Merrimack's Denia Davis-Stewart. Dimitrijevic also holds the most assists so far this season, has a 12 assist game, and most recently a 15 assist game vs. the Long Island University Sharks. The only other double-digit assist getter in a single game is Ashley Forker of CCSU against UMass Lowell on 12/5/19.

CONFERENCE OPENER DETERMINES REMAINDER OF SEASON?

During seasons that the Terriers fall in their opening conference contest, St. Francis averages 6.4 victories on the season. The average includes the current 4-8 record, and the defeat to Fairleigh Dickinson on Thursday, January 2. On the positive side, the Terriers have been victorious in three of their last five openers, where they would average 13.8 wins in their respective seasons, dating back to the 2010-11 campaign. During the NEC Championship season (2014-15), the Terriers fell to Sacred Heart 71-55 on 1/3/15 in Fairfield, CT.

Linda Cimino was named the 13th head women's basketball coach in program history by Director of Athletics Irma Garcia on May 21, 2018.

Cimino enters her second season at the helm of St. Francis Brooklyn. During Cimino's first season on Remsen Street, she led the Terriers to a historic finish with 18 total victories including 12 in NEC play, which are a program record. Cimino guided the Terriers to the No. 3 seed in the 2019 NEC Tournament and hosted Mount St. Mary's in the NEC Quarterfinals.

While in Brooklyn Heights, Cimino coached one of the conference's greats in Australian point guard Amy O'Neill. She would go on to achieve a plethora of accolades that included being named an NCAA Stat Champion in Assists Per Game, All-Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Second Team honoree, and All-NEC First Team selection under Cimino. O'Neill became the first Terrier in program history to record a triple-double, and she accomplished the feat twice during her senior season.

The Terriers set a number of team records in 2018-19, which included most points on offense in a single-season (2,329), and most free-throws made (456). She also coached Jade Johnson, who is the returning leading scorer in the NEC. During Cimino's first season in Brooklyn Heights, Johnson tallied a career-high 598 points during her junior campaign, and set the record for most points in a single-season.

Prior to being named the Terriers' 13th head coach, Cimino spent four seasons as Binghamton's head coach in the America East. Cimino's positive energy and relentless work ethic changed the culture at Binghamton University over her four seasons, both on and off the court. Known for her passion and enthusiasm, Cimino considers player development, strong recruiting and building relationships key ingredients in constructing a winner. Her leadership style reignited a sense of energy and pride at Binghamton.

From 2015-18, at Binghamton, the Bearcats averaged 15+ wins and played at or above .500 in conference play each year. In 2017-18, the Bearcats received a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), marking the first time that the program reached a national postseason tournament since Binghamton moved up to NCAA Division I prior to the 2001-02 season. Playing in its first-ever Division I national postseason game, Binghamton won, 70-59, at Youngstown State in the opening round of the WBI. It was a historic win for the Bearcats in more ways than one. Binghamton finished with 20 wins for the first time since the 2000-01 season, the year before it moved up to the NCAA Division I level. Binghamton also boasted the America East Player of the Year, Imani Watkins, who set the program's all-time scoring record. Watkins was also named to the All-America East First Team and finished up her career with 2,125 points. Alyssa Ewing James was an anchor for Cimino on the defensive end of the floor. James joined the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound club in 2017-18 and set the America East and Binghamton blocks record for a career with 270. James also became just the second three-time America East Defensive Player of the Year in conference history.

In 2017-18, Binghamton was included among the top 50 teams in the nation in several categories. As a team, Binghamton was ranked ninth in the nation with 5.9 blocks per game. It was also 24th in field goal percentage defense (.362), 34th in scoring defense (57.4 ppg.), and 47th in steals (9.9 spg.).

COACHING STAFF

Peers have taken notice of Cimino as she was named the 2016 America East Coach of the Year. Binghamton was picked to finish last in the America East Conference in 2015-16, but under Cimino's guidance, it finished in a three-way tie for third place. The Bearcats won their most games (14) and most conference games (eight) since the 2010-11 season, putting Binghamton amongst the most improved teams in the NCAA. At the America East Tournament, Binghamton advanced to the conference semifinals for the first time since 2011.

As a coach who focuses on player development, Cimino takes great pride in working with her players to reach their full potential. Most notably, Kim Albrecht had two breakout seasons under Cimino's guidance, capping her career as a NCAA statistical champion in which she led the country in free throw percentage (91.4). This was the first statistical champion in Binghamton basketball history.

Her first year with the Bearcats saw a program best two players named to the America East All-Rookie Team, including the America East Rookie of the Year. The team's ability to shoot the ball significantly improved under her guidance as the team finished first in the America East in free-throw percentage (.720) after finishing last the season prior to her arrival. The team also finished third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage after finishing sixth the previous season.

Cimino arrived at Binghamton after a successful eight-year run as the head coach at Caldwell University. Her strong ability to connect with and motivate her players played a significant role in her rebuilding the Cougars' program. She is the program's all-time leader in wins with a 128-100 (.561) overall record. This includes a 90-52 (.633) mark in her final five years at the helm, averaging 18 wins a season after Caldwell went 39-71 in the four years prior to her tenure. In only her second year with Caldwell, her team was recognized as one of the most improved teams in the country.

In 2010-11, Cimino led the Cougars to their most successful season in the program's history. She guided the program to the most wins in their history (21), broke the mark for win percentage (.778), made the program's first appearance in the national rankings and won the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference (CACC) Regular Season Championship.

In addition to the 2010-11 championship, Caldwell shared the CACC title in 2012-13 while also going 15-4 in conference play and rattling off a school record 15 consecutive wins. In both 2012-13 and 2013-14, Caldwell advanced to the CACC Tournament championship game. Furthermore, Caldwell earned a bid to the ECAC Division II Tournament twice during her career.

Cimino was able to attract high caliber student-athletes to Caldwell that paid off for both her team and the student-athletes. She recruited and coached three CACC and two ECAC Rookie of the Year players, as well as two CACC Players of the Year and two Division II All-Americans. Under Cimino's watch, Caldwell was just as successful in the classroom. Thirteen different players were selected to the CACC's All-Academic Team, and during the 2013-14 season, the overall team GPA was a 3.4.

Away from the court, Cimino has had an equally impactful career as an athletics administrator. In addition to her success as Caldwell's head coach, Cimino was the Associate Director of Athletics and Senior Woman Administrator all eight years. She oversaw facilities, game-day operations and scheduling for all Caldwell programs, in addition to serving as the sport administrator for all of the women's teams. Cimino was also heavily involved in Caldwell's Cougar Pride Booster Club, oversaw the Student Athlete Advisory Club (SAAC) and coordinated the athletic department's community outreach program. In 2011, she was selected to participate in the NCAA's Women and Minorities Mentor Program.

Among her committee work, she was appointed the Chair of the NCAA Women's Basketball Rules Committee prior to the 2018-19 season. She has served on the NCAA Women's Basketball Regional Advisory Committee (East Region), in which she was also a NCAA site representative for two regional tournaments. She also served on the NCAA Division II USA Today Coaches Poll Committee and WBCA National Coach of the Year Award Committee. At Binghamton, Cimino was selected to take part in the pilot WBCA Mentoring Program.

Prior to arriving at Caldwell, Cimino was a health education teacher in the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District for five years. During that span she was as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Adelphi University after previously serving as the head girls' varsity basketball coach at Calhoun High School for three seasons. She began her college coaching career at the age of 22 as the head coach at Queensborough Community College, where she led the team to the CUNY championship game in 2002.

A member of Adelphi's basketball program from 1997-00. She graduated from Adelphi in 2001 with a Bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education and her Master's degree in Health Education from Adelphi in 2004. A native of Lincoln, RI, Cimino was All-State in both basketball and softball at North Smithfield High School.

GAME #17 - Central Connecticut @ Mount St. Mary's (MD) - 1/18/20

EMMITSBURG, MD- The Mount St. Mary's women's basketball team led by 22 points with 8:13 remaining Saturday (Jan. 18) and a win seemed almost assured. But the Central Connecticut Blue Devils put together a late run to make the Mountaineers sweat before taking home a 72-64 victory at Knott Arena. Jatarrikah Settle led the Mount (9-8, 4-1 NEC) with 16 points and six rebounds. In her return to the starting five, Kayla Agentowicz put together 12 points and four assists in just under 28 minutes of playing time. Taylor Addison reached double figures with 12, as did Rebecca Lee who finished with 10. "It feels really good," Agentowicz said postgame. "I've been trying to find a rhythm and it came together in practice this week." The Mount shot 52.9 percent from the floor, marking the fifth time this season that more than half of the shots with in. They also held the Blue Devils to 39 percent, and forcing 21 turnovers with nine steals and four blocks. "What's really special about our team is our diversity," Agentowicz said. "We can go one through five and switch in and out. We work to defend and we take pride in that." Central Connecticut (11-16, 0-6 NEC) received a game-high 18 points and nine rebounds from Ashley Berube. Mount St. Mary's looked to take control in the second quarter with an 11-0 run. Central Connecticut only managed two shots in the first five minutes and were held scoreless until a free throw by Emma McCamus at the 4:08 mark. The Mountaineers earned their largest lead in the half with a 10 point lead, 28-18, halfway through the quarter. Despite committing 14 turnovers, the Blue Devils chiseled away at the lead towards the end of the half, and Mount took an eight point advantage into the locker room. The third quarter also belonged to the Mountaineers, thanks to a burst of scoring. Mount went 10-of-14 (71.4 percent) from the field, along with a pair of triples and a perfect 3-of-3 from the charity stripe. A driving layup by Addison at the horn was the cherry on top for a 59-40 lead with 10 minutes to go. Addison struck again two minutes later with a three pointer for the Mount's 22 point lead. Then the Mountaineers went cold in a scoring drought that lasted six minutes. CCSU seized the moment with a 13-0 run, boosted by four points from Bruna Vila Artigues. Her successful foul shots with 2:33 remaining forced Lee out of the game with her fifth foul and cut the Mount's lead down to nine Agentowicz finally broke the dry spell with two in the paint, but the Blue Devils kept coming, trimming their deficit down to seven with 1:32 to go. But the comeback stalled on two more CCSU turnovers, and four points by Addison secured the victory for the Mountaineers.

MOON TOWNSHIP, PA- The St. Francis Brooklyn women's basketball team (18-13, 12-7) fell to the Mountaineers of Mount St. Mary's (MD) (15-15, 9-10) by a score of 80-74 in the quarterfinal round of the 2019 Northeast Conference Tournament at the Pope Physical Education Center. The Terriers hosted their first quarterfinal contest since 1994. The Mount earned their first victory in tournament play since 2013-14 when they took down Wagner in the quarterfinals. Coming off a three-game winning streak dating back to the contest against Bryant approximately two weeks ago. The Terriers looked for their fourth straight victory and their 19th victory of the season. St. Francis Brooklyn was looking for their first basket to begin the contest after Rebecca Lee started off with the game's first two points for the Mount. Roughly two minutes in, junior guard Jade Johnson sank home a jumper just outside the paint to put the home team on the board. The Mountaineers would respond back with a 6-0 run led by freshman Michaela Harrison, who sank a triple from the far corner to give her squad the largest lead of the quarter at eight. St. Francis Brooklyn turned the tables with a 6-0 run of their own featuring Maria Palarino, Amy O'Neill, and Ally Lassen. All three student-athletes contributed a basket each during the respective run. The Mount once again responded to conclude the quarter on a 5-0 run. A two-game losing streak for the Mount would not sit well for the opposition, as they came out on a 7-0 run to begin the second quarter. The Terriers closed the gap to within one with a three-point blast from freshman guard Ebony Horton before Bridget Birkhead answered with a triple of her own to extend the lead back to four for the Mount. With 54 seconds remaining in the first half, none other than Horton grabs two points to knot the game at 35 heading into the locker room. "She's a tremendous player, an outstanding athlete, an excellent defender, and as the year went on, she became a better and better offensive player and an offensive threat." Momentum could not be obtained by either team coming out of the locker room, as baskets were traded back and forth with one another to keep the score within two or tied. The largest lead for the Terriers was four, as the home team maintained the lead for the entirety of the stanza. A foul on All-NEC first teamer Juliette Lawless sent the All-NEC second teamer in Jade Johnson to the line for three shots to extend the lead to two possessions. On an ensuing possession in the final seconds of the quarter, senior guard Maria Palarino drew a foul against Lawless, who would then convert both of her free-throws to give the Terriers a two-point lead heading into the final period of regulation. The final quarter was yet another nail-biting performance from both programs, that saw back and forth scoring. Junior guard Jade Johnson excited the crowd by netting home a long three-point basket with 7:13 remaining in the contest to put her squad up by a lone point. The exclamation of the quarter occurred when the opposition's Michaela Harrison netted a three-point field goal to quiet the home crowd as her team took a four-point lead heading into the final five minutes of regulation. Harrison would do it once again, by converting on another three to extend the lead to (7) multiple possessions. An eight-point lead was not difficult to come back from after Harrison sank in two free throws after drawing a foul against Horton, but the Terriers never backed down or gave up for a second. A steal from Ally Lassen sent Palarino to the house for a pair to narrow the lead at four with 58 ticks on the clock. Back and forth timeouts occurred as Samantha Keltos was injured on a play where she was fouled on the shot. The substitute player, being Mia Ehling would come into the contest sinking both of her teammates free-throws to narrow the lead to just a single basket. The ensuing possession for the Mountaineers saw Ebony Horton steal the ball away from Michaela Harrison. Head Coach Linda Cimino would take a timeout with possession, as she needed a single basket to knot the game at 76. Redemption for Harrison would occur as she stole the ball from Maria Palarino with 8 seconds remaining, which would seal the fate of the historical season on Remsen Street for the first year head coach and her players.

HOW IT HAPPENED:

- Senior guard Maria Palarino tallied 20 points, grabbed six rebounds, and converted a perfect six-of-six from the free-throw line. She also converted seven-of-10 from the field in 27 minutes of action.
- Junior guard Jade Johnson scored 20 points grabbed three rebounds, converted seven-of-nine from the free-throw line, and sank three triples in eight tries in 40 minutes.
- Freshman guard Ebony Horton recorded 14 points, grabbed 10 rebounds, assisted on three baskets, and stole one. Horton converted six-of-14 from the field in 39 minutes of play.
- Sophomore forward Ally Lassen etched seven points into the score sheet and grabbed eight rebounds. She would steal three, and convert three-of-five from the charity stripe in 26 minutes of play.
- Senior guard Amy O'Neill registered four points, assisted on 10, stole a pair, and grabbed six rebounds in 39 minutes of play.
