The Terriers are coming off their second victory of the season, and a statement victory following one of their most lackluster performances inside the Daniel Lynch '38 Gymnasium on Saturday, January 23 against LIU. St. Francis is looking to avenge the three consecutive defeats against the Seahawks of Wagner College, dating back to February 11, 2019 inside the Spiro Sports Center. The Seahawks are off to their best start in nearly two decades, as they've won their previous five of seven games. Senior forward Ally Lassen has tallied at least 15 points over the previous three contests against the Seahawks. St. Francis Brooklyn hasn't claimed victory on Staten Island since January 12, 2013, when Sarah Benedetti, and Jessica Kaufman both tallied 18 points each, while Eilidh Simpson etched 13 points to the scoresheet as well.

- Named NEC Prime Performer for the week of 2/1/21
- One of six NEC student-athletes to have recorded 20 points twice in a single game during the 2020-21 campaign thus far.
- While on a 24-minute restriction in three games to start the season, as per Coach Cimino, Dimitrijevic averaged 13 points per game.

Alyssa Fisher - Guard - Sophomore - Captain

- Eighth in minutes played in the NEC averaging 31.41 per-game
- Tallied 15 points, and stole a team high four against LIU in the 28th Annual Battle of Brooklyn on Thursday 1/28.

Eszter Varga - Guard - Freshman

- Averaged 13.9 points and 4.0 assists per game during her high-school career.
- Participated in the 5x5 and 3x3 Hungarian Championships and was a starter on the 3x3 National team

Fruzsina Horvath - Forward - Freshman

- Named NEC Rookie of the Week presented by Pilot Pen USA during the week of 12/23
- One of four players to tally double-digit points at LIU on Thursday

BROADCASTER TIPS

- Sophomore guard Nevena Dimitrijevic is three points away from 500 in her career.
- The Fairleigh Dickinson series was pushed back from 1/14-15 to the NEC makeup week of 2/9-10 due to COVID-19 related issues within the Knights' program.
- Sophomore guard Nevena Dimitrijevic is one of three Northeast Conference players to tally eight assists (vs. CCSU 12/15) on the young season (Forker, CCSU vs. FDU 12/19, Swogger, SFU (PA) at La Salle 12/05, and vs. LIU on 1/08/21)
- Senior forward Ally Lassen is the only NEC student-athlete to record TWO 20 point performances during the 2020-21 campaign (20 and 21 against CCSU 12/14-15). Three others have three: Bryant's Bjelko, Mount's Bresee, and SFU's Swogger.
- The Terriers set a conference season-high in field goal attempts with 80 against Central Connecticut on 12/15. They also hit a third-highest FG attempt rate with 75 at Bryant on 12/08/20.



SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION:

- Wagner has earned its third and fourth straight wins against the Warriors of Merrimack College this past weekend.
- Guard Khaleah Edwards was named an NEC Prime Performer for the week of February 1, 2021.
- The previous two victories, and the start through seven conference games, is the best since 1998-99.
- Forward Emilija Krista Grava ranks sixth in the NEC in scoring, averaging 12.71 PPG through seven games. Krista Grava also ranks third in the league in field-goal percentage, averaging 46.6% from the field.
- Guard Alaysha Dailey sits fifth in the league with 3.43 assists-per-game, she trails Nevena Dimitrijevic, who sits first in the NEC. Dailey also ranks in the top-10 for free-throw shooting, as she averages 65.5% per contest.
- Forward Kem Nwabudu is the lone Wagner Seahawk with a 20-point performance this season.
- Khaleah Edwards is the lone NEC student-athlete to turn the basketball over double-digit times during the season. She did so against Seton Hall in non-conference play on December 11, 2020.
- Kate Tokuhara tallied five steals against Merrimack in its win on Saturday. She becomes the seventh player to have 5+ steals/gm, this season.

COVID-19 CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

The Terriers are now one of 10 teams within the Northeast Conference. During the offseason, the Robert Morris Colonials departed for the Horizon League, and the NEC, one again, returned to a 10 team league. Due to COVID-19, the Terriers and the remainder of the NEC, will be playing a total of 18 games throughout the regular season:

- The Terriers will be playing each team within the conference on a back-to-back schedule either inside the Daniel Lynch '28 Gymnasium, or on the road, one time.
- Longest road trip is three games beginning on January 28 at LIU, and concluding on February 5 at Wagner College.
- Due to the postponement of the Fairleigh Dickinson series, the longest home stand is now four games beginning on February 9-10 in a back-to-back set against the aforementioned cross-river rivals, and concluding on February 13 and 14 against Saint Francis (PA).
- The Terriers and LIU will be playing each other once at their respective arenas, each. The 28th annual Battle of Brooklyn will take place on the road, inside the Steinberg Wellness Center (1/28) The latter contest will air on ESPN+
- Due to COVID-19, and the uncertainty of the schedule, the NEC has put together three weeks for makeup dates. January 19-20, February 9-10, and March 4-5.
- The 2021 NEC Tournament will continue to take place at the site of the highest seed. The semifinal round will occur on Wednesday, March 10. The championship game will take place on Sunday, March 14.

NEV NAMED TO LIEBERMAN WATCH LIST

Sophomore guard Nevena Dimitrijevic was named to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame/Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Nancy Lieberman Award Preseason Watch List. The Serbian native became the first Terrier in program history to be recognized for the respective award, and the first NEC student-athlete since Jess Kovatch (SFU) during the 2017-18, and 2018-19 campaigns. Other players to be named to the list include Rutgers' Diamond Johnson, Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia, UConn's Paige Bueckers, and 2019 National Champion DiDi Richards of Baylor University.

LASSEN CONTINUES TO LEAD ON THE CHARITY STRIPE

Senior forward Ally Lassen tallied six-of-six free-throws from the charity stripe against the Long Island University Sharks on Thursday, January 28. Lassen became just the 10th player within the Northeast Conference to convert at least five free-throws in as many attempts this season. She joins the likes of SFU's Karson Swogger, SFU's Haley Thomas, Sacred Heart's Adrienne Hagood, Bryant's Shannon O'Connor, LIU's Camille Gray, Mount's Kendall Bresee, followed by her teammate Nevena Dimitrijevic, who accomplished the feat against the aforementioned Mount on January 7, 2021.

NEV STILL STANDS IN RARE TERRITORY

During her first season, sophomore guard Nevena Dimitrijevic made history, and recorded accolades heard around the Northeast Conference and its full-time member schools. The Serbian native tallied seven Rookie of the Week honors, that saw her land in the top-five of all NEC student-athletes dating back to 1998-99.

TERRIERS ARE DOUBLE-DOUBLE TEAMING

Freshman forward Zharia Hutchinson becomes the first Terrier to record a double-double in a season opener since former student-athlete Kendra Williams accomplished the feat in the 2007-08 opener against NJIT on November 11, 2007, inside the Daniel Lynch '38 Gymnasium. Williams tallied 11 points, and grabbed 11 boards in 35 minutes on the hardwood. Hutchinson, against Bryant on December 8, would tally 18 points, and grab 14 rebounds. The Montgomery, AL native also converted seven-of-12 from the field, and four-of-five from the charity stripe in 36 minutes on the court. Dating back to 1998-99, Caitlyn O'Malley recorded 16 points, and grabbed 14 rebounds against La Salle during the 2001-02 opener. On December 15 against Central Connecticut, freshman forward Fruzsina Horvath recorded her first collegiate double-double, where she posted 17 points, and grabbed 10 rebounds in just her fourth game. Senior forward Ally Lassen added to the fun by tallying her third career double-double, by adding 21 points to the scoresheet, and tying a career high in rebounds grabbed with 12 on the evening. St. Francis Brooklyn becomes the first Northeast Conference program in 2020-21 to tally three double-doubles by three different student-athletes (Horvath, Hutchinson, Lassen)

EUROPEAN CONNECTION

Head coach Linda Gimino has recruited five of the 10 players on her squad, from Europe. Sophomore guard Nevena Dimitrijevic hails from Kragujevac, Serbia. Freshman guard Carmen Segura is from Valencia, Spain. Senior guard Marta Zori is from Badalona, Spain. Freshman forward Fruzsina Horvath hails from Budapest, Hungary. Finally, freshman guard Eszter Varga is from Somogy, Hungary. The most since the 2016-17, when the Terriers had Denmark's Etta Andersen. Ontario, Canada's Samantha Keltos. Sydney, Australia's Alex Delaney. Melbourne, Australia's Meg Crupi.

FISH HAS A KNACK FOR THE DOGS

Sophomore guard and captain Alyssa Fisher set a career high in points during her first-ever meeting against Bryant inside the Chace Athletic Center, with 17 points. During the 2020-21 season opener, Fisher would set a new career-high with 19 points against the aforementioned Bulldogs. She would also set a new career-high with four triples made, and converted seven field goals in the season opener as well.

TERRIERS SIGN ISABELLA POSSET FOR 2021-22

Posset, from Beaver, PA, has spent the previous two seasons with former Northeast Conference foe, Robert Morris. During her tenure in Moon Township, Posset was named to the All-NEC Third Team, and was selected to the All-NEC Rookie Team. Additionally, Posset was named an NEC Academic Honor Roll recipient in both seasons as a Colonial. Some of the accomplishments stand out within the NEC:

- As a sophomore, named to the All-NEC Third Team, becoming the sixth player to move from Rookie to First/Second/Third Team
- Paced the NEC in steals (2.3), the only league player to average above 2.0
- Led the team in minutes (26.6) and steals, also ranking third in scoring (7.9)
- Reached double figures in scoring 13 times, guiding the team twice in that category
- Registered a career-high 16 points (6-9 FG, 4-4 3PT), four steals, four caroms, and three assists versus Merrimack (1/18)
- Collected the second most steals in RMU history with eight, adding 11 points and five rebounds against Sacred Heart (1/20)
- Registered the 100th steal of her career versus the Pioneers, becoming the fourth fastest player to reach that mark
- Contributed 10 points (4-6 FT), seven rebounds, two assists, and two steals in the NEC Quarterfinals versus Wagner (3/9)
- As a freshman, played in all 33 games, starting 25
- Named to the All-NEC Rookie Team
- Led the team in assists, steals, minutes (25.9), and ranked second in scoring (7.6)
- Reached double-digit points 11 times, and paced the team twice in that category
- Began her collegiate career with a career-high eight assists off the bench at Youngstown State (11/6)
- Set a career-high with 16 points (5-8 FG, 4-7 3PT) in her first career start versus Pitt-Johnstown (12/15)
- Provided 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting, adding two caroms and two assists against Delaware State (12/18)
- Stuffed the stat sheet against Mount St. Mary's with 13 points (7-8 FT), seven rebounds, and seven assists (1/5)
- Collected 14 points (4-8 FG), eight caroms, three assists, and two steals at LIU Brooklyn (1/14)
- Swiped a season-high six steals against Wagner (1/26)

Linda Cimino enters her third season at the helm of St. Francis Brooklyn after being named the 13th women's basketball head coach in program history by Director of Athletics Irma Garcia.

During her inaugural season on Remsen Street, Cimino led the Terriers to a historic finish with 18 victories including 12 in NEC play. The latter, is a program record. Cimino guided the Terriers to the No. 3 seed in the 2019 NEC Tournament and hosted Mount St. Mary's in the NEC Quarterfinals.

While in Brooklyn Heights, Cimino has coached two of the best point-guards that the Terriers and NEC have ever seen in Australian point guard Amy O'Neill and Serbian point guard Nevena Dimitrijevic. O'Neill would go on to achieve a plethora of accolades that included being named an NCAA Stat Champion in the Assists Per Game category, All-Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Second Team honoree, and All-NEC First Team selection under Cimino. O'Neill became the first Terrier in program history to record a triple-double, and she accomplished the feat twice during her senior season. In her first collegiate season, Dimitrijevic recorded numerous accolades. Many of them, became firsts in program history. The Serbian native was selected to the Second Team All-NEC team, All-Rookie Selection, NEC Rookie of the Year, and Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Third Team honoree.

On December 4, 2019, Cimino earned her 200th career NCAA victory against East Stroudsburg University. The Terriers set several team records in 2018-19, which included most points on offense in a single-season (2,329), and most free-throws made (456). She also coached Jade Johnson, who concluded her tenure on Remsen Street as the fifth highest scorer in program history (1,396). During Cimino's first season in Brooklyn Heights, Johnson tallied a career-high 598 points during her junior campaign and set the record for most points in a single-season.

Before her current stint in Brooklyn Heights, Cimino spent four seasons as head coach of the Bearcats of Binghamton University, in the America East Conference. Cimino's positive energy and relentless work ethic changed the culture over her four seasons in Central New York, both on and off the court. Known for her passion and enthusiasm, Cimino considers player development, strong recruiting and building relationships key ingredients in constructing a winner.

In 2017-18, the Bearcats received a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI), marking the first time that the program reached a national postseason tournament. Playing in its first-ever national postseason game, Cimino's Bearcats were victorious over Youngstown State. Binghamton finished with 20 wins for the first time since the 2000-01 season. Binghamton also boasted the America East Player of the Year, Imani Watkins, who set the program's all-time single-season scoring record. Watkins was also named to the All-America East First Team and finished up her career with 2,125 points, which was also the most in program history, all under Cimino. Alyssa Ewing James was an anchor on the defensive end of the floor. James joined the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound club in 2017-18 and set the America East and Binghamton blocks record for a career with 270. James also became just the second three-time America East Defensive Player of the Year in conference history. Also, Kim Albrecht logged two breakout seasons under Cimino, capping her career as the NCAA's free-throw percentage leader (91.4). This was also the first statistical champion in program history. Under Cimino's tutelage, Binghamton was ranked ninth, nationally with 5.9 blocks per game. It was also ranked 24th in field goal percentage defense.

Cimino was named the 2015-16 America East Coach of the Year. During the season, Cimino's squad finished second in program history in the most steals and steals per game category. The Bearcats won their highest number of overall contests, and conference games since the 2010-11 season, putting Binghamton amongst the most improved teams in the NCAA.

Her first season with the Bearcats saw a duo named to the America East All-Rookie Team, including Rookie of the Year. The team's ability to shoot the ball significantly improved under her guidance as the team finished first in the conference in free-throw percentage, after finishing in the bottom of the respective category, prior to her arrival. That same year, Cimino's Bearcats also finished third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage after finishing sixth the previous season.

Before she arrived at Binghamton, Cimino would log eight years as the head coach at Caldwell University. Her strong ability to connect with and motivate her players played a significant role in her rebuilding the Cougars' program. She is the program's all-time leader in wins (128). This includes 90 victories in her final five seasons at the helm after Caldwell went 39-71 in the four years prior to Cimino's arrival. Cimino's Cougars were recognized nationally as one of the most improved teams in the country, just two seasons in.

In 2010-11, Cimino led the Cougars to their most successful season in the program's history. She guided the program to the most wins in its history, and made the program's first appearance in the national rankings and won the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference (CACC) Regular Season Championship. Caldwell shared the CACC title in 2012-13 while also going 15-4 in conference play and rattling off a school-record 15 consecutive wins. From 2012-14, Caldwell advanced to the CACC Tournament championship game. Furthermore, Caldwell earned a bid to the ECAC Division II Tournament twice during her career. She recruited and coached three CACC and two ECAC Rookie of the Year players, as well as two CACC Players of the Year and two Division II All-Americans. Under Cimino's watch, 13 different players were selected to the CACC's All-Academic Team.

As a coach who focuses on player development, Cimino takes great pride in mentoring her players to reach their full potential. Many of her former players have gone from student-athletes to becoming a mainstay on the bench alongside Cimino. Most recently, three coaches in Jessica Coscia, Alyssa Ewing-James, and Kennedi Thompson, are currently serving as assistants on Remsen Street.

Off the court, Cimino has had an impactful career as an athletics administrator. In addition to her success as Caldwell's head coach, Cimino was the Associate Director of Athletics and Senior Woman Administrator all eight years. She oversaw facilities, game-day operations and scheduling for all Cougar programs, in addition to serving as the sport administrator for all of the women's teams. Cimino was also heavily involved in the Cougar Pride Booster Club, oversaw the Student-Athlete Advisory Club (SAAC) and coordinated the athletic department's community outreach program. In 2011, she was selected to participate in the NCAA's Women and Minorities Mentor Program.

Prior to her tenure in New Jersey, Cimino was a health education teacher in the Bellmore-Merrick Central School District, on Long Island for five years. During that span, she was an assistant coach at Adelphi University, her alma mater. She also served as the head girls' varsity basketball coach at Calhoun High School for three seasons. Cimino began her collegiate coaching career at the age of 22, as the head coach at Queensborough Community College, where she led the Tigers to the CUNY championship game in her lone season at the helm of the program.

Among her committee work from 2016 to 2020, Cimino served a four-year term on the NCAA Women's Basketball Rules Committee. In August 2018, Cimino was named as the Chair of the Rules Committee, where she then served a two-year term. She has served on the NCAA Women's Basketball Regional Advisory Committee (East Region), in which she was also an NCAA site representative for two regional tournaments. She also served on the NCAA Division II USA Today Coaches Poll Committee and WBCA National Coach of the Year Award Committee. At Binghamton, Cimino was selected to take part in the pilot WBCA Mentoring Program.

Cimino keeps her faith on the forefront of all, as she is currently of writing a novel on faith and leadership. She also is an active partitioner and lector at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Manhattan. In 2019, she was inducted into the Rhode Island Interscholastic League Hall of Fame, where she was recognized for her extraordinary efforts on and off-the-court, as a Rhode Island native. As one of the best to suit up for the Adelphi Panthers women's basketball program, Cimino continues to appear in the record books for her alma-mater years later in numerous categories.

She graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education and her Master's degree in Health Education. Both from Adelphi. A native of Lincoln, RI, Cimino was All-State in both basketball and softball at North Smithfield High School.

Cimino resides in New York City.

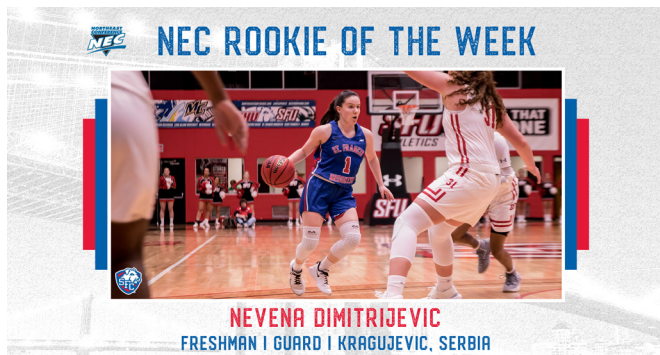

With the victory, the Seahawks upped their winning streak to four straight games and moved to 5-2 overall and 5-1 in Northeast Conference (NEC) play. The Warriors fell to 0-4 on the year and remain winless in conference action. This marks the Seahawks' best start through six conference games since 1998-99, when that team also went 5-1 to start league play and finished with a 16-12 record and 13-7 in the conference. Four Seahawks placed in double-figures, led by Khaleah Edwards, who poured in a team and season-high 19 points. Kem Nwabudu and Amanda Pollard each scored 11 points and grabbed five rebounds in the victory. Zhaneia Thybulle rounded out the scoring with ten points. Merrimack's Kate Mager led all scorers with a game-high 21 points on 7 of 12 shooting from the floor. Mayson Kimball added 11 points while Alyssa Casey posted a double-double, finishing with 10 points and 10 rebounds. The Warriors held a 45-32 edge on the boards. The Seahawks turned 19 Warriors mishaps into 24 points. Wagner only held the lead for 6:51 and outscored the Warriors, 34-20 over the fourth and overtime periods. Alayshia Dailey dished out a season-high eight assists. Kate Tokuhara matched her career-high, recording five steals. It marked the third time in her career she has done so and first since recording five at New Mexico State back on Feb. 29, 2020, when she was a member of CSU-Bakersfield.
