URBANA (2-8, 1-8) vs. #5/7 SHEPHERD (9-0, 9-0)

RAM STADIUM • SHEPHERDSTOWN, WV

SHEPHERDSTOWN, W. Va. -- Junior quarterback **Jeff Ziemba** (Newark, Del./St. Mark's) completed 14-of-21 passes for 217 yards and a pair of touchdowns to lead Shepherd University to a 41-14 win over Fairmont State in MEC football action at Fairmont on Thursday night.

Shepherd improves to 9-0, 9-0 in conference play, while Fairmont State falls to 5-4, 5-4.

Shepherd took a 7-0 lead when junior running back **Jabre Lolley** (Wilmington, Del./St. Mark's) scored on a six-yard run with 9:10 left in the first quarter.

Lolley scored on a one-yard run out of the Wildcat formation with 3:58 left in the first quarter to increase the lead to 13-0.

The score was setup by an 83-yard interception return by junior cornerback **Adam Coles** (Oxon Hill, Md./Potomac).

Fairmont State cut the lead to 13-7 when Cooper Hibbs teamed with Brandon Boyd on a 27-yard scoring pass with 10:37 left in the second quarter.

Shepherd took a 20-7 lead when Ziemba fired a 15-yard scoring strike to sophomore wide receiver **Angelo Jean-Louis** (Wellington, Fla./Palm Beach Central/Fork Union/Marshall) with 8:32 left in the second quarter.

Senior running back **Allen Cross** (Elkridge, Md./Long Reach) rambled 72 yards for a touchdown with 6:00 left in the second quarter to up the Shepherd lead to 27-7.

Junior defensive back **Tre Sullivan** (Accokeek, Md./Gwynn Park) picked up a punt that was blocked by Jean-Louis and ran 15 yards for a score with 2:19 left in the half as Shepherd took a 34-7 lead into the break.

Ziemba fired a 23-yard scoring strike to junior wide receiver **Billy Brown** (Gaithersburg, Md./Gaithersburg) with 19 seconds left in the third quarter to extend the lead to 41-7.

Hibbs teamed with Boyd on a 22-yard scoring pass with 14:10 left in the fourth quarter.

Hibbs completed 16-of-38 passes for 204 yards for the Falcons.

Brown paced the Rams with seven receptions for 145 yards. Boyd had 10 catches for 142 yards to lead Fairmont.

Cross had 17 carries for a game-high 118 yards to lead the Shepherd ground game. Lolley added six carries for 49 yards. Austin White rushed 18 times for 73 yards for the Falcons.

Shepherd gained 401 yards of total offense while Fairmont totaled 252. Shepherd limited Fairmont to 48 rushing yards. The Rams had seven sacks on the night.

Junior defensive back **CJ Davis** (Hagerstown, Md./South Hagerstown) had five solo tackles and a pair of pass breakups to lead the Ram defense.

A REIGN OF EXCELLENCE

Head Coach Monte Cater is now in his 29th season at the helm of the Shepherd football program. The Rams have had a great deal of success since Cater arrived in 1987 as they have won 15 conference titles over that period. In that time the Rams have made two trips to the NAIA Playoffs and eight trips to the NCAA II Playoffs (1998-99, 2005-07, 2010, and 2012-13). Cater tops the lists in all-time victories in WVIAC and MEC history.

If the Rams score 24 or more points, there is a good chance they will come out on top. Shepherd owns a 294-17 (.945) all-time record when reaching the magical 24-point mark. Included in that record is a 166-14 (.922) record since 1990 and a 171-16 (.914) mark under Cater.

14

The Rams sport a 379-75-26 (.816) all-time record when holding the opposition to 14 points or less. Currently, Shepherd has won 105 of its last 106 games when holding the opposition to 14 or less and owns a 127-3-1 (.973) record since 1990 when turning the trick. Shepherd is 138-7-1 (.948) under Cater in such games.

7

Shepherd is 126-105-26 (.540) all-time in games decided by seven points or less. Shepherd has a 44-30-1 (.593) record since 1990 and a 48-39-1 (.551) mark under Cater in games decided by seven or less.

150

Another key to victory is the Rams' running game. Shepherd is 191-28-2 (.868) since 1980 in games that it rushes for 150 or more yards. Since 1990, the record is 140-16-1 (.895) and under Cater it is 149-22-1 (.869).

ANYTHING LESS THAN 100

Defensively, the Rams will try to contain the running game and force teams to pass. If they hold the opposition to under 100 yards rushing, the odds on a win go up dramatically. Since 1980, the Rams are 165-24-1 (.871) when holding teams to less than 100 yards. Since 1990, Shepherd is 130-19 (.872) in such games and 138-22 (.862) under Cater.

ON THIS DATE

The Rams have played eight games in their history on November 14 with a 3-5-0 overall mark, including a 1-4-0 record at home.

Junior **CJ Davis** joined the likes of Shepherd standout return specialists **Bootsie Washington**, **James Rooths**, and **Deante Steele** to lead NCAA II in punt returns as a freshman. Davis is currently ranked third in NCAA II in kickoff returns with a 32.8 average. He returned a kickoff 96 yards for a score against Charleston this season. Junior quarterback **Jeff Ziemba** completed 14-of-21 passes for 217 yards and a pair of touchdowns in the win over Fairmont State. His 5,862 passing yards rank him third on the Shepherd all-time list, his 431 completions rank him third, while his 46 career touchdown passes place him in third. His 2,481 passing yards this season are the second most in program history (**Kevin Clancy - 2,979, 2010**). Ziemba (21) needs just one touchdown pass to tie the single season mark of 22 shared by **Chad Broadwater (1996)** and **Kevin Clancy (2010)**.
