CHARLESTON (3-5, 3-5 MEC) vs. #2/4 SHEPHERD (8-0, 8-0 MEC)

RAM STADIUM • SHEPHERDSTOWN, WV
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2017 • NOON

SHEPHERDSTOWN, W. Va. -- Senior quarterback **Connor Jessop** (Ashburn, Va./Broad Run/Virginia Tech) completed 18-of-24 passes for 313 yards and three touchdowns and added a rushing score to lead Shepherd University (8-0, 8-0 MEC) to a 45-14 win over West Virginia Wesleyan (4-5, 4-4 MEC) in MEC football action at West Virginia Wesleyan on Saturday.

Shepherd took a 7-0 lead when senior running back **Jabre Lolley** (Wilmington, Del./St. Mark's) scored on a two-yard plunge out of the Wildcat formation with 1:39 remaining in the first quarter. Senior kicker **Zach Wise** (Berkeley Springs, W. Va./Berkeley Springs) added the extra point.

Jessop teamed with Lolley on a 34-yard scoring play with 10:32 left in the second quarter to up the lead to 14-0.

Sophomore outside linebacker **Jared Austin** (Woodbridge, Va./C.D. Hylton) raced down the sideline for an 82-yard interception return with 6:55 left in the quarter.

Shepherd took a 28-0 lead into the break as Jessop weaved his way into the end zone for a seven-yard score with 1:07 left in the half.

The Bobcats got a 14-yard touchdown pass from Ryan Deal to Christian Nelson with 5:03 left in the third quarter to make it 28-7.

Shepherd took a 31-7 advantage behind a 29-yard field goal from Wise with 16 seconds left in the third quarter.

Jessop teamed with junior wide receiver **Ryan Feiss** (Forest Hill, Md./North Harford) on a 74-yard scoring strike with 13:10 left in the fourth quarter.

Jessop tossed an 18-yard scoring pass to sophomore tight end **DJ Cornish** (Felton, Del./Lake Forest) with 10:46 left in the game.

West Virginia Wesleyan added a score as Deal connected with Jajuan Linzy on a 68-yard scoring strike with 8:28 left in the game to complete the scoring.

Deal completed 17-of-34 passes for 275 yards for the Bobcats.

Feiss led the Shepherd receivers with five catches for 109 yards, while Cornish added six receptions for 92 yards. Linzy had three receptions for 87 yards for West Virginia Wesleyan.

Lolley had 11 carries for 49 yards to lead the Shepherd ground game. Tra Jackson had 14 carries for 31 yards for the Bobcats.

Shepherd gained 440 yards of total offense, while West Virginia Wesleyan had 333.

Senior defensive end **Elijah Norris** (Upper Marlboro, Md./Archbishop Carroll) led the Rams with eight tackles (seven solos). He added 2.5 tackles-for-loss (-six yards). Freshman linebacker **Chrys Lane** (Baltimore, Md./Dunbar) added seven stops (five solos). Austin had a pair of interceptions on the day. Brandon Grayson had seven tackles (six solos) to lead Wesleyan.

Shepherd gained 479 yards of total offense, while Urbana had 282.

A REIGN OF EXCELLENCE

Head Coach Monte Cater is now in his 31st season at the helm of the Shepherd football program. The Rams have had a great deal of success since Cater arrived in 1987 as they have won 16 conference titles over that period. In that time the Rams have made two trips to the NAIA Playoffs and 10 trips to the NCAA II Playoffs (1998-99, 2005-07, 2010, 2012-13, and 2015-16). Cater tops the lists in all-time victories in WVIAC and MEC history.

If the Rams score 24 or more points, there is a good chance they will come out on top. Shepherd owns a 317-17 (.949) all-time record when reaching the magical 24-point mark. Included in that record is a 189-14 (.931) record since 1990 and a 194-16 (.923) mark under Cater.

14

The Rams sport a 388-75-26 (.820) all-time record when holding the opposition to 14 points or less. Currently, Shepherd has won 114 of its last 115 games when holding the opposition to 14 or less and owns a 137-3-1 (.975) record since 1990 when turning the trick. Shepherd is 147-7-1 (.951) under Cater in such games.

7

Shepherd is 130-105-26 (.547) all-time in games decided by seven points or less. Shepherd has a 48-30-1 (.613) record since 1990 and a 52-39-1 (.570) mark under Cater in games decided by seven or less.

150

Another key to victory is the Rams' running game. Shepherd is 203-28-2 (.875) since 1980 in games that it rushes for 150 or more yards. Since 1990, the record is 152-16-1 (.902) and under Cater it is 161-22-1 (.877).

ANYTHING LESS THAN 100

Defensively, the Rams will try to contain the running game and force teams to pass. If they hold the opposition to under 100 yards rushing, the odds on a win go up dramatically. Since 1980, the Rams are 181-24-1 (.881) when holding teams to less than 100 yards. Since 1990, Shepherd is 144-19 (.883) in such games and 154-22 (.875) under Cater.

ON THIS DATE

The Rams have played 12 games in their history on Nov. 4 with a 6-6-0 overall mark, including a 4-2-0 record on the road.

Shepherd has accomplished a great deal of success at Ram Stadium since it became the home of the Rams in 1959. The Rams have a 208-70-6 (.743) overall record. Shepherd has registered undefeated home records in 17 different seasons, including a record-setting 8-0-0 mark in 2015.
