

## 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Paul Kaiser Track & Field Classic at Shippensburg University \*Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023\*

Shippensburg University will be hosting the 18<sup>th</sup> Paul Kaiser Classic on Saturday, April 29, 2023.

This will be a Non-Scored Meet.

## Meet information:

UNLIMITED ENTRIES on the track. UNLIMITED ENTRIES in the Javelin, High Jump & Triple Jump. You are limited to 3 entries in the Long Jump, Hammer, Discus and Shot Put. If you need additional entries in those field events, contact Coach Osanitsch directly. We want your athletes to have the best chance of qualifying for their conference championships.

\$375.00 entry fee for each Program, \$750.00 combined. You may choose to do \$20.00 per entry and/or \$20.00 per relay for smaller squads. Payments are now made with directathletics.com. Please pay once you register your team online. We will also accept team check payments as well. Please make check payable to "Shippensburg University Track & Field".

<u>Facilities</u>: Shippensburg's Track, located at Seth Grove Stadium, is an eight lane Beynon 2000 facility. 3/16 inch maximum spike length. The long and triple jump runways, high jump apron and javelin runway are a Beynon 2000 surface. Restroom facilities are located under the stadium. There will be a separate bathroom for athletes/coaches. There will be NO locker rooms or showers available. We will have the ability to turn the start line around depending on wind direction that day in the 100 & 100/110 hurdles. We also can turn all of our jumping facilities to have the wind at our favor.

<u>Scratch Table:</u> Coaches, contact me directly with scratches that I will then pass along to the timing crew. We will also have a scratch table when you arrive to the meet.

Entries: Entries will be accepted on Directathletics.com. Entry deadline will be 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Team payments are now made through Directathletics.com when you register.

A Preliminary Performance List will be posted on Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup> at the Shippensburg University Men's Track & Field Website @ Shipraiders.com

Advancement to Finals: 8 will advance to finals in the throws and horizontal jumps. Eight will also advance to a final in the 100 meter dash and 100/110 HH. Event Winners will be awarded a T-Shirt!

<u>Training Room</u>: Please bring your own tape and supplies. We will supply water for you to fill up individual bottles. Our sports medicine staff will be on hand to handle emergency situations.

<u>Clerking</u>: First call is 20 minutes prior to event start. Check in for running events will be at the clerking tent. Hip numbers will be worn for running events. Field events check in with head officials at site. Please report to field event officials 30 minutes prior to your event.

<u>Timing</u>: We will be using a Finish Lynx system operated by MACFAT. This is the same crew which does the PIAA State Track & Field Championships.

<u>Field Events</u>: We have laser measuring devices for all our throwing and jumping events!

<u>Wind Readings</u>: We will be recording wind readings for the 100, 200, 110HH & 100 HH. We will also record the wind reading on all LJ/TJ attempts.

<u>Results</u>: Results will be posted on our timing crew's website <a href="https://macfat.net/">https://macfat.net/</a> Race results will instantly be displayed on our stadium scoreboard.

<u>Implement Weigh-In's:</u> We will not certify implements in the throws. However, if your athlete achieves a NCAA provisional or Automatic mark on a throw, please let the official know and the implement will immediately be impounded and certified at our throws shed and then returned to the athlete once we have declared the implement legal. In addition, if you have NCAA caliber athlete in the throws we will certify their implements prior to the beginning of the competition.

<u>BUS Parking:</u> Instructions will be given closer to the meet. They will be assigned to a parking lot near our throws area.
