SETON HALL TIP-INS

- The Hall is 8-5 on the year and 1-1 in league play after splitting their first two BIG EAST contests
- The Pirates are coming off back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances as Anthony Bozzella enters his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater
- JaQuan Jackson leads the BIG EAST in scoring in her first season as a Pirate
- The Pirates feature one of the nation's youngest squads, boasting a roster that includes a total of nine freshmen
- Seton Hall has three players in the top-five in the league in steals per game; LaTecia Smith (2.9, second), Kaela Hilaire (2.6, third) and Jackson (2.5, tie-fourth)
- Deja Winters is the reigning BIG EAST Freshman of the Week after 10 points in a win over St. John's on Friday
- The Pirates lead the conference in both blocked shots and steals and rank third in the league in scoring offense

MUSKETEER MINUTIAE

- Xavier hosts The Hall with a 9-5 record on the year and a 1-2 mark in BIG EAST action
- After splitting their first two league games, the Musketeers fell on Tuesday night to St. John's
- Raeshaun Gaffney leads XU with 14.3 points per game, ranking eighth in the conference in scoring
- Xavier ranks second in the BIG EAST in both scoring defense (57.4 ppg) and field goal percentage defense (35.7 percent)
- Leah Schaefer is XU's leading rebounder at 6.5 per game

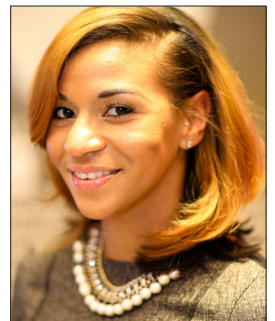

BUTLER RECAP

The Pirates faced their first road test of BIG EAST action on Monday night, falling at Butler
 • The contest was tied after a quarter and The Hall trailed by five at the break, but BU used a 23-12 third quarter to build a double-digit lead it would not relent

- JaQuan Jackson led The Hall with a career-high 25 points but was the lone Pirate in double-figures
- Butler held a 44-32 edge on the glass leading to a 20-5 advantage in second-chance points
- Kaela Hilaire led all players with seven assists while LaTecia Smith grabbed a team-high seven rebounds
- The setback snapped a four-game winning streak for The Hall in the series against the Bulldogs

XAVIER SERIES NOTES

The Pirates have faced Xavier six times since the Musketeers joined the BIG EAST

- The Hall is 6-0 all-time against the Musketeers, the lone BIG EAST foe they are unbeaten against
- Last season after an 82-66 victory in South Orange, the Pirates snagged a 72-67 triumph in Cincinnati
- The contest at the Cintas Center on Feb. 21 was the first game in the series decided by single-digits
- In that game at XU, Aleesha Powell scored 21 points while Tiffany Jones finished with a 14-point, 16-rebound double-double off the bench
- In the home contest, Tabatha Richardson-Smith (27) and Shakena Richardson (23) combined for 50 points and The Hall forced 20 XU turnovers leading to a 30-8 edge off of them

The Hall opened BIG EAST play on Friday night, entering its 35th year of conference action and fourth since the league realigned for the 2013-14 campaign.

IMPACT TRANSFER

JaQuan Jackson sat out the 2015-16 season after transferring from Louisiana Tech and leads BIG EAST in scoring during her first year as a Pirate with 18.0 points per game. Bozzella has had massive success bringing in impact transfers during his three seasons, with Aleesha Powell (Iona), Shakena Richardson (Florida State) and Daisha Simmons (Alabama) all earning All-Conference laurels after joining the program.



HEAD COACH ANTHONY BOZZELLA

- Has led The Hall to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015 and 2016, the first NCAA berths since 1995 and the third and fourth in the program's history.

- Has posted three-straight 20-win seasons at Seton Hall, boasting a 79-34 (.699) record over his three-plus seasons as head coach.

- Named the 2015 BIG EAST Coach of the Year, the Maggie Dixon Division I Coach of the Year, and named one of 10 finalists for the Naismith Division I Women's College Coach of the Year award.

- Guided Seton Hall to the first regular season BIG EAST title in program history in 2014-15.

- His SHU teams have posted three of the top-five scoring seasons in program history, scoring a record 2,569 points in 2014-15.

- Took an Iona program that was mired in 20-straight losing seasons and went to the postseason five times, reaching the MAAC title game on three occasions

- At Southampton, he took a team that never had a winning record and guided them to six-straight postseason appearances.

- Guided LIU-Brooklyn to the NEC Championship and the NCAA Tournament in just his first season despite inheriting a program that had never posted a winning record prior to his arrival.

ROOKIE REWARDS

- Shadeen Samuels was named BIG EAST Rookie of the Week on Dec. 12, becoming the third Pirate in three weeks to win the award

- Deja Winters (Dec. 5) and Kaela Hilaire (Nov. 28) received the honor in prior weeks

- Winters and Hilaire became the first pair of teammates to win the award in back-to-back weeks since 2011, while the trio winning in three-straight marks a first for the BIG EAST since UConn's Tamika Williams, Ashja Jones and Swin Cash in 1998-99

RUN PIRATES, RUN!

- So far this season, The Hall is out-scoring opponents 116-96 in fast break points

- Against both Savannah State (Nov. 11) and Boston College (Nov. 17), Seton Hall did not allow a single fast break point against

- The Pirates have allowed single-digit fast break points in nine of 13 contests

BIRDIE ON THE BLOCKS LIST

- Lubirdia Gordon now has 104 career blocks, tops among active players in the BIG EAST

- She became the eighth player in Seton Hall history to eclipse the century-mark in blocks on Dec. 18

- Gordon's 74 blocks in 2015-16 were the second-most in a single-season in program history

EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

- After being picked fifth in the BIG EAST and graduating four starters last season, the Pirates finished tied for second in the final league standings

- In each of its three seasons under Bozzella, Seton Hall has out-paced preseason projections

FRESH FACES

- Overall, nine of the 14 Pirates to see time this season are playing for Seton Hall for the first time

- Eight different Pirates have scored in double-figures in a game this season, with six doing so for the first time in their respective SHU careers

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS
