The programs are meeting for the ninth consecutive season since the Franciscan Cup trophy was devised by the schools' Presidents to commemorate the annual renewal of the rivalry St. Bonaventure has won five of the first eight official Franciscan Cup matchups Six of the eight Franciscan Cup matchups have been decided by single digits including four by three points or less

The programs met 25 times from 1939-61, with the Bonnies nationally ranked in six games Siena lost the first 17 road games in the series before breaking through in 2014

Seventh Season as a Head Coach 104-100 (.510)

> First Season at Siena 3-5 (.375)



Was introduced as the 17th head coach in Siena Basketball history on May 2

36-year-old piloted Mount St. Mary's to 101 wins and a 67-39 (.632) record in the Northeast Conference in six seasons leading his alma mater

Guided the Mount to a pair of NEC Tournament Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2014 and 2017, highlighted by a First Four victory over New Orleans in 2017

Tabbed both the 2016–17 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year – named after his legendary predecessor whom he played for at the Mount - and CollegeInsider.com's Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year, presented annually to the top Division I minority coach

The Mount achieved a stellar 60-19 (.759) overall home record at Knott Arena during his tenure, and was the only NEC program to post a winning conference record in each of Christian's six seasons in Emmitsburg

Previously served as an assistant coach at VCU (2011–12), William & Mary (2008–11), and Division III Emory & Henry (2004–06), and as director of basketball operations at Bucknell (2006-08)

Three-time team captain at Mount St. Mary's under Phelan and Milan Brown amassed 581 points in 90 career games, including 56 starts

Quinton, Virginia native was married to his wife, Allie, who played softball at Mount St. Mary's, just three days after his hiring at Siena, and is the proud father of a six-year-old son, Jacoy

Siena returns to the road for three of its next four games

The Saints have posted two wins away from home so far this season, including a true road win at A-10 foe George Washington Siena snapped an 11-game road losing streak with their victory over the Colonials on Nov. 8 in the nation's capital The victory was the Saints' first on the road since Dec. 17 of last season at Bryant

Freshman guard Jalen Pickett was named both the MAAC Player and Rookie of the Week Monday

He became just the fourth MAAC freshman in the past 32 years to earn the conference's Player of the Week honors

Schadrac Casimir (Iona - Dec. 15, 2014), Darrell Barley (Canisius - Jan. 24, 1994), and Lionel Simmons (La Salle - Dec. 21,
1986) are the the only other freshmen to be named MAAC Player of the Week since 1986

Pickett also repeated as MAAC Rookie of the Week for the second straight week

Pickett averaged a double-double with 20.5 points and 10.5 assists against CAA contender Hofstra and Ivy favorite Harvard
Pickett posted career-highs and his first collegiate double-double with 27 points and 13 assists against the Pride
He is the only player nationally to reach both marks in a game so far this season per sports-reference.com
Pickett ranks eighth nationally in assists (7.1), 27th in steals (2.4), and 48th in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.17)
He also ranks third in the MAAC in both scoring (16.6) and threes (20), fourth in blocks (0.9), and sixth in FG% (.490)
Siena ranks in the top-10 nationally in both fewest fouls per game and fewest turnovers per game
The Saints rank fourth nationally, committing just 14.1 fouls per contest
Siena ranked 304th nationally in fouls last season, averaging 20.0 per game
The Saints and Holy Cross combined to go 0-3 from the free throw line on Nov. 18
Per stats.com, it was the first game in which neither team made a free throw dating back to at least the start of 1996-97
Robert Morris (2) and Central Connecticut (0) combined to attempt just two free throws on Feb. 14, 2015
It marked the first time in 18 years that Siena failed to make a free throw in a game

The Saints rank seventh nationally, averaging only 9.4 turnovers per game

Siena ranked 325th out of 351 Division I teams last season, averaging 15.1 turnovers per contest

The Saints also lead the MAAC and rank 30th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.44

Siena was 12th worst nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio last season (0.73)

The Saints rank second in the MAAC averaging 8.9 made threes per game Siena averaged just 6.9 threes per game last season

The Saints made 10 or more threes in each of their first three games to open the season

It marked the first time that Siena made 10 or more threes in three consecutive games since accomplishing the feat in four straight contests from Jan. 15-25, 2001 vs. Iona (14), at Saint Peter's (10), vs. Canisius (14), and vs. Manhattan (11)

The Saints averaged 12.0 threes while shooting 39.1% (36-92) from distance over their first three games

However, Siena is averaging just 7.0 threes while shooting only 27.8% (35-126) over the past five games

The Saints are shooting 65% (67–103) on two-point field goal attempts over the past three games However, Siena is shooting just 30.6% (22–72) from three-point range over that time Overall, the Saints are shooting 50.9% from the floor over their past three games

The combined overall record of the five teams that Siena has lost to is 27–13 (.675)

All five teams currently possess winning records

Siena's roster ranks sixth nationally with an average height of nearly 6-5, according to kenpom.com

The Saints have started the same lineup in all eight games so far this season, which features an average height of over 6-7

The Saints are looking to improve upon last year's 8-24 overall record in which they finished tied for 10th in the MAAC at 4-14

Siena played the 36th toughest non-conference schedule nationally

The Saints played six games vs. teams ranked in the top-100 of the final RPI report

Fourteen of Siena's 23 games were decided by five points or fower (F-0), including eight by one possession (4-4)

Fourteen of Siena's 32 games were decided by five points or fewer (5-9), including eight by one possession (4-4)

The Saints lost three games by one point

Siena set a program record with five overtime contests, including a pair of triple overtime affairs
The Saints used 19 different starting lineup combinations
Twelve of the 15 players who saw game action each made at least one start, although no player started every game
Siena enters the 2018-19 season without its top-six scorers from a year ago
Three of the Saints' top-six scorers transferred, two more left the program, and rising junior guard Khalil Richard suffered a season-ending significant partial tear of the quadriceps tendon in his right knee during a preseason scrimmage at UMass Oct. 20 Richard was the team's top returning scorer after averaging 9.2 points last season Siena returns just 28% of its total points, 30% of its assists, 35% of its minutes, and 38% of its rebounding

Fisher is the Saints' top returnee after averaging 7.8 points and 4.9 rebounds in a team-high 28 starts

Siena welcomes eight newcomers to its 17-man roster

Syracuse transfer **Braedon Bayer** becomes the first graduate transfer in program history **Don Carey** (Mount St. Mary's), **Jimmy Ratliff** (North Alabama), and **Denzel Tchougang** (Cypress College) all join the program as transfers, with Ratliff and Tchougang both eligible to play immediately

The newcomers are highlighted by four true freshmen including **Sloan Seymour**, who's father, Steve, was an assistant coach at Siena from 2001-04, and was previously the head coach at Drexel (1999-01)

The Saints were projected to finish 11th (last) according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll

Signal's coaching striff in the covernth youngest in Division Levith an average are of 15 years.

Siena's coaching staff is the seventh youngest in Division I, with an average age of 35 years, 174 days as of the season opener Christian and each of his three assistant coaches are all 40 years of age or younger Voungest Coaching Staffs

The 36-year old Christian enters his seventh season as a head coach, after first entering the head coaching ranks at his alma mater Mount St. Mary's at just 30

Christian was recently named one of 30 up-and-coming coaches to keep an eye on **Team** by The Athletic

Christian is the architect of "Mayhem"

The style features a pressure defense predicated on limiting threes and an offense fueled by three-point shooting

Last season Christian's Mount St. Mary's squad led the NEC and ranked 19th nationally in threes (10.1), 34th in turnover margin (+2.7), and 49th in three-point field goal percentage (.379)

Last season Siena ranked 250th in threes (6.9), and 342nd out of 351 teams in turnover margin (-4.2), albeit ranked 89th in three-point field goal percentage (.367)

### Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena enters its 29th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 22nd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 21 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,968 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools such

as Boston College, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,807 by more than 1,100 fans Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,390,773 fans (an average of 6,514) over 367 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions Siena boasts a 241-126 (.657) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 226-104 (.685) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

Recorded first 11 career double digit scoring performances during breakthrough junior season

Led Siena in rebounding a team-high 11 times last season
