Was introduced as the 17th head coach in Siena Basketball history on May 2

Named one of 30 up-and-coming coaches to keep an eye on by The Athletic

36-year-old piloted Mount St. Mary's to 101 wins and a 67-39 (.632) record in the Northeast Conference in six seasons leading his alma mater

Guided the Mount to a pair of NEC Tournament Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2014 and 2017, highlighted by a First Four victory over New Orleans in 2017

Tabbed both the 2016-17 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year - named after his legendary predecessor whom he played for at the Mount - and CollegeInsider.com's Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year, presented annually to the top Division I minority coach

The Mount achieved a stellar 60–19 (.759) overall home record at Knott Arena during his tenure, and was the only NEC program to post a winning conference record in each of Christian's six seasons in Emmitsburg

Previously served as an assistant coach at VCU (2011-12), William & Mary (2008-11), and Division III Emory & Henry (2004-06), and as director of basketball operations at Bucknell (2006-08)

Three-time team captain at Mount St. Mary's under Phelan and Milan Brown amassed 581 points in 90 career games, including 56 starts

Quinton, Virginia native was married to his wife, Allie, who played softball at Mount St. Mary's, just three days after his hiring at Siena, and is the proud father of a six-year-old son, Jacoy

Siena continues its season long four-game homestand this afternoon

The Saints had there three-game winning streak at the Times Union Center snapped with Wednesday's loss to Iona
This is Siena's first four-game regular season homestand since Dec. 23, 2009 - Jan. 2, 2010 (won all four games)
This is tied for the Saints' longest regular season homestand since playing five straight in the Capital Region from Jan. 3-21, 1996
Siena enters today's contest tied for third in the MAAC Standings with Quinnipiac, with five league games remaining
The Saints would end the weekend in a tie for first place with a win today, coupled with losses by both Canisius and Monmouth
Siena was tied for the ninth greatest turnaround in the nation (+8.5) entering this week
The Saints have achieved a five-win improvement from last season, while also doubling
Their MAAC win total

Siena was predicted to finish last according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, after finishing tied for last in 2017-18 with an 8-24 overall record including a 4-14 MAAC mark Siena saw its season long four-game winning streak snapped by Iona Wednesday night Matched longest winning streak since winning five straight from Feb. 26 - Mar. 8, 2010 The Saints won four straight to open February to mark the program's best start to the

month since winning seven straight to open Feb. 2007
Siena enters play today having won seven of their last nine overall
The Saints rank 26th in the nation in scoring D allowing a program Division I best 64.1 points
Siena's previous Division I low for points per game allowed was 65.3 in 1984-85
This marks the Saints' best scoring defense in 54 years since allowing 62.6 in 1964-65
Siena has allowed an average of just 57.1 points over its past 15 games on only 41.8%

Shooting including 30.3% from three

The Saints had allowed an average of 73.7 points one 52% shooting including 44.1% from three over their first 11 games Siena ranked fifth worst nationally in field goal defense and second worst in three-point defense at that time

The Saints have held their opponents to 70 points or less in 15 straight games, marking the program's longest stretch since a 17-game streak from Dec. 8, 1992 - Feb. 10, 1993

The Saints swept the MAAC's weekly awards for the third time this season on Monday

Evan Fisher was named MAAC Player of the Week for the second time

Freshman Jalen Pickett was named MAAC Rookie of the Week for the eighth time

Pickett matches Iona's **Schadrac Casimir** (2014–15) for the most MAAC Rookie of the Week awards since Fairfield's **Derek Needham** won the honor a league record-tying 10 times (**Lionel Simmons**, LaSalle: 1986–87) during the 2009–10 season
Pickett swept the MAAC Weekly Awards on Dec. 3, becoming just the third league freshman in 32 years to be Player of the Week Siena has won seven true road games this season, which marks the program's most since winning nine during the 2009–10 season
The Saints have won three straight road games, and five of their last six away from home overall Siena won just one true road game last season, and had lost 11 straight prior to a Nov. 8 victory at George Washington
The Saints snapped an 11–game MAAC road losing streak spanning exactly 23 months with their win at Marist Jan. 11

Siena is 6–2 in games decided by three points or less
The Saints have won three straight on the road by two points apiece
Pickett ranks amongst the national leaders in assists (6.1 – 18th), steals (2.0 – 51st), and assist–to–turnover ratio (2.30 – 56th) **Defensive Comparison First 11 Games**

Pickett leads the MAAC in both assists and assist-to-turnover ratio, and also ranks second in the MAAC in steals, eighth in scoring (14.3), and eighth in threes (51)

Pickett needs 75 points (minimum six games left) to break Siena's freshman scoring record of 447 by Nico Clareth (2015–16)

Fisher has enjoyed a breakout season, and combined with Pickett to provide the Saints with a formidable one-two punch The duo has combined to account for 62% of the Saints' assists, 47% of the scoring, and 34% of the rebounding Fisher ranks sixth in the MAAC in scoring (15.9), rebounding (6.1), and field goal percentage (.502)

Fisher has tallied 382 points in 24 games this season, after totaling just 348 over 97 games spanning his first three seasons Siena boasts two of the MAAC's top-three freshmen scorers in Pickett and Sloan Seymour (9.0)

Seymour leads the MAAC overall and ranks eighth nationally amongst Division I freshmen with 73 threes Seymour needs just four threes to break Siena's freshman record of 76 set by Scott Knapp in 1997–98

The Saints rank amongst the national leaders in both fewest fouls and turnovers Siena has committed the third fewest fouls nationally (14.0), after ranking

The Saints also lead the MAAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.19 - 77th nationally)
after ranking 12th worst nationally in the statistic last season (0.73)
Siena is on pace to likely break the program records for both threes and attempts
The Saints are on pace to shatter the program record for attempts (722 in 2001102) and and challenge for the school record in makes (283 in 1998-99)
Head coach Jamion Christian has amassed a 75-44 (.630) conference record over his seven seasons as a head coach
Including postseason play, he has led his programs to an 84-48 (.636) record and won NEC Tournaments titles in 2014 and 2017
Christian has guided his programs to a 28-11 (.718) mark following Jan. 15 the past three seasons
Christian has fallied a 19-7 (.731) record in his first seasons at both Siena and Mount St. Mary's following Jan. 15
The Saints wrapped up the non-conference eportion of their schedule with a 5-8 record
It marked the program's most non-conference victories since going 7-4 in 2015-16
The Seven non-conference opponents Siena lost to are a combined 15-68 (.628)
Siena and Holy Cross met twice (first time played same team twice in non-conference competition

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 29th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 22nd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 21 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,968 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools such as Boston College, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,807 by more than 1,100 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,436,685 fans (an average of 6,498) over 375 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 245-130 (.653) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 230-108 (.680) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98




