Was introduced as the 17th head coach in Siena Basketball history on May 2

36-year-old piloted Mount St. Mary's to 101 wins and a 67-39 (.632) record in the Northeast Conference in six seasons leading his alma mater

Guided the Mount to a pair of NEC Tournament Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2014 and 2017, highlighted by a First Four victory over New Orleans in 2017

Tabbed both the 2016-17 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year - named after his legendary predecessor whom he played for at the Mount - and CollegeInsider.com's Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year, presented annually to the top Division I minority coach

The Mount achieved a stellar 60-19 (.759) overall home record at Knott Arena during his tenure, and was the only NEC program to post a winning conference record in each of Christian's six seasons in Emmitsburg

Previously served as an assistant coach at VCU (2011-12), William & Mary (2008-11), and Division III Emory & Henry (2004-06), and as director of basketball operations at Bucknell (2006-08)

Three-time team captain at Mount St. Mary's under Phelan and Milan Brown amassed 581 points in 90 career games, including 56 starts

Quinton, Virginia native was married to his wife, Allie, who played softball at Mount St. Mary's, just three days after his hiring at Siena, and is the proud father of a six-year-old son, Jacoy

# QUICK HITS



Siena enters today's lone regular season meeting with MAAC preseason favorite Rider in a four-way tie for second in the standings. The Saints stand just a game back of frontrunner Monmouth with seven conference contests remaining. Siena was predicted to finish last according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, after finishing tied for last in 2017-18. The Saints have already achieved a four-win improvement from last year, including a three-win MAAC improvement. Siena is playing its best basketball of the season, having won six of its past seven games.

The Saints' only two losses over the past month have come at the hands of league-leader Monmouth. This marks the first time that Siena has won six games during a seven-game stretch since Jan. 7 - Jan. 30, 2016. A win today would mark the program's best eight-game stretch since winning eight of nine from Feb. 21 - Mar. 31, 2014. Siena is in search of a season-high fourth consecutive win today.

The Saints have posted two separate three-game winning streaks over the past month. A win today would match the program's longest winning streak since winning five straight from Feb. 26 - Mar. 8, 2010. Siena concludes a stretch today where it plays four of five away from home.

The Saints have won three of their first four road games during the stretch, and four of their last five away from home overall. Siena has won seven games away from home this season, including six true road victories. A victory today would mark the program's most true road wins since winning nine road games during the 2009-10 season. The Saints won just one true road game last season, and had lost 11 straight prior to their Nov. 8 victory at George Washington. Siena snapped an 11-game MAAC road losing streak spanning exactly 23 months with their win at Marist Jan. 11.

The Saints open a season long four-game homestand Wednesday. Siena has ascended to 32nd nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 64.7 points. The Saints have allowed an average of just 57.1 points over the past 13 games, on only 42.7% shooting including 31.4% from three.

Siena had allowed an average of 73.7 points on 52% shooting including 44.1% from three over their first 11 games this season.

The Saints ranked fifth worst nationally in field goal defense and second worst in three-point defense at that time.

Siena has held the opposition to 70 points or less in 13 straight games, marking the program's longest stretch since a 17-game streak from Dec. 8, 1992 - Feb. 10, 1993.

Head coach **Jamion Christian** has amassed a 74-43 (.632) conference record over his seven seasons as a head coach.

Including postseason play, he has led his programs to an 83-47 (.638) record and won NEC Tournaments titles in 2014 and 2017. Christian has posted a winning conference record in each of his first six full seasons as a head coach.

Christian has guided his programs to a 27-10 (.730) mark following Jan. 15 the past three seasons. Christian has tallied an 18-6 (.750) record in his first seasons at both Siena and Mount St. Mary's following Jan. 15.

Siena has been led this season by standout freshman point guard **Jalen Pickett**.

Pickett has been MAAC Rookie of the Week a league-high seven times, including five straight weeks from Dec. 31 - Jan. 28.

This week marked the first time that Pickett had not been named MAAC Rookie of the Week since Christmas Eve.

Pickett has won the most MAAC Rookie of the Week awards since **Schadrac Casimir** of Iona won eight times in 2014-15.

**Kenny Hasbrouck** holds the Siena record with eight MAAC Rookie of the Week awards in 2005-06, while the league record is 10 shared by **Derek Needham** of Fairfield (2009-10) and **Lionel Simmons** of LaSalle (1986-87).

Pickett swept both MAAC Player and Rookie of the Week honors Dec. 3, becoming just the fourth freshman in the past 32 years to earn the conference's Player of the Week honors joining Casimir (Iona - Dec. 15, 2014), **Darrell Barley** (Canisius - Jan. 24, 1994), and Simmons (La Salle - Dec. 21, 1986).

Pickett ranks amongst the national leaders in assists (6.2 - 19th), steals (2.0 - 50th), and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.29 - 68th). Pickett leads the MAAC in both assists and assist-to-turnover ratio.

Pickett is also third in the MAAC in steals, eighth in scoring (14.8), and ninth in threes (4.7).

Senior **Evan Fisher** has enjoyed a breakout season, and combined with Pickett to provide the Saints with a formidable one-two punch.

The duo has combined to account for 62% of the Saints' assists, 47% of the scoring, and 34% of the rebounding.

Fisher was named MAAC Player of the Week for the first time in his career on Dec. 31.

Fisher ranks fifth in the MAAC in both rebounding (6.1) and field goal percentage (.514), and sixth in scoring (15.6).

Fisher has tallied 344 points in 22 games this season, after totaling just 348 over 97 games spanning his first three seasons.

Siena boasts two of the MAAC's top-three freshmen scorers in Pickett and **Sloan Seymour** (9.0).

Seymour ranks second in the MAAC with 67 made threes.

**Scott Knapp** holds Siena's freshman record with 76 threes in 1997-98.

Siena ranks in the top-10 nationally in both fewest fouls and turnovers.

Siena stands fourth nationally, averaging just 14.0 fouls per contest.

The Saints ranked 304th nationally in fouls last season, averaging 20.0.

Siena and Holy Cross combined to go 0-3 from the foul line on Nov. 18.

Per stats.com, it was the first game in which neither team made a free throw dating back to at least the start of 1996-97.

Robert Morris (2) and Central Connecticut (0) combined to attempt just two free throws on Feb. 14, 2015.

It marked the first time in 18 years that the Saints failed to make a free throw in a game.

Siena ranks 10th nationally averaging only 10.3 turnovers per game.

The Saints have committed 15 turnovers or fewer in every game so far this season.

The Saints ranked 325th out of 351 Division I teams last season, averaging 15.1 turnovers per contest.

Siena also leads the MAAC and ranks 76th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.20.

The Saints ranked 340th nationally last season with a 0.73 assist-to-turnover ratio.

Siena possesses three of the top-10 players in the MAAC in three-point makes.

Seymour ranks second with his 67 makes, while Pickett is ninth (47), and **Kevin Degnan** stands tied for 10th (46).

The Saints rank second in the MAAC and 78th nationally averaging 8.8 made threes per game, after making just 6.9 last season.

Siena made 10 or more threes in each of their first three games to open the season.

It marked the first time that the Saints made 10 or more threes in three consecutive games since accomplishing the feat in four straight contests from Jan. 15-25, 2001 vs. Iona (14), at Saint Peter's (10), vs. Canisius (14), and vs. Manhattan (11).

Siena is in the program's milestone 30th season of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference competition.

The Saints have won at least a share of seven MAAC Regular Season Championships, and captured five tournament titles.

Siena was predicted to finish 11th (last) according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

The Saints are without their top-six scorers from last year's team which was 8-24 overall and tied for 10th in the MAAC at 4-14.

Three of the top-six scorers transferred, two more left the program, and rising junior guard **Khalil Richard** suffered a season-ending significant partial tear of the quadriceps tendon in his right knee during a preseason scrimmage at UMass Oct. 20.

Richard was to be the team's top returning scorer after averaging 9.2 points last season.

Siena returned just 28% of its total points, 30% of its assists, 35% of its minutes, and 38% of its rebounding from last season.

Fisher is the Saints' top returnee after averaging 7.8 points and 4.9 rebounds in a team-high 28 starts in 2017-18.

Siena welcomes nine newcomers to its 18-man roster.

The Saints wrapped up the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 5-8 record.

Most non-conference victories since going 7-4 in 2015-16.

Seven non-conference opponents Siena lost to are a combined 108-62 (.635).

Non-conference wins over league leaders Harvard, Norfolk State and Robert Morris.

Siena and Holy Cross met twice in non-conference action.

It was the first time that the Saints played the same non-conference team

twice in the same season since 2013-14 (Purdue).

Siena's roster ranks sixth nationally with an average height of nearly 6-5, according to kenpom.com.

Siena's coaching staff is the seventh youngest in Division I, with an average age of 35

years, 174 days as of the season opener.

Head coach **Jamion Christian** and each of his three assistants are all 40 or younger.

The 36-year old Christian enters his seventh season as a head coach, after first

entering the head coaching ranks at his alma mater Mount St. Mary's at just 30.

Christian was one of 30 up-and-coming coaches to keep an eye on by The Athletic.

Christian is the architect of "Mayhem".

The style features a pressure defense predicated on limiting threes, and an offense fueled by three-point shooting.

Last season Christian's Mount St. Mary's squad led the NEC and ranked 19th nationally in threes (10.1), 34th in turnover margin

(+2.7), and 49th in three-point field goal percentage (.379).

## Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 29th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 22nd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 21 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351

Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,968 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools such as Boston College, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,807 by more than 1,100 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,431,125 fans (an average of 6,500) over 374 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 245-129 (.655) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 230-107

(.682) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009-10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002-03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2018-19 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and final time during a five-year agreement from 2015-19
