Was introduced as the 17th head coach in Siena Basketball history on May 2

Named one of 30 up-and-coming coaches to keep an eye on by The Athletic

36-year-old piloted Mount St. Mary's to 101 wins and a 67-39 (.632) record in the Northeast Conference in six seasons leading his alma mater

Guided the Mount to a pair of NEC Tournament Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2014 and 2017, highlighted by a First Four victory over New Orleans in 2017

Tabbed both the 2016-17 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year - named after his legendary predecessor whom he played for at the Mount - and CollegeInsider.com's Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year, presented annually to the top Division I minority coach

The Mount achieved a stellar 60-19 (.759) overall home record at Knott Arena during his tenure, and was the only NEC program to post a winning conference record in each of Christian's six seasons in Emmitsburg

Previously served as an assistant coach at VCU (2011-12), William & Mary (2008-11), and Division III Emory & Henry (2004-06), and as director of basketball operations at Bucknell (2006-08)

Three-time team captain at Mount St. Mary's under Phelan and Milan Brown amassed 581 points in 90 career games, including 56 starts

Quinton, Virginia native was married to his wife, Allie, who played softball at Mount St. Mary's, just three days after his hiring at Siena, and is the proud father of a six-year-old son, Jacoy

Siena concludes its regular season slate with the annual Western New York trip this weekend

The Saints are looking to snap a three-game losing streak in Western New York dating back to a sweep of the trip in 2015-16

Siena heads into the final weekend of the regular season with a chance to secure the program's eighth MAAC Regular Season title

The Saints enter tonight in a three-way tie for second with Quinnipiac and Rider, and just a half game back of frontrunner Iona

Siena would capture no worse than a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship with a sweep this weekend

The Saints would be no worse than the No. 3 seed with a sweep this weekend

Siena would clinch the No. 1 seed and regular season title outright with a sweep, Rider

win over Iona, and one loss by Quinnipiac

The Saints can still be seeded anywhere from 1-6 heading into the final weekend

Siena was picked to finish last according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll after finishing

tied for last place last season

The Saints are tied for the 10th greatest turnaround nationally (+8.5) as of Monday

Siena has achieved a seven-win improvement overall, and six-win MAAC improvement

The Saints posted an 8-24 overall record last season including a 4-14 mark in the MAAC

Jalen Pickett has been named MAAC Rookie of the Week a conference record-tying 10 times

Pickett is one of just 12 freshmen ever to win 10 or more conference rookie of the weeks

Pickett trails only **Jared Sullinger** of Ohio State (12 in 2010-11) and **Matt Witt** of Eastern

Kentucky (11 in 2002-03) for the most conference Rookie of the Week awards in NCAA history

Pickett is tied with **Derek Needham** of Fairfield (2009-10) and **Lionel Simmons** of La

Salle (1986-87) for the most MAAC Rookie of the Week awards in the league's 38-year history

Pickett swept the MAAC Weekly Awards on Dec. 3, becoming just the fourth league freshman in 32 years to be Player of the Week

Siena enters play winners of nine of their last 12

The Saints tied for the program's best February since going 7-1 in February 2007

Siena won four straight to open last month to match the program's longest

winning streak since winning five straight from Feb. 26 - Mar. 8, 2010

The Saints won each of their three February road games by two points apiece

Siena's seven true road wins this season mark the program's most since winning

nine during the 2009-10 season

The Saints have won five of their last six road games overall

Siena won just one true road game last season, and had lost 11 straight prior to a

Nov. 8 victory at George Washington

The Saints snapped an 11-game MAAC road losing streak spanning exactly 23

months with their win at Marist Jan. 11

Pickett ranks in the top-50 nationally in assists (6.6 - 10th), steals (2.1 - 37th), and

A/TO (2.58 - 37th)

Second among all freshmen in steals, third in assists, and seventh in A/TO ratio

Pickett leads the MAAC in both assists and A/TO, and also ranks second in steals,

seventh in blocks (0.8), eighth in scoring (15.4), and ninth in threes (58)

Broke Siena's freshman scoring record Sunday which now sits at 448 points

Needs five steals to break the freshman record of 64 (**Marquis Wright** in 2013-14)

The Saints rank 36th nationally in scoring D allowing a program DI record-low 65.2

Siena has allowed an average of just 60.0 points over past 18 games on 43.0% shooting (31.2% from three)

The Saints had allowed 73.7 points on 52% shooting (44.1% from three) over their first 11 games

Siena ranked fifth worst nationally in FGD and second worst in three-point FGD at that time

The Saints held the opposition to 70 points or fewer for 15 straight games from Dec. 22 - Feb. 13, marking the program's longest

stretch since a 17-game streak from Dec. 8, 1992 - Feb. 10, 1993

Senior **Evan Fisher** has combined with Pickett to form a formidable one-two punch

The duo has combined to for 64% of the Saints' assists and 47% of the scoring

A two-time MAAC Player of the Week, Fisher ranks tied for fifth in the MAAC in

scoring (15.7), and eighth in both rebounding (5.8) and field goal percentage (.492)

Fisher has tallied 423 points in 27 games this season, after totaling just 348 over

97 games spanning his first three seasons

Siena boasts two of the MAAC's top-four freshmen scorers in Pickett and **Sloan**

Seymour (8.8)

Seymour ranks third in the MAAC overall and stands eighth nationally amongst freshmen with 80 threes

Seymour broke Siena's freshman record for threes set by **Scott Knapp** (76 in 1997-98)

Seymour also ranks fifth in program single-season history for threes

The Saints rank amongst the national leaders in both fewest fouls and turnovers

Siena has committed the fourth fewest fouls nationally (14.1), after ranking 304th last year averaging 20.0

The Saints stands eighth nationally averaging just 10.0 turnovers per game, after ranking 325th nationally last season (15.1)

Siena has committed 15 turnovers or fewer in every game this season

The Saints have achieved a +6.0 turnover margin over the past seven games

The Saints also lead the MAAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.26 - 58th nationally)

after ranking 12th worst nationally in the statistic last season (0.73)

Siena has set a new program single-season record with 746 three-point attempts

The Saints are also 29 threes shy of the school record of 283 in 1998-99

Siena is 6-2 in games decided by three points or less

Head coach **Jamion Christian** has amassed a 77-45 (.631) conference record over his

seven seasons as a head coach

Including postseason play, he has led his programs to an 86-49 (.637) record

and won NEC Tournaments titles in 2014 and 2017

Christian has posted a winning conference record in each of his first seven seasons as a head coach

Christian has guided his programs to a 30-12 (.714) mark following Jan. 15 the past three seasons

Christian has tallied a 21-8 (.724) record in his first seasons at both Siena and Mount St. Mary's following Jan. 15

Quinnipiac defeated Siena 107-100 in an historic triple overtime affair Feb. 17 in Albany

The Bobcats' **Cameron Young** scored a MAAC record and 2018-19 DI high 55 points (third highest DI scoring effort this century)

Pickett posted the second highest scoring total in program history with 46 points

Pickett added 13 assists to become just the second player this century to put up 45-plus points and 10-plus assists in a game

LIU Brooklyn's **Antawn Dobie** scored 53 points and added 13 assists on Feb. 22, 2003 vs. St. Francis Brooklyn

Young and Pickett combined to score 101 points, which was the most by opposing players in a game since at least 1996-97

Pickett was named both the MAAC and CBS Sports/USBWA National Freshman of the Week for his efforts

Siena broke the century mark in scoring for the first time in 16 years

The Saints had a season-low four turnovers in 55 minutes of play, and rallied from a 20-point deficit with 12:55 left in regulation

The Saints wrapped up the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 5-8 record

It marked the program's most non-conference victories since going 7-4 in 2015-16

The seven non-conference opponents Siena lost to are a combined 129-75 (.632)

Siena and Holy Cross met twice (first time played same team twice in non-conference in same season since Purdue in 2013-14)

Siena is in the program's milestone 30th season of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference competition

The Saints have won at least a share of seven MAAC Regular Season Championships, and captured five tournament titles

The Saints are without their top-six scorers from last year's team which was 8-24 overall and tied for 10th in the MAAC at 4-14

Three of the top-six scorers transferred, two more left the program, and rising junior guard **Khalil Richard** suffered a

season-ending significant partial tear of the quadriceps tendon in his right knee during a preseason scrimmage at UMass Oct. 20

Richard was to be the team's top returning scorer after averaging 9.2 points last season

Siena returned just 28% of its total points, 30% of its assists, 35% of its minutes, and 38% of its rebounding from last season

Fisher is the Saints' top returnee after averaging 7.8 points and 4.9 rebounds in a team-high 28 starts in 2017-18

Siena welcomes nine newcomers to its 18-man roster

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 29th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 22nd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 21 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,968 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools such as Boston College, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,807 by more than 1,100 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,457,035 fans (an average of 6,500) over 378 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 247-131 (.653) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 232-109 (.680) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009-10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002-03)

The Saints are scheduled to host the 2018-19 MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center for the 19th time in 29 seasons, and final time during a five-year agreement from 2015-19
