Siena has won nine of the past 13 meetings overall, including five of the last seven in Albany The Saints' last four home wins have come by an average of 11.3 points Siena Head Coach **Carmen Maciariello** (2008–11) and assistant coach **Bob Simon** (2006–11) both previously served as assistants at Fairfield

Siena Basketball alumnus named 18th head coach in Program history on March 25th Division I assistant coach, which has

41-year-old native of nearby Clifton Park completed first season as an assistant coach in second stint on staff last season

Helped guide Siena to a 17-16 overall record including an 11-7 mark in the MAAC last season

Saints' 17 wins tied for the most of any MAAC team, and the squad's nine-win improvement was tied for the 11th best turnaround nationally. Siena finished in a tie for second place in the MAAC – placing nine spots higher than their preseason poll prediction – which tied UT Arlington for the largest improvement nationally.

Served as coordinator for Siena defense last season which ranked 42nd nationally allowing 66.0 points per game, the third best mark during the program's 43-year Division I era. Earlier last season, Maciariello's defense held the opposition to 70 points or fewer for 15 straight games, marking the program's longest such streak in 26 years.

First entered the collegiate ranks as Siena's director of basketball operations during the 2005-06 season under the direction of 2017 Siena Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Fran McCaffery

Graduated cum laude from Siena in 2001, while helping guide the Saints to 20 wins and a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship during his senior season, after having sat out the previous year per NCAA transfer regulations following his matriculation from the University of New Hampshire

Recently completed 11th season as a Division I assistant coach, which has included stops at Siena (2018-19), George Washington (2014-18), Boston University (2011-14), and Fairfield (2008-11)

Teams have made seven national postseason tournament appearances while averaging 20.5 wins and a .624 winning percentage, and has also helped guide his programs to a 124–70 (.639) conference mark and, including his time as an undergraduate at Siena, has won a conference regular season or postseason title at each school

Siena returns to the Capital Region to open its second of two season long four-game homestands at the Times Union Center tonight
The Saints are a perfect 9-0 in Albany this season, and are one of just 24 remaining Division I teams who are unbeated in thome
Steria's finine-game home win streads is the longest since over unlining a program record 38 stagisht from 2008-10-800
Steria is in the midst of a stretch where they play six of eight within the friendly confines of the Times Union Center
The Saints lead the MAMC in both scoring (73.8) and field goal percentage (4.450)
Steria is averaging 0.2 points per game more this year than they did last season

Siena routed American 96-80 in the season opener
The 96 points scored was the program's most in a season-opener in 35 years, dating back to a 110-64 thrashing of East
Stroudsburg to tip off the 1984-85 campaign
The 10-point margin of victory was the largest in a season-opener since an 82-52 triumph over Boise State in Albany to start the
2008-09 MAAC Championship season, and the largest margin by a coach in his Siena debut since Dan Cunha in 1941-42
The Saints' streak of 39 consecutive games committing 15 turnovers or fewer was snapped Nov. 14 at Harvard (17)
It was the first time Siena committed more than 15 turnovers since a triple overtime loss vs. Monmouth on Feb. 21, 2018
The Saints ranked eighth nationally last season averaging just 9.8 turnovers per game
Siena returns two starters and 10 letterwinners from last year's team
The Saints welcomed back 41% of their scoring and 40% of their rebounding from a year ago
Three of the team's top-four scorers from last season either graduated or transferred
Siena welcomes five newcomers to the program this season, including four true freshmen
Illinois State transfer Matt Hein becomes the program's third-ever graduate transfer, dating back to last season
Highly touted transfers Burns (Notre Dame) and Carey (Mount St. Mary's) are also set to don the Green and Gold for the first
time after sitting out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer regulations
A total of seven players and coaches from the 2019-20 roster hail from the Greater Capital Region
The Saints are under the direction of alumnus Carmen Maciariello 'of who was named the program's 18th head coach Mar. 25
Maciariello is Siena's third different head coach in three seasons
Maciariello is the first alumnus to lead the program since Bill Kirsch (1972-82)

The Saints are looking to build off last season's 17-16 overall record which included an 11-7 mark in the MAAC
Siena's nine-win improvement from the previous year was tied for the 11th best turnaround nationally

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena is in its 30th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 23rd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997–98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 22 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,767 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

Siena ranked 12th overall in the Northeast – and second amongst all Northeast midmajor teams – in average attendance last season, and stood 19th nationally amongst all mid-major programs in attendance

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools Boston College, California, Oregon State, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,659 by more than 1,000 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,521,207 fans (an average of 6,481) over 389 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 257-132 (.661) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 242-110 (.688) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98

In 2009–10, Siena established a new program record with 133,505 fans (an average of 7,853) for 17 home games, which ranked 66th nationally in tying for its highest national ranking ever (2002–03)

The Saints have hosted the MAAC Basketball Championships at the Times Union Center 20 times in their 30 years in the conference

Scored in double figures four times overall, and is averaging 7.0 points in six games as a starter
Carmen Maciariello's first official signing after being promoted to head coach
Enjoyed breakout performance at Adidas Gauntlet in April 2019, competing for the Cali Rebels AAU team
Averaged 17.3 points over seven games at the Adidas Gauntlet Première Showcase, while shooting 54% from the field including an even 50% from three
Scored 31 points and added seven rebounds vs. Play Ball Nation YIIS in the Adidas Gauntlet, and tallied 26 points on the strength of 7-11 shooting from three vs. Marcus Smart
Named First Team All-Prep Elite Conference after averaging 18 points and eight rebounds during 2018-19 season for Middlebrooks Academy
Played high school basketball at Frederick K.C. Price III Christian High, averaging 21.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 2.5 steals, and 1.4 blocks on his way to earning All-California Interscholastic and Team MVP acclaim during the 2017-18 season



Siena Basketball Head Coach **Carmen Maciariello** has announced his first official signings for the Saints' Class of 2024. **Aidan Carpenter, Colin Golson, and Bennett Kwiecinski** have all committed to Siena during the early signing period, and will enroll at the College next fall.

"In this class we looked to add versatility, and our three incoming Saints will be able to thrive in both our offensive and defensive systems," said Maciariello. "They all embody what we look for in a Siena Saint."

A 6-5, 185-pound guard, Carpenter is ranked the No. 1 recruit in Maine and No. 22 overall in the New England Class of 2020 according to the New England Recruiting Report. The Hamden, Connecticut native, who is playing for Dan Haynes at Lee Academy in Maine this year, was named the NEPSAC Player of the Year after averaging 24 points and five assists while leading Hyde School in Bath, Maine to the NEPSAC Class C Title last season. Carpenter plays his AAU basketball for Rhode Island Elite under the direction of coach Nick Light.

"Aidan is a big guard who can play either on or off the ball," explained Maciariello. "He has tremendous quickness, and thrives running the wing or pushing the ball. Defensively, he can guard multiple positions."

A 6-7, 235-pound forward from Detroit, Golson is set to suit up for Ferndale High and coach Juan Rickman this season after transferring from East English Village. He plays AAU for coach DeJon Curd of the REACH Legends.

"Colin is a big, athletic forward with a seven-foot wingspan," described Maciariello. "He can defend all positions on the court, and will add grit and power to our frontcourt."

A 6-8, 205-pound forward out of Wilmette, Illinois, Kwiecinski was named a Top-15 prospect in the Class of 2020 by the City/Suburban Hoops Report in Chicago. He attends Loyola Academy, where he averaged 13.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 1.8 blocks last season under the direction of Tim Livatino. Kwiecinski, who plays AAU for the Illinois Wolves and coach Mike Mullins, has a twin brother, Jordan, who also recently committed to playing Division I basketball at Drake University.

"Bennett will be able to play the three or four for us, and has a tremendous basketball IQ," noted Maciariello. "We love big wings, and he will provide us with a workmanlike approach to the game. He has the ability to stretch the defense with his shot, as well as put it on the floor."

"We welcome these young men and their families to our program," added Maciariello. "They are all special people who commit to being the best they can be daily."
