

Siena in the MAAC Tournament

Siena is making the program's 31st appearance in the MAAC Tournament since joining the league in 1989–90

The Saints have won five titles (1999, 2002, 2008, 2009, 2010), which is tied with Manhattan for second most (Iona – 12)

Siena has posted an impressive 39–25 (.609) MAAC Tournament record, which is second only to Iona (57–26, .687)

The Saints are 39–15 (.722) in MAAC Tournament games against all programs outside of Iona (0–10)

Siena is the No. 1 seed in the MAAC Tournament for the sixth time (1991, 2000, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2020)

The Saints are 12–2 as the No. 1 seed and won nine straight

Siena has won its past three of five titles as the No. 1 seed (2008, 2009, 2010)

The Saints are playing in the MAAC Tournament outside of Albany for just the 11th time, and first since 2014 (Springfield, MA)

Siena is 10-9 in MAAC Tournament games played outside of the Capital Region The Saints have only won one of their five MAAC Championships outside of Albany (Buffalo -1999)

Siena has posted a stellar 8–2 MAAC Tournament record vs. Manhattan
The Saints' eight MAAC Tournament wins over the Jaspers are their most vs. any program

With today's game, Siena will have played more MAAC Tournament games vs. Manhattan (11) than any other opponent The Saints have won eight straight MAAC Tournament games against the Jaspers
Siena is 20–8 (.714) all-time in the MAAC Quarterfinals

The Saints are a perfect 6-0 vs. Manhattan in the quarterfinal round

Siena is 23-7 (.767) all-time in MAAC Tournament openers, and won 11 of their last 13

The Saints are a perfect 5-0 all-time in the MAAC Tournament vs. #9 seeds Siena has won its five games vs. #9 seeds by an average of 15.4 points

Siena Basketball alumnus named 18th head coach in program history on March 25th

Division I assistant coach, which has birthed at the set of the coach in Division I assistant coach, which has birthed at the set of the coach in the coach in

41-year-old native of nearby Clifton Park completed first season as an assistant coach in second stint on staff last season

Helped guide Siena to a 17-16 overall record including an 11-7 mark in the MAAC last season

Saints' 17 wins tied for the most of any MAAC team, and the squad's nine-win improvement was tied for the 11th best turnaround nationally. Siena finished in a tie for second place in the MAAC – placing nine spots higher than their preseason poll prediction – which tied UT Arlington for the largest improvement nationally.

Served as coordinator for Siena defense last season which ranked 42nd nationally allowing 66.0 points per game, the third best mark during the program's 43-year Division I era. Earlier last season, Maciariello's defense held the opposition to 70 points or fewer for 15 straight games, marking the program's longest such streak in 26 years.

First entered the collegiate ranks as Siena's director of basketball operations during the 2005-06 season under the direction of 2017 Siena Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Fran McCaffery

Graduated cum laude from Siena in 2001, while helping guide the Saints to 20 wins and a share of the MAAC Regular Season Championship during his senior season, after having sat out the previous year per NCAA transfer regulations following his matriculation from the University of New Hampshire


Recently completed 11th season as a Division I assistant coach, which has included stops at Siena (2018-19), George Washington (2014-18), Boston University (2011-14), and Fairfield (2008-11)

Teams have made seven national postseason tournament appearances while averaging 20.5 wins and a .624 winning percentage, and has also helped guide his programs to a 124–70 (.639) conference mark and, including his time as an undergraduate at Siena, has won a conference regular season or postseason title at each school

Siena begins its quest for a sixth MAAC Tournament Championship

The Saints have won five MAAC Tournament Championships (1999, 2002, 2008, 2009, 2010)

Siena secured the program's eighth MAAC Regular Season Championship and fourth outright

Siena was projected to finish sixth according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll

The Saints have now won MAAC Regular Season Championships in 1990-91 (share), 1998-99 (share), 1999-00, 2000-01 (share),

2007-08 (share), 2008-09, 2009-10, and 2019-20 since joining the conference in 1989-90 (31 seasons)

Siena has clinched the MAAC's automatic bid to the NIT should they not win the MAAC Tournament Championship

The Saints enter the MAAC Tournament riding a nine-game winning streak which is tied for the third longest in program history Overall, Siena has won 12 of its last 13, with its only loss coming on the road at second place Saint Peter's by five points The Saints' nine-game win streak is the longest since winning a program record 15 straight from Dec. 23, 2009 - Feb. 8, 2010 Siena is allowing just 60.2 points during its nine-game win streak on just 39% shooting including only 26% from three

The Saints had allowed an average of 72.0 points on 45% shooting including 34% from three over their first 20 games Three Siena players were named All-MAAC selections in Jalen Pickett (First Team - unanimous), Manny Camper (First Team), and **Elijah Burns** (Second Team)

This marks just the fifth time in 31 years that the Saints have boasted multiple first team All-MAAC honorees, and first since a league-record three following the 2009-10 season in Alex Franklin (Player of the Year), Ronald Moore, and Ryan Rossiter

Pickett was named to both the Lou Henson Award Preseason and Midseason Watch Lists (top Division I mid-major player)

Pickett ranks seventh nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.23), 20th in assists (6.0), and 24th in minutes (36.9)

Pickett also stands fourth in the MAAC in scoring (15.3), seventh in blocks (1.1), and tied for ninth in threes (57)

Pickett needs only 50 more points to become the 45th member of the Siena Basketball 1,000 Point Club

The Saints are under the direction of alumnus **Carmen Maciariello 'o1** who was named the program's 18th head coach Mar. 25 Maciariello is Siena's third different head coach in three seasons

Maciariello is the first alumnus to lead the program since **Bill Kirsch** (1972–82)

The Saints are looking to build off last season's 17-16 overall record which included an 11-7 mark in the MAAC

Siena's nine-win improvement from the previous year was tied for the 11th best turnaround nationally

The Saints' 17 wins were tied for the most of any MAAC team

Siena is in its 30th season of competition at the Times Union Center, and 23rd since making the full-time move to downtown Albany in 1997-98

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance in each of the past 22 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move to the TUC

Siena ranked 94th nationally out of 351 Division I programs in attendance last season, drawing an average of 5,767 fans over 16 home dates at the Times Union Center

Siena ranked 12th overall in the Northeast – and second amongst all Northeast mid-major teams – in average attendance last season, and stood 19th nationally amongst all mid-major programs in attendance

The Saints' average attendance last season out-drew power five conference schools Boston College, California, Oregon State, Stanford, USC, and Washington State, and exceeded the overall Division I national average of 4,659 by more than 1,000 fans

Siena has drawn a grand total of 2,554,577 fans (an average of 6,484) over 394 dates at the Times Union Center

The Saints welcomed their 2-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 against Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions

Siena boasts a 262-132 (.665) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a 247-110 (.692) mark since making the full-time move to the facility in 1997-98. The Saints won a program record 38 straight games at the Times Union Center from 2008-10.



Siena Basketball Head Coach **Carmen Maciariello** has announced his first official signings for the Saints' Class of 2024. **Aidan Carpenter, Colin Golson, and Bennett Kwiecinski** have all committed to Siena during the early signing period, and will enroll at the College next fall.

"In this class we looked to add versatility, and our three incoming Saints will be able to thrive in both our offensive and defensive systems," said Maciariello. "They all embody what we look for in a Siena Saint."

A 6-5, 185-pound guard, Carpenter is ranked the No. 1 recruit in Maine and No. 22 overall in the New England Class of 2020 according to the New England Recruiting Report. The Hamden, Connecticut native, who is playing for Dan Haynes at Lee Academy in Maine this year, was named the NEPSAC Player of the Year after averaging 24 points and five assists while leading Hyde School in Bath, Maine to the NEPSAC Class C Title last season. Carpenter plays his AAU basketball for Rhode Island Elite under the direction of coach Nick Light.

"Aidan is a big guard who can play either on or off the ball," explained Maciariello. "He has tremendous quickness, and thrives running the wing or pushing the ball. Defensively, he can guard multiple positions."

A 6-7, 235-pound forward from Detroit, Golson is set to suit up for Ferndale High and coach Juan Rickman this season after transferring from East English Village. He plays AAU for coach DeJon Curd of the REACH Legends.

"Colin is a big, athletic forward with a seven-foot wingspan," described Maciariello. "He can defend all positions on the court, and will add grit and power to our frontcourt."

A 6-8, 205-pound forward out of Wilmette, Illinois, Kwiecinski was named a Top-15 prospect in the Class of 2020 by the City/Suburban Hoops Report in Chicago. He attends Loyola Academy, where he averaged 13.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 1.8 blocks last season under the direction of Tim Livatino. Kwiecinski, who plays AAU for the Illinois Wolves and coach Mike Mullins, has a twin brother, Jordan, who also recently committed to playing Division I basketball at Drake University.

"Bennett will be able to play the three or four for us, and has a tremendous basketball IQ," noted Maciariello. "We love big wings, and he will provide us with a workmanlike approach to the game. He has the ability to stretch the defense with his shot, as well as put it on the floor."

"We welcome these young men and their families to our program," added Maciariello. "They are all special people who commit to being the best they can be daily."
