Siena Basketball alumnus has led his alma mater to at least a share of back-to-back MAAC Regular Season Championships in his first two seasons.

Achieved the tied for second best 47-game head coaching start in Siena's storied history (Paul Hewitt: 33-14, Mike Deane: 32-15), and was tied for the fourth fastest coach in MAAC history to reach 30 overall wins (43 games).

Finalist for the 2020-21 Hugh Durham (top Division I mid-major coach) and Skip Prosser Man of the Year awards.

The only one of the 61 new Division I head coaching hires during the 2019-20 season to lead his team to an outright conference regular season championship.

Named one of the "Top-12 Most Immediately Successful Hires of the 2019-20 Season" by CBS Sports' Matt Norlander.

Became the first rookie head coach in program history to lead Siena to an outright MAAC Regular Season Championship in his first season, while his 20 wins tied for the most of any first-year Siena head coach.

Native of nearby Clifton Park, NY was promoted to be the 18th head coach in program history on Mar. 25, 2019.

On Mar. 26, the 43-year-old signed a three-year contract extension which runs through the 2025-26 season.

Maciariello and his wife, Laura, are the proud parents of a four-year-old daughter, Reese, and a son, Matteo, who celebrated his first birthday on May 12.

Siena returns to the Times Union Center where they continue a stretch playing three of four at home

This will be the team's second longest home stretch, trailing only a season-long three-game homestand set for Jan. 28 – Feb. 4. The Saints saw their 14-game Times Union Center winning streak snapped with Saturday's home-opening setback vs. Delaware.

The 14-game win streak was the second longest in program history at the Times Union Center (38 straight from 2008-10).

Siena had also won 16 straight regular season home games in Albany prior to Saturday.

The loss marked the program's first defeat at the Times Union Center since Mar. 10, 2019 (MAAC Semifinals vs. Iona), and first regular season loss since Feb. 17, 2019 vs. Quinnipiac.

The Saints played all of their 2020-21 home games on-campus at the UHY Center without spectators due to COVID-19.

Saturday's game was Siena's first regular season contest at the Times Union Center in 619 days.

Siena continues its challenging non-conference schedule to tip off the 2021-22 season.

The Saints face their third straight conference preseason favorite tonight (St. Bonaventure – A-10, Delaware – CAA, Yale – Ivy).

Siena next travels to defending BIG EAST Tournament Champion Georgetown Friday, before hosting Harvard, picked to finish second in the Ivy, to round out a grueling opening five games.

Siena has posted a 22-7 overall record (.758) overall record spanning the program's past 29 games.

The Saints tallied a program record-tying 16-game win streak from Feb. 7, 2020 – Jan. 16, 2021.

Siena won a school-record eight straight road games from Feb. 23, 2020 – Jan. 16, 2021.

The Saints are in search of at least a share of the program's third straight MAAC Regular Season Championship.

Siena is looking to complete the three-peat for the second time in school history (2008-10).

The Saints earned a share of the ninth MAAC Regular Season crown in program history in 2020-21.

Siena has achieved a 27-9 (.750) record in MAAC Regular Season action the past two seasons.

The Saints were predicted to finish eighth according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

Siena has captured the regular season crown after being picked sixth and first, respectively, the past two seasons.

The Saints return just three scholarship players from last year's MAAC Regular Season Co-Champions.

Siena welcomes back only 29% of its scoring, 26% of its rebounding, and 21% of its assists from last season's squad.

The program's returnees played just a collective 53 games (26 starts) in a Siena uniform entering this season.

The Saints welcome 10 newcomers to their 2021-22 roster, featuring six upperclassman transfers and four true freshmen.

Siena added Power Five conference transfers **Michael Baer** (Iowa), **Anthony Gaines** (Northwestern), and **Jordan Kellier** (Utah).

Cal Poly transfer **Colby Rogers** averaged 12.2 points last season as a sophomore.

The Saints achieved a 12-5 overall record last season, including a 12-4 league mark to claim a share of the regular season crown.

Siena overcame four separate COVID-19 pauses from Nov. 13 onward,

including a 21-day span between games in February.

The Saints were the second-to-last Division I team (Merrimack) who played to tip-off their season (Jan. 3).

Siena opened the season with six straight wins to tie for the fourth best start to a season in program history.

The Saints were ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll three times, reaching as high as 21st (preseason).

Siena ranked amongst the national leaders in scoring defense (63.0 – 22nd), field goal percentage defense (.409 – 42nd), and field goal percentage (.460 – 69th).

The Saints had three players earn All-MAAC honors, highlighted by MAAC Player of the Year **Manny Camper**.

Camper became the second straight Siena player to be named MAAC Player of the Year (**Jalen Pickett**).

Last Time Out: Delaware 83, Siena 63 (Nov. 13 - Albany, NY)

Delaware scored 22 unanswered points down the stretch to open a 30-point lead. The Blue Hens shot 55% from the field and held a 46-20 advantage in points in the paint.

Siena shot a stellar 9-14 (64%) from three, but just 13-41 from two (32%).

Colby Rogers scored a game-high 20 points for the Saints, connecting on 6-7 three-point attempts.

Jackson Stormo and **Anthony Gaines** narrowly missed double-doubles, posting nine points and eight rebounds and eight points and 10 caroms, respectively.

Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena Basketball achieved the highest average home attendance amongst all 56 Northeast mid-major programs during the 2019-20 season, according to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Attendance Report. Moreover, the Saints broke the top-100 nationally overall in attendance for the 23rd straight season, ranking 83rd overall out of 350 Division I programs with an average of 6,228 fans per game.

Siena leapfrogged Atlantic 10 foe Rhode Island for top billing in Division I Men's Basketball attendance amongst all Northeast mid-major programs during the 2019-20 season. The Northeast is comprised of nine states according to the United States Census Bureau: Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Vermont. Mid-major teams are defined as programs from the 25 conferences which do not comprise "high majors," which are the Power 5 (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, and SEC), AAC, and Big East.

Siena improved 11 spots in the national average attendance rankings this to finish 83rd overall in 2019-20, marking the program's highest mark in five years dating back to a ranking of 82nd for the 2014-15 season. The Saints have now ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance for each of the past 23 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move downtown beginning in 1997-98. Siena also stood 12th overall nationally in average home attendance amongst all 263 mid-major programs, an improvement of seven spots from the previous season.

The Saints' average attendance of 6,228 during the 2019-20 season at the Times Union Center was the program's highest mark in four years since averaging 6,269 fans in 2015-16, and outranked the NCAA average of 4,601 by more than 26%. Siena saw an increase in average home attendance of 461 spectators from the 2018-19 campaign, as the 7% improvement was the program's highest in 11 years since achieving a 14% increase in 2008-09 from the 2007-08 season. Additionally, the Saints boasted a pair of capacity crowds of 7,146 fans in 2019-20 against Manhattan (Feb. 16) and in the home finale vs. Niagara (Mar. 4).

Siena ranked third in average home attendance amongst the 22 Division I programs from the state of New York, trailing only national leader Syracuse and other high-major competitor St. John's. However, the Saints outranked 16 high-major programs nationally, including nine Power 5 teams in Boston College, California, Georgia Tech, Miami, Northwestern, Oregon State, Stanford, USC, and Washington State.

The stellar fan support helped propel Siena to a perfect 14-0 record at the Times Union Center in 2019-20, as the Saints were one of just 13 Division I teams nationally to go undefeated at home in 2019-20. Siena achieved an unblemished home mark for the third time in 23 seasons since making the full-time move downtown (17-0 in both 2008-09 and 2009-10), and the 14-game win streak in Albany marks the second longest in program history (38 straight between 2008-10). The Saints won by an average of 11.1 points per game at home in 2019-20, and trailed for a total of just 14:09 over their final seven games at the Times Union Center.

Siena has now drawn more than 2.5 million fans over 394 all-time games at the Times Union Center, dating back to the program's first home contest in the facility during the 1990-91 season. The Saints welcomed their two-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 vs. Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions. Siena holds a 262-133 (.663) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a stellar 247-111 (.690) mark since permanently making the facility its home beginning with the 1997-98 season.






