The home team has won every matchup, with five of the first six played at Siena

The Saints have averaged 80.5 points over the first six meetings

Bucknell won the lone previous meeting in Lewisburg 115-92 in 2017, with the 207 combined points marking the most in a Siena game in 17 years

**Carmen Maciariello** is 1-0 vs. Bucknell

**Nathan Davis** is 1-3 vs. Siena

### Last Meeting

Siena led wire-to-wire and by as much as 18

The Saints were 29-35 (83%) from the free throw line, while Bucknell was just 7-9

**Elijah Burns** scored 28 points on 10-13 shooting, and Siena outscored Bucknell by 30 when he was on the floor

**Jimmy Sotos** tallied 23 points, seven rebounds, and four steals for the Bison

## Carmen Maciariello

Siena '01

### Third Season

33-19 (.635)

Siena Basketball alumnus has led his alma mater to at least a share of back-to-back MAAC Regular Season Championships in his first two seasons

Achieved the tied for second best 47-game head coaching start in Siena's storied history at 32-15 (Paul Hewitt: 33-14, Mike Deane: 32-15), and was tied for the fourth fastest coach in MAAC history to reach 30 overall wins (43 games)

Finalist for the 2020-21 Hugh Durham (top Division I mid-major coach) and Skip Prosser Man of the Year awards

The only one of the 61 new Division I head coaching hires during the 2019-20 season to lead his team to an outright conference regular season championship

Named one of the "Top-12 Most Immediately Successful Hires of the 2019-20 Season" by CBS Sports' Matt Norlander

Became the first rookie head coach in program history to lead Siena to an outright MAAC Regular Season Championship in his first season, while his 20 wins tied for the most of any first-year Siena head coach.

Native of nearby Clifton Park, NY was promoted to be the 18th head coach in program history on Mar. 25, 2019

On Mar. 26, the 43-year-old signed a three-year contract extension which runs through the 2025-26 season

Maciariello and his wife, Laura, are the proud parents of a four-year-old daughter, Reese, and a son, Matteo, who celebrated his first birthday on May 12

# QUICK HITS



Siena returns to the road to begin a stretch where they play six of seven away from home to close out the 2021 calendar year

The Saints will play at home just once – Dec. 3 vs. Manhattan – over a 41-day span from Nov. 22 to Jan. 2

Siena closes out its non-conference slate with four road games – all against Patriot League foes

The Saints will go 17 days between games – Dec. 11 at Holy Cross to Dec. 28 at American – due to finals and the holiday break

This will mark the program’s longest in-season break in 39 years since going 18 days between games Dec. 11–29, 1982

Siena is looking to build off its first win of the season last time out vs. Harvard Monday night

The Saints snapped a six-game losing streak dating back to last season with their victory over the Crimson

Siena had been 22–3 over their previous 25 games immediately preceding their six-game losing streak

The Saints concluded a grueling season-opening five-game stretch Monday vs. Harvard

Siena opened with three straight games against conference preseason favorites (St. Bonaventure, Delaware, Yale)

The Saints’ fourth opponent – Georgetown – is the defending BIG EAST Tournament Champion

Perennial Ivy League power Harvard was picked to finish second in their preseason poll, just behind Yale

Siena plays its first afternoon game of the season today in Game #6

After nighttime tips in each of their first five games, six of the Saints’ next eight games are slated for afternoon starts

The Saints are 9–3 in their last 12 afternoon games (5 p.m. or earlier starts)

Siena snapped a mini two-game skid at the Times Union Center Monday night, after having won their previous 14

The Saints’ 14-game win streak was the second longest in program history at the Times Union Center (38 straight from 2008–10)

Siena had also won 16 straight regular season home games in Albany prior to their home-opening defeat

The home-opening loss vs. Delaware on Nov. 13 marked the program’s first defeat at the Times Union Center since Mar. 10, 2019 (MAAC Semifinals vs. Iona), and first regular season loss since Feb. 17, 2019 vs. Quinnipiac

The Saints played all of their 2020–21 home games on-campus at the UHY Center without spectators due to COVID-19

The home-opener was Siena’s first regular season contest at the Times Union Center in 619 days

The Saints officially welcomed local Guilderland standout and North Carolina transfer **Andrew Platek** on Nov. 16

Platek received multiple waivers from the NCAA, and was granted eligibility for a fifth and final season beginning Nov. 19

Platek received his first waiver on Oct. 25, and began practicing with the team on Oct. 27

Platek has averaged 10.5 points and 3.0 assists in 20.5 minutes off the bench spanning his first two games

Platek appeared in 124 games (11 starts) over four seasons with the Tar Heels, averaging 2.6 points in 10.5 minutes of action

The Saints have been led by the one-two punch of **Colby Rogers** and **Jackson Stormo** early on this season

A first-year transfer from Cal Poly, Rogers ranks ninth in the MAAC averaging 14.6 points

Rogers is shooting at a torrid 47.2% clip from three-point range (17–36), which ranks 43rd nationally

Stormo adds 12.8 points, while ranking fourth in the MAAC in rebounding (7.8) and fifth in blocks (1.2)

The Saints are in search of at least a share of the program’s third straight MAAC Regular Season Championship

Siena is looking to complete the three-peat for the second time in school history (2008–10)

The Saints earned a share of the ninth MAAC Regular Season crown in program history in 2020–21

Siena has achieved a 27–9 (.750) record in MAAC Regular Season action the past two seasons

The Saints were predicted to finish eighth according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches’ Poll

Siena has captured the regular season crown after being picked sixth and first, respectively, the past two seasons

The Saints return just three scholarship players from last year’s MAAC Regular Season Co-Champions

Siena welcomes back only 29% of its scoring, 26% of its rebounding, and 21% of its assists from last season’s squad

The program’s returnees played just a collective 53 games (26 starts) in a Siena uniform entering this season

With the addition of Platek, the Saints now have 11 total newcomers on their 2021–22 roster (seven transfers, four true freshmen)

Siena ranks tied for fourth nationally for the highest number of newcomers on their roster

Four of Siena’s transfers – Platek (North Carolina), **Michael Baer** (Iowa), **Anthony Gaines** (Northwestern), and **Jordan Kellier** (Utah) – matriculate from Power-Five programs, which is tied with five other teams for the most in all of Division I

Cal Poly transfer **Colby Rogers** averaged 12.2 points last season as a sophomore

The Saints achieved a 12–5 overall record last season, including a 12–4 league mark to claim a share of the regular season crown

Siena overcame four separate COVID-19 pauses from Nov. 13 onward, including a 21-day span between games in February

The Saints were the second-to-last Division I team (Merrimack) who played to tip-off their season (Jan. 3)

Siena opened the season with six straight wins to tie for the fourth best start to a season in program history

The Saints were ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top-25 Poll three times, reaching as high as 21st (preseason)

Siena ranked amongst the national leaders in scoring defense (63.0 – 22nd), field goal percentage defense (.409 – 42nd), and field goal percentage (.460 – 69th)

The Saints had three players earn All-MAAC honors, highlighted by MAAC Player of the Year **Manny Camper**

Camper became the second straight Siena player to be named MAAC Player of the Year (**Jalen Pickett**)

Camper is now starring for the NBA G League’s Grand Rapids Gold, while Pickett plays for Penn State

## Siena and the Times Union Center

Siena Basketball achieved the highest average home attendance amongst all 56 Northeast mid-major programs during the 2019-20 season, according to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Attendance Report. Moreover, the Saints broke the top-100 nationally overall in attendance for the 23rd straight season, ranking 83rd overall out of 350 Division I programs with an average of 6,228 fans per game.

Siena leapfrogged Atlantic 10 foe Rhode Island for top billing in Division I Men's Basketball attendance amongst all Northeast mid-major programs during the 2019-20 season. The Northeast is comprised of nine states according to the United States Census Bureau: Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Vermont. Mid-major teams are defined as programs from the 25 conferences which do not comprise "high majors," which are the Power 5 (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, and SEC), AAC, and Big East.

Siena improved 11 spots in the national average attendance rankings to finish 83rd overall in 2019-20, marking the program's highest mark in five years dating back to a ranking of 82nd for the 2014-15 season. The Saints have now ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance for each of the past 23 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move downtown beginning in 1997-98. Siena also stood 12th overall nationally in average home attendance amongst all 263 mid-major programs, an improvement of seven spots from the previous season.

The Saints' average attendance of 6,228 during the 2019-20 season at the Times Union Center was the program's highest mark in four years since averaging 6,269 fans in 2015-16, and outranked the NCAA average of 4,601 by more than 26%. Siena saw an increase in average home attendance of 461 spectators from the 2018-19 campaign, as the 7% improvement was the program's highest in 11 years since achieving a 14% increase in 2008-09 from the 2007-08 season. Additionally, the Saints boasted a pair of capacity crowds of 7,146 fans in 2019-20 against Manhattan (Feb. 16) and in the home finale vs. Niagara (Mar. 4).

Siena ranked third in average home attendance amongst the 22 Division I programs from the state of New York, trailing only national leader Syracuse and other high-major competitor St. John's. However, the Saints outranked 16 high-major programs nationally, including nine Power 5 teams in Boston College, California, Georgia Tech, Miami, Northwestern, Oregon State, Stanford, USC, and Washington State.

The stellar fan support helped propel Siena to a perfect 14-0 record at the Times Union Center in 2019-20, as the Saints were one of just 13 Division I teams nationally to go undefeated at home in 2019-20. Siena achieved an unblemished home mark for the third time in 23 seasons since making the full-time move downtown (17-0 in both 2008-09 and 2009-10), and the 14-game win streak in Albany marks the second longest in program history (38 straight between 2008-10). The Saints won by an average of 11.1 points per game at home in 2019-20, and trailed for a total of just 14:09 over their final seven games at the Times Union Center.

Siena has drawn more than 2.5 million fans over 397 all-time games at the Times Union Center, dating back to the program's first home contest in the facility during the 1990-91 season. The Saints welcomed their two-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 vs. Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions. Siena holds a 263-134 (.662) all-time record at the Times Union Center, including a stellar 248-112 (.689) mark since permanently making the facility its home beginning with the 1997-98 season. Overall, Siena has drawn a total of 2,569,821 fans over 397 dates at the Times Union Center, an average of 6,473 fans per game.

Led the MAAC shooting 65.5% from the floor, and paced Siena with a +/- of +100 (+9.40 per 40 minutes) last season  
Scored in double figures in 11 times last year, highlighted by back-to-back season-high 18-point performances  
Named to the 2020-21 NABC Honors Court and MAAC Academic Honor Roll  
Matriculated to Siena after spending his first two seasons seeing limited action at Pepperdine
