Siena returns to the Capital Region to open a season-long four-game homestand tonight

The Saints' four-game homestand will take place over the span of just seven days

Siena enters its four-game homestand having played just five home games to date over the first three months of the season

The Saints also continue a grueling stretch tonight featuring six games in the span of only 12 days

Siena had played their previous six games prior to this stretch over a 49-day period

Two of the Saints' six games during this current stretch - Jan. 25 at Iona and Feb. 1 vs. Canisius – are COVID makeups

Four of Siena's last five games during the stretch are against teams currently ranked seventh or worse in the MAAC Standings

A pair of road contests bookend the four-game homestand during this stretch

The Saints play the program's milestone 400th game tonight at the facility now known as MVP Arena

Siena holds a 264-135 (.662) all-time record at the facility dating back to 1990

The Saints have averaged 6,466 fans over their first 399 games in the facility

Siena, however, is playing just its second game at "MVP Arena" since the name officially changed on Jan. 1

Prior to Jan. 1, the Saints' home facility had been previously known as the Times Union Center since 2007, and was also previously Pepsi Arena (1997-06) and Knickerbocker Arena (1997-07)

Siena is looking to bounce back after having lost two straight following a four-game winning streak

The Saints have achieved at least a four-game winning streak now in four consecutive seasons

Siena also had its four-game road win streak halted following its last two defeats

The home-opener was the Saints' first regular season game at MVP Arena in 619 days Siena returns just three scholarship players from last year's MAAC Regular Season Co-Champions Siena welcomes back only 29% of its scoring, 26% of its rebounding, and 21% of its assists The returnees played just a collective 53 games (26 starts) in a Siena uniform entering this season With the addition of North Carolina transfer **Andrew Platek** in mid-November, the Saints now have 11

Siena ranks tied for fourth nationally for the highest number of newcomers on their roster
Four of Siena's transfers - Platek (North Carolina), **Michael Baer** (Iowa), **Anthony Gaines**(Northwestern), and **Jordan Kellier** (Utah) - matriculate from Power-Five programs, which is tied with five other teams for the most in all of Division I
The Saints achieved a 12-5 overall record last season, including a 12-4 league mark to claim a share of

# Siena and MVP Arena

Siena Basketball achieved the highest average home attendance amongst all 56 Northeast mid-major programs during the 2019-20 season, according to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Attendance Report. Moreover, the Saints broke the top-100 nationally overall in attendance for the 23rd straight season, ranking 83rd overall out of 350 Division I programs with an average of 6,228 fans per game.

Siena leapfrogged Atlantic 10 foe Rhode Island for top billing in Division I Men's Basketball attendance amongst all Northeast midmajor programs during the 2019–20 season. The Northeast is comprised of nine states according to the United States Census Bureau: Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Vermont. Mid-major teams are defined as programs from the 25 conferences which do not comprise "high majors," which are the Power 5 (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, and SEC), AAC, and Big East.

Siena improved 11 spots in the national average attendance rankings to finish 83rd overall in 2019–20, marking the program's highest mark in five years dating back to a ranking of 82nd for the 2014–15 season. The Saints have now ranked in the top-100 nationally in attendance for each of the past 23 seasons, coinciding with the program's full-time move downtown beginning in 1997–98. Siena also stood 12th overall nationally in average home attendance amongst all 263 mid-major programs, an improvement of seven spots from the previous season.

The Saints' average attendance of 6,228 during the 2019–20 season at MVP Arena was the program's highest mark in four years since averaging 6,269 fans in 2015–16, and outranked the NCAA average of 4,601 by more than 26%. Siena saw an increase in average home attendance of 461 spectators from the 2018–19 campaign, as the 7% improvement was the program's highest in 11 years since achieving a 14% increase in 2008–09 from the 2007–08 season. Additionally, the Saints boasted a pair of capacity crowds of 7,146 fans in 2019–20 against Manhattan (Feb. 16) and in the home finale vs. Niagara (Mar. 4).

Siena ranked third in average home attendance amongst the 22 Division I programs from the state of New York, trailing only national leader Syracuse and other high-major competitor St. John's. However, the Saints outranked 16 high-major programs nationally, including nine Power 5 teams in Boston College, California, Georgia Tech, Miami, Northwestern, Oregon State, Stanford, USC, and Washington State.

The stellar fan support helped propel Siena to a perfect 14-0 record at MVP Arena in 2019-20, as the Saints were one of just 13 Division I teams nationally to go undefeated at home in 2019-20. Siena achieved an unblemished home mark for the third time in 23 seasons since making the full-time move downtown (17-0 in both 2008-09 and 2009-10), and the 14-game win streak in Albany marks the second longest in program history (38 straight between 2008-10). The Saints won by an average of 11.1 points per game at home in 2019-20, and trailed for a total of just 14:09 over their final seven games at MVP Arena.

Siena has drawn more than 2.5 million fans over 399 all-time games at MVP Arena, dating back to the program's first home contest in the facility during the 1990-91 season. The Saints welcomed their two-millionth fan on Dec. 23, 2014 vs. Cornell, and have drawn crowds in excess of 10,000 on 33 occasions. Siena holds a 264-135 (.662) all-time record at MVP Arena, including a stellar 249-113 (.688) mark since permanently making the facility its home beginning with the 1997-98 season. Overall, Siena has drawn a total of 2,579,727 fans over 399 dates at MVP Arena, an average of 6,466 fans per game.
